NON PRO CONDITIONS UPDATES FROM THE NRHA BOARD

In May of this year, the National Reining Horse Association (NRHA) Board of Directors approved a proposal to change its Non Pro Conditions starting January 1, 2018. After receiving a tremendous amount of comments and questions from the membership, the Board met on June 15 to revisit the topic. Following discussion, they approved to rescind the proposal (#27-01-18) so that it will not go into effect next year.

Following the May Board Meeting, a great amount of feedback was given to the Board and NRHA's Non Pro Committee. Many members expressed concerns about how

the rule would impact them as Non Pros and how it could be detrimental to the industry overall. In response, the topic was added to the June 15 Board Meeting agenda and was reviewed. As a result, a motion was put forward and approved to rescind the rule change that, in effect, leaves the rule unchanged from what is currently listed in the 2017 NRHA Handbook.

The Board intends to continue discussions regarding Non Pro Conditions, and appreciates receiving member feedback on programs and rules that are important to them. For a digital copy of the 2017 NRHA Handbook, visit nrha.com.

GOODBYE TO AN ICON! MR MELODY JAC



Lantz Performance Horses' Facebook page announced the death of 1988 National Reining Horse Association Futurity Open Champion Mr Melody Jac. He passed away June 6 at the age of 32 on the Lantz farm where he lived out his breeding career and retirement.

Mr Melody Jac (Hollywood Jac 86 x Dude's Bueno Gal x Senor Jessie Day) was shown by \$3 Million Rider Tim McQuay earning over \$112K in a short career during an era where earnings were dramatically less than today. His foals earned nearly \$800,000 and his highest money earning son was Heza German Melody (Melonkali Honey x Kaliman)

with over \$92K in earnings.

Mr Melody Jac was bred by Richard Greenberg. An exceptional broodmare sire – with daughters producing earners of over \$1.1 million including the 2004 Wimpys Little Step stallion, Yellow Jersey (x Ms Clara Melody), who was retired with more than \$150K in winnings after earning gold team and bronze individual medals for Mandy McCutcheon. In fact, it was the Mr Melody Jac breeding that swayed Tim McQuay to purchasing Yellow Jersey, now the senior stallion at McQuay Stables.

SECOND ANNUAL WILD CARD REINING CHALLENGE RESULTS

The 2017 Wild Card Reining Challenge and Tamarack Ranch 4 Year Old Futurity held at the incredible South Point Hotel and Casino Arena in Las Vegas, Nevada marked a successful second year when it increased an overall 85%. That large of a jump wasn't quite expected, but was a huge blessing and an indication that this new event is being welcomed with open arms by the reining community.

The Wild Card Reining Challenge is a game changer for reining horses and their riders. The focus on the 4-year-old reiner with huge payouts, educational seminars and a fun, family-friendly environment drew participants from all over the U.S., Canada and even spectators from England and the Netherlands.

The show began with two slates of NRHA Affiliate Qualifiers under the Desert Reining Horse Association. Dunit In Wranglers with rider/owner Melissa Wigen from Plain City, Utah, won both slates of the Novice Horse Level 2 Non Pro and ultimately the High Point Championship. Wigen's ac-

complishments in the show pen are remarkable considering that not long ago she had a devastating horse accident which has resulted in multiple surgeries. Just eight weeks prior to the Wild Card event, Wigen was in surgery once again. Not only has she had to recover physically, but also regained her self-confidence. Dunit In Wranglers has given Wigen that confidence and she is so very grateful.

"I have a nice horse and I am thankful everything came together," Wigen said. "I absolutely love Brumley shows. The staff treats their exhibitors so nicely. They put so much work into the ground and you can tell that they care about their exhibitors. The prizes are also over the top. Brumley events are by far my favorite shows."

Rookie competition was tough. "The Rookie and Green divisions are some of my favorites," said Amanda Brumley, producer of the Wild Card Reining Challenge. "I love to see new faces in our sport, as the grass roots of our industry are vital to its success."

Newcomer to the reining world is Wendy Claus from Scottsdale, Ariz. Wendy spent 30 years riding cutting horses. The Wild Card was Wendy's fifth reining competition. Wendy and her horse, Drag N Tail, swept the DRHA Rookie division winning the High Point Championship custom trophy buckle and Bob's Custom Trophy Saddle. Wendy was also Reserve High Point Champion DRHA Green As Grass and Green Reiner.

"We bred and raised my horse Drag N Tail (a.k.a. Batman)" Claus said. "In fact I showed his dam and grand-dam in cuttings as far back as 1984. It's incredibly rewarding to have this line of horses in my own family for more than 30 years. The only saddle I own is a cutting saddle, so it definitely was a dream come true to win my very own Bob's Custom reining saddle in Vegas!"

Another highlight of BMG Events is the Non Pro Maturity sponsored by SmartPak. The Maturity offers horses 7 years of age and older and Arabians 6 years of age and older, a place to shine. Kevin Rosenbaum from Scottsdale, Ariz. and his steady gelding, Rolex N Chex, claimed the Championships in the Level 4, 3 and 2 divisions winning a total of \$1,384.44, three trophy buckles, custom trophies, ribbons, and lots of horse cookies.

"We really appreciate that these events run so smoothly," Rosenbaum said. "I'd like to thank BMG Events for being the first to create a special event for the 4 year olds, while also making the maturity an important part of all your shows. Thank you to Brumley Management and the amazing sponsors that make these prizes possible."

Friday, May 26 began at 9:00 a.m. with Two Million Dollar NRHA Professional Jordan Larson's Reining Seminar. The focus was on correcting a problem often seen with horses in the run down to the stop. Jordan worked with two horses, donated by Muehlstaetter Performance Horses for the seminar. Jordan presented in detail the ways he works with horses that do not "rate" down to the stop and his training routine to teach the horse to listen to his legs and hands. The semi-

nar was free to all who attended and broadcast live over the internet via HorseShowGlobal.com, produced by Classic Video.

Following the Jordan Larson Seminar, the youth riders performed at their best, impressing everyone with such young talent. Kaylee Naylor is a frequent face in the reining pen and a tough competitor, winning both slates of Youth 14 – 18 and placing second and third on her other two horses. Kaylee's success led to High Point Champion on Spookamatic, Reserve High Point on Spooks Dunit and third on Hezza Rowdy Whiz.

Kaylee's excitement was overflowing after her wins.

"The show was amazing and I can't wait for next year! My horses were amazing for me and I can't wait for High Roller. I got the privilege to show both of my dad's derby horses and they were so good (considering I was so nervous)," Naylor said.

Brumley said, "Kaylee is an exceptional athlete and person. I have watched her grow up from a little girl to an extraordinary young woman. I am happy for her success."

The excitement grew with the approach of the Tamarack Ranch 4 Year Old Non Pro Futurity and 4 Year Old Stakes. Two time NRHA Level 4 Non Pro Futurity Champion Tish Fappani, Scottsdale, Ariz., and her gelding Fun Sized (Tinker With Guns x Brennans Dream, by Magnum Chic Dream) entered the show pen looking cool and collected. When the dust settled the pair marked a 214.5 to win the Level 4 and 3 Futurity and Stakes divisions earning a total paycheck of \$20,755. Tish was shocked by the payout and thrilled with her little horse.

"Miles, (Fun Sized), was not shown as a 3 year old due to an injury. He has always been small. My son, Luca, named him Fun Sized, which is so appropriate," Fappani said. "I didn't get to come last year. Miles is so kind minded, but green. Coming into this show I didn't enter the Stakes divisions thinking he could not be competitive. I'm glad I was talked into it."

Fappani said, "I love this 4 year old concept. The Futurity eligibility is so good to level the playing field for horses just like Miles, while the Stakes is open to all 4 year olds giving them their own showcase event. It's great for our industry and our horses."

Fappani went on to thank Tamarack Ranch for their support of the concept and the show. "On top of the prize money, I won a Bob's Custom Saddle, Custom Reiner Trophy, beautiful buckle, SmartPak horse cooler and lots of cookies for Miles. Down time was great too. We had time to spend hanging at the pool with the boys, go to dinner and even see a show. Great event!"

Tish Fappani wasn't the only big winner. Janelle Flaherty from Scottsdale, Ariz., entered her father-in-law's home bred horse Walla Walla Lil Pep (Walla Walla Whiz x Juanita Chic Olena) and was Reserve Level 4 and Level 3, Champion Level 2 and Level 1 in the Futurity divisions winning \$14,346.80. Unlike Tish, Janelle didn't cross enter into the Stakes, which if she had would have won approximately another \$9,000.

When asked about it, Flaherty said, "I actually didn't plan on showing him at all. Couple days prior to the competition, my husband Patrick and I were sitting in one of the bars here at South Point talking about it with my father-in-law, Steve. We decided to go for it. I didn't bring any of my show cloths so I borrowed hat, chaps and a shirt from friends. I had a nice quiet ride which turned out to be quite the payday."

Flaherty said, "The 4 year old futurity option is so important for horses not ready as a 3 year old (to show) for whatever reason. This can only do good things for the industry."

The Prima Ballerina (Topsail Whiz x Dancer Nic) owned

and ridden by Jennifer Gilliam from Pine Grove, Cali., was Reserve Champion in the Level 4 and 3 Stakes and Champion Level 2. Jennifer and her mare added another \$7,744.50 to their lifetime earnings.

Saturday morning, "Inside the Mind of An NRHA Judge" with Jody Brainard seminar on the South Point concourse had a standing room only crowd. Exhibitors got a chance to review video clips of runs, were presented with examples of how maneuvers are marked on the score sheet, and had the opportunity to ask lots of questions.

"When I came up with the concept of this event, I knew what my goals were. I wanted a showcase event for 4 year old reining horses, and learning opportunities for exhibitors. My plan is to have these seminars grow as the event grows. They are extremely valuable. I can't thank Jordan and Jody enough for generously donating their time as presenters," Brumley said.

Saturday afternoon's showcase event, the Tamarack Ranch Open 4 Year Old Futurity and Open 4 Year Old Stakes was a reining and spectator experience to remember. The sizable number of entries and new faces to BMG events competed for tens of thousands of dollars in prize money. Forty Six horses were set to compete, but the atmosphere was calm, cool and collected. Draw 21, Gabe Hutchins riding the

Tamarack Ranch, Joseph Oregon, entry Ladi With A Gun (Gunner x Easy Lil Lady) hoped to repeat their 2016 Level 4 Futurity win. Hutchins had faith in the mare and that she could also be competitive in the Stakes. His faith paid off. The duo marked a 219.5 to tie for the championship with Andrea Fappani riding Legends West (Custom Legend x Western Whizzy) owned and raised by Scott Loughridge. Both horses earned checks for \$6,692.76.

Hutchins' cross entry in the Stakes put him third in the

Level 4 Open division adding another \$1,800.17 for a total of \$8,492.93 in prize money for the pretty bay mare. Hutchins showed another mount, Spookmon (Smart Spook x Brennas Red Dunit) marking a 221 to win Reserve Champion Level 4 Open Stakes and an additional paycheck of \$2,769.50.

Level 3 Open Tamarack Ranch 4 Year Old Futurity Champion, Hollywallwood, a 2013 stallion (Walla Walla Whiz x Strike Like A Star) with rider Pierre-Luc Phaneuf from Whitesboro Texas for owner Guy Methot scored a 217 and a check for \$4,923.40. As his friends affectionately call him, 'P-Luc' was very pleased with his horse.

"I couldn't be happier with my run," Phaneuf said. "He was with me every step. I think the Wild Card Reining Challenge is a great concept for horses that weren't ready their 3 year old year to have a chance to show their potential as 4 year olds. 'Wally' was a perfect candidate for this show. I am glad I was able to give him the chance to prove himself. He is a really nice horse. Definitely made my trip from Texas (to the event) worth every mile."

Benny Maddox rode Little Cannonball (Tinker With Guns x Chex Out The Cowgirl) bred and owned by Bill Coburn, Redding Cali., to win the Level 2 and 1 Open Futurity. Maddox's wins earned him a check of \$3,879.08. Patrick Flaherty brought Walla Walla Lil Pep back into the show pen after his wife's big win the day prior to pick up another \$5,675.59 which makes the Flaherty's total win \$20,022.39.

Andrea Fappani, Scottsdale Ariz., took the Level 4 Open Stakes Championship aboard Rancho Oso Rio's entry Spooks Show Time (Spooks Gotta Whiz x Dolittle Lena) marking a 222.50 and earning \$3,461.88.

The Level 3 and 2 Open Stakes were dominated by assis-

tant trainers of Martin Muehlstaetter, of Muehlstaetter Performance Horses from Scottsdale Ariz. Lorinaldo Gomes, a native of Brazil, rode Gunners High Roller (Gunner x Yoplait Light) for owners Marc & Kathy Gordon to the Level 3 and 2 Championships receiving a check for \$4,162.51. Marc and Kathy Gordon's second entry piloted by Linde Von Koeding from Germany won both reserve titles and a check for \$3,070.28. It was a great day in the Muehlstaetter barn!

Four Million Dollar NRHA Professional Andrea Fappani after the event said, "Wild Card Reining Challenge is a great opportunity to showcase four year olds and build their confidence in the show pen. It's a great facility and perfect time of year for young horses. The horse I Co-Championed on (Legends West) just wasn't ready to take the pressure as a three year old. Waiting to show him proved to be the right decision. If I would have tried to show him too early I know it wouldn't have been good for his confidence. Showing him at the Wild Card was the perfect start to his show career."

Brumley said, "I want to thank our incredible sponsors who contribute to this event, South Point Arena, Tamarack Ranch, Markel, Lucas Oil, Silver Spurs Equine, Horse & Rider Magazine, Smart-Pak as well as the reining professionals and contestants for their continuous support BMG events. Most of all I want to thank my family for their endless support and faith in my sometimes scary ideas. Tracy and I have contributed over \$80,000 in the past two years directly to this event. Why? We are not tremendously wealthy people, but we believe in this event and our industry enough to risk our own money. We love horses and this sport. We want positive growth, and to see the right things done for the industry's participants. We are truly blessed to have this opportunity and with wonderful people in our lives."

2018 AQHA HALL OF FAME INDUCTEES

Five horses and six AQHA members have been selected for induction into the American Quarter Horse Hall of Fame in 2018.

Induction into the American Quarter Horse Hall of Fame is the highest honor that can be bestowed by AQHA. Those chosen for induction are recognized for their lifetime of accomplishments and service.

The horses in the Class of 2018 are Maroon (TB), Otoe, Runaway Winner, Smart Chic Olena and The Ole Man.

The four men and two women who will join the Hall of Fame are Abigail Kawanakoa of Nuevo, Cali.; Dr. Tom Lenz of Louisburg, Kansas; the late AQHA Past President Gene Graves of Grand Island, Nebraska; Georga and the late Raymond Sutton of Gettysburg, South Dakota; and the late Robert Sutherland of Kansas City, Missouri.

The Thoroughbred mare, Maroon, was foaled in 1949 without many expectations, the result of a free breeding to a difficult mare. After an unpromising start to her own racing career, she flipped over in the gate in her first official start and injured her back, she recovered to start winning against such noted horses as Brigand, Johnny Dial, AQHA Hall of Fame horses Black Easter Bunny and Miss Meyers. She raced 52 times officially and produced 13 foals. Six generations later, her offspring are still winning. The hard-starting mare had founded a dynasty for her owners and American Quarter Horse Hall of Fame members R.C. “Punch” and Suzanne Jones of Tatum, New Mexico. Maroon died in 1977.

In 1961, the yearling stallion, Otoe, sold for \$20,000 – about double the cost of a new house – to Donald Ranch of El Paso, Texas. As a 2-year-old, Otoe delivered on the promise of his Sugar Bars bloodlines, winning five times in 13 race starts as a 2-year-old. He was shown at halter 23 times, winning grand champion 20 times and becoming an AQHA Champion in 1962. He was retired to the breeding shed, and in 1964, his first foal crop hit the ground. His foals won in the show ring and on the racetrack. Otoe is among the leading sires of Open AQHA Champions. He colicked and died in 1971.

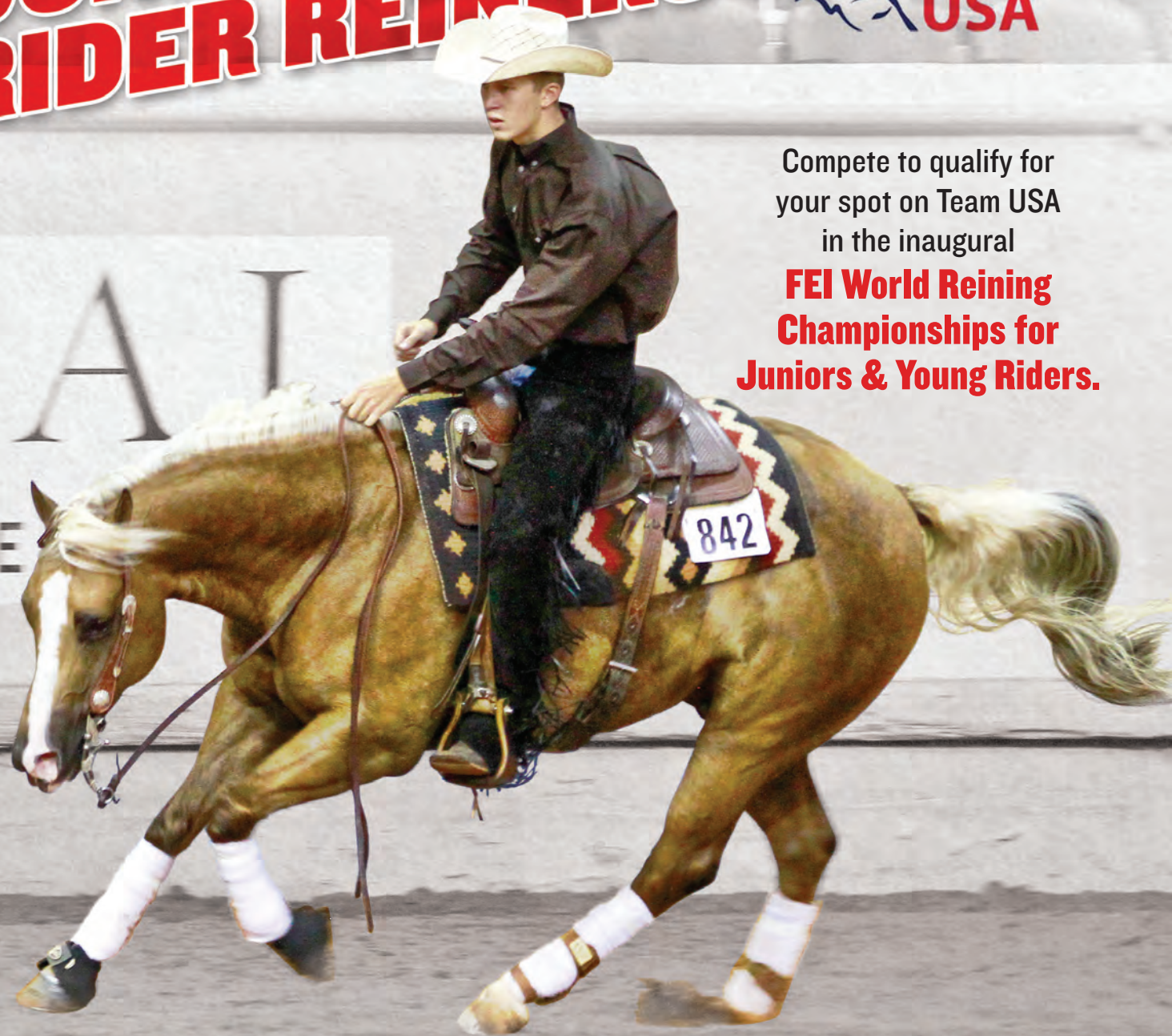
In 1987, Runaway Winner lived up to his name. The 1985 gray stallion by Bediuno (TB) earned \$369,410 and set a top speed index of 104 before retiring due to a chipped knee. It was in the breeding shed where Runaway Winner really hit his stride for owner and AQHA Past President Jerry Windham of College Station, Texas. Runaway Winner sired the winners of \$13.7 million, including two champions in his first two foal crops. He became known as a sire of broodmares and a sire of sires. He was euthanized in 2015.

The versatile Smart Chic Olena competed at high levels in two difficult disciplines, and he sired foals just like him. Smart Chic Olena was the 1990 AQHA world champion in senior cutting and the 1993 world champion in senior reining, the only horse in AQHA history to do so. After retirement to the breeding shed, the 1985 sorrel stallion by Smart Little Lena and out of Gay Sugar Chic by Gay Bar King proved he was a sire to be reckoned with. His foals have earned more than \$12 million in cutting, reining and reined

cow horse competition. Last owned by Trevor and Tiffany Bond of Mound Valley, Kansas, Smart Chic Olena was euthanized in 2012.

From birth, The Ole Man was destined for the racetrack. The 1963 sorrel stallion was foaled after the death of his breeder, Frank Vessels Sr. of Los Alamitos, Cali., and he was named The Ole Man in Vessels' honor. The son of American Quarter Horse Hall of Fame members Three Bars (TB) and Chicado V collected \$21,156 on the racetrack in 1965-66. Race career finished, The Ole Man sired horses that were conformation and racing winners. His daughters produced more winners. The Ole Man died in 1995 and is buried at the farm of his last owner of record, Roy Browning of Shawnee, Oklahoma.

The late Gene Graves thought of himself as being in service to the members, making sure members received full value from their AQHA memberships. Graves was elected to the AQHA Board of Directors in 2000, serving on task forces and committees before being elected to the AQHA Executive Committee. Graves served as AQHA president in 2012-13. Diagnosed with pancreatic cancer prior to serving as AQHA president, Gene's goal was to serve AQHA to the best of his ability. He died June 14, 2013, just three months after successfully completing his presidential term.

Racehorse breeder and owner Abigail Kawanankoa became involved in American Quarter Horse racing in the 1970s, and her horses dominated the tracks in the early 1990s. Her mare Florentine was broodmare of the year in 1996, the same year "Miss Abigail" was champion owner, starting horses at 12 tracks in nine states and one Canadian province, winning 38 races in 153 starts. In 1993, A Classic Dash won the All American Futurity for Kawanankoa. To date, foals bred by Kawanankoa have won \$9.89 million on the track. The 30-year breeder has produced four world champions that have won five world championships.

Dr. Tom Lenz, a veterinarian and a past president of the American Association of Equine Practitioners, has spent his life speaking out for equine welfare. After time in the U.S. Army, he earned his DVM in 1975 from the University of Missouri before beginning private practice. Dr. Lenz has been an AQHA honorary vice president since 2009, serving on AQHA committees, as well as the AQHA Equine Welfare Commission. Dr. Lenz is a member of the American Horse Council, serving on the welfare committee and also serves on the board of directors for the Unwanted Horse Coalition.

He received the AAEP distinguished service award in 2005. He recently retired from Zoetis. Dr. Lenz also writes the monthly Horse Health column for The American Quarter Horse Journal.

Georga and Raymond Sutton have been breeding American Quarter Horses in South Dakota since the 1960s, earning the AQHA Legacy Award – given for 50 consecutive years of breeding – in 2001. Raymond was an international judge and a national director from 1985 until his death in 2005. Georga was elected an AQHA director in 2005, serving on the international and Hall of Fame selection committees. She was named an honorary vice president in 2013. The Suttons also worked actively in the South Dakota Quarter Horse Association. The Suttons' annual horse production sale is thought to be the oldest consecutive sale in the world, with 2016 marking the sale's 65th anniversary.

The late Robert Sutherland's goal was to make good horses available to everyone. The 40-year breeder of American Quarter Horses started the RS Bar Ranch in suburban Kansas City with the intention of breeding the best to the best. Sutherland helped found the Missouri Quarter Horse Association and served several terms as president. He helped arrange for American Quarter Horses to be part of the prestigious American Royal Horse Show in Kansas City, where he was chairman of the horse show for 10 years. Sutherland donated 25 horses each to the colleges of agriculture at Kansas State University and the University of Missouri. Both colleges are still breeding American Quarter Horses. His bust stands in the American Quarter Horse Hall of Fame & Museum as a founder of the museum.

The American Quarter Horse Hall of Fame & Museum beautifully showcases the dozens of horses and people who have earned the distinction of becoming part of the American Quarter Horse Hall of Fame. To be a part of the Hall of Fame, horses and people must have been outstanding over a period of years in a variety of categories. Inductees are those who have brought exceptional visibility and/or contribution to the American Quarter Horse. Hall of Fame inductees are chosen each year by a selection committee and honored at the annual AQHA convention.

Derby Open Champions
Justin Wright on Lil Bay Hawk

JUSTIN WRIGHT TAKES NRCHA DERBY OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP ON LIL BAY HAWK

A thrilling day of reined cow horse action on Saturday, June 17, wrapped up the main event at the National Reined Cow Horse Association Derby in Paso Robles, Cali., with the finals for Open and Non Pro competitors. Champions were crowned in three Open and three Non Pro Derby divisions and the crowd saw a longtime top competitor win his first major Open event!

The NRCHA Derby is the biggest and richest event for 4- and 5-year-old reined cow horses, with the total payout in 2017 exceeding \$300,000. Shown two-handed in a snaffle bit or a hackamore, horses are judged in three events: rein work, herd work and cow work.

of Santa Maria, Cali.. He had three horses in the finals and won the Championship – his first NRCHA Premier Event Open title – with Stephen Silva’s Lil Bay Hawk (Catty Hawk x Gray Little Freckles x Playgun), scoring a phenomenal 672.5 composite (225 herd/220.5 rein/227 fence).

Wright and Lil Bay Hawk were the composite leaders after two events, and were among the last few horses to go down the fence. Wright needed a big score to overtake the leader, NRCHA Two Million Dollar Rider Todd Bergen, Eagle Point, Ore., and Boonlight Roan Bar (Bet Hesa Cat x Cat Boonlight Jewels x High Brow Cat), who were in the lead with a 666.5 total.

Derby Open Finals night was emotional for Justin Wright, “I don’t remember most of it,” Wright said of the fence

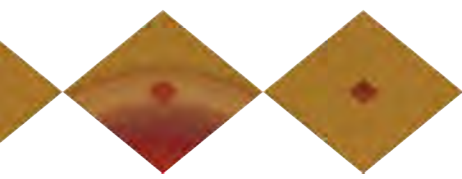

work. “He went in there, and it felt good, and it just all worked out. Every turn, it seemed like we just stayed in time, and it was incredible. It’s everything I’ve ever dreamed of – winning a major, and it’s just incredible.”

The Championship paid \$29,588 and came with prizes including a saddle from Jividen’s Customs, sponsored by McSpyder Ranch; a Gist buckle; boots from Rios of Mercedes; and product from Platinum Performance and Santa Cruz Animal Health.

Todd Bergen rode Boonlight Roan Bar to the Open Reserve Championship, earning \$22,391 for owner Tony Grover.

Wright had two other horses in the Open finals. He tied for 4th on Mark and Kelly Gowing’s home-bred stallion, Step To The Light (CD Lights x Shinersdiamondjackie x Shining Spark) scoring a 663.5 (216.5 herd/224.5 rein/221 cow), earning \$12,795. His other finalist, Light N Sassy (CD Lights x Dual Sass x Dual Pep), finished 11th with a 656 composite, earning \$3,998 for owners Mark and Kimberly Rauch.

By the time the finals came around, Light And Sassy had already won big as the preliminary scores determined the 2017 Derby Open Novice Horse Championship. Brand-new to her trainer’s program she demonstrated her talent and work ethic as she not only earned the Novice Horse title, but also claimed a spot in the Open Finals.

Light And Sassy (CD Lights x Dual Sass x Dual Pep), a 2012 mare, scored a 653.5 composite (214.5 herd/ 219.5 rein/219.5 fence), winning nearly \$3,000. Mark and Kim Rauch, Arlington, Washington, sent the mare to Wright just two months ago. Even for Wright, one of the NRCHA’s top

20 professionals, it was a challenge to prepare a new horse for a major event in such a short time frame.

“She’s a really neat mare. She’s had to work hard the last couple months to get used to a new program. She stepped up to the plate and never second-guessed what I was asking. She always tried her guts out and came out the next day with a good attitude. She’s advanced really quick. I was still unsure when I got here, because I hadn’t showed her at a major event. She has surprised me all week, and has been better every time I got her out,” Wright said.

He was pleased to deliver the news to the Rauches that their mare had not only won the prestigious Open Novice Horse title, but had a chance to earn an even bigger prize on Saturday.

“It’s very exciting making the finals for them, because they’re newer owners. They’re really neat people, and this is the first aged event horse I’ve showed for them. It’s cool that she was able to do this,” Wright said.

The Open Novice Horse Reserve Champion was Spin N Twist Arey (Dual Rey x Cats Twisted Whisker x High Brow Cat), shown by NRCHA Million Dollar Rider Zane Davis for owner C Ranches, Inc. Spin N Twist Arey scored a 650.5 (215.5 herd/214.5 rein/220.5 fence), collecting a \$2,355 paycheck and a berth in the Derby Open finals.

Intermediate Open Champion

The Derby Intermediate Open Champion was Nee On Lights (CD Lights x Shine Smartly x Shining Spark), shown by NRCHA Professional Shawn Hays, Nocona, Texas, for owner Yellow Creek Ranch. Nee On Lights, a 2012 stallion bred by Hays’ wife, and her father, Walter Greeman, scored a 655 composite (216 herd/218 rein/221 fence). The Intermediate Open Championship came with a \$6,981 paycheck. Hays and Nee On Lights earned another \$3,198 for finishing 12th in the Open.

“I drew a good cow, and that little horse, he was on target in the fence work. He was a little tired because it’s been real hot today. The cows, in the prelims, the heat kind of tapped them out, but the cows didn’t weaken today. They stayed strong. We went down and made a good right turn, jumped out and made a good left turn and got circled up,” Hays said.

Hays praised the honest nature of the horse he has known since he was foaled, out of the Hays family’s champion performing and producing mare, Shine Smartly.

“He goes in and tries to give you the same run every time. He doesn’t try and cheat you. He’s just a really solid little

show horse,” Hays said.

Hays had two other horses in the finals. He earned combined paychecks of \$3,317 in the Open and Intermediate Open on Hes The Katz Meow, owned by Dustin Deckard; and picked up \$551 in the Intermediate Open aboard Playin Motown, owned by Moncrief and Lee.

Limited Open Champion

Hollister, Cali., professional Brendon Clark piloted Metal Cat (Metallic Cat x Tipofthestar x Grays Starlight) to the Derby Limited Open Championship, scoring a 632.5 composite (215 herd/210.5 rein/207 fence). The win paid \$5,836.

“I won the Level 1 Limited Open here last year, and was Reserve in the Limited Open, so to come back this year and be able to win the Limited, is exciting. I worked really hard over the last few years trying to learn as much as I can, and I’m still learning something every day,” Clark, a former professional bull rider, said.

Clark owns Metal Cat in partnership with friends Quentin Kersh and Jonathan Fine, and praised the gelding’s steady temperament and cow sense.

Clark said, “He’s a horse that doesn’t need a lot of work. You don’t need to warm him up much. You just go in, and he does what you want. He’s a nice-minded horse.”

Level 1 Limited Open Champion

The Wright Quarter Horses team had another reason to celebrate on Thursday, as Justin Wright’s assistant trainer, Daniel Sanchez, won the Level 1 Limited Open Championship riding Mi Smart Ichi Girl (Cat Ichi x A Smart LaG-Girl x Laker Doc), owned by Mary Hobbs. The 2012 mare scored a 641.5 composite (211 herd/212 rein/218.5 fence),

earning \$2,123.

“She’s a super gritty mare. She’s always been gritty, and a great fence horse. She’s not going to get outrun down the fence. If the cow has a little spunk to it, she’s going to be right there with it, and that’s what she did today. Everyone said it was scary, but we were just trying to get that cow caught,” Sanchez said.

The 22 year old horseman has been an assistant trainer to top NRCHA Professionals, starting his career under Jake Gorrell, Hanford, Cali.. Sanchez currently works for Justin Wright, which completes a full-circle family tradition.

“My dad worked for the Wrights for 20-plus years. Justin has known me since I was a baby. He’s pretty much like my big brother, been a role model my whole life. I’ve looked up to him showing horses, so it’s pretty great to be competing against him now and working for him. It’s pretty awesome,” Sanchez said.

He thanked Wright, Gorrell, his parents, and Mi Smart Ichi Girl’s owner, Mary Hobbs, for believing in him.

“She stuck with me when I was 21 years old and sent this mare to me. I don’t know many people who would send a horse to a 21 year old, but she did, and it’s worked out great for the both of us,” Sanchez said.

The Level 1 Limited Open Reserve Champion was another Justin Wright protégé, Jared Jones, who rode Linda Tayne’s Gunna Smokum Alittle (Little Lotto Lena x Mia Gunna Smokum x Smokum Oak) to a 637 (214 herd/213 rein/210 cow), earning \$1,592.

Derby Non Pro, Intermediate Non Pro & Novice Non Pro Champion



Hope Miller on Dare to Sioux

A special bond between Hope Miller and her 5-year-old gelding, Dare To Sioux (A Shiner Named Sioux x Tari Darlin x Tavis Catalyst) helps the pair consistently achieve fence work performances that any top professional trainer would envy. The non pro from Washington State piloted “Baby Sioux” to the highest fence score of any rider at the 2017 NRCHA Derby, a 229, to seal triple Championships in the Non Pro, Intermediate Non Pro and Novice Non Pro divisions.

“He is amazing. That’s the only thing I can say. Amazing. Special,” Miller said. “He tries his hardest with the fence work. It’s his favorite thing to do.”

It’s often said that the most talented horses have oddball qualities, and Dare To Sioux fits that mold.

“He is so quirky. We always joke that he acts like a girl,” Miller said. Her preparation to show consists of keeping him happy. “I walk him around, I pet him, I give him a cookie and tell him he’s so pretty and so cute, and let him have his confidence. He’s an odd horse. Sometimes you have to ride him a lot and sometimes you just walk him. It really just depends on what he needs.”

Their composite score of 656.5 (210 herd/217.5 rein/229 fence) earned triple paychecks totaling \$12,364. Miller’s prizes included a saddle from Jividen’s Customs, buckles sponsored by the Will Rogers Memorial Center, boots from Rios of Mercedes, a hat from Shorty’s Caboy Hattery, gift certificates from Farnam, therapeutic equine products from Back On Track, and product from Platinum Performance and San Juan Ranch/Santa Cruz Animal Health.

The Derby Amateur Champion was Jorge Cid, who rode Wright On Hickory (Hes Wright On x Hickorys Miracle x Docs Hickory) to a 640.5 composite (215 herd/215

rein/210.5 fence). The Amateur win paid \$1,620, and Cid also earned a spot in the finals for the Non Pro, Intermediate Non Pro and Novice Non Pro divisions. The 2017 show season represents a return to cow horse competition for Cid, who graduated from college in Texas and then returned to his native Venezuela.

“I was out for three years. Being able to come back to a big show like this and win in the Amateur is awesome. I moved back to my country, to Venezuela, and have been working with my dad in the family business,” Cid said.

Living and working in Venezuela does not provide Cid many opportunities to ride, and he appreciates the well-trained and uncomplicated Wright On Hickory, a mare he bought in February at the NRCHA Celebration of Champions.

“That’s the thing, I just ride whenever I come to the shows. I have three days to practice before the shows so it’s quite a challenge,” Cid said. “Wright On Hickory is just amazing and she’s so easy to get ready and to show. That’s a big help.”

Cid rides with NRCHA Professional Shawn Hays, Noco-na, Texas, who suggested he try Wright On Hickory earlier this year. Cid began his cow horse show career in successful fashion on a bridle horse, and had been eager to take on the challenge of a younger mount.

Cid said, “I always wanted to show in the derby classes. It was a challenge, after three years of not showing, to get a derby horse. They’re not as mature as the bridle horses, so it’s a bigger challenge for sure. It’s been good so far. I made the finals [at the NRCHA Stallion Stakes] in Vegas, I made the finals here, so - just keep showing and see how it goes.”

The Amateur Reserve Champion was Jesse Spence, Yamhill, Oregon, who guided A Stylish Spark (Stylish Rey Gay x Just A Sparknshine x Shining Spark) to a 637 score (210 herd/216.5 rein/210.5 cow), earning \$1,350. Spence will also advance to the finals in the Derby Non Pro and Novice Non Pro divisions.

Bridle Spectaculars at NRCHA Premier Events deliver some of the best cow horse action a reined cow horse fan will ever see. The bridle horses are the veterans of the NRCHA, with all the ingredients: talent, training and years of experience.

The CD Survivor Memorial Bridle Spectacular, named in honor of the late, great stallion owned by NRCHA sponsor Holy Cow Performance Horses, is a \$50,000-added contest that never fails to thrill spectators, year after year.

Sixteen elite bridle horses and their riders took to the arena Friday night, representing some of the reined cow horse industry's finest equine athletes and most talented trainers. As it often does in NRCHA competition, the Championship came down to the final event, the fence work, where a phenomenal 227 score elevated Brother Jackson (Pepto-boonsmal x Shes Icing Onthe Cat x High Brow Cat), shown by NRCHA Hall of Fame horseman Ken Wold, of Wilton, Cali., to the win. Brother Jackson scored a total 661.5 (220 herd/214.5 rein/227 cow), earning \$23,400.

"I've been doing the fence work ever since I was 20 years old, and I'm 70 now, and always dreamed of having that run – and I had it. That's all I can say. It was really special," Wold said. "There are a lot of great horses here, and great riders. This is as tough as it gets, in my opinion. I feel very blessed, and I thank the Lord for this."

Brother Jackson is owned by Daniel Perez, Westley, Cali., a longtime friend and customer of Wold's. Perez became smitten with Brother Jackson when he saw him compete at the NRCHA Snaffle Bit Futurity in 2012. At that time, the stallion was trained and shown by NRCHA Million Dollar Rider Zane Davis. When Perez had an opportunity to buy the stallion in December 2014, he didn't hesitate.

"It's a privilege to have this kind of horse, and to watch Ken show him. It's fun. I knew he was capable of having a good run. We've been waiting for it to come out in him, and it did tonight," Perez said.

The support from Holy Cow Performance Horses, sponsor of the \$50,000-added bridle class each year at the NRCHA Derby, was particularly appreciated by Wold.

“It enables these great bridle horses to show what they are. To see them work that well in the cutting and the reining and the fence work is really phenomenal, and without the support from Holy Cow, we would never be able to come up to this level,” Wold said. “I also thank Dan Perez, who believed in this horse from day one. We’ve had some ups and downs, but you couldn’t ask for a better customer. My wife, Ramona, has been behind me when I’m marking 208’s, too, so I’m glad that we all got to have a good night. It is special.”
