JOHN HOYT – THE INDUSTRY LOST A LEGEND


The entire reining community and western horse world was saddened to hear of the passing of John Hoyt on the morning of December 20, 2016. He was surrounded by family and friends in his cabin in Texas.

Talented, outspoken and beloved and admired by many in the reining community, Hoyt was a legendary horseman who influenced many of the industry's top riders. Al Dunning summed up Hoyt's influence on reining and other western disciplines by saying, "John was the Dale Wilkinson of the West!"

NRHA Judge and long-time friend Greg Darnall added to that opinion saying, "He's the John Wayne of the horse training business. He backs away from nothing." Hoyt was well-known for his ability to mentor others with blunt honesty and to get extraordinary performances out of ordinary horses.

Hoyt, a native Californian, was inducted into the NRHA Hall of Fame in 2010 after a decade-spanning and award-winning career. His accomplishments include more than \$49,300 in NRHA earnings and multiple AQHA World Championships. Hoyt qualified for 21 AQHA World Championship Shows in a row. He was the 1986 NRHA Futurity Limited Open Reserve Champion on Okies Sure Bet. In 1988, he rode Lady Kiper to win the Intermediate and Limited Open ancillary classes at the NRHA Derby.

CUSTOM CROME IS NEWEST NRHA \$4 MILLION SIRE

In late December, the National Reining Horse Association announced that Custom Crome has become the association's newest Four Million Dollar Sire. This accomplishment makes him only the ninth stallion to achieve this milestone and came quickly upon the heels of reaching NRHA Three Million Dollar status just four years earlier.

The 1990 AQHA stallion is owned by Steve Simon of Marietta, Okla. Custom Crome is by Crome Plated Jac and out of Another Greyhound.

As a performer, Custom Crome won the 1993 NRHA Open Futurity with NRHA Hall of Fame Inductee Mike Flarida at the reins. Throughout his show career Custom Crome earned nearly \$110,000 and was inducted in to the NRHA Hall of Fame in 2009.



Owned and bred by NRHA Million Dollar Owner and Hall of Fame Inductee Rosanne Sternberg. the 2001 Stallion by NRHA Six Million Dollar Sire Smart Chic Olena and out of Sugarplum Spook (by NRHA Two Million Dollar Sire Grays Starlight) had a successful show career with \$403,150 in NRHA lifetime earnings.

FEI ANNOUNCES CANDIDATE CITIES FOR WORLD EQUESTRIAN GAMES 2022

Two cities have been announced as official candidates to host the FEI World Equestrian Games[™] 2022. Lexington, Kentucky and Šamorín, Slovakia have both been selected as potential hosts for the FEI flagship in six years' time.

"We are very happy to have two such strong official candidates for the 2022 FEI World Equestrian Games," FEI President Ingmar De Vos said. "Both the Kentucky and Samorin venues have the infrastructure in place already to host the Games, which is one of the biggest events on the global sporting calendar.

"The last edition in Normandy two years ago attracted more than half a million spectators and a worldwide television audience of 350 million, delivering a significant economic impact to the French economy.

"There's no doubt that these Games are a huge undertaking, but we believe both Šamorín and Kentucky have the capability to host spectacular Games and we look forward to working with them through the further stages of the bid process over the next year."

The next phase in the decision-making process for the 2022 Games will include site visits between January and May 2017, with a deadline of June 2017 for submission of

the Candidates' complete bid and signed host agreement. The Candidates will make formal presentations to the FEI Evaluation Commission in the third quarter of 2017, with the final FEI Bureau decision and allocation of the Games in November 2017.



The FEI World Equestrian Games, held every four years in the middle of the Olympic cycle, combines eight World Championships at one event. The FEI disciplines - Jumping, Dressage and Para-Equestrian Dressage, Eventing, Driving, Endurance, Vaulting and Reining - are all included on the competition schedule.

The inaugural FEI World Equestrian GamesTM were hosted in Stockholm, Sweden in 1990. Since then the Games have been staged in The Hague, Netherlands in 1994, Rome, Italy in 1998, Jerez, Spain in 2002, and Aachen,

Germany in 2006. The first Games to be organized outside Europe were the Alltech FEI World Equestrian Games in Lexington, Kentucky 2010. The Games came back to Europe for the 2014 edition, the Alltech FEI World Equestrian Games in Normandy, France.

The 2014 Games in Normandy attracted more than 500,000 on-site spectators and a worldwide television audience of 350 million, as well as delivering an economic

impact of €368 million to the French economy.

The FEI World Equestrian Games 2018 will be held at the Tryon International Equestrian Center in North Carolina September 10-23, 2018. The 2018 Games were originally allocated to Bromont, Québec, Canada, but were switched to Tryon at the beginning of November following the withdrawal of Bromont earlier this year.
