TAMARACK RANCH DEVELOPING HORSE FUTURITY JOINS TULSA REINING CLASSIC

The Tamarack Ranch Developing Horse Futurity will be the first of the major aged events held during the Tulsa Reining Classic and the headline event is set to begin August 31 at 9 am. The show, which takes place at Tulsa's Expo Center, has a rich tradition of innovative classes and exhibitor-friendly policies and the Developing Horse Futurity is one of its most popular.

Tamarack Ranch, of Joseph, Oregon has come on board as naming sponsor of the event for 2016. The developing horse futurity has attracted the attention of riders worldwide who are interested in showing those "not quite ready for prime-time" horses. Its level playing field protects those horses that peak later, performance-wise, and is considered an important step toward lengthening the show careers of reining horses.

Popular from its inception, the futurity keeps growing yearly and its new sponsors are proud to stand behind an event that has such a positive impact on the industry. NRHA Professional Gabe Hutchins said "It seems like every year we all have a 3-year-old not that is quite ready when it comes time for those early futurities. We still want to find out what we have – and season them – so this gives a great place and opportunity to show them. Probably a lot of those horses, brought on at their own pace – will go on to Oklahoma City and be fine. In the meantime, for horses that excel at different times there is still an event to show and potentially win something."

Colleen McQuay of Global Reining Sport Group which produces the event, was glad to welcome Tamarack Ranch on board. She said, "Gabe Hutchins and the team at Tama-

rack Ranch have a keen eye on the industry and how the young horses are be trained and brought along in their reining careers and therefore the developing futurity is a perfect fit for them."

Tamarack Ranch was established by Pat Simar and his wife Suzy. Located in Oregon's mountainous northeast corner, it began with a love of horses first in the form of riding and ranch horses. When that progressed to a desire to do something competitive the Simars started with the local trainer Matt McDowell. Reining had great appeal and goal one was to establish an exceptional set of broodmares.

A few years ago Hutchins sold some horses to the ranch.

From that a business relationship began and grew to Gabe keeping over a dozen Tamarack Ranch horses in training. Creating a training facility at the ranch in Oregon was the logical next step. Now under construction, the facility should be completed late summer and Gabe and his wife Suzi (currently at Hickory Creek Ranch in Armore, Oklahoma) will relocate to Oregon after the Tulsa Reining Classic.

Gabe noted, "With the great band of broodmares there are now 12 yearlings and 18 babies on the ground. The facility is definitely growing and the plan is to have really nice yearlings to sell every fall and keep some to show too. The ranch is just to the point of having enough horses to do that and we are really looking forward to the future. "

The National Reining Horse Association will host the NRHA High School Reining Championship during the 2016 NRHA Derby. Eight of the most talented high school riders will represent their association to compete for the 'Slide of their Lives': four riders from the 2015 NRHA Youth 14-18 Top Ten and four from the 2015 14-18 North American Affiliate Championship (NAAC) class.

It's well known how competitive the World Champion race is, resulting in a list of riders who are seasoned athletes and highly driven. The youth riders from the NRHA Youth 14-18 Top Ten are Terri June Granger, Emily Morris, Emily Sitzman and Claire Streeter.

The four riders from the 2015 Youth 14-18 NAAC class have already secured a championship after working all of the 2015 show season to qualify for the 2015 NAAC class. These riders are Annabeth Payne, Kenleigh Wells, Kaitlyn Baker and McKenzie Duncan.

These eight high school riders will draw a horse at random donated by supporters, and only have five minutes of warm-up time before

NRHA TO HOST COLLEGIATE REINING CHAMPIONSHIP DURING NRHA DERBY

The National Reining Horse Association will host the annual NRHA Collegiate Reining Championship during the 2016 NRHA Derby. 12 of the most notable collegiate riders will represent their association to compete for the slide of their lives: four riders selected by NRHA, four from the Intercollegiate Horse Show Association (IHSA), and four from the National Collegiate Equestrian Association (NCEA).

Holly Phillips took home the title of 2015 NRHA Col-

legiate Reining Championship aboard Olenas ChocolaChic donated by Maurice Robinson and Buchanan Performance Horses. Phillips from Fremont, Ohio, will defend her championship title this year representing the NRHA again alongside three other members.

Riders chosen to represent NRHA went to go through an application process to in order to compete. The riders chosen are Danielle Cohen from Stillwater, Okla., Blair

McFarlin from Franklin, Tenn., and Kyndall Harper from St. Augustine, Fla.

Four riders chosen to represent IHSA from the 2015-2016 show season are: Leah Piper (Middle Tennessee State), Kelsey Wilson (West Texas A&M), Dylan Dombrowski (Cazenovia College), and Sarah Yu (Ohio State University).

The four riders selected to represent the NCEA from the 2015-2016 show season are as follows: Taylor Brown (Fresno State), Chantz Stewart (Texas Christian University), Hannah Jechow (Texas A&M), and Ebba Lange (Oklahoma State).

These 12 collegiate riders will experience the ultimate catch ride as they compete aboard horses donated by gener-

ous supports of the program. Riders will participate in a random draw before the event to decide which horse they will ride. A true testimony to the skill set of these competitors, they only have five minutes of warm up time before they walk down the gateway of champions and compete for the title of NRHA Collegiate Catch Ride Champion. The Equine Industry Vision Award is the first major award to showcase innovation across the equine industry. Established and sponsored by Zoetis, the presti-

He helped create many programs, including the AAEP Foundation and the On Call program, which provides veterinarians to discuss horse health on equine event telecasts. Carpenter's continued encouragement of the equine industry to work together also led to the inception of the Horse Industry Alliance.

While with AQHA, Carpenter was instrumental in the development and renovation of the American Quarter Horse Hall of Fame & Museum. Carpenter strongly believes that preserving the stories and history of great horses and

equestrians is key to showcasing the impact horses have on our lives.

In his current position as commissioner and CEO of the NRHA, Carpenter's leadership and dedication to growing the sport of reining has led to a new office and hall of fame location. He is also spearheading an upgrade of the NRHA's information technology platform to provide fast, effective information to its members.

"I am honored by the opportunity to join the outstanding list of recipients of the Equine Industry Vision Award," Carpenter said. "My personal interest has always been to connect people with horses, knowing the positive effect they have had on my life. My career has truly been a labor of love, and I hope the initiatives I have contributed to have inspired others to get involved."

Carpenter is chair of the Horse Show Committee for the American Horse Council and has previously served as a member of the council's Government Affairs Advisory Committee and Animal Welfare Committee. He is also chair of the Equine Science Advisory Committee at his alma mater, Colorado State University. Carpenter recently assisted in connecting two Colorado State academic programs, occupational therapy and equine science, to study the potential benefits of equine-assisted therapy.

ITALY TO HOST THE 2016 NRHA EUROPEAN DERBY & PRE FUTURITY

At the May 2016 National Reining Horse Association (NRHA) Board of Directors meeting, the board was presented with a proposal brought forward by Gerd Wilhelm (Germany), Roberto Coughi (Italy) and Francois Zurcher (Switzerland/France) to create a platform organization – the European Federation of Reining Associations (EFRA) – for all NRHA European Affiliates.

The board approved to move forward in creating a Memo of Understanding followed by a contractual agreement to set the parameters and expectations of the arrangement with the European Federation of Reining Associations (EFRA). NRHA and the above listed ERFA representatives are working toward that end.

“Although NRHA is very hopeful and optimistic about the long-term results of this concept, unfortunately it has caused a sudden change in plans regarding the 2016 NRHA European Derby,” commented NRHA Commissioner Gary Carpenter. “We were excited about possibilities of working with the AMERICANA. They have been

very gracious in working with us, and we appreciate their cooperation and professionalism.”

Considering the above changes, the 2016 NRHA European Derby & Pre Futurity will now be held at the Palasturla in Manerbio, Italy, on September 19 – 24, and will be managed by the Italian Reining Horse Association (IRHA).

“Following the agreement between the NRHA and the ERFA, moving forward, the NRHA European Derby will be held in Italy in conjunction with the IRHA Derby,” said Roberto Cuoghi. “For this reason, and because of the sudden changes in plans, we felt it was appropriate to try to host the European Derby in Italy this year as well and reached an agreement to host the event in Manerbio. We are working very hard to make this event as successful as it has always been and to further promoting the sport of Reining in Europe in years to come.”

TOPSAIL WHIZ BECOMES FIRST NRHA \$11 MILLION SIRE

Always in a league of his own, Topsail Whiz has made yet another milestone in the world of Reining. The late Topsail Whiz has now become NRHA’s one and only 11 Million Dollar Sire. Less than two years after hitting the 10 Million milestone, the legacy of Topsail Whiz lives on.

Coming from a dynasty of famous reining sires, the 1987 stallion owned by six-time NRHA Futurity Champion and Hall of Fame Inductee, Bob Loomis Reining Horses was sired by Topsail Cody, an NRHA Million Dollar Sire, and out of Jeanie Whiz Bar (by Cee Red). Topsail Whiz was

third in the 1990 NRHA Open Futurity with Loomis at the reins. Topsail Whiz was inducted into the NRHA Hall of Fame in 2003.

Following an outstanding reining career, earning nearly \$50,000, he retired to the breeding shed, becoming NRHA’s All-Time Leading Sire based on his money-earning offspring. Having sired several champions in the NRHA Futurity and Derby in both the open and non pro divisions, Topsail Whiz has become a household name in the sport of Reining. Just some of the most well-known offspring sire



by Topsail Whiz include: 1996 NRHA Futurity Champion Whizard Jac, 2003 NRHA Futurity Champion The Great Whiz, 2005 NRBC L3 Champion Easy Otie Whiz, 2001 NRHA Derby Reserve Champion West Coast Whiz, 1999 NRHA Derby Champion Topgun Whiz and 2011 NRHA Derby Reserve Champion Whiskey N Diamonds. Topsail Whiz is the sire of Million Dollar Sires West Coast Whiz, Whizard Jac, and Walla Walla Whiz, as well as Two Million Dollar Sires Conquistador Whiz and Whiz N Tag Chex.
