# USEF NAMES U.S. REPRESENTATIVES FOR SVAG FEI WORLD REINING CHAMPIONSHIPS

Three horsemen and one horsewoman and their horses will represent Team USA August 11-13 in Switzerland.

The United States Equestrian Federation has announced the athletes and horses that will represent the United States at the 2016 SVAG FEI World Reining Championships August 11-13 in Givrins, Switzerland.

The U.S. will be represented by the following combinations (in alphabetical order):

Shane Brown (Elbert, Colorado) with Susan Geiger's Wind Er Up Wimp, a 2009 American Quarter Horse stallion.

Troy Heikes (Scottsdale, Arizona) with Denise Bixler and Steve Tarani's RSD One Hot Deal, a 2007 American Quarter Horse gelding.

Kari Klingenberg (Scottsdale, Arizona) with Pam Nelson's Mr Electric Spark, a 2009 American Quarter Horse stallion.

Nick Valentine (Pilot Point, Texas) with Glo Tazi's

Hollywood Golden Gun, a 2007 Quarter Horse stallion, or with Denise Bixler and Steve Tarani's Lil Gun Dunit, a 2006 American Quarter Horse gelding.

# The Right Horse at the Right Time Troy Heikes and RSD One Hot Deal

Before Troy Heikes and Denise Bixler met, both were at entirely different places in their reining lives. Heikes wanted to cut back, being selective of his clientele. Bixler was losing enthusiasm and love for the sport. Bixler got hooked on reining during the 2010 Alltech FEI World Equestrian Games (WEG). She became enthralled with the excitement of the sport, especially the thrilling sliding stops. After she witnessed the U.S. Reining Team win a Team Gold medal at the WEG, she longed to be one of the competitors or at least have a horse that could make it to a world competition. As such, she got a couple horses, but learned very quickly she was working with the wrong trainer.

"Personally, I wasn't getting where I wanted to be. My horses were not reaching their full potential. Within a year, I was ready to get out," said Bixler.

Not knowing where to turn, she elicited the help of her friend, Anna Schwartz, a mutual friend of Troy Heikes, who encouraged Heikes to connect with Bixler. What started out as a conversation about helping Bixler find the right trainer quickly turned into one about Heikes competing with her horses.

"I get calls all the time from people talking about their dreams, and sometimes they're bigger than life, but I took it for what it was and decided to look at her horses," reflected Heikes.

When Heikes caught his first look at Bixler's horses, it was like he was on the island of misfit toys. All of them had problems and no one would give them a second look. One horse had been off for eight months with a tendon tear. RSD One Hot Deal, also known as Rudy, just came off an abscess with a quarter of a hoof missing and had a funny looking eye, and Lil' Gun Dun It, or J.J., had a sore back. At the time, these were horses not for the faint of heart. Heikes could not saddle them, let alone ride them.

"I got J.J. vet care and Rudy's hoof grew back. They were horses no one gave a second thought to, no one looked at, and no one could show them. I think it was a much bigger leap of faith on his part than on mine because they really are so talented. I can't believe, looking back, I was the mother who believes her child is gifted," laughed Bixler.

So much for Heikes cutting back. With their awkward, gangly features, Heikes committed to the horses and their idealistic owner. Even Bixler was enjoying the sport again.

Her partnership with Heikes was a match made in heaven and both wanted to give the horses a great experience.

"If we went out and didn't win, I didn't care. I do not think Troy believed me at first. It wasn't about running the horses into the ground to try and get them to win. It was, 'are they at their full potential, and are they happy,' not riding them within an inch of their life to get them to their full potential. That's not who Troy is, and that's why I love him so much," explained Bixler.

Heikes' leap of faith and Bixler's confidence in her horses and in Heikes paid off when Heikes represented the U.S. at the 2014 Alltech FEI World Equestrian Games (WEG) as an individual with Lil' Gun Dun It, a 2006 Quarter Horse gelding. RSD One Hot Deal, a 2007 Quarter Horse gelding, landed an alternate spot. Bixler's dream came true and it was a surreal experience for Heikes.

"It was truly a great feeling and a highlight of my career. A lot of great things have happened to me as a breeder of reining horses, as a trainer, and a coach. The experience of representing U.S.A., competing in a foreign country, and walking in opening ceremonies was overwhelming," said Heikes, who finished just out of the top 10 during the WEG.

Heikes has come a long ways since pretending his bike was a horse, tying ropes to his handlebars like bridle reins. As the veteran international competitor, Heikes will help guide the U.S. Team at the SVAG FEI World Reining Championships in Givrins, Switzerland. This time, he will compete with RSD One Hot Deal and Lil' Gun Dun It will be in the reserve position. Bixler gave RSD One Hot Deal the barnname Rudy, after Rudy Ruettiger, the small, determined, and big-hearted Notre Dame football player. Like his namesake, he may not be the most athletic, but Bixler and Heikes believe in him because of his tenacious inner-drive and positive attitude.

"The name definitely fits. This horse doesn't look like a reining horse. He's long legged, but he is one of those horses who digs in deeper than most horses you ever get to throw a leg over. [Bixler] said someday he's really going to be able to get in [the arena] and play. How she knew, I don't know, but as a six-year-old, he really came into his own and was Reserve Level 3 [National Reining Breeders Classic] Derby Champion. He had a tremendous year as a six-year-old," said Heikes.

Having two horses compete at such a high level goes far beyond Bixler's dreams. If it was not for Heikes, she would have sold the horses. Now, she will have to wait and see if her ambitious horse and his magician rider can claim the Team and Individual Gold medals. "It was just a magical thing that happened when Troy got them [the horses], and he was somehow able to get through to them in the most kind, fair, and generous way. Because of that, you can see the partnerships that they have," said Bixler.



wasn't a 'project horse'. Shane found Denny at Belar Farm and decided that we would fit well together. I trusted his judgment," reflected Geiger.

Denny was not in Colorado for more than a week before he headed to Oklahoma City, Okla. to compete

in the 2015 National Reining Horse Association (NRHA) Derby. Brown's assistant trainer Emily Emerson competed with him in all four levels of the Open division.

"Denny hadn't been shown a lot prior to me getting him. He had a few things that needed work; he's a very physically talented horse who loves to compete. As a rule, he only gives as much as you ask for, but the more you ask the more he gives," said Geiger.

With anticipation, Geiger finally got to ride Denny at the 2015 Rocky Mountain Reining Horse Association Summer Slide Show. However, following the competition, she did not get to ride him again for another six months, as she was needed in Wisconsin to tend to her mother who was experiencing serious health issues. It was during her time away that

# **Shane Brown and Wind Er Up Wimp**

When Shane Brown went horse-scouting in Texas for three clients last June, he did not realize he was bringing his 2016 SVAG FEI World Reining Championships partner, Wind Er Up Wimp or "Denny", back to Colorado with him. Even Brown's aspiring client, and Denny's owner, Susan Geiger was in for a surprise. It all started at the 2011 Ariat Kentucky Reining Cup when Geiger observed Brown and Sheryl Mease's Houston Shine, capture the World Championship Freestyle. During this time, Geiger made a comment to Brown that she wanted a horse that could compete at an international level.

"A little over a year ago, I decided I wanted a horse that

she handed the reins to Brown, who turned Denny into a better horse.

"When I came back, I saw huge development in his spins; he had a very fast rough spin, and Shane smoothed it out in terms of getting them more cadenced. Denny realized he didn't have to give Shane 110 percent; he just went along as Shane asked for more. He kept turning into a better and better horse. His stops are phenomenal. The faster he goes the better he stops. Now, he's just as responsive, but not overly sensitive. He has more confidence in himself and us as his riders," said Geiger.

Denny kept improving the more he competed. In March, both Brown and Geiger competed with him at the 2016 Cactus Reining Classic. Brown and Denny earned a first-place finish in the Ancillary Open division. Following competition, and remembering Geiger's goal, Brown encouraged her to get Denny's passport because he thought Denny had potential to compete at the international level. As a result, Brown and Denny competed at the 2016 National Reining Breeding Classic and Selection Trial for the 2016 SVAG FEI World Reining Championships. They placed second overall and were the top U.S. combination.

"I kept the thought of Susan's goal in my head; she had the interest, and the opportunity came up. She had the horse that was of age and eligible. He is a good, sound horse and definitely an athlete. This was something she wanted to do, so it was all one step at a time," said Brown.

Although Geiger dreamed of having a horse compete in an international-level competition, it was not something Brown thought much about in the beginning of his career. Once he had the clientele and horses that could compete at that level, it became more realistic. Now, Brown will get his chance on the world stage. He will join U.S. teammates Troy Heikes, Kari Klingenberg and Nick Valentine in Switzerland for a chance at a Team Gold medal. Brown worked for Heikes when he was beginning his career, and Heikes played a major role in his decision to become a horse trainer. Competing with him in a major world competition has come full circle.

"Troy and I talk a lot. The fact that he has done this before, the team is drawn to his experience. One of Troy's attributes is he is a really good teacher so he'll be able to



help the team out greatly. This competition will present a different set of challenges, and it's going to be a different experience.

I'm looking forward to the opportunity of representing the U.S. and going with my fellow teammates; that's a different part that we don't get to do in most of our competitions," said Brown.

Brown has the upmost confidence in the 2009 Quarter Horse stallion. "He's a very sound horse and a huge stopper, so I don't have to be overly concerned about what the ground is or isn't like. He didn't start showing until he was five, most start showing at three, which will probably help him because he hasn't been there so many times. He's still waiting and listening and not telling me what to do," said Brown.

Geiger is incredibly proud that her horse and trainer are competing at the 2016 SVAG FEI World Reining Championships. It is an item she can check off her bucket list. No matter the result, she knows she will come home with her fun-loving horse and skillful trainer. However, there is a chance medals could accompany her. Winning them runs in Denny's family. His half-brother Yellow Jersey was part of the Gold medal winning U.S. team and won an Individual Bronze Medal with Mandy McCutcheon at the Alltech FEI World Equestrian Games in 2014.

"I can't think of anybody that deserves it more than Shane. It's his time. I am beyond excited that my horse made the U.S. Team, and I don't think that this would have happened without Shane as my trainer. I am also very aware that this affects his other clients as well, and that it is because he has such a good assistant trainer in Emily Emerson that he is able to take the time to go to Switzerland," explained Geiger.

The 2016 SVAG FEI World Reining Championships take place August 11-13 in Givrins, Switzerland.

Amberley Snyder earned national recognition in 2015 when she was invited to compete at RFD-TV's THE AMERICAN Presented

by Polaris RANGER, which paid out \$2 Million in cash awards. The world's richest one-day rodeo also made a special presentation to Amberley to benefit her Future Farmers of America Amberley Snyder Courage Fund, which recognizes those that have overcome life's challenges to be an inspiration to others.



Snyder has been riding since she was three and competing in rodeos since she was seven years old. Rodeo became a passion and the love only got stronger as time went on. In 2009, she qualified for both the National High School Finals Rodeo and the National Little Britches Finals where she won the Finals and World All-Around Championships as well as finishing in the top 6 three events.

Then, In January of 2010 she was driving to the National Western Stock Show in Colorado when she was involved in a rollover car accident leaving her paralyzed from the waist down. Doctors told her she would never have any chance of walking again and that her days



spent on a horse were over. A year and a half later, she figured out how she could barrel race once again using a seatbelt, Velcro and another strap to hold her in place. Through her competition and through her motivational message a worldwide audience began to get to know this exceptional individual.

"Everything happens for a reason, and there's a reason this happened to me," she says. "I have zero doubt

I will walk again. Five years in a wheelchair just blows my mind. But it's not forever. The opportunities have outweighed the bad things."

# A SPARKLING VINTAGE IS NEWEST NRHA MILLION DOLLAR SIRE

During the 2016 NRHA Derby, A Sparking Vintage became the National Reining Horse Association's newest Million Dollar when his two highest ranking offspring, Not Ruf At All and Platinum Vintage, made it into the top ten. A Sparkling Vintage is the 27th NRHA Million Dollar Sire.

By NRHA Four Million Dollar Sire Shining Spark and out of Vintage Badger, this 1997 bay stallion has an impressive reining resume that includes the 2001 National Reining Breeder's Cup (NRBC) Intermediate Open Derby Champion, the 2001 NRHA Open Futurity Top Five, and the 2002 ANCR Maturity Open Champion and Limited Open Champion. His Lifetime earnings total \$82,000. The stallion is currently owned by Silver Spurs Equine.

2013 NRHA Futurity Champion Not Ruf At All (LTE \$415,766.08) became the 2016 NRHA Open Derby Reserve Champion after winning the 2016 NRBC. Second ranking offspring, 2015 NRHA Open Derby Champion Platinum Vintage (LTE \$197,945.04), placed in the top



The pair set the bar scoring a 223.5 and remained unbeat. Aboard the 8-year-old stallion by Tidal Wave Jac and out of What A Sunrise, owned by Vannietvelt/



De Pauw, the NRHA Million Dollar Rider last year claimed the NRHA Open World Championship. "What can I say, he is a great athlete with a big heart and I have to give credit to Craig Schmersal, who we bought him from, for the wonderful job he did with him," said Fonck.

Sliding to the second step of the podium was yet another NRHA Million Dollar Rider, Rudi Kronsteiner of Germany. Aboard the 8-year-old stallion owned by Glis Ranch, Dr Lee Hook (Ray Gay Quixote x Chickadualsha), Kronsteiner posted a 221.5.

The 2015 NRHA Open World Reserve Champions, Cira Baeck and Whizasunnysailor BB owned by Ruediger Diedenhofen placed third. The 8-year-old stallion is an own son of NRHA Eleven Million Dollar Sire Topsail Whiz and out of Walla Walla Sunshine. The duo closed their run with a 220.5.
