NRBC INCREASES NUMBER OF OPEN FINALISTS AT 2017 EVENT!

The National Reining Horse Association Board of Directors met on December 20 and in an eleventh hour decision moved to increase the number of Open Finalists at the 2017 NRBC show.

Not only will the 20th NRBC cross the \$20 Million payout mark, it will take an incredible 30 finalists in every Open and Non Pro finals in the Levels 1-4 divisions. Earlier this year the board had opted to increase from 20 to 30 finalists for the L3, L2 and L1 Non Pro divisions, creating a total of 30 more Non Pro finalist spots for the show set for April 16-23.

With this new decision, there will also be 30 more finalists in the Open Classic! So now every eligibility division from L1 to L4 in both the Open and the Non Pro Classic will have 30 finalists.

NRBC President Tom McCutcheon brought the idea of increasing the number of Open Finalists to the board. He said, "Reining has become much more competitive at all levels. We think that doing this will benefit both owners and trainers. More horses will have

a chance to earn important credentials for their records."

According to NRBC Secretary Treasurer Cheryl Magoteaux

Cody, the change came about after

the printed version of the Premium book was printed and mailed. "So the terms and conditions that are in our 2017 Show Premium Book are outdated. We will update the Terms and Conditions on the web site right away."

Cody added, "In a year where we are celebrating 20 years of the NRBC, it seemed fitting to the entire board to increase opportunities for those who participate. Of course, besides the achievement, all NRBC finalists receive paychecks and awards. We are all looking forward to a historic show in 2017!"

WIMPYS LITTLE STEP MAKES HISTORY AGAIN!

One of the most decorated National Reining Horse Association (NRHA) sires has done it again. This time, Wimpys Little Step can thank his 12 offspring in the 2016 NRHA Futurity Finals for helping him achieve his newest milestone, NRHA Nine Million Dollar Sire. At 17 years old, Wimpys Little Step is only the second sire to reach this status. The palomino stallion, bred by Hilldale Farm, is owned by Xtra Quarter Horses, LLC of Purcell, Okla.

Wimpys Little Step is by NRHA's newest Three Million Dollar Sire Nu Chex To Cash and out of Leolita Step. With Shawn Flarida riding, Wimpys Little Step won both the 2002 All American Quarter Horse Congress Futurity and the NRHA Futurity.

Fourteen years later during the 2016 NRHA Futurity, with six offspring in the NRHA Non Pro Futurity Finals, one foal took home a Non Pro Futurity Championship. Wimpys Little Jessie (out of Jessie Dot Tari) ridden by Taylor Zimmerman won the Level 1 Non Pro, in addition to placing third in the Level 3 Non Pro, seventh in the Level 4 Non Pro and third in the Level 2 Non Pro. Collectively Zimmerman and Wimpys Little Jessie took home an estimated \$44,600.

There were an six offspring representing Wimpys Little Step in the Open Futurity. Altogether his 12 money earning offspring made over \$106,810 in the 2016 NRHA Futurity Finals.

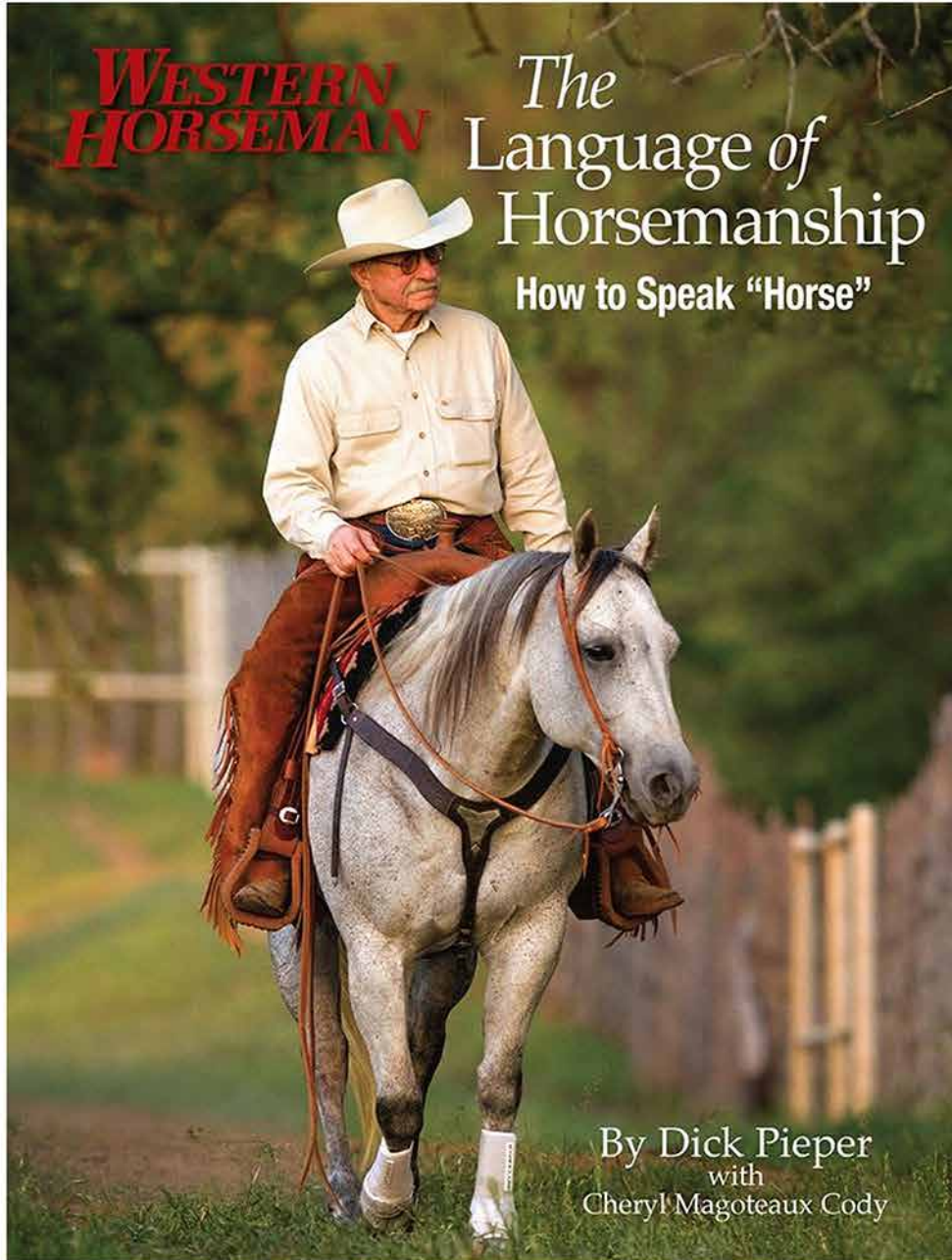

2017 NRHA EUROPEAN FUTURITY AND DERBY UPDATE

Members of the National Reining Horse Association European Affiliate Council (EAC) reconvened in Oklahoma City on December 3. After consideration of the potential dates for the 2017 and 2018 NRHA European Derby, the NRHA European Affiliate Council held a follow-up meeting to reconsider the matter. The dates would burden an already busy Fall show season and would not be ideal. With this in mind, the EAC reversed their decision on 2017 and 2018 NRHA European Derby locations.

The 2017 NRHA European Futurity will be held in

Cremona, Italy on March 27 – April 1, 2017. This NRHA owned event will be managed by the Italian Reining Horse Association.

The 2017 NRHA European Derby will be held in Kreuth, Germany on July 23- July 30, 2017. This NRHA owned event will be managed by NRHA Germany.

The EAC also agreed to hold a meeting in January in conjunction with the NRHA European Summit.

CALLING ALL JUNIOR AND YOUNG RIDER REINERS IN THE USA!

In August of 2017 the inaugural FEI World Reining Championships for Juniors & Young Riders will take place in Switzerland! The qualification period begins January 1, 2017 and to be eligible to compete as an individual or as a member of a team an Athlete must achieve a minimum average score of 67 at one Juniors or Young Riders CRI3* during the qualifying period. Horses must be 7 years of age or older.

Juniors are athletes from the beginning of the year they reach 14 until the end of the year they reach 18. Young Riders are Athletes from the beginning of the year they reach 16 until the end of the year they reach 21.
