2016 HIGH ROLLER REINING CLASSIC

The 9-year-old High Roller Reining Classic, September 9th through 17th, at the South Point Event Center, Hotel and Casino in Las Vegas is the largest of the four reining competitions presented annually by the Scottsdale, Arizona-based Brumley Management Group,

The action began when the first reiner stepped eagerly into the Priefert Arena on September 9 and when the dust had settled, the outcome proved to be a very nice win in the High Roller Classic Open for Tom Foran and Blue Collar Tag. Blue Collar Tag is owned by Sleipner, LLC of Beverly Hills, California. The 8-year-old bay gelding is sired by Two Million Dollar Sire, Whiz N Tag Chex. Foran and Blue

Collar Tag turned in a 74, which was also the high score of the day. Crystal McNutt and White Gunpowder placed second with a 73.5. Owner Kim Niven won on White Gunpowder last spring at the Wild

Card Challenge in the Prime Time Non Pro.

The Intermediate Open was won by Maya Stessin and Gunsmokes TNT, the Limited Open by Spook Dunit and Jesus Chavez, the Rookie Professional by Daphne Thompson and Check Your Gun Lad, and the Open Cat 4 by Jessica Dooley and Maybe Lou Dunit.

Saturday spotlighted the kids!. In the Short Stirrup division Addisyn Schmersal teamed Cromer Out Whiz to win with a solid 70 score. The Youth 13 & Under class was the largest of the "kid" classes with 19 entries, though the Youth 14 -18 was not far behind with 18 teenagers participating. Winner of

the 13 & Under was Luca Fappani, riding Custom Spook, the horse Andrea Fappani rode at the HRRC last year to win the USEF Open. Luca tied for second as well, riding his mom's horse, Premier Diamond. Caroline Buchanan tied with him for second, riding Lucky Cee Blair. Caroline won the individual Gold Medal at last year's HRRC Youth Tournament. Kate Buchanan (Bronze individual Medal in the 2015) won the 14-18 with her good Vintage Neptune.

Kaylee Naylor was second with Spookamatic. All of these winning kids are from Scottsdale, except for Addisyn who hails from Oklahoma. In the Breed Restricted Arabian competition Siena Krueger won the 13 & Under with VLQ Friendly Fire and Abbey Weiss won the 14-18 on Dun With Style RA.

The Youth classes were larger than anticipated and ran late, eventually pushing the show up to 10 pm Saturday night. In the Rookie competition Laura Johnson and Vintage Sparks won the Level 2 and 1 Rookie, as well as the DRHA Rookie and the Green Reiner. Joe Moran and AR Guns N Roses won the Prime Time Rookie and Leah Miller and Jac Be Whizard won the Green As Grass. After the kids finished up in the Lucas Arena, Robyn Schiller rode Plenty Of Guns to win the Novice Horse Non Pro with a solid 72 and then took second as well, posting a 71.5 with CD Star Commander and taking home total prize money just over a \$1000 for her efforts. Dan Huss won the Novice Horse Level 2 with Chics Dream for owner, Morris Kulmer of Bountiful, Utah. Shane Brown and Wimpys Lucky Girl were a half point behind to take

second place for Holly Van Duys of Westcliffe, Colorado. At evening's end Crystal McNutt teamed Zee Gunslinger to win the NARHA 4/5 Yr Old Open Arabian Futurity, taking home over \$1,600 for the run.

Following the WPR (World Para Reining) competition was television coverage for the local Tina Montana show, "What's Country in Vegas". The camera crew was visible all Saturday afternoon,

interviewing and filming the WPR riders especially the charming and energetic Freddy Win and his talented Reiner, Downright Juicy (Trucker). "Trucker" is owned by Juli Moran and trained by Ashley Kelkenberg.

On Sunday the kids started the ball rolling once again and continued to entertain and earn applause throughout the morning session and into the afternoon at the Lucas Oil Arena. In the Short Stirrup division Addisyn Schmersal held on to the lead she took yesterday with Cromer Out Whiz to win, besting her Saturday 70 score with a 71. Luca Fappani did the same thing in the Youth 13 & Under class riding Custom Spook into first place and tying for second on Premier Diamond with Ashley Jackson and Smart Like

Steady, Caroline Buchanan (on BOTH Spark Me Again and Lucky Cee Blair) and Bo Van Duys on Aim Your Pistol. Gina Schumacher won the 14-18, posting a sterling 73 with Judys A Little Moody. Kaylee



Naylor was second with All Natural Shine (same young lady as yesterday but on a different horse). In the Breed Restricted Arabian competition Siena Krueger won the 13 & Under again with VLQ Friendly Fire and Abbey Weiss owned the 14-18 one more time with Dun With Style RA.

NARHA Youth Tournament prizes were awarded in front of an appreciative crowd, with the Gold Medal award and the big scholarship money going to Team 19 – Luca Fappani, Custom Spook; Adrianna Adams, Cashen Big Chex; Siena Krueger, VLQ Friendly Fire; Sophia Polumbo, Miss Trashy Lady and McKenna Bein, MK Check Please. Luca also took the individual Gold Medal. Individual Silver Medal went to Kate Buchanan on Vintage Neptune and Individual Bronze went to Kaylee Naylor and her two good Reiners, Spookamatic and All Natural Shine.

Late afternoon in the Lucas Arena brought the Open Novice Horses and a nice score of 74 plus the win for

Pedro Baiao and Hesa Sparklin Crome. Dan Huss grabbed the Reserve spot with a 73.5 on Maximum Dream. Robyn Schiller teamed Plenty of Guns to win the Novice Horse Non Pro Level 2, followed by a 4-way tie for second with Melinda Cresap, ARC King Snapper; Derek Brummett, Thischicsamistress; Melissa Wigen, Dunit In Wranglers and Gillian Galligan, Magnums Chic Dun It, all claiming a piece of the action! Meanwhile in the Preifert Arena, across the way, well over a hundred entries were slugging it out until 7:30 pm in the early evening for the Rookie titles. When the dust settled, Tracy Burnside and Honky Tonkin Dream had won the Rookie Level 2 and the Prime Time Rookie. Laura Johnson had tied for fourth in the Rookie 2, while winning the Rookie Level 1, the DRHA Rookie and the DRHA Green Reiner. That left the Green As Grass title to a delighted Jac Bee Whiz and rider Dana Pastorino. The WPR group finished up their competition with newcomer Erin Reid winning the first day's competition on Twylite Zone, owned by Ashlye Daniel. On Sunday, Kim Olivetto and Optimus Shine tied for first with Briana Bartlett on Western Whiz. Debbie Brown and Arkys Smart Leo Lad won the NARHA 4/5 Yr Old Half-Arabian Futurity Level 4, taking home over \$1,200 for their efforts. Tyson Randle missed by a half-point to take Reserve honors with Destined To Shine and nearly \$1,000 for his trouble. Arkys Smart Leo Lad is *Bask, Bay El Bey and *Serafix-bred on his Arabian sire's side and Peppy San Badger plus Smart Little Lena breeding from his Quarter horse dam. The NARHA Futurity Level 1 was a duel between brothers Nathan Kent and SH Smoke N Sparks and Preston Kent and SH Rockin Reminic with Nathan edging his brother out this time.

There were almost a hundred entries in the Non Pro and that kept all of us busy until after 7 pm. Paige Diamond beat this big bunch with a solid 73 on her great champion, Diamond Oak. Kylie Robinson and Wimpys Tonnob took Reserve with a 72 and Megan Dante teamed Lookies Gotta Gun to mark a 71.5 for third.

There were over a hundred entries in the Non Pro Tuesday and that held everyone's attention from dawn until early evening. Top team of the day was Gina Schumacher and Snip O Lution. The Texas duo posted a 72.5 early on and held the lead throughout the competition. Snip O Lution (Einsteins Revolution) was a 2012 NRHA/Markel Insurance Marketplace Sale graduate that came to national notoriety in 2014 by winning the Lucas Oil Open go around Level 4 NRHA Futurity. The 5-year-old Palomino is both handsome and talented. Second place honors went to Michael Garnett and Spooksgottachicolena. Four teams tied for third by posting 71 scores: Jeanne Levine and Whizen Thru The Cash, Gina Schumacher and Judys A Little Moody and Cady Shaw, riding both Bulletproof and Dream Whiz Me.

The title in the Prime Time Non Pro division went to Jeanne Levine and her great gelding Whizen Thru The

Cash. Jeanne and "Champ" have been hitting some serious high notes over the past year following their big win at Reining By The Bay in 2015. Second and third went to Cady Shaw and her two horses, Bulletproof and Dream Whiz Me. In the NP Masters and the Intermediate Non Pro Jackie Redish and Custom Smart Juice were on top with Kathy Copus and Gunball Machine slipping into second place. Also in the NP Masters and Intermediate Non Pro money was the familiar star of television and motion pictures, William Shatner, riding Smart In Coryagable. The "Captain of the Starship Enterprise" was vocal and aggressive in his warm-up and his time in the show pen, particularly impressive when you consider that he is now 86 and still riding and competing in Reining!

In the NRHA Non Pro Category 4, fourteen Arabians competed. Audrey Hart took the top spot riding Dunit On Fyre RA, with Linda Jacobs in the Reserve spot on Al Marah Matt Dillon. Abbey Weiss was third on Dun With Style RA.

Just as promised the action began early on Wednesday morning and simply never stopped. The Limited Non Pro took over the Priefert Arena and 78 competitors lined up to back their horse and rider team's athletic ability with real reining action. Midway through the day, Megan Dante and Lookies Gotta Gun posted a sizzling 73 and held on to the lead to win the title. Jenny Ricotta and SS Spyderman posted a 71.5 to take reserve and Patricia Cooley and Irishdotcom tied with Laura Thomas and Dun With Me for third place honors.

Tamarack Ranch Non Pro Futurity Won by James Morgan and Partychicatrashya

Wednesday in the Lucas Arena showcased the \$21,000 Added Tamarack Ranch Non Pro Futurity, the \$10,000 Added Smartpak Non Pro Maturity and the NARHA Arabian/Half-Arabian Non Pro Futurity. In the Tamarack Futurity, James Morgan rode Partychicatrashya to win both the Level 4 and 3, taking home a handsome \$6,113.13 for

Chic taking reserve in both the Level 2 and Level 1.

In the \$2,500 Added NARHA Arabian/Half-Arabian Level 4 Non Pro Futurity, the Manager of the Brumley Management Group, Amanda Brumley, won the competi-

tion and the \$1,856.25 on her handsome Arabian gelding, TS Mae Gossip. Abbey Weiss and TR Flash Flood took home \$1,237.50 for reserve.

Cohen Wins Level 4 SmartPak Non Pro Maturity

In the Level 4 SmartPak Non Pro Maturity, Dana Cohen rode Magnum Refund to win both the Level 4 and 3. Cori Vokoun was reserve in those two divisions with Whizin Off Sparks, and won the Level 2 and 1 for good measure.

Some top Arabian and Half-Arabian reiners showed up for the NARHA class with Audrey Hart scoring the top money on Dunit On Fyre RA. Linda Jacobs and Al Marah Matt Dillon were reserve and Chandler Hiser teamed Hollywood Honey to take third.

One of the day's great highlights was the Pony Races, a fund raiser for the NARHA and their outstanding Youth program. The races featured some big name NRHA train-

Race winner and Calcutta winner was Jordan

McBurney and her husband Sean. It was a wonderful and entertaining evening and a great High Roller Reining Classic moment.

Thursday was the final morning for Non Pro action in the Priefert Arena at the 2016 High Roller Reining Classic. After warming up with great runs in the Maturity yesterday, Melissa Wigin and Dunit In Wranglers came back

to win this morning in the Non Pro, while Wimpys Little Nite and Courtney Battison took home the reserve. In the Prime Time, DeWayne Copus and Daddy Day Care scored a 72 to win both this and the Masters, while Britta Jacobsen and Okie Wimpys turned in a 71.5 for second place honors in the Prime Time. Gayle Samuelson and Doubleshot Shotgun were reserve in the Masters. The two big Non Pro winners of the day, Melissa Wigen and DeWayne Copus, then tied for first in the Intermediate. The Arabians enjoyed their Non Pro competition too, with Chandler Hiser winning on his Hollywood Honey and Linda Jacobs taking reserve with Al Marah Matt Dillon, capping off a great day of Non Pro competition.

Andrea Fappani Rides Ifwhizwereguns To Win Tamarack Ranch Open Futurity

Of course, the day's main focus was on the Lucas Oil Arena where the Pros were showing off many of their very best 2016 National three-year-old prospects in the \$80,000 Added Tamarack Ranch Open Futurity. Almost a hundred young horses showed up to try out their legs and show off their young talents. It was definitely the Class of the Class of 2013. In the Level 4 it cost a minimum score of a 217.5 just to make a paycheck at this party. In the first hour Franco Bertolani and Hollywood Nites set the tone with a solid 217.5. Then Craig Schmersal with Wimpys Little Spook and Casey Deary with HA Calico Joe posted 219's, and that was before lunch. At lunchtime Jordan McBurney and Gibsons Finest (the only lady in the Level 4 money and the winner of the Level 3) and Jason Vanlandingham both threw down 220's. Those scores held well until 2:45 when Shawn Florida and Spooks The Hard Way turned in a beautiful run and posted a 221. Most of us thought that was the end of it, until about 5 pm with just a single handful of horses left to show,

The owners, B & L Holdings LLC took home \$14,662.50 and Patricia Holtzman, who owns Spooks The Hard Way, made a handsome \$8,925.00 for the reserve placing.

Mizzen Gunner and Jesse Beckley were fifth in the Level 4 and reserve in the Level 3 to take home over \$11,000. Ruben Van Dorp and Smart Twinkletown won

the Level 2 and earned close to \$13,000 between the level placements. Reserve in the Level 2 was Justa Cool Nite and Francesco Martinotti. Kari Klingenberg won the Level 1 with Gunnachicya.

Most of these superlative young horses are on their way to more Futurities this fall and winter, of course. Like the other competing trainers, Josiah Haaby, who rode Smart Chics Boomer to reserve honors in the Level 1, was already making plans for the upcoming weeks and months. "We bought this filly at the NRHA Sale in Oklahoma City and this is her second show," says Si who hails from Dragonfly Ranch in Oregon. "She had a good run, her stops were great and we need to work on the turns. She'll be up at the Idaho Low Roller and then at Oklahoma. She's owned by Sandra Tow, Redmond, Oregon."

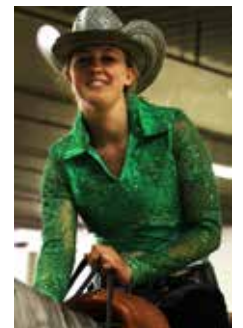

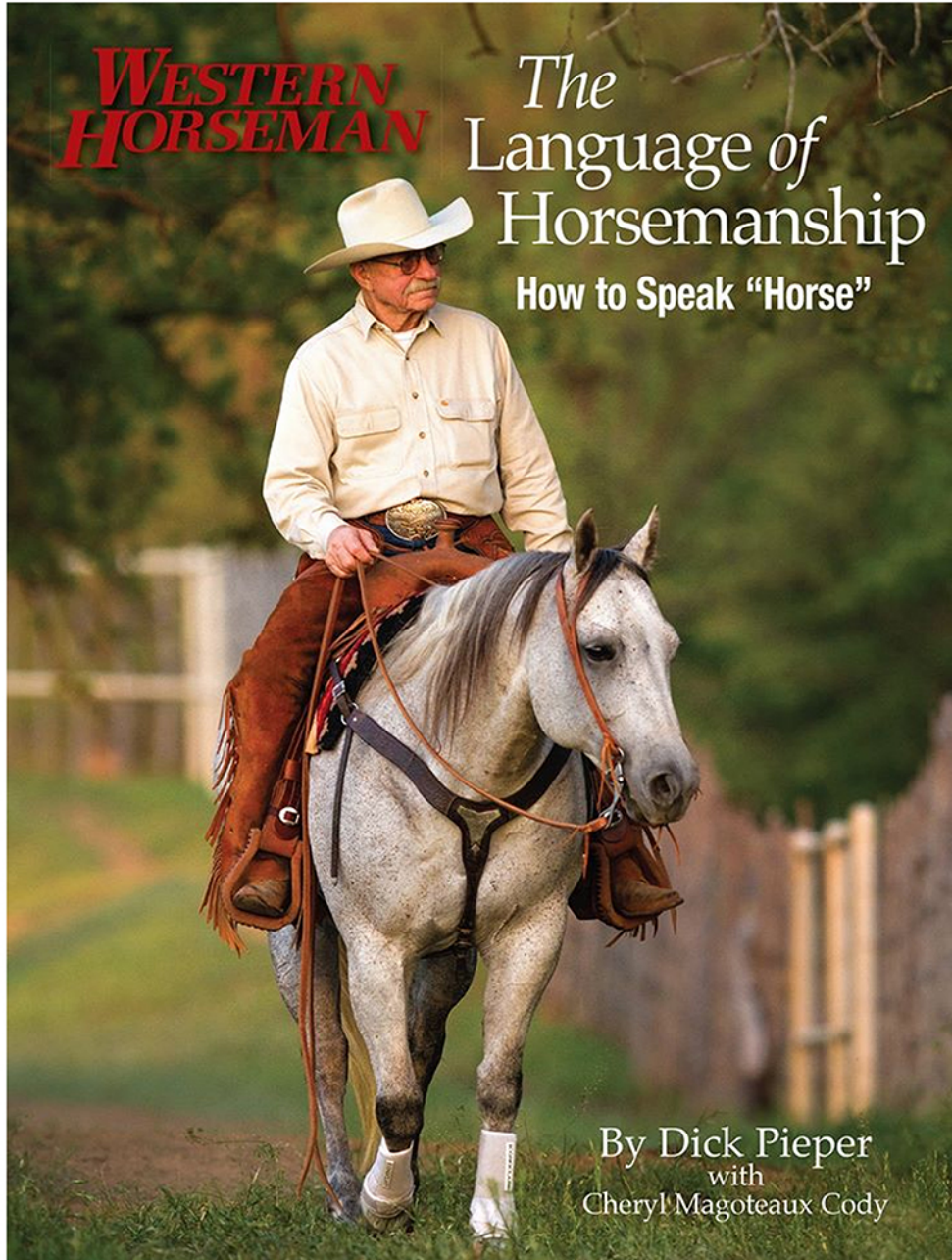

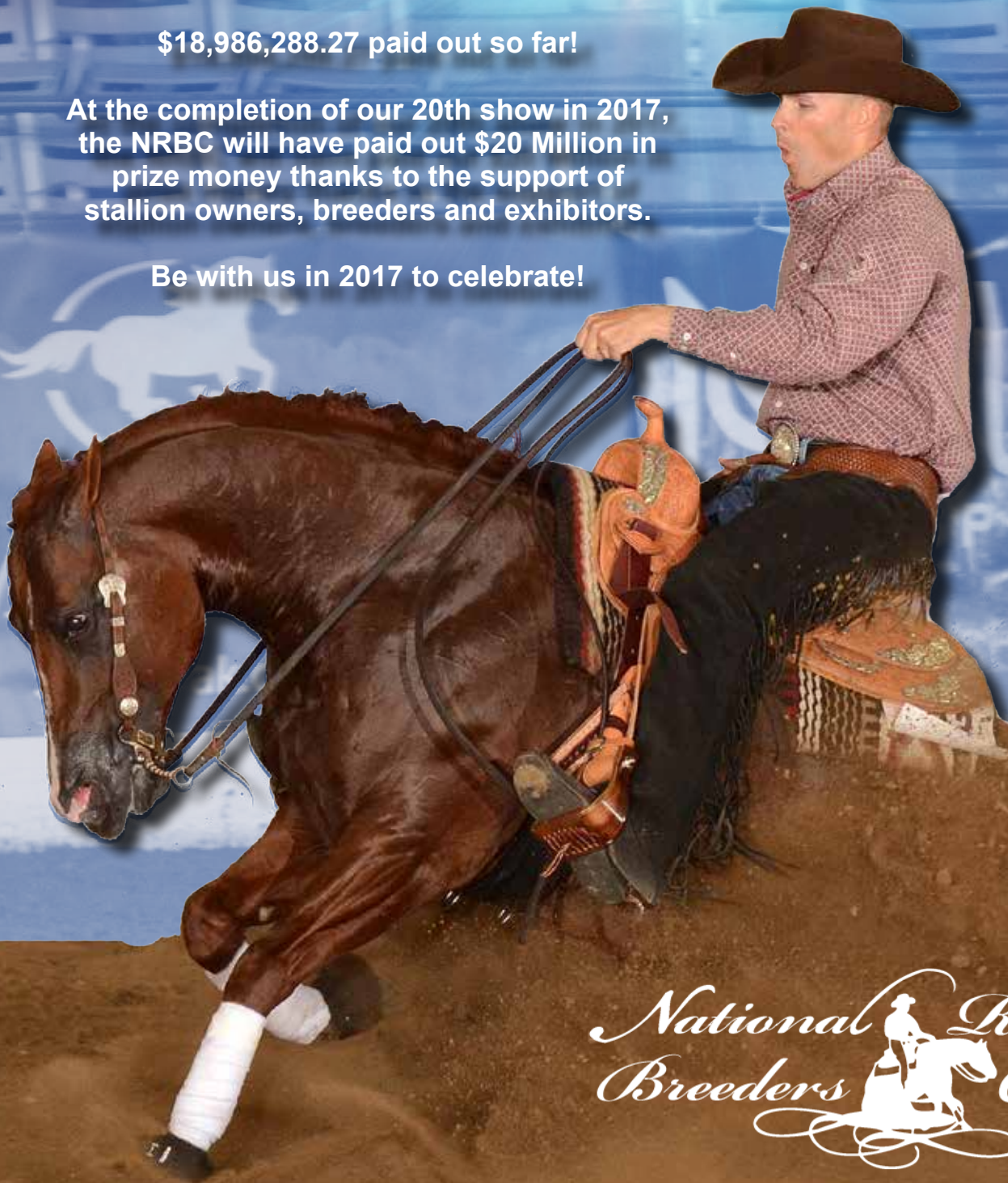

2016 NRHA EUROPEAN DERBY & PRE FUTURITY REINING ACTION IN MANERBIO

The National Reining Horse Association (NRHA) European Derby & Pre Futurity began with NRHA ancillary classes. Winning the €400-added NRHA Novice Horse Non Pro Level (L)2, in a field of 56 entries, was Italian Tommaso Coltrioli with his Gunslinger Lil Step between the reins. Aboard the 6-year-old American Quarter Horse sorrel stallion by Wimpys Little Step and out of Playguns Rose, Coltrioli scored a 144 for the win.

Topping the €400-added Novice Horse L2 Open, which counted 54 entries, was NRHA Million Dollar Rider Bernard Fonck riding DJ Ruf (Sailin Ruf x RS Dewars Jack). The 5-year-old American Quarter Horse sorrel stallion owned by Cosimo Grippa with Fonck in the saddle closed with a 144.5 score.

Fonck Wins €1.875-added NRHA Open

2014 NRHA Open World Champions, Ebony Spook and Ann Fonck, once again left their mark in the show pen. The talented 8-year-old mare by NRHA Three Million Dollar Sire Smart Spook and out of Ebony Whiz, slid to the highest step of the podium after posting a 218.

Reserve honors went to Italian Pierluigi Chioldo and RS Poliphemus Jac (RS Great Jac Feona x Harlan Glo), a 10-year-old stallion owned by Piet Mestdagh.

Bernard Fonck wins 2016 NRHA European Open Pre Futurity presented by Rabboni Quarter Horses

The 2016 National Reining Horse Association (NRHA) European Derby & Pre Futurity offered an action packed day in Manerbio, Italy, on the fifth day of competition.

The first champions crowned were the €1,500-added NRHA European Level (L)4 and L2 Open Pre Futurity winners. NRHA Million Dollar Rider Bernard Fonck took home the L4 championship riding Red Collar Tag, (Whiz N Tag Chex x Kachina Oak) for owner Sabine Lisec with a 219.5. “We’ve had this horse ever since he was a weanling. Since he was for sale I told Sabine (Lisec) that I thought he would be a good prospect for her and



she decided to purchase him. I’ve only schooled him a couple of times before showing him today and I must admit

that he felt really good. It looks like he’s going to be a good horse!” said Fonck who also took reserve honors riding Missedouttinseltown (Hollywoodstinseltown x Miss Sliding Peppy), owned by Dries Verschueren, after posting a 218.

Winning the €1,000-added Open L2 of the Pre Futurity was Fonck’s assistant trainer, Lorenzo De Simone, aboard Gildo and Giuliano Mercuri’s The Chromed Gun (The Cocked Gun x Custom Highlights). “I’m so happy to have won this title with this mare. She was really quiet, was with me all the way and proved what a big stopper she is. I cannot thank her owners enough for trusting me with her,” commented De Simone following his win.

The reserve championship was for Matteo Vedovato and Hot Miffy Cd (Mifillenum x Hot Tamale Baby), owned by Vittorio Rabboni,

Prior to the European Pre Futurity, the €400-added NRHA Limited Non Pro and €800-added Intermediate Non Pro were held. French Charlene Aubretton and A Reminic Star, (Lenas Starfish x Miss Reminic Chex) owned by CJA Quarter Horses, posted a 143 to win both classes.

Luke Phillimore and Tin Whizin, (Tinsel Nic x Whizin Off Sparks) owned by Roma Phillimore, settled for second place honors in both the ancillary classes a point behind the winners.

Anna Lisec and Tari Whizin are 2016 NRHA Derby Non Pro Level 4 Champions

The 2016 National Reining Horse Association (NRHA) European Non Pro Derby finals held in Manerbio, Italy, lit the Palasturla Equestrian Center arena from the very first competitor that went through the in gate. A young group of up-and-coming riders performed to the best of their ability making the sixth edition of the event one to remember.

Draw 1 in the second section of the finals was Anna Lisec riding her Tari Whizin (Topsail Whiz x Tari Badgekin). With the 7-year-old stallion between the reins, the talented Austrian rider did not hesitate to show off her mount’s athletic ability. Once the duo closed their run, a 224 appeared on the score board and remained unbeaten and for the second year running, Anna Lisec took home the L4 Non Pro championship.

“Like I said last year following the finals, I did not expect to win. My horse was amazing, and I am so happy. The whole week I had a little trouble with him but we solved the problems and he was great,” said Lisec. “Last year, with This Wimps So Fly, I just wanted to do the best I could. This year I wanted to win! It was a tough final, and a tough go-round. Having won is the best feeling ever and I cannot thank my parents, my trainers Ann



and Bernard Fonck, my team and my horses for helping me achieve this result.” Only a half-a-point behind the winners was 20-year-old Clemens Hefel riding his Rio Juice (Smart Like Juice x Tari What). Also from Austria and also riding a 7-year-old stallion, Clemens was quick to praise his mount and his trainer, NRHA Professional Grisca Ludwig. “Rio Juice has always a solid and awesome horse...he is simple incredible. I came back from



the States last week after spending some time riding with Martin Muehlstaetter. Grisca did a fantastic job with my horse when I was away

and I cannot thank both these great trainers enough!” said Clemens who also claimed the L3 championship.

Winning the L2 Non Pro Derby title was 17-year-old Carlo Ambrosini with Saturday Pepper (Saturdaynight Custom x Miss Snapper Lena), owned by Ambrosini Quarter Horses ASD. With the 6-year-old stallion between the reins, Ambrosini scored a 221. “My horse was bred by us and this makes the win twice as sweet. He’s a very talented horse but I must admit that this evening in the warm up pen I wasn’t quite sure that we would do well. Once we went in the pen I was confident that we could



run hard and I’m very very happy!” said Carlo who also left Manerbio with the L3 reserve championship.

It took a run-off between Italian Enrico Sciulli and German Alina Janoush to determine who would take the L1 Non Pro championship. 19-year-old Sciulli and his mare, Snips Gotta Bud (Nic It In The Bud x Snip O Chex), were determined to bring home the title and the duo closed their run with a 221.5. They also took the L2 reserve championship. Janoush and her mare, Ace Got It Dun (Spooks Gotta Gun x Good Lookin Dun It) posted a 219 in the run-off and settled for the L1 reserve championship.

Spooks O Lena and Pierluigi Chioldo win the Open Derby with a 229!

To say that the NRHA European Open Derby finals on Saturday night in Manerbio, Italy, thrilled the crowds is an understatement! The 43 finalists that performed in the four levels wrote history and the scores prove it. In the Level (L)4, the top 15 scores went from a 229 to a 220, and posting the amazing high score of the show was Pierluigi Chioldo with Spooks O Lena (Spooks Gotta Gun x Lonesome Sally Lena) between the reins. The athletic 7-year-old mare is owned by Ambrosini Quarter Horses ASD and was nominated by Ambrosini Quarter Horses ASD & Davide Rossi.

“This mare is simply incredible and tonight was the best I’ve ever felt her in the show pen. I’ve had her in training for the past two years and she just gets better and better every time,” said the Italian NRHA Professional. “She was great in the go round but tonight I was so confident and felt that if I asked for more she would give more! She was awesome and deserved to show off what she is capable of. It’s the best way for her to retire and be a full-time brood mare.”



The L4 Open Derby co-reserve championship, half-a-point behind the winners, went to NRHA Million Dollar Rider Rudi Kronsteiner riding AB Peppy Diamond



(OT Taris San Peppy x Mare Made), a 7-year-old stallion (owned by Jennifer Nixdorf and nominated by Antonello Businaro), and to NRHA Professional Markus Gebert aboard Sugar Little Step (Wimpys Little Step x AH Sugar Sugar), a 4-year-old stallion owned by Quarter Dream Srl and nominated by Wolf Dieter Luft.

Gebert and his mount also claimed the L3 championship.

"We bought this horse last year before the Italian Reining Horse Association (IRHA) Futurity. I rode him two days before that show and he was fantastic. This year, at the NRHA European Futurity, he was injured in his stall and we had to give him a resting period. When we brought him back to the show pen, we won the Swiss Open Derby and now, here we are! He is super, really amazing and is always quiet. He listens, he waits and this evening, everything was in the right place," claimed the German rider.

The L2 Open title, with a 220 score, went to NRHA Professional Moreno Sacchi riding Spooks Midnight (Spooks Gotta Gun x Smart Dottie), a 6-year-old mare owned and nominated by Francesco Mazza. "I showed this mare for the first time at the Italian Derby. This is the second show for us and we made the finals thanks to the consolation run. I'm very happy because now we understand each other better and this evening she was super!" said the Italian rider.

Taking the L2 reserve championship back to Belgium was Matyas Gobert riding Koen Brutsaert's CJ Whiz (Top-sail Whiz x Dream Olena Chic). The 7-year-old stallion nominated by Euro-Vets Inc. closed his run with a 218.5 score.

Winning the L1 Open Derby championship was NRHA Professional Nicola Sergio of Italy and his Ruf Little Chex (Lil Ruf Trouble x Nu Dynamite Chex). The 6-year-old gelding, nominated by Luigi Parise, posted a 217.5 with Sergio in the saddle. "I've always be-



lieved in this horse, he is fantastic. We've made the final in every special event we took part in. This evening he was great and was with me all the way. He will now take a break until the end of the year and then we will see!"

Italian NRHA Professional Angelo Benedusi reined Little Hancock (Docs Tivio Hancock x Little Bay Solano), a 7-year-old Quarter Horse gelding owned and nominated by Arianna Asteris, to the reserve championship in the L1 division with a 216.

This year she’s qualified for RFD-TV’s The American barrel racing semifinals during the Salina, Utah qualifying race. She also competes in the National Intercollegiate Rodeo Association in barrel racing and breakaway roping and she regularly competes in amateur and professional rodeos across the western United States.

On her website you can find this quote, which accurately describes Snyder’s influence: “She has let the challenges she faces refine her, not define her.”

Her presentation on Thursday, September 1, had attendees – young and old – riveted to their seats.

Afterward the line of people waiting to meet her and get photos and autographs lasted over an hour.

Gunny Mathison Youth Horsemanship and Reining Clinic

Gunny Mathison returned to spend time with the industry's future during the youth reining and horsemanship clinic. A NRHA Professional, Mathison is a great motivator and proven trainer, and he showed his skill at communicating with the younger set, keeping a large group captivated with his insight and help.

Gunny began training reining horses professionally in 2002 as an assistant trainer for NRHA Million Dollar Rider Tom McCutcheon. He gained valuable experience in many aspects of the equine industry while working for Tom and in 2008 started his own training operation and these days trains out of north Texas.

With over \$700,000 in National Reining Horse Association earnings, Gunny has been a finalist at every major NRHA event multiple times and earned championships in both the American Quarter Horse Association and American Paint Horse Association.

Terry Thompson Non Pro Clinic

An emphasis on true horsemanship basics as well as reining technique was the order of the day for the Terry Thompson Non Pro Clinic held at the Tulsa Reining Classic. One attendee noted, "He helped so much with those basics and how to build on them to a successful showing approach."

With 47 years as a reining trainer and coach Thompson, of Aubrey, Texas is a top 100 all-time money earner for the NRHA with over \$320,000 in Lifetime Earnings. He has won the NRHA Open Derby, All American Quarter Horse Congress, and literally hundreds of other major events. Plus, the strength of his coaching is shown in the fact that his youth and Non Pro riders have earned over 200 world and national titles!

Matt Mills Judging Clinic

Showing riders how to deliver maneuvers that are rewarded by Judges was one theme of Matt Mills' Judging Clinic held during the Tulsa Reining Classic. He pointed out that understanding the best way to present the pattern was a key to success.

Mills, an NRHA Professional from Cave Creek, Arizona, enjoyed a successful career as a youth showing western



pleasure, horsemanship and trail horses. In 1996 he switched reining exclusively and is consistently ranked as a National Reining Horse Association Top Twenty Professional.

In 2006 Matt was a member of Team USA that earned Gold at the World Equestrian Games (WEG) in Aachen, Germany. He brings his expertise and show experience to helping Non Pros and youth riders and is well-known for his professionalism, showmanship, and charismatic personality in his clinics across the US, Europe and Mexico.

He has also launched a video series designed for riders of any discipline. The videos help riders who do their own training at home as well as advanced level riders looking to fine-tune their show horses. McQuay and Magoteaux-Cody Present Show Management Seminar

"Our experience has shown over the many years that because of the budget factor, work load and demands in this industry it continues to be harder and harder for affiliates to run the horse shows on a volunteer basis," said Colleen McQuay of Global Reining Sport Group said. "Basically this seminar really is just the beginning of creating a system allowing managers to network their ideas and issues."

Seminar attendees discussed issues within their specific regions as well as solutions to common obstacles.

"I wanted to come to learn more ways to grow our show, get sponsors and other people's views," said Valerie Vernon, secretary of the Eastern Plains Reining Horse Association, an attendee of the seminar. "The big thing that Cheryl and Colleen were talking about was sharing our resources and I'm a true believer in a



professional show management."

With the growth of the sport of reining, show management teams are subject to bigger demands than in years past. As a response to the rise Cheryl Magoteaux Cody of Pro Management, Inc. said the industry is also seeing a growth in the need for professional show management teams.

She noted that one of those teams is Michele and Shawn Florida with the Buckeye Reining Series in Ohio. Michele said the initiative to begin the Buckeye Reining Series came out of necessity. A group of seven couples, including the Floridas, got together to promote reining, because in their area of Ohio there was a lack of reining involvement. In only its second year the business has surged.

Michele was able to attend the seminar via conference call and said the decision to do so was an important one to her and her team.

Ultimately, the success of the industry was by far the focus of the seminar and all the participants noted that they hoped it was the first of many to come.
