As the last rider in the draw, Craig Schmersal and Face The Attitude (Pale Face Dunit x Miss Lil Addy Tude) had only one option – to give everything they had and the crowd was certainly with them. Thunder couldn't have been heard over the cheers of the audience! Face The Attitude ran her big circles like a thoroughbred, loped small like a pleasure horse, spun like a top, and slid into the Open NRHA Futurity Championship like the top-level reiner that she is.

"I'm happy for my family, my help, all the people that rooted for me, and have been rooting for me for so long" an emotional Schmersal said. "I've been a finalist probably 22 times, maybe 21. It's unbelievable to do it on a mare that we happen to own. It's a thrill. It's a dream come true, and I thought this day would never come!"

Schmersal has won every major NRHA event in the past, but until 2017, the NRHA Futurity Championship title has eluded the NRHA \$3 Million Dollar Rider.

Face The Attitude is a homegrown filly by Pale Face Dunit (LTE \$70,000+) a stallion who Schmersal has worked hard to promote and has been standing at Schmersal Reining Horses, and out of Miss Lil Addy Tude who has accumulated more than \$120,000 in NRHA and USEF lifetime earnings. Face The Attitude is owned by Hickory Creek

Ranch LLC, was bred by KC Performance Horses LLC and nominated by Ginger Schmersal.

"She's a great little mare, this was a great night. She just came through for me." Craig said after they scored a 226.5 to win the championship title and the \$150,000 purse.

The 2017 NRHA Level 4 Open Futurity Champion received a Silver Spurs custom saddle, a custom Montana Silversmiths Trophy Buckle, Anderson Bean boots, Classic Equine Contour Pedic Reiner, Bluebonnet Feed, a SmartPak Gift Card, a Shorty's Caboy Hattery certificate and tote bags courtesy of KO Trading. He also took home a four-horse slant gooseneck trailer for the use of one year courtesy of Twin Cities South Trailers the official trailer of NRHA, and a custom Italian leather headstall courtesy of Conqueror Art. The Level 4 Champion Rider and Owner will each receive a beautiful, diamond Champion ring from MS Diamonds TX.

All American Vintage piloted by Andrea Fappani took the NRHA Futurity Reserve Championship with a 224.5. All American Vintage is owned by Cuoghi Reining Horses USA Inc, bred by Petra Zeitler, and nominated by Harper Connor. The young stallion is by A Sparkling Vintage out of All Ruffed Up. Fappani took home \$119,993 for the title which unofficially brought him into the NRHA Five Million Dollar Rider ranks.

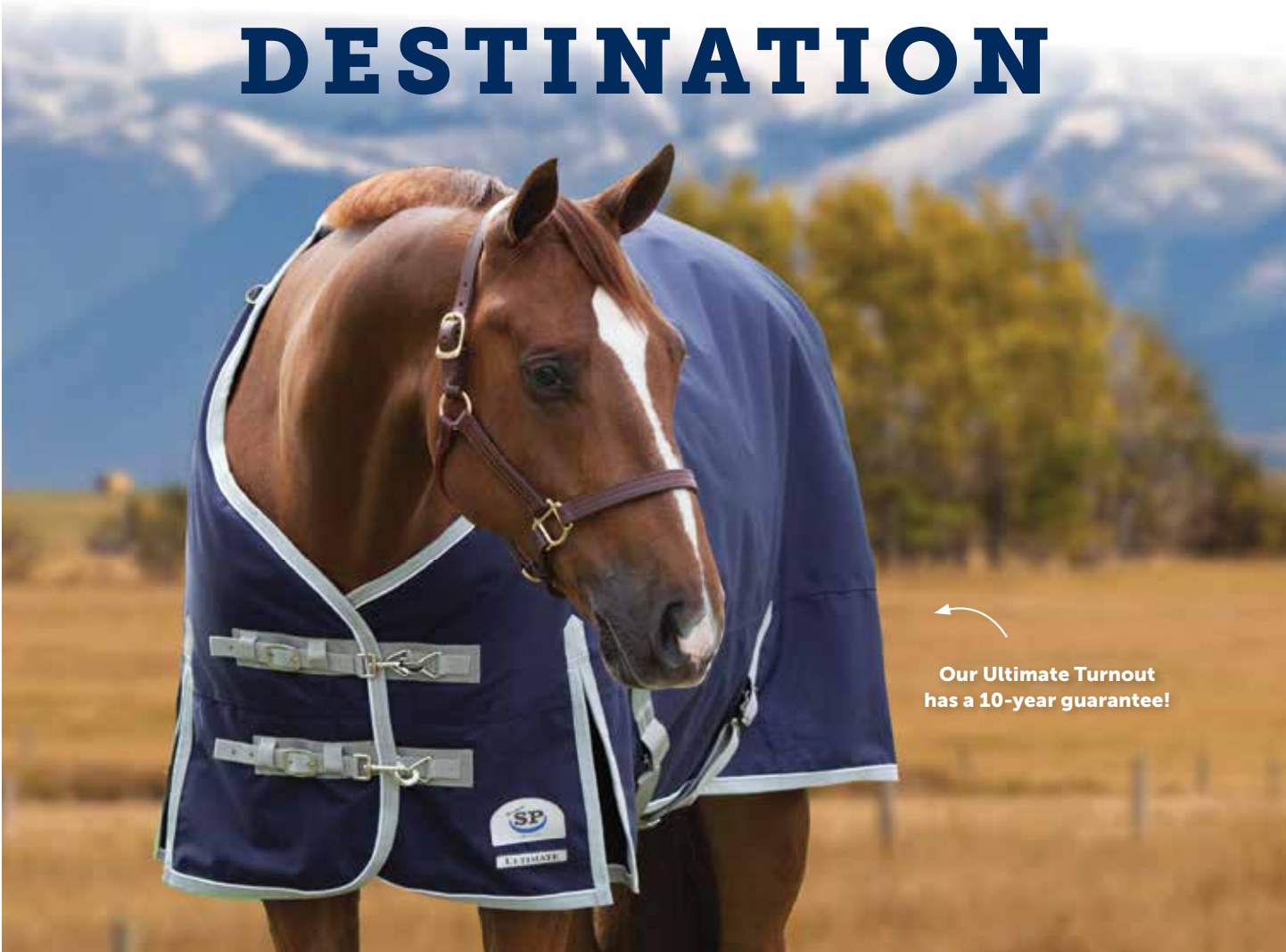
Fans saw a three-way tie for the Level 3 Open Futurity Championship when Casey Hinton on Mega Mag, Marco

Mega Mag, a young stallion that the Hintons own themselves, is sired by Magnum Chic Dream out of Big Gold Chex. He was bred and nominated by Garth Hystad.

“It was a very fun run,” Hinton said. “‘Elvis’ became the house favorite, I think. Everything about the run worked out, except for one thing – the second lead change. The first stop was good, turns were good – circled phenomenal. My goal was to have a penalty-free run. Other than the second lead change, the performance was like I would like it to be.”

Story Book Stables’ Shine Plum Shine is by Shine Chic Shine out of Plum Reyning. He was bred by Andre De Bellefeuille and nominated by Rosanna Sternberg.

Ricotta said, “I got this horse in May. He’s a stud, but he’s good to be around. He’s good minded, and SUPER talented.”

Hendrickdon’s mount You Gotta Be Dreamin is owned, bred, and nominated by Jake and Heather Dahl, DVM. The

son of Magnum Chic Dream is out of Forever Going Steady.

“The horse was awesome. I knew this was a big stopping and turning situation, so he came in and nailed that first stop. He turned HUGE that first way, but had a little trouble that second way. He circled up nice – I didn’t try to over-do it, and then finished up really well. My last two stops were really good,” Hendrickson said. “I’ve had the horse since he was two, so it’s pretty cool to have the horse this whole time in my barn and then have this success on him.”

The 2017 NRHA Level 3 Open Futurity Champion received a Bob’s Custom saddle, a custom Montana Silversmiths Trophy Buckle, Anderson Bean boots, Classic Equine Contour Pedic Reiner, Bluebonnet Feed, a SmartPak Gift Card, a Shorty’s Caboy Hattery certificate and tote bags courtesy of KO Trading. Each of them also earned a \$21,946 check, except for Casey Hinton who had the added success of winning the Open Prime Time Futurity which added \$2,086 to his earnings.

“I was just trying to stay focused, and go in there and just enjoy the ride actually,” Fisk said with a chuckle.

“That was my big thing, you know, just to try to stay slow, keep quiet, and don’t over-show my horse.”

Vanessa Strotmann rode Cashing In Diamonds to the Level 1 Open Futurity Championship after earning 217 points from the judges. "Diamonds" is a mare that Stefano Calcagnini bought at the NRHA/Markel Insurance Sale in 2015. Cashing In Diamonds is by Lil Joe Cash out of Diamond Steppin Whiz. She was bred and nominated by Green Valley Ranch. Vanessa took home \$8,211 for the win.

Strotmann said, "She really stepped it up for me. She was focused, and she was ready. I had a little trouble in a couple of stops. It's been a long week; I was a little bit out of horse, and we got hung up in a couple of stops, but she was REALLY good everywhere else."

The Level 1 Reserve Open Futurity Championship title went to Josh Crawley and his own Gunnamoonya (Gunnatrashya x Shining Moonstone) who scored a 216.5 in the finals. Josh earned \$6,024.

MANDY MCCUTCHEON WINS NRHA NON PRO FUTURITY ON BEST NITE EVER

Amidst a cheering, whistling, and stomping crowd, Mandy McCutcheon delivered a spectacular performance to win the 2017 NRHA Non Pro Futurity. Mandy rode Best Nite Ever (Gunnars Special Nite x Best By Benz) also known as “Flower” to a 219 in a runoff that may have resulted in one of their best nights ever!

When considering the abilities of the 3-year-olds showing in the futurity, some only need raw talent and good horsemanship. However, Flower had to have some time off during her 2 year-old year to have some bone chips removed. With Team McCutcheon's help the filly recovered, caught up with her peers, and won the NRHA Non Pro Futurity and \$42,274.

Mandy said, “[In my first run] I was a little rough in a couple of spots where I made her a little jittery, and I just tried to go back in the second run and smooth that out a little bit. She showed really good for me. She does the big stuff real easy, and so it’s more of just letting her do things and not making her do things.”

Kelle Smith earned the reserve title in the NRHA Non Pro Futurity with a 217.5 after the runoff. Kelle’s first run won the Prime Time Non Pro Futurity with a 216.5. Kelle has always believed in Night Time Spook (Spooks Gotta Whiz x Custom Night Time) even when others doubted, and these wins cemented her faith in the young stallion who wasn’t

started until July of his 2-year-old year. Kelle took home \$32,234.

“I’m thrilled to death. This is a special horse. He needs no introduction; I think that everybody has finally realized what I’ve known – just how special he is. I mean he came from the stall and did the runoff,” Smith said. “I asked how much time we had and they said that we have 10 minutes. I was like, ‘he’s ready.’ I wouldn’t have ever run off if it wasn’t for this horse. I mean, any other horse I’ve ever brought to the futurity, I would never have run off. We had a stumble and a bad back up, so there you go.”

Kevin Ball and This Chic Guns It Claim Level 3, 2, and 1 Non Pro Futurity Championships

Kevin Ball slid into the Levels 3, 2, and 1 NRHA Non Pro Championships on This Chic Guns It, a daughter of Colonels Smoking Gun and This Chic Dun It. In mid 2016, Kevin mentioned to his trainer, Nathan Piper, that he would be interested in buying a futurity prospect at the end of the year. Piper called him back the next day and told him that he had found one and sent a video to Kevin. Kevin was concerned about the timing, but he trusted Nathan and bought the filly. After this win and others, Kevin definitely believes that the timing was right on after all!

Ball said, “She was really good. I got a little bit nervous coming into the pen just because she had lost her confidence a little bit in her left turn, but we got through it, and built her confidence back. From the first moment that we ran in there to the moment that we walked out, she was just right there with me. I know she was a little bit tired, but when I said, ‘let’s go on,’ she went to work. She’s nothing but a trooper.” The duo scored 215 points and earned the \$49,724 check.

Championship went to Kristen Darnell-Titov and Gunsup In Tinseltown. Kristen rode the son of Hollywoodstinseltown and Always Gotyer Gunsup to a 214.5 and brought her take to \$17,258.

Alex Purus won reserve in the Level 1 NRHA Non Pro Futurity Championship on Its Cocktail Hour (Wimpyneed-sacocktail x BH Silver Enterprise). The duo was awarded 211.5 points and \$7,070.

Andre Lauzon of Canada and his filly Sonia Smart Chic earned the Level 2 NRHA Non Pro Futurity Reserve Championship as well as Reserve in the NRHA Prime Time Non Pro Futurity Championship with a 212. Sonia Smart Chic is by Smart Chic Olena out of Miss Poco Whizard. Andre pocketed \$15,748 for the titles.

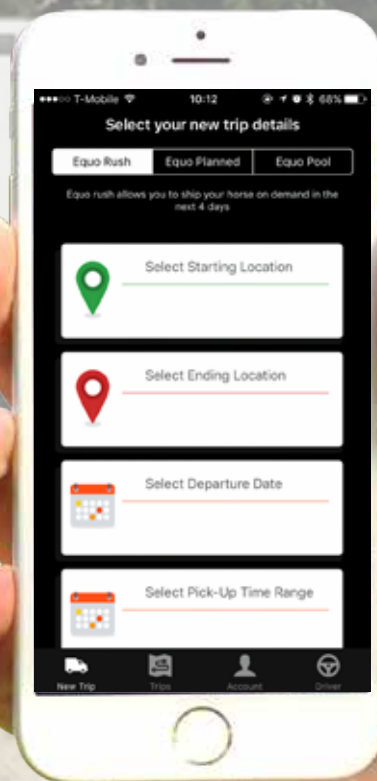
Cade McCutcheon Pilots One Stormy Nite to NRHA Youth Non Pro Championship Title

dam was shown by Tom as a 4-year-old, and is now being shown by Cade’s sister, Carlee in Rookie classes. Cade can also take personal credit for One Stormy Nite’s success as the colt was one of the first few 2-year-olds that Cade has started himself.

SHAUNA LARCOMBE DOMINATES THE FIRST DAY OF ADEQUAN® NORTH AMERICAN AFFILIATE CHAMPIONSHIPS

Horse and rider combinations from across the country filled the Oklahoma State Fairpark on Thanksgiving Day to kick off the NRHA 2017 Futurity. Some of these competitors, with hopes of earning the Adequan® North American Affiliate Championships. Arriving here to compete was no easy feat, as competitors must have placed within the top 10 at an Affiliate Regional Championship (ARC) to earn their

spot in OKC.

Shauna Larcombe and Designed With Shine (Smart And Shiny x Taris Designer Genes) earned the Adequan® NAAC Open and Intermediate Open Championships with a score of 222.5. The 6-year-old mare was bred by NRHA Million Dollar Owner Rancho Oso Rio LLC, and is owned

by NRHA Million Dollar Owner and Hall of Fame Inductee Rosanne Sternberg.

“This mare is just awesome, she is getting better and better,” said NRHA Professional Larcombe. “It was almost perfect; until the last horse we were first, second and third. Now she is getting a deserved holiday.” The wins were even more special, as each of the horses she competed on are owned by Sternberg.

“Rosanne [Sternberg] has been fantastic,” Larcombe said. “I have been in the United States just over a year and she asked me to come to her place and ride some horses; it has been awesome. The opportunities, shows and horses she has given me are just fantastic. Today has been the icing on the cake and I can’t wait for next year.” The duo qualified at the South Central ARC representing the Southwest Reining Horse Association.

Matthew Noel Palmer and Gunner Be A Maverick (Gunner x Dun It Preciously) earned a 221.5 to win the Adequan® NAAC Open Reserve Championship and the USA Reining championship, representing the Eastern Pennsylvania RHA, after his success at the Northeast ARC. The gelding, bred by Nathalie McEntire, had less than \$400 in NRHA LTE as a 7 year old, when Palmer found him for his client, Mark Hurd.

“He has been a steady eddy; it has been unreal,” said NRHA Professional Palmer. “He has won five or six times out of the eight I have showed him. His previous owners must not have showed him a lot. It is a unique situation but every time I have shown him, he has been there for me. He has stepped up to the highest level with success, which is fun and gratifying. It was my third year showing in this for the same owner, and we won the other two years, so today is a little bittersweet, but very special.” ‘Maverick’ will now be ridden by Hurd, who has never shown before, in Green Reiner classes.

Emily Emerson and Wind Er Up Wimp (Wimpys Little

Step x Wind Her Up Doc) earned the Adequan® NAAC Intermediate Open Reserve Championship for owner Susan Geiger with a score of 220.5.

“He warmed up so good,” Emerson said. “He was good-minded, everything was easy, and I knew I couldn’t warm him up too much or I wouldn’t have enough horse. He is honest, and I know what it takes to get him ready to go. It was fun to win at the Mountain ARC [representing Rocky Mountain RHA] and then come here and win second.”

The 8-year-old stallion, bred by NRHA Million Dollar Owner and Hall of Fame Inductee Vaughn Zimmerman, will get time off before preparing for the FEI World Equestrian Games™ Tryon 2018.

“I know I have the horse, that is the nicest thing,” Emerson said. “He is good enough, it is just a matter of getting the run put together when we need it; today is a confidence boost.”

The Adequan® North American Affiliate Championships had a suspenseful conclusion, with one horse after another outdoing the previous score. With two horses left to compete, Ariana Kate Dejong and White Chocolat Chunk (Chocolate Chic Olena x Meadow Jac) scored a big 218 to earn the Adequan® NAAC Limited Non Pro Championship. The 13-year-old and ‘Chip’ came to OKC representing the Great Western Reining Horse Association.

“This year my goal was to win the affiliate classes I qualified in, and the fact that I actually won the Limited Non Pro championship was amazing,” Dejong said. “He was so good through the whole run, he was so soft. I couldn’t ask for anything more.” Dejong will show her 12-year-old gelding bred by Sally Brown in the Adequan® NAAC 13 & Under, and he will also be shown by her mother, Rejeanne, later in

the week.

The NRHA Professional rode the 4-year-old gelding, bred and owned by Cross C Ranch, to a 221.5

for the titles.

“It has been a thrill,” Sarah said. “It is my first year on my own, even though I have some experience and worked here and there for trainers, I have never stepped out on my own and shown consistently.” To make the wins even more special, the gelding was raised and trained by her husband, NRHA Professional Matthew Cunningham, whom she mar-

“I got her as a long 3-year old, and my husband shows her in the non pro,” Robinson said. “She is athletic enough to compete in the open and do well, yet good-minded enough to throw a non pro on her and say ‘put your hand down and go show.’” The 5-year-old mare, owned by her husband Maurice Robinson, qualified him for the 2017 NRBC Finals in Levels 1, 2, 3 and Prime Time Non Pro. Bred by Oldenburg Farm LLC, the mare and her mount came to the NAAC representing the Tennessee Reining Horse Association.

“It is pretty rare to find one that is this good minded, nice to be around, athletic, and with that work ethic.” Robinson said.

“Bobby trained her mom and I have loved her since she was a baby,” said Kristen.

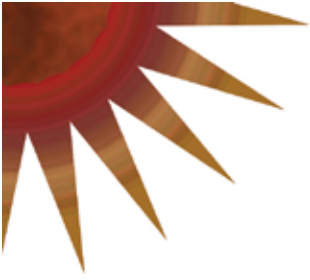

Bub's costume was as authentic as he could make it from the tapaderos and spade bit on his horse to the Garracha pole that he carried and the studded leather cuffs that he wore.

Poplin said, "The old, old vaquero used the garrocha

pole, and actually that pole is 13 feet long. The purpose of the garrocha pole was to train your horses to fight bulls in Spain. That's the distance that you wanted to keep a bull from hitting your horse. That's where it originated. Now in Brazil, they actually have garrocha competitions. I was watching that and I got really intrigued and that's what gave me the idea to do it."

Learning to perform in the traditional vaquero way was harder than Bub initially thought, but he said, "What I really enjoyed about it the most as I figured it out is that what it does is it really gets your horse broke. You have to really focus on making a perfect circle – being able to do one and a half spins and then lope out underneath that pole. This horse has really done a lot in the reining pen and I started it with him and he struggled at first. By the time I got done, it

actually got him more broke so it's pretty cool!"

Poplin and Smokin Custom Crome's captivating performance earned 225 points and \$6,544.

Dan James on Don Magnum earned the reserve spot in the

VAUGHN ZIMMERMAN INDUCTED INTO THE NRHA HALL OF FAME

NRHA Million Dollar Owner Vaughn Zimmerman was recognized at Sliders Night Out as NRHA’s newest Hall of Fame Inductee. Zimmerman defines the very criteria for the NRHA Hall of Fame Induction.

Vaughn has enjoyed a long-time involvement with the

I’ve been doing in ever since.” Zimmerman said. “It’s a passion. It’s something I love; and to be grouped with the people in the Hall of Fame that I am with is humbling to me because everyone has done so much to help reining. In so many ways, I know that I have tried to help reining, but I know that reining has helped me more than I’ve helped it.”

Zimmerman has supplied financial support to the industry by providing integral sponsorships to many regional and major shows, and by donating stallion breedings to various breeding program auctions supporting NRHA Affiliates.

Vaughn has contributed multiple top caliber horses to the industry including many highly sought after consignments to the Markel Insurance Futurity Sales such as Commanders Lil Step (Wimpys Little Step x Miss Bam Bam Command), the 2011 high-seller. Vaughn also consigned Not Ruf At All (A Sparkling Vintage x All Ruffed Up), but then made the wise decision not to sell the horse. Not Ruf At All went on to become the third ever reining Triple Crown champion after winning the 2013 NRHA Futurity, the 2014 NRHA Derby, and the 2016 NRBC.

Vaughn enjoys watching the Zimmerman legacy continue through his grandchildren who seem to share the same passion and dedication for reining.

Lyle Lovett is Awarded the NRHA Dale Wilkinson Lifetime Achievement Award

Attendees of the premiere Reining Horse Foundation benefit event, Slid-er’s Night Out were pleasantly surprised to find celebrity Lyle Lovett among them; the audience displayed their appreciation with a standing ovation when the 4-time Grammy Award winning singer was presented with the NRHA Dale Wilkinson Lifetime Achievement Award.

Criteria for the award include a long and varied involvement in the reining horse industry preceded by a deep passion for the event that surpasses monetary gain. In order to be considered for the award, a person must also demonstrate a willingness to enhance the sportsmanship and congeniality of the sport of reining as well as introducing new participants to reining.

Lovett boasts a 16 year history with the reining industry and in that time as a Non Pro competitor, owner, and breeder has demonstrated such a passion and influence for

the industry that he was honored with an award named for him – the Lyle Lovett Distinguished Service Award.

Horses, Lyle has owned, have earned more than \$450,000, with more than \$151,000 of that figure having been earned by Smart And Shiney (Smart Shiner x Tronas Pearl, a stunning palomino stallion that Lyle campaigned through a partnership with \$3 Million Rider, Tim McQuay.

HISTORY MADE AT 2017 NRHA FUTURITY

The 2017 NRHA Futurity was a historic event. The Non Pro Level 4 Finals included both its youngest competitor ever, as well as its eldest. Multiple riders, owners, and horses met new milestones after the Open and Non Pro Finals as well.

Dr. James (Jim) Morgan, DVM is celebrated as the oldest competitor ever to make it to the Level 4 Non Pro Finals at 72 years old. He won the Non Pro Futurity 3 years in a row in 1984, 1985, and 1986. Dr. Morgan has a goal of reaching the Million Dollar Rider mark before he has to give his horses a rest.

“I’ve made 28 futurity finals in a row,” Morgan said. “As I look back on it, probably the nine times that I got second [in the finals] are just as profound [as winning it] because I raised most of those horses, and when you are raising two or three foals at a time, you don’t get to pick so you bring what

you raise. Some of them weren’t the best horses, but they tried hard, and they were second – some of them.”

Born 21 years after Dr. Morgan won his first Non Pro Futurity, Carlee McCutcheon beat her brother, Cade’s, record by 5 months when she became the new youngest rider in the Level 4 Non Pro Finals at 12 years and 2 months old at the time of the finals. This record seems to be a McCutcheon family tradition as Cade beat his mother’s record, and now Carlee topped Cade’s.

Carlee said, “I like it a lot! It’s fun to be the youngest, everyone congratulates me, and it’s nice to be congratulated!”

Also celebrating historical milestones, is Tom McCutcheon who unofficially passed the Million Dollar Owner mark after the success that horses he owns enjoyed including the Non Pro Futurity Champion, Best Nite Ever (One

Special Nite x Best By Benz) who won \$41,159.91. Before the Non Pro Finals, horses that Tom owns had earned \$950,437.67.

Silver Spurs Equine will also be celebrating induction into the Million Dollar Owner ranks soon, boasting an unofficial total of \$1,022,712.56. Xtra Dun Step (Wimpys Little Step x All That's Dun) added \$69,876.40 to the total for taking 4th place in the Level 4 Open finals. Xtra Gotta Step (Wimpys Little Step x Gotta Git Ya Dun) added \$8,304.02 for qualifying in the Level 4 Open finals.

Shawn Florida unofficially became a Six Million Dollar Rider after the Open Finals when Mr. Masota Star (Wimpys Little Step x Cee Another Masota) earned \$69,876.40 for placing 3rd in the Level 4 Finals, and Missin My Tinsel (Hollywoodstinseltown x Dont Miss This) earned \$21,173.50 for placing 9th. After the Open Finals, horses that Florida has ridden have earned a combined total of \$6,047,064.95.

Andrea Fappani may soon enjoy the official title of being

NRHA's newest Five Million Dollar Rider after two horses that Fappani rode in the Open Futurity Finals brought his total unofficially to \$5,061,176.53. All American Vintage(A Sparkling Vintage x All Ruffed Up) placed 2nd in the Open Finals and earned \$113,936.75. Lil Patron placed 26th and earned \$8,913.68.

Franco Bertolani also unofficially crossed the NRHA Million Dollar Rider milestone after Masked Gun (Colonels Smoking Gun x Dun It For Chex) earned \$45,062.63 when he tied for 5th in the Level 4 Open Futurity, and Chex For Nite (Gunners Special Nite x Dun It For Chex) contributed \$10,540.92 for placing 20th in the Level 4 Finals to help Bertolani achieve the title.

DOT TEMPORARILY WAIVES LOGGING DEVICE MANDATE FOR AGRICULTURE

90-DAY WAIVER EXTENDED TO LOOK AT AGRICULTURE'S REQUEST FOR AN EXEMPTION FROM MANDATE

Press Release from Department of Transportation
Dec. 3, 2017

The Department of Transportation has granted a 90-day waiver from the requirement that agricultural and livestock haulers install electronic logging devices in their vehicles. Over those 90 days the department plans to look closely at agriculture's request for an exemption while developing additional guidance for agricultural haulers.

Most farmers and ranchers should be exempt from the ELD mandate because they can claim covered farm vehicle status, but drivers who haul livestock, live fish and insects are likely to fall under the requirements.

In September, the American Farm Bureau Federation and seven livestock organizations petitioned DOT for a waiver and exemption from the Dec. 18 ELD implementation deadline. In their request, the groups explained their two biggest concerns about the requirement: livestock haulers' readiness to comply and the effect on the transported animals' well-being.

Drivers who have to use ELDs would be limited to current hours of service rules, which restrict a driver to only 14 "on duty" hours, with no more than 11 active driving hours. Once a driver hits those maximum hour allotments, he must stop and rest for 10 consecutive hours, which would be problematic when transporting livestock and other live animals.

In their petition, the groups pointed out livestock haulers' strong commitment to ensuring the safety of both the animals they're transporting and the drivers they share the road with. In addition, livestock haulers often receive specialized training beyond that required for their counterparts

driving conventional commercial motor vehicles. The pork industry's Transport Quality Assurance Program and the beef industry's Master Cattle Transporter program provide detailed instruction on proper animal handling and transportation methods.

"As reflected in the [Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration's] data, the emphasis these programs place on animal welfare benefits driver safety as it encourages livestock haulers to slow down, be more aware of their surroundings and road conditions, and avoid rough-road situations that could result in animal injury," the groups noted.

Another major roadblock to implementation for livestock haulers is their lack of awareness of the rule. Because the livestock hauling industry is small compared to the overall trucking industry, it isn't strongly engaged by DOT's Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration. As a result, livestock drivers who are aware of the program have had difficulty researching the ELD marketplace and identifying cost-effective solutions that are compatible with livestock hauling and current agricultural hours of service exemptions.

In their petition, the groups also asked DOT to address the incompatibilities between the FMCSA's hours of service rules and the structure and realities of the U.S. livestock sector.

"For many drivers, there is concern that there are those, with no understanding of or concern for animal welfare or livestock hauling, who will arbitrarily penalize them for choosing the proper care of animals over stopping in excessive heat or cold because of an arbitrary HOS cutoff," the groups said.

How this law Could Impact Horse Show Industry

As a breeder, owner, trainer or competitor in the horse industry, it is important to understand the implications of the ELD Mandate. The facts are that horse people would be required to install an electronic logging device (ELD) in your truck.

There are some exemptions in place for farm or agricultural hauling where an ELD would not be required.

However, many of the rigs used for hauling horses and the activities horse owners participate in, especially those that frequently travel to horse shows, fall outside the allowed exemptions.

What is the ELD Mandate? In 2012, the United States Congress enacted the bill "Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21 Century that was introduced by President Obama.

A part of this bill included a provision requiring the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Act (FMCSA) to develop a rule mandating the use of electronic logging devices (ELDs) on commercial vehicles.

Do we have to comply since we are hauling horses, not cattle or other livestock? Yes, horses are livestock and are specifically listed in the transportation bill language. It is not just the horse industry that is facing the ELD Mandate.

Families that show cattle, pigs and other livestock and travel long distances to show and compete will be impacted as well. It will also impact any other type of activity or hobby that requires a large vehicle and trailer and where there is the potential to win money in competitions.

The ELD Mandate requires that your vehicle must be fitted with a device under the following conditions: The “Not For Hire” myth: It is not uncommon to see “Not For Hire” graphics on trucks and horse trailers. The idea behind this is to avoid certain Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) regulations. This is an old fable that does not protect those hauling horses from fines for non-compliance. A “Not For Hire” sign on your rig will not protect you if it is determined that your truck and trailer fit into the commercial category or are being used for commercial purposes. Nor will it protect you if you are driving a vehicle and trailer that requires a commercial license.

A recreational vehicle exemption does not always apply: Living quarters horse trailers can be classified as recreational vehicles for private use. This classification exempts both the truck and trailer from being considered commercial as well as the requirements for the driver to obtain a commercial driver’s license. However, if an officer or inspector determines that the truck and trailer is being used in “furtherance of a commercial enterprise”, then the driver and vehicle are out of compliance with FMCSA regulations which can result in fines and being detained for an extended period.

For example, we have been made aware of situations where the owners of truck and trailers stopped by the Highway Patrol or other inspectors, were required to both obtain a Department of Transportation (DOT) number for their vehicle, and find a driver with a commercial driver’s license in order to resume their trip.

Most who show horses will fall outside of the exemption requirements. (See below) You are required to obtain a Commercial Driver’s License due to the weight of your truck and trailer (see below) license in order to resume their trip. In these cases, once the ELD Mandate is in effect, the drivers could also be required to purchase and install an ELD unit. (See below for clarification about the meaning of

“furtherance of a commercial enterprise”)

What does an ELD do? The ELD or electronic logging device synchronizes with the engine of a vehicle and keeps track of hours of service. It logs driving time, vehicle speed, routes, and keeps track of mandated rest periods as well as other data points. Once the vehicle is in motion and reaches 5 miles per hour, the ELD keeps track of time for the next 14 hours – nonstop.

Under the standard ELD regulations, there are no provisions to account for traffic, fueling, or loading and unloading. In those 14 hours, drivers are only allowed to drive for 11 hours. Because of this, drivers are forced to drive as much as they can during the 14 hours once the clock on the ELD starts. When the 14-hour limit has been reached, the ELD indicates to the driver that they must stop and “rest” for 10 consecutive hours. The ELD keeps track of any “infractions” – that is, going over the 14 hours as well as vehicle speed – and has reporting functions so inspectors can review the logs and fine drivers for infractions from days past.

This means that those hauling horses will be required to stop their trip once the 14-hour threshold is reached and cannot resume travel until the 10-hour rest period has passed. If the threshold is breached, the ELD makes a record that can be reviewed by authorities and you can be fined.

Have you noticed in the last several years all of the trucks that are parked along the side of the road? Have you noticed that on and off ramps and picnic and rest areas are sometimes filled up with trucks? Those typically are drivers that have reached their limit and have to immediately find a place to park their trucks to avoid costly violations.

If you are required to install an ELD for your truck and horse trailer, this could easily happen to you too. Mandated breaks: According to the Hours of Service outlined in the Federal Motor Carriers Safety Administration rules, rest breaks are mandatory in addition to the ten hour rest period. Commercial drivers are required to take a 30-minute break within the 11 hour driving period and cannot go past 8 hours without taking a break.

This mandatory break is calculated from when the vehicle starts moving and is tracked by the ELD. It does not take into account any other stops or breaks that may have occurred within the 8-hour time period. The break must be 30 consecutive minutes. A driver cannot substitute the 30-minute break with a 10-minute break and later a 20-minute break. There is no getting around this as the ELD records and stores the 30 consecutive minute break periods and will subject the driver to penalty for a rule violation upon inspection.

Additionally, the 30-minute break is included in the 14-hour time limit. Imagine your horses in 100 degree weather.

What constitutes a Commercial Motor Vehicle (CMV) classification? Are you writing off your truck or trailer as a business loss or expense on your tax returns? Tax write offs for your truck and trailer would make them fall under the commercial classification. Are your truck and/or trailer being used for your business? If your truck or trailer is being used for your business, they fall under the commercial classification. If you are a trainer, your truck and trailer is used for business, there's no doubt about it. If you are a Non Pro or amateur competitor, your truck and trailer can be considered as used for business (see "furtherance of a commercial enterprise" explanation below). If you are a Non pro or amateur and breed horses and sell them, your truck and trailer are considered as used for business.

Do you only haul your own horses? If not and if you collect payment, (for example splitting fuel costs) to haul a friend or client's horse to a show, to the trainer, to the vet, or to the breeder, your truck and trailer are considered commercial vehicles.

Have you won money competing with your horse or a client's horse? Even though most often competing with horses is not profitable for a Non Pro when calculating all the costs, the FMCSA could consider money won at a horse show or event, a profit. They can also consider hauling to an event with the intent or hopes of winning some money, as pursu-

ing a profit. This definition of "profit" then classifies your truck and trailer as commercial.

Do you have sponsors? Do you have their stickers on your truck or trailer? Just about everyone knows a roper, rodeo or horse show contestant who has a "day job" (horseshoer as an example) that spends part of their time traveling to events to compete. In many cases, especially with rodeo events, (some associations have strict rules about sponsorships and others do not) they also have sponsors, whether its ropes, saddle pads, clothing or other equipment. Those sponsorships qualify as "furtherance of a commercial enterprise" and then put them in the commercial category.

If your vehicle has a Gross Vehicle Weight Rating over 10,000 pounds and is used for your business or with the intent to make a profit or involved in interstate commerce, like going to horse shows out of your home state, it then falls into the commercial vehicle classification by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA).

Simply, if you are traveling to horse events frequently, and drive a dually with a 4+ horse trailer, you are more than likely to fall into the classification where an ELD is required on your vehicle.

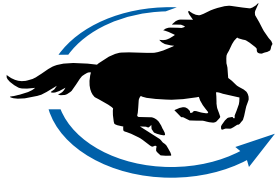
