
If you build it, they will come . . . This was the thought process behind the Oklahoma Reining Horse Association's (OKRHA) Ride and Slide upping the ante by adding an open and non pro derby to its second annual March show. The inaugural year proved that reiners would indeed support an event of this caliber without hesitation. The show that in the past had been a smaller weekend type event, grew to nearly triple the size, basically overnight.


With much more prize money added, and the lack of a similar derby happening this time of year, it attracted riders from all directions.

Thiago Boechat, of Xtra Quarter Horses, was a driving force in developing the idea for this show. He knew people were familiar with the facility, and with few other opportunities to test out their derby-aged horses before the NRBC, this offered the potential to put on a great event.

The second year for this event proved that OKRHA was ready for the rush. They restructured the show office, adjusted the schedule, added days and show arenas, and nearly doubled the prize money.

#### XTRA QUARTER HORSES OPEN DERBY

The Xtra Quarter Horses Open Derby totaled \$62,000 in prize money, including a novice horse division for horses with less than \$10,000 in lifetime earnings.

Overall, 87 horse and rider teams came to play. When the dust settled, the Xtra Quarter Horses Open Derby Championship was topped with a tie between NRHA Professionals, Mathieu Buton, of Aubrey, Texas, and his family's mare, Ms Mercedes Whiz (Cromed Out Mercedes x Ms Hollywood Whiz) and Jordan Larson, of Whitesboro, TX, on Cee My Pistol (Gunner x Cee Dun It Do It), owned by Coquaike LLC. Both horse and rider teams marked an impressive 225.5, to best the field of 87 entries. Each team received a payout of \$7,886.06, and divvied up the prizes, which included a trophy saddle from Scottsdale Western World, a Lawson bronze, a beautiful buckle made by Hebillas Custom Buckles, MVP Equine supplements, Just Stitch It merchandise and Cowboy Couture gift cards.

Buton's score also earned him the Level 3 Open Championship (\$4670.78), and Larson earned the Novice Horse Derby Championship (\$5,093.12).

Reserve Champion of the Novice Horse Derby was Justin Michels, of Cannon Falls, Minn., who scored a 220.5 on Deana Nell's horse, Gunning To Survive (Gunners Special Nite x Shining Survivor), bringing home a check for \$3,100.16.

The Level 3 Reserve Championship went to Dany Tremblay of Overbrook, Okla. and the four year old stallion, PS Mega Shine Chic (Shine Chic Shine x Mega Sugar Baby), owned by Amanda and Brad Kelly. They earned a paycheck of \$2843.09 for their performance.

Ryan Rushing of Windsor, Colo., captured the Level 2 Open title on Judy Box's gelding, Ima Ruf

Spook (Smart Spook x Lil Ruf Sara) with a score of 220. The Level 2 Reserve Championship went to Bobby Avila Jr, of Rogersville, Mo. He and I Am Magnificent (Magnum Chic Dream x Hide N Cita), owned by Vaughn Zimmerman, scored a 218.

#### BLUEBONNET FEEDS NON PRO DERBY

The Non Pro Derby was generously sponsored again this year by Bluebonnet Feeds and boasted a \$36,000 purse and also included a novice horse division. There were 60 entries all vying for the top spot.

The Level 4 title was captured with a score of 220 by Taylor Zimmerman, of Springfield, Mo. on her mare, Wimpys Little Jessie (Wimpys Little Step x Jessie Dot Tari). They took home a check for \$4,902.51, along with the Scottsdale Western World trophy saddle, Hebillas buckle and a slew of other prizes.

Not far behind was Cade McCutcheon. He and Custom Made Gun (Gunner x Custom Made Dunit) scored a 219 and took home the reserve championship and a check for \$2,984.14.

Both the Level 3 and Level 2 Non Pro titles were captured by one team, Ryan Humphrey of Whitesboro, Texas, and his stallion, Hollywood Hype (Hollywoodstinseltown x Shiners Miss Lena). The duo scored a 218 to earn both championships, and a total combined payout of \$4,368.68. (Plus another \$2,238.10 for his 3rd place finish in the Level 4).

The Level 3 Reserve Championship went to David McBurney, of Palo, Iowa and Fancy Steppin Whiz (RC Fancy Step x TC West Coast Wendi). Their score of 216 earned them a paycheck of \$1,530.934.

David Silva, Sr., of Pilot Point, Texas and Face Time (Pale Face Dunnit x Shine On Tejon) earned the reserve honors in the Level 2 division with a 214.5, winning \$1,128.26.

The Non Pro Primetime division was also dominated by two riders and their talented mares.

# NRCHA STALLION STAKES OPEN PRELIMS COMPLETE

#### Swales Wins Fence Work Go-Round; Ralls & Phillips Tie for Composite High Score

The preliminary competition for the 2017 National Reined Cow Horse Association Stallion Stakes Open riders wrapped up Tuesday, March 28, at the South Point Equestrian Center in Las Vegas, Nevada, determining the 20 horses that will advance to the clean-slate finals and a shot at the \$35,000 Open Championship check on Saturday, April 1.

It took a composite score of 651.5 to advance to Open finals. Two horses tied for the high overall score of the prelims, with the 2016 Snaffle Bit Futurity Champion team of Duals Lucky Charm (Dual Smart Rey x TRR Miss Pepcid Olena x Pepcid), shown by Kelby Phillips; and the catchriding team of Raise A Smart Cat (WR This Cats Smart x Raise The Best x Mr Sun O Lena), shown by Phillip Ralls, both earning a 662.5.


The fence work go-round winner, with a scorching 228, was Cats Picasso (Metallic Cat x Playboys Vixen x Hickoryote), shown by NRCHA Professional, John Swales. Cats Picasso and Swales will have a chance to collect the \$10,000 bonus Stallion Stakes Metallic Cat Incentive check for the second year in a row. The pair won the incentive in 2016, and will be among three Metallic Cat offspring in the Open finals.

# WORLD PARA REINING INTERNATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

The \$25,000 added 2017 World Para Reining International Championship, scheduled for July 4-9 at the beautiful National Equine Center in Ermelo, owned by the Dutch National Equine Sports Federation (KNHS).

The WPR International Championship will be a World Equestrian Games-style event, with International teams competing for team medals, and individual medals. The event will be held during the 2017 Diamond League Western event. Diamond League Western is one of the biggest events in the Netherlands, organized for the second consecutive year.

Apart from the WPR International Championship, Diamond League Western will be offering a double judged national western show, open to all breed, an international AQHA Show, APHA Show, ApHC show and classes for Arabian and thoroughbred horses. The organizers of DLW are Ria de Vos and Roy van der Hoeven. Ria de Vos owns a western riding school in the middle of the country. NRHA professional and judge, Roy van der Hoeven owns a western riding school in the west of the country. Both of them are very pleased to offer a podium for the WPR International Championship.

"We are very pleased and excited to facilitate World Para Reining," Ria de Vos said. "We fully support the initiative because no one should be left out when it comes to riding. The Netherlands are not familiar with Para Reining. In 2015 there was a demonstration show during the KNHS National Championship Reining, organized at a facility in Schijndel in the South of the Netherlands. Para Dressage riders Nicole den Dulk and World Champion Rix van der Horst were amongst the competitors and they had great fun. The KNHS Center is a beautiful location that meets all the needs and the KNHS Staff is fully cooperating to make

this event into a success, assisting any way they can. Especially for this event, reining footage will be moved in a couple of weeks before the show so there will be some time to prepare the show arena properly. For WPR riders that come from overseas or from another European country that cannot bring their own horse, we have several horses available, able to compete in the different WPR grades.

Prior to the competition, we will arrange a clinic so the riders will get to know their horse. We have decided to donate the benefits of DLW 2017 to Parapaard. Parapaard is a national Dutch organization that supports other organizations that are engaged in activities to facilitate riders with a physical disability. Their slogan is 'Because no one should be left out!' We copied that, so we hope that many riders will participate to make people realize that riders with a disability matter as much to us as a NRHA One Million Dollar Rider does."

All over Europe, riders are preparing to qualify for this prestigious WPR Championship and get together to represent their country with a team. To be eligible to participate at the WPR International Championship, a rider must compete at two WPR approved shows. The qualification deadline is set at June 1, 2017. In this context the Netherlands have another prime. The Dutch Reining Horse Association, the official affiliate of the NRHA, facilitates WPR with the WPR 2017 Saddle Series. The DRHA is hosting four WPR approved shows this year of which two are scheduled during the qualifying period for the Championship.

WPR initiator Lisa Coulter said, "I am very excited to work with the DRHA and DLW. Both locations, the KNHS Center in Ermelo and Reining Center Meertenhof in Grathem, where the Saddle Series are being held, are beautiful locations that suit the purpose. We are looking forward to competing in Ermelo with a USA team and a Canadian team and meeting the European teams. The \$25,000

prize money will be fully distributed to the riders competing in the WPR International Championship and the show managers efforts to give as much back to the Para riders as possible. There is no retainage of this generously sponsored WPR money. That's a pretty big thing to acknowledge and something important for the riders to understand. Besides the

money, the riders take home wonderful awards, such as, podium medals, ribbons and sheets. And since we are competing in the Netherlands, I expect them to be awarded with some beautiful flowers as well, although they probably can't take them back home. But I am sure they will love it!"

The survey will be tailored to individual segments and distributed via an online link, and the AHC encourages those in the industry to share the link as much as possible.



# 2017 AMERICAN QUARTER HORSE HALL OF FAME INDUCTEES

The 2017 American Quarter Horse Hall of Fame inductees were honored at the Hall of Fame Banquet March 19 at the Grand Hyatt Hotel in San Antonio, Texas.

"Induction into the American Quarter Horse Hall of Fame is the highest honor possible in our Association, and we welcome these deserving individuals into the Hall of Fame," said Craig Huffhines, Executive Vice President of the American Quarter Horse Association.

The horses inducted into the Hall of Fame are the stallions, Strawfly Special and Zips Chocolate Chip; the gelding, Majestic Scotch; and the mares, Casey's Ladylove and Dashing Phoebe.

The horsemen are AQHA Past President, Peter J. Cofrancesco III of Sparta, N.J., AQHA executive committee member, the late Dick Monahan of Walla Walla, Wash., Bobby D. Cox of Fort Worth, Texas, the late Marvin Barnes of Ada, Okla., and trainer and horsewoman Sandra Vaughn of Hernando, Fla.

#### Casey's Ladylove

The 1961 mare, Casey's Ladylove was the foundation of a barrel racing dynasty. James and Frances Loiseau of Flandreau, South Dakota, bought the mare as a 2-year-old for \$720 when looking for a horse their children could ride. Later, they started breeding her, selling the colts and keeping the fillies for their broodmare band that led to such barrel racing and rodeo champions as French Flash Hawk, known to barrel racers as "Bozo," and Frenchmans Guy, a leading sire of barrel-racing horses.

#### **Dashing Phoebe**

Dashing Phoebe was a fast runner and the mother of fast runners. The 1983 sorrel mare by Dash For Cash won or placed in 15 of 20 career starts, earning \$609,553 on the racetrack. She was a two-time AQHA racing champion filly, earning that honor

in 1985 and 1986. She earned her AQHA Supreme Racehorse title in 1987. In 2008, she was named an AQHA Dam of Distinction after producing 15 winners, five stakes winners and the earners of nearly \$2.4 million. She was bred by San Jose Cattle Co. of Rockport, Texas. She was euthanized in 2013 and buried on owner Kirk Goodfellow's Dreams Come True Ranch near Nacogdoches, Texas.

#### **Majestic Scotch**

Majestic Scotch was born to lope in a show ring. The 1994 sorrel gelding won 10 World Championships in western riding and western pleasure and seven Reserve World Championships in those classes plus showmanship. Majestic Scotch was bred by Donald and Jean Bangasser of Ackley, Iowa, and was owned by Sharnai Thompson of Pilot Point, Texas. He was shown in classes from halter to hunt seat equitation to trail. He earned a youth AQHA Supreme Champion award and 13 Superiors. He retired from competition in 2012. He was euthanized in 2013, the same year he was inducted into the National Snaffle Bit Association Hall of Fame.

#### **Strawfly Special**

Racing stallion Strawfly Special sired two winners of the All American Futurity, Streakin Flyer and Ausual Suspect. The 1987 stallion by Special Effort was bred by Dan and Jolene Urschel of Canadian, Texas, and was owned by Double Bar S Ranch of Moreno Valley, Cali. Strawfly Special's offspring earned more than \$25 million on the racetrack, and his gelded son, Tailor Fit, was racing world champion in 1999 and 2001. Strawfly Special died in 2004.

#### **Zips Chocolate Chip**

Zips Chocolate Chip was a leading sire of award-winning western pleasure horses. The 1985 bay stallion was by Zippo Pine Bar and out of the Custus Jaguar mare, Fancy Blue Chip. After a short

career in the show ring, earning \$18,000 in western pleasure futurities, Zips Chocolate Chip moved to the breeding barn. He was a sire of AQHA and National Snaffle Bit Association champions. He was also a model for a Breyer horse. After his breeding career was over, he retired to owner-breeder Ann Myers' farm. He was euthanized in 2015 due to complications of old age.

#### **Marvin Barnes**

The late Marvin Barnes of Ada, Okla., was the owner and trainer of Mr Master Bug, a Supreme racehorse and winner of the All American Futurity, and FL Lady Bug, an American Quarter Horse Hall of Fame inductee. The 50-year cumulative breeder and his late wife, Lela, were fixtures in Oklahoma Quarter Horse racing for more than 50 years. Marvin bred the earners of more than \$3.9 million on the track and two World Champion horses who earned seven World Championships.

#### Peter J. Cofrancesco III

Peter J. Cofrancesco III of Sparta, New Jersey, was the first president of the American Quarter Horse Youth Association to become president of AQHA. Cofrancesco grew up showing horses with his family in many aspects of AQHA competition, later specializing in halter. He was elected to the AQHA Executive Committee in 2008 and served as president in 2011 – 2012, focusing on youth involvement.

#### Bobby D. Cox

An owner and 30-year breeder of American Quarter Horse racehorses, Bobby D. Cox of Fort Worth, Texas, bought his first racehorse in 1976. His homebred mare, All About Ease, won the Ruidoso Futurity in 2004, the same year his homebred stallion, Brimmerton, won the Rainbow Derby and the All American Derby. In 2007, Cox's homebred Dont Let Down won the All American Derby. Horses that Cox has bred have earned \$20 million and horses he has owned have earned \$16 million on the racetrack.

#### Dick Monahan

Racehorse owner and breeder, Dick Monahan of Walla Walla, Wash., bought his first race-bred yearlings in 1969. He and his wife, Brenda, raised and raced American Quarter Horses for more than 30 years. He was elected as an AQHA director in 1985. At the time of his death in 2009, Monahan was serving on the AQHA Executive Committee.

#### Sandra Vaughn

Judge, breeder and AQHA Professional Horsewoman, Sandra Vaughn of Hernando, Fla., became a professional trainer at age 19. She has trained horses to multiple champion titles and has ridden horses to seven World Championships and 11 reserve World Championships. In 2003, she was part of the team that helped Movin Artfully become the Farnam Superhorse. In 1995, the first year the award was given, Vaughn was named the Professional Horsewoman of the Year. She served as an AQHA director from 2006 to 2013.



# Magnesium in Equine Nutrition Part Two WHAT'S THE REAL STORY?

The most recent equine nutritional research recommends approximately 10g of magnesium daily to avoid deficiency symptoms. Grains and forages contain anywhere from 0.2-0.5% Mg. After a quick look at the magnesium levels along with corresponding calcium and potassium, the logical assumption is that the horse is getting a sufficient amount of magnesium.

However, the more we learn about nutrition the more we find that magnesium is actually required by the body in relatively large amounts and is a necessary cofactor for more than 300 enzymatic reactions vital to every major metabolic pathway.

When exposed to the environmental stresses of training, travel and performing, horses can become irritable, easily fatigued and lose concentration or focus. Blood pressure and excitability may increase as the level of adrenaline (a stress hormone) increases in the blood. Under conditions of mental or physical stress, magnesium is released from the blood cells and goes into the blood plasma. From there, it is excreted into the urine. Chronic stress depletes the body of magnesium, leading to magnesium deficiency symptoms. The greater your level of stress, the greater the magnesium loss.

The high stress lifestyle of performance horses and the variable levels of magnesium in feeds has led to an increased need for magnesium. Areas with acid soils and soft water may not provide enough magnesium the needs of performance horses. In addition, the acidic water or soil may also impair magnesium uptake from the GI tract.

Magnesium can be supplied in several different forms. There are several magnesium salts readily available, but the best supplements provide magnesium in the most biologically active forms, including chelated or complexed forms. Chelation and complexing means that the magnesium is bound to a highly absorbable molecule like an amino acid that is actively picked up from the GI tract, so the magnesium is absorbed with it.

The most effective products use this biologically active form of magnesium in the form of Magnesium Monoglycinate. The monoglycinate form supplies the most available form with the highest metal concentration. Also, this form is slightly sweet to the taste and very palatable. That's important because most non-complexed magnesium salts have a strong taste and can limit the horse's willingness to eat them.

Currently, the most common form of magnesium available is Magnesium Sulfate, commonly called Epsom salts. Epsom salts are not suitable for regular feeding. One side effect of regular feeding of Epsom salts, is diarrhea. The usual form used in animal feeds is Magnesium Oxide, but even high-quality Magnesium Oxide is only about 50% absorbable and tends to be quite variable. Some sources have been over-processed and can be totally unavailable.

Calcium levels also influence magnesium uptake. Magnesium increases calcium solubility which then competes with magnesium for adsorption. Calcium levels in a equine diet are generally greater that 1%. As a result, the calcium to magnesium ratios in equine diets range from 2.5-4.0:1. Nutritionists are beginning to try to reduce that ratio as close to 1:1 as possible. This cannot be accomplished without some form of magnesium fortification. So if your horse's diet includes alfalfa which is high in calcium, it is most likely deficient in Magnesium.

Magnesium is non-toxic and nearly impossible

to overdose orally. The GI tract absorbs what it needs and dumps any excess. The main pathway for disposal of magnesium in the body is the kidneys. Over supplementation of magnesium in the diet, usually only results in loose bowels or transient diarrhea. However, the chelated forms with the higher availability reduces this effect as less magnesium reaches the large intestine.


Magnesium salts are very water soluble and magnesium is easily excreted, but if renal function is impaired there could be an overdose because of the body's inability to dispose of magnesium. Thus, Magnesium salts should <u>NOT</u> be fed to horses with impaired kidney function or those

with restricted water intakes.
