FEI WORLD EQUESTRIAN GAMES™ TRYON 2018 LOGO AND PROMO VIDEO UNVEILED

Tryon International Equestrian Center (TIEC) unveiled the FEI World Equestrian Games™ Tryon 2018 (FEI WEG) event logo and promotional video at the 2017 FEI World Cup™ Finals in Omaha, Neb., on Friday, March 31.

Held every four years in the middle of the Olympic cycle, the 2018 FEI WEG will be held September 11 – 23 at the Tryon International Equestrian Center (TIEC) in Tryon, NC.

The press conference was hosted by key members of the FEI WEG Organizing Committee, Mark Bellissimo, CEO, and Michael Stone, President and Sports Director; alongside FEI Secretary General Sabrina Ibáñez, and U.S. Equestrian President Murray Kessler.

“We are thrilled to launch the brand and rally enthusiasm for the 2018 Games,” said Bellissimo. “The promo video is only a taste

FEI Secretary General Sabrina Ibáñez said, “It’s truly great to be part of today’s launch and the start of the countdown to the 2018 Games in Tryon. We couldn’t ask for a better venue to host our flagship event and we are already

The FEI World Equestrian Games™ is the world championship event for eight equestrian disciplines – Jumping, Dressage and Para-Equestrian Dressage, Eventing, Driving, Endurance, Vaulting and Reining, and is the most prestigious equestrian event in the world. More than 500,000 people are expected to attend the 13-day event.

Nestled in the rolling hills of North Carolina’s Blue Ridge Mountain range, Tryon Resort is uniquely qualified to host the event. The Resort, which opened in 2014, is situated on a vast 1,600 acres and includes the Tryon International Equestrian Center. As one of the world’s premier equestrian venues, TIEC already has the majority of infrastructure in place.

Since its inception in 1990, the FEI WEG has been held in a remarkable list of locations: Stockholm, Sweden (1990), The Hague, Netherlands (1994), Rome, Italy (1998), Jerez de la Frontera, Spain (2002), Aachen, Germany (2006), Lexington, Kentucky (2010), and Normandy, France (2014).

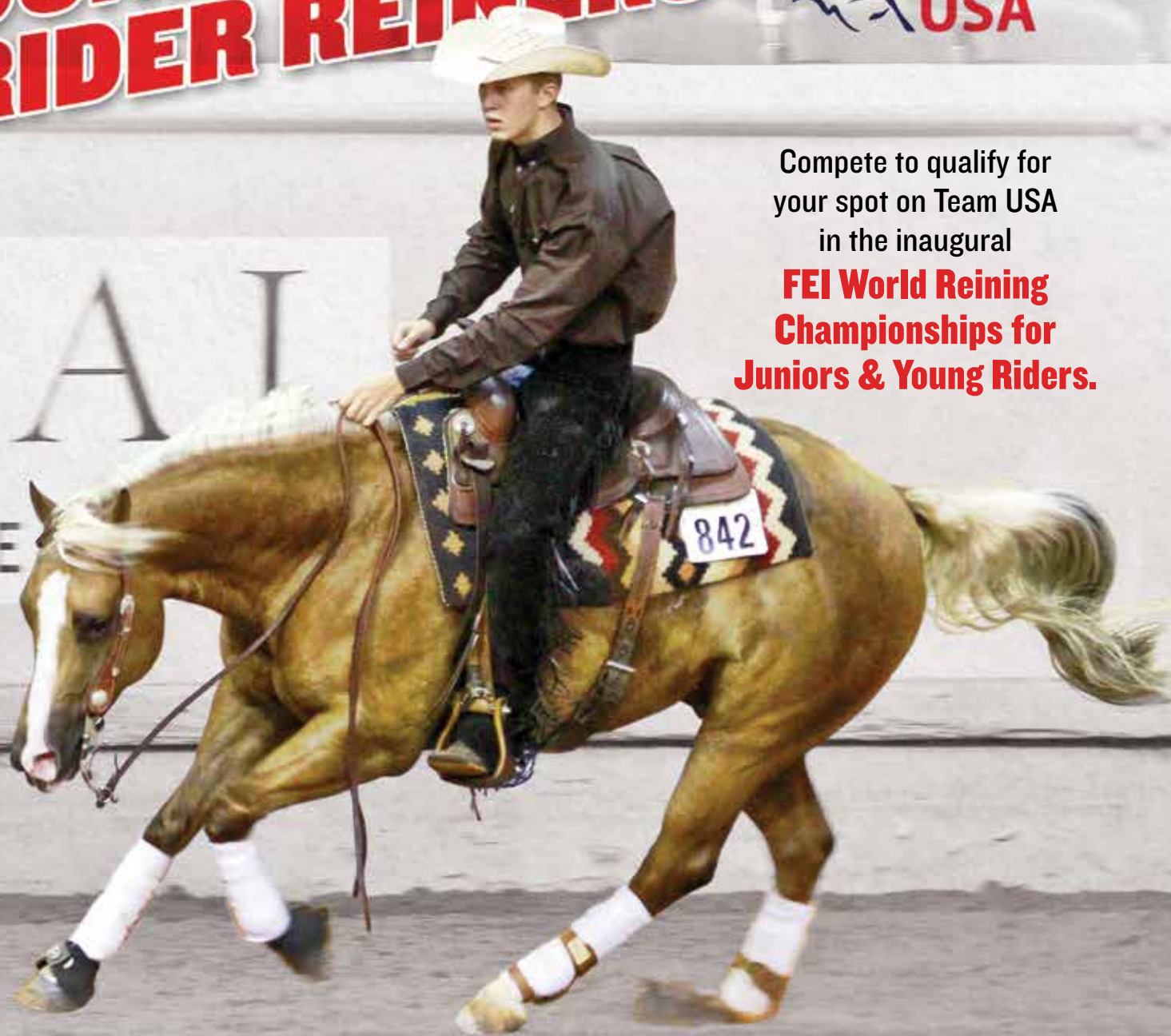

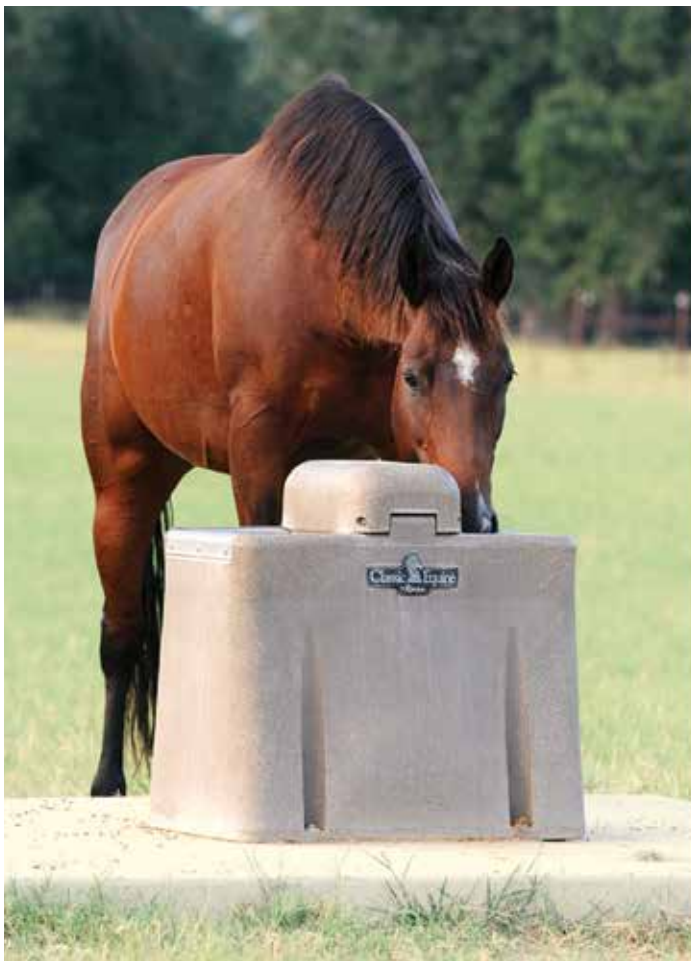

JERRY KIMMEL'S OPEN REINING NIGHT AT THE NRBC

Hundreds of spectators, breeders, trainers and owners are anticipating the tough competition of the 2017 Open Reining Night. Few will be anticipating it more than Jerry Kimmel, owner of Kimmel Reining Horses, who returns as one of the NRBC's most popular sponsors.

Magnesium in Equine Nutrition Part Three

WHAT'S THE REAL STORY?

As mentioned, Magnesium and Calcium have antagonistic functions within the muscle cell. Calcium is released during muscle contraction and binds to the actin-myosin complex, locking it in the shortened or contracted state. In order to relax the muscle Magnesium is required. Magnesium ions are released and knock the Calcium from the binding site, allowing the actin-myosin complex to relax back to the inactive or non-contracted state. Therefore, muscles cells muscular structures deficient in Magnesium are associated with tetanic muscle states, muscle spasms, or muscles that cannot relax or return to the normal state. An excess of Calcium or a deficiency of Magnesium

can both cause a temporary muscle tetany in horses called tying-up or Recurrent Exertional Rhabdomyolysis (RER).

In horses that exhibit RER symptoms, characterized by chronic tying-up during work sessions, can be helped with supplementation of a bioactive Magnesium source. Please note that RER from tying up is different that EPSM tying up associated with a carbohydrate metabolic issue.

Clinically, Magnesium has been used to treat cases of spontaneous smooth muscle contraction in humans. This includes conditions such as asthma, preeclampsia and eclampsia, seizures and other problems with muscle spasms and arrhythmias.

Magnesium can also be used as an anti-anxiety supplement. The primary symptoms of low Magnesium are anxiety, tension and an inability to focus or relax. There are many cases where horses show a reduction in these symptoms after supplementation with Magnesium, so it is worth seeing if it helps trying.

The Merck Veterinary Manual describes EMS as follows:

"Equine metabolic syndrome (EMS) describes a characteristic collection of clinical signs and clinicopathologic changes in equids. It is found in both horses and ponies and has also been recognized in donkeys. Affected animals typically are obese, with increased condition score overall and increased adiposity in the neck and tail head regions. Laminitis, both chronic and acute, is common. Hyperinsulinemia with normal blood glucose concentrations (insulin resistance) is the primary clinical pathologic finding. Other associated signs include infertility, altered ovarian activity, and increased appetite. Other laboratory findings include hypertriglyceridemia, increased serum concentrations of leptin, and arterial hypertension. Previously, this cluster of clinical signs in horses was referred to as hypothyroidism, peripheral Cushing disease, prelaminitic syndrome, or Syndrome X. EMS replaces these earlier terms. EMS may be the end result of an inability to properly metabolize dietary carbohydrate, and many horses exhibit exaggerated glucose and insulin responses to an oral hexose load before developing true insulin resistance. Any abnormality in carbohydrate metabolism in horses has been termed insulin dysregulation."

Some horses and ponies show symptoms of Equine Metabolic Syndrome (EMS) or

Insulin Resistance (IR). These conditions are characterized by lumpy, abnormal fat deposits on the neck, above the tail head and on the shoulders. Unlike a horse suffering from Cushing's Disease, EMS horses usually have a normal ACTH response, but show elevated insulin level in the blood, even when fasting. They also show slow clearance of glucose from the blood after a meal. The horse will not have the extra thick hair coat associated with Cushing's, but the hair may appear to be harsh. There will either be a tendency to laminitis, white line disease, or sore feet, or a history of laminitis/founder. These IR/EMS horses respond well to additional Magnesium in their diets. The extra Magnesium works best if it is given when the horse is on a low glycemic diet and, if possible, in a regular exercise program.

It should be noted that blood Magnesium levels normally rise following glucose ingestion or following a meal high in simple carbohydrates, indicating that Magnesium is involved with the action of insulin to clear glucose from the blood. The IR/EMS horse may show elevated insulin levels following a carbohydrate meal. These horses will also do better if they are fed a low glycemic diet (one low in simple carbohydrates) in addition to Magnesium supplementation; however, Magnesium supplementation can be beneficial without the low glycemic diet.

Magnesium may help to protect horses from laminitis by supporting peripheral circulation, preventing the arterioles from contracting and lowering blood pressure. Grass in the early spring is often low in minerals and high in sugar content – this may be why spring grass is often associated with laminitis or founder in grazing horses and ponies.

The response to Magnesium in EMS/IR horses has not been determined by any proper scientific studies so far. All evidence is anecdotal hearsay, but there is some historical

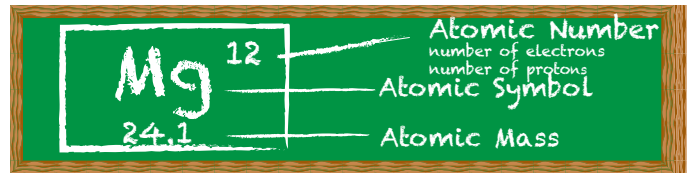


precedent for it as there is an old horseman's trick of giving Magnesium salts, usually Epsom salts, to horses that are foundering or in danger of foundering. Horse owners have given Magnesium supplements to their horses for many years and most have shown positive results. While there is not any statistical analysis of the work, in such numbers the evidence must count for something!

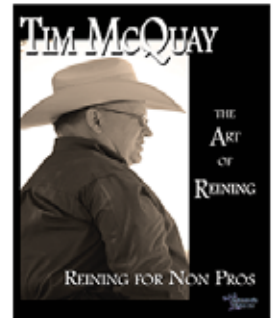
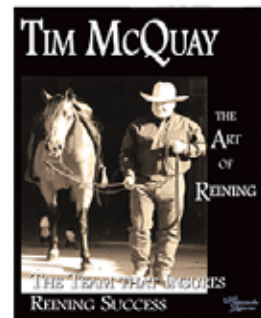
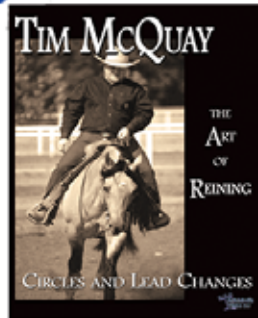
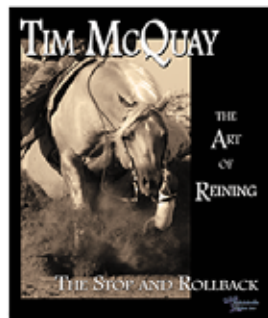
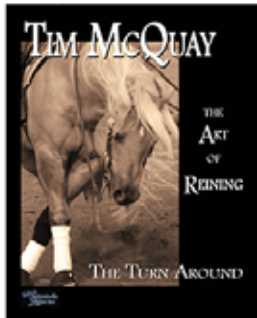

REINING HORSE FOUNDATION TO AWARD SPECIAL HIGH SCHOOL RODEO SCHOLARSHIP

The Reining Horse Foundation and the National Reined Cow Horse Association (NRCHA) are partnering to offer a \$2,500 college scholarship benefiting the competitor marking the highest reining score in reined cow horse at the 2017 National High School Finals Rodeo (NHSFR), July 17-23 in Gillette, Wyo.

The collaboration led to the inaugural award presented in 2016 to Jayde Atkins of Broken Bow, Neb., riding the 2003 gelding Sonitas Last Dual (Dualin Jewels x Sonitas Ann x Sonitas Last). Atkins bested a field of 112 reined cow horse contestants to win the national championship. She also received the prestigious Morrison bronze courtesy of the National Reining Horse Association (NRHA).

In late 2014, the National High School Rodeo Association (NHSRA) began offering reined cow horse as an event. It joined a lineup of bareback riding, bull riding, saddle bronc riding, tie-down roping, steer wrestling, team roping,

and cutting for boys; and breakaway roping, barrel racing, pole bending, goat tying, cutting, team roping and the queen contest for girls. NHSRA, NRCHA and NRHA acknowledge that reined cow horse events can elevate the riding ability of NHSRA members who choose to learn and take part in the event.

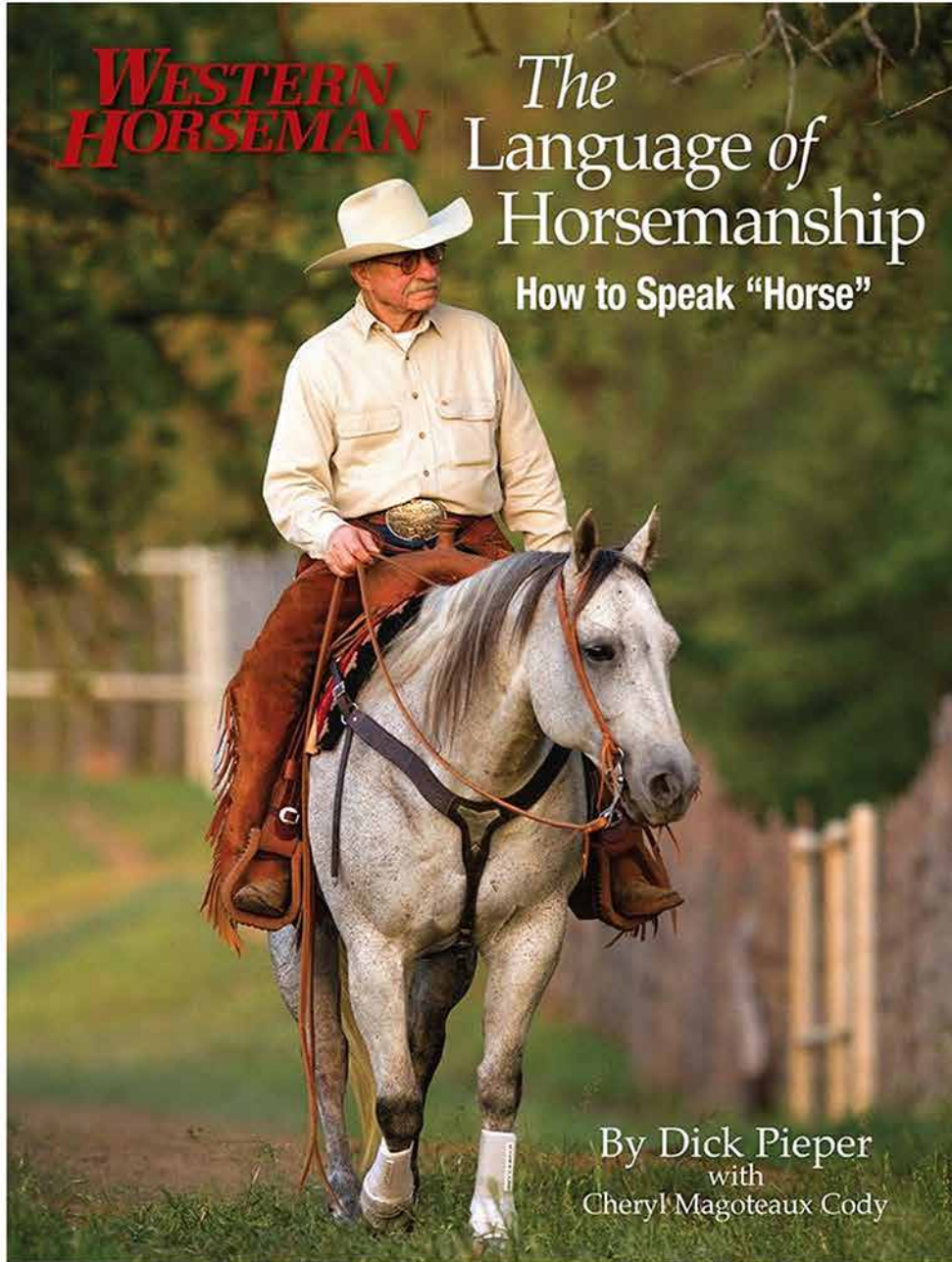
NRHA and the Reining Horse Foundation anticipate the scholarship may entice more students to be introduced to reining through the reined cow horse event. As part of the reined cow horse competition, contestants complete a reining pattern, commonly referred to as dry work.

Based in Oklahoma City, Okla., the Reining Horse Foundation is the philanthropic arm of the National Reining Horse Association. Core programs for the 501(c)3 nonprofit organization include youth scholarships, the Dale Wilkinson Memorial Crisis Fund and the NRHA Hall of Fame.

DUN IT FOR WHIZKEY/INFERNO SIXTY SIX BECOME NRBC HOSPITALITY SPONSORS

Dun It For Whizkey/Inferno Sixty Six will sponsor the Hospitality Stations at this year's NRBC. The event is already known for hospitality and special amenities, but steps it up another level for the anniversary year.

Bred and owned by Cardinal Reining Horses, Dun It For Whizkey is a 2013 AQHA gray stallion. Shown by Franco Bertolani, Dun It For Whizkey dominated futurity competitions in 2016 thanks to his extreme physical talent and trainable disposition. Showing against the best in the world, the duo won the Tulsa Classic Open L4 Futurity Championship and the AQHA Congress Open L4 Futurity Championship. Then, at NRHA's biggest event, Bertolani guided the flashy stallion to the NRHA Open L4 Futurity Co-Reserve Championship out of 376 entries. All in all, Dun It For Whizkey won \$165,000 in only three outings. A blue blood through and through, Dun It For Whizkey is by Topsail Whiz, the NRHA All Time #1 Reining Sire, with offspring earning over 11 million dollars. His dam, Dun It For Chex, was the NRHA #1 Leading Dam for 2016, and she has produced offspring earning over \$669,000.

Dun It For Whizkey will continue to be

shown by trainer Franco Bertolani and begin his breeding career this year.

ANN FONCK AND SHINERS VOODOO SCORE BIG TO WIN THE NRHA EUROPEAN OPEN FUTURITY

Cremona, April 1 – As the lights went out in the CremonaFiere Arena, the 2017 National Reining Horse Association (NRHA) European Open Futurity finalists wrote yet another page of history. It took a 222 or higher to make it in the final top ten Level (L)4 rankings and a 231 to claim the L4 Open Futurity Championship.



Draw 21 in a field of 25 finalists in the second section of the European Futurity Open finals, multiple past NRHA Open and Reserve Open World Champion Ann Fonck kept the reining fans in Cremona glued to their seats from the moment she burst in the pen riding Shiners Voodoo (Shiners Voodoo Dr x BR China Rose) for owner Kimberly Wegner. The show went on as Fonck and the flashy palomino performed fast and precise spins and controlled circles. The duo closed their run with three deep stops that set the dirt – and the +1’s – flying!

“I am thrilled and cannot believe how good my horse was for me tonight,” said Ann about the stallion she won both the German Breeders and French 3-year-old Futurity on last year. “I know how talented he is and when I rode in the pen I knew that he was capable of winning but I never thought that we would earn such a big score! I have to give credit to my husband, Bernard (Fonck) for helping me out during this

week and to our incredible team that worked endless hours behind the scenes...I don’t know how they did it!”

Shiners Voodoo was bred by Patricia Blankeney Creson and nominated by Reto Erdin. Prior to the European Futurity, the talented stallion had already collected \$12,198 to his name with Ann Fonck in the saddle. On Saturday night, he added \$17,551 to his LTE.



Early in the draw, NRHA Million Dollar Rider and multiple past NRHA Open World Champion Bernard Fonck had set the bar aboard Missedouttinseltown (Hollywoodstinseltown x Miss Sliding Peppy) owned by Golden Paint Ranch. The pair had set the stands on fire with their powerful run paid back by the judges with a 228.5 which earned them the reserve championship as well as \$14,559. In the past edition of the Italian Reining Horse Association (IRHA) Futurity the sorrel stallion, with Fonck in the saddle, had tied for third place bringing his earnings to \$15,485.

Past NRHA Intermediate Open World Champion Guglielmo Fontana topped both the L4 and L3 qualifiers riding Whiz Wild West (Spark N Whiz x West Coast Oak) owned by Luga Quarter Horses bred and nominated by Mattia Camisi. In the clean-slate finals, the bay gelding rode Fontana to a 226 and the L3 European Futurity Open title. “I don’t believe I’ve ever ridden a horse as talented as Whiz Wild West,” said the NRHA Professional following the awards presentation. “He was absolutely incredible tonight and it was an honor for me to place behind two incredible champions – Bernard and Ann Fonck – who I worked with for three years.” Fontana took home a paycheck worth \$21,121 for his L3 win and for placing third in the L4.



Second place honors in this division with a 222.5 score went to Canadian NRHA Professional Morey Fisk, now based in Mooslargue France, riding Whiz My Freckles (Spooks Gotta Whiz x Dun Lost My Freckles), a mare owned by Peter Arnet, bred and nominated by Lewisville Development, LP.

Fisk, who is a three-time NRHA European L4 Open Futurity champion, added \$11,880 to his LTE amounting to \$337,000 prior to coming to Cremona.

Winning the title in the L2 division was Italian NRHA Professional Silvia Venezia who posted a 220 riding Gunnerine (Hollywood Gun Dunit x E Harmony Dot Com), a mare owned, bred and nominated by Teresa Rosati. “I’ve had this sweet mare in training since she was a 2-year-old, and I broke and trained her myself,” said Venezia. “I am thrilled with how she performed tonight and even though I knew we could achieve this result, until it’s over you never know.”

Co-Reserve honors in the L2 – with a 217.5 went to NRHA Professional Nicola Cordioli of Italy riding Unwhizzjable (Star Spangled Whiz x Late Little Jaba), a mare owned by Andrea Pengo, bred and nominated by Silvia Sgaggio.



NRHA Professional Matteo Cuniglio rode RS Canaletto Jac (RS Great Jac Feona x RS Red Moon Olena), a mare owned, bred and nominated by Claudio Rizzo, to first place honors in the L1 and to Co-Reserve honors in the L2 division. “I started riding this mare in December last year and immediately liked her,” said the Italian rider who won the L1 Open qualifier in Cremona. “We get along really well and she was good for me from day one. This is my first European Futurity title and I couldn’t be any happier.”

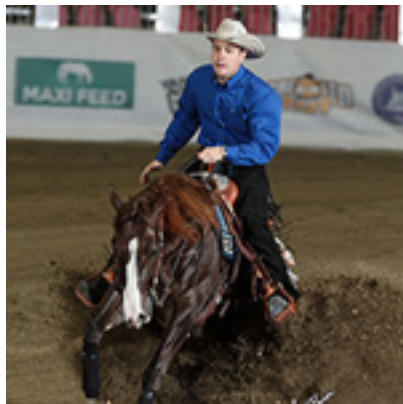

The NRHA European Futurity, held for the very first time in Italy after leaving the historical venue in Kreuth, Germany, after eight years, officially closed with the Open finals which showcased an incredibly high level of competition.

EDOARDO BERNARDELLI AND RS GAUDI JAC ARE EUROPEAN NON PRO FUTURITY CHAMPIONS



Cremona, March 31 – The National Reining Horse Association (NRHA) European Non Pro finals closed the day in Cremona, Italy. In a field of 32 finalists in the four levels, Anna Lisec of Austria had set the bar riding her Gunners Nite Slider (Gunners Special Nite x Wind Her Up Chic). Aboard the gelding bred by Oldenburg Farm LLC and nominated by Cardinal Hill Training Center LLC, Lisec closed her performance with a 217.5 to lead the Euro 36,000-added Level (L)4 Non Pro division. The young rider’s score held until the go-round leaders, Edoardo Bernardelli and RS Gaudi Jac, performed a penalty-free run and big stops closing their run with a 219. Bred and nominated by Claudio Rizzo, RS Gaudi Jac is by RS Great Jac Feona and out of RS

Shadow Olena. “I got my horse when he was a yearling from Rizzo and I trained him myself,” said the young rider who was on the Italian team that took gold medal honors in the past FEI European Reining Championships held in Aachen, Germany. “I showed him last year at the German Breeders Futurity and at the Italian Futurity but we weren’t quite ready yet. In the last 6 months, he matured a lot and he was really easy to show here. I am very happy with this major win!”



Once the Non Pro finals were over, Anna Lisec – who boasts over \$55,000 LTE – and Gunners Nite Slider settled for the L4 Reserve Championship.

It was truly a special evening for Suzanne

Scharroo of the Netherlands. Aboard her mare, My Private Gun, bred by Henk Hendrikse and nominated by herself, Scharroo went on to win the Euro 16,000-added L3 division with a 215.5. “I purchased this sweet mare when she was 6-weeks-old and trained her myself. I don’t usually break and train my horses, but she is such an easy horse to work with. Achieving this result is truly incredible,” said Scharroo about her mare by Gunner and out of Private Enterprise, who also slid to fourth place in the L4 division.

The Reserve Championship in the L3 division – with a 214 score – went to Jennifer Nixdorf and her Hollysmartin (Hollywoodstinseltown x Tarismartin), a mare bred and nominated by Marino Pilotto. The duo made it back to the L3 finals through the consolation run.



Winning the Euro 9,000-added European Non Pro L2 division with a 212.5 was Alex Kubli of Switzerland aboard his Gunna Ruf Ya, a stallion by NRHA Million Dollar Sire Gunnatrashya and out of Lil Ruf Lady. “I have to give credit to my trainer, Morey Fisk, who I’ve been riding with for the past six years, for having trained both my horse and myself,” said Kubli who tied to win the L2 qualifying go-round with his mount. “Winning my major event here is pretty special and, I must admit, my horse was very good to me all the way!”



Winning the Euro 4,000-added Level 1 division of the NRHA European Non Pro Futurity with a 212 was Katharina Dejori with her Daicy between the reins. The mare, bred by Mauro Scotti and nominated by Filippo Masi, is by ARC Blueyed Redskin and out of Margaritaz. “I purchased her when she was a 2-year-old. I showed her a few times, with not much luck, and in the go-round here we weren’t that lucky but we were fortunate to make it to the finals,” said the rider from Sud Tirol. “I ride with Giovanni (Dido) Masi de Vargas, who has been riding my 9-year-old stallion for the past year, and who has helped me a great deal with Daicy. I am thrilled with this unexpected win!”

Earning the L1 Co-Reserve Championship with a 206 were Alisa Maurer and her VK Gumps Little Time (Little Gump x Smart Little Time), bred and nominated by Nicole Gelbert-Hahn, and Luca Zago riding his Spatatrip (Spat Olena x Dark Blue River), bred by Matteo Gottardo and nominated by Zago.

NUMBER OF NRBC FINALISTS INCREASES FOR 2017

In 2017 not only will the 20th NRBC cross the \$20 million payout mark, it will take an incredible 30 finalists in every Open and Non Pro finals in the Levels 1-4 divisions. In midsummer of 2016, the board opted to increase from 20 to 30 finalists for the L3, L2 and L1 Non Pro divisions, creating a total of 30 more Non Pro finalist spots.

Then in December the Board went a step further and did the same in the Open so now every eligibility division from L1 to L4 in both the Open and the Non Pro Classic will have 30 finalists.

NRBC President Tom McCutcheon brought the idea of increasing the number of Open Finalists to the board. He said, "Reining has become much more competitive at all levels.

We think that doing this will benefit both owners and trainers. More horses will have a chance to earn important credentials for their records."

According to NRBC Secretary/Treasurer, Cheryl Cody, the change came about after the printed version of the Premium book was printed and mailed. "So the terms and conditions that are in our 2017 Show Premium Book are outdated, but the updated terms and conditions can now be found on the NRBC website."

McCutcheon added, "In a year where we are celebrating 20 years of the NRBC, it seemed fitting to the entire board to increase opportunities for those who participate. Of course, besides the achievement, all NRBC finalists receive paychecks and awards."

Albion College **ALBION COLLEGE EQUESTRIAN PROGRAM EXPANDS** Equestrian

Albion College became part of the horse world in 2004 with the construction of the Nancy G. Held Equestrian Center on 340 undeveloped acres at the south end of campus. The college itself is a longstanding part of Michigan's educational fabric, having been established in 1835, but it wasn't until 2003 graduate Randi Heathman wrote her senior honors thesis about the additional students Albion might attract with the addition of an equestrian program that the idea took root.

Heathman's thesis predicted that the liberal arts college of 1,300 students could bring in an additional 15 students per year if it offered equestrian opportunities; in the first year of

operation, it brought in 25 and the program has grown ever since.

Recently, with the renovation and expansion of the Held Center's indoor arena in the summer of 2016, the program brought its Intercollegiate Horse Show Association (IHSA) western team under its roof for the first time. Albion has had a western team since 2006 but facility constraints meant the college's hunt seat and dressage riders practiced on campus and the western riders trained at a private barn off-site.

Moving the team has both united the program and introduced a new face to the Albion community: AQHA Professional Horseman and CHA master instructor Nathan Horsman.

He's the one now tasked with taking the western program to the next level – a role he's undertaken with full knowledge of the work that will be involved and a plan to make good things happen.

“My goal is to bring this program and my students to a nationally competitive level,” Horsman says. “With Albion College's backing and plans for building a barn just for the western program, I feel this is attainable. We have some great riders and students who are dedicated to learning.”

Three of those riders recently returned from the IHSA Semifinals competition in Amarillo, Texas, having qualified during the regular season of intercollegiate shows. And with a full season of college coaching experience now

under his belt, Horsman is firmly focused on what comes next – and his first priority is to acquire more horses who know their jobs and can give his students the correct feel in their reining patterns.

“And if they happen to be by Wimpys Little Step, that won't hurt either,” Horsman jokes.

The expansion of the Albion College reining program is another new direction for the little school in the Midwest that took a chance when it became a part of the horse industry back in 2004. But with a track record of previous success and an infusion of excitement surrounding the growth of the western disciplines on campus, all signs point to good things in Albion's future.

Metallic Dual earned a 657 composite (218 herd/216.5 rein/223 fence). The Reserve Championship paid \$25,939.

As the highest-scoring offspring of Metallic Cat in the Stallion Stakes Open Finals, Metallic Dual also earned the \$10,000 Metallic Cat Open Incentive check, sponsored by Alvin and Becky Fults of Fults Ranch, Metallic Cat's owners.

Stakes entries are shown in a snaffle bit or hackamore, competing in herd work, rein work and cow work. The event attracts many top Snaffle Bit Futurity horses from the past two years, as well as those who might have missed the Futurity but are now ready to perform competitively.
