The 2017 Southwest Reining Horse Association Futurity began Tuesday with the Novice Horse Open Levels 1 and 2 held in the Hardy Murphy Coliseum. The day was filled with flashy reining horses and big maneuvers as reiners

second section will also be held Wednesday in the Ancillary Arena.

Jason Vanlandingham rode Staring Shine to the win in the Novice Horse Open Levels 1 and 2 with a score of 73. Staring Shine is by Shine Chic Shine and out of Staring Amie, and owned by Vaughn Zimmerman.

Vanlandingham used the SWRHA Futurity to test his mount's abilities after mediocre showing at the AQHA Congress.

"I showed him at [The Tulsa Reining Classic] and he was really good for me there and then when I went out to the Congress, things weren't as tight as I would have liked them to have been," Vanlandingham said.

The 3-year-old stallion showed up in Ardmore in grand form to lead Vanlandingham to the win and a combined paycheck of \$2,262.

"I'm planning to go to the futurity (NRHA Futurity) on him so basically [my plan] was just to make sure everything was lined up for him before we go to Oklahoma City," Vanlandingham said of Staring Shine. "I wanted to test him a little bit... I three-quarter showed him [on Tuesday in Ardmore], but sent him down to his stops good and he's a big stopper so that part was really good. He was nice for me."

Following Vanlandingham in second place in Level 1 was Todd Wright riding Mi Mega Cash to a score of 72.5 for owner Anita Horn. In Level 2 the second place win went to Dany Tremblay riding Misters Temptress to a 72.5 for owners Adh Mor Ranch.

SWRHA FUTURITY COMPETITION HEATS UP

The 2017 Southwest Reining Horse Association Futurity continued Thursday in Ardmore, Okla., at the Hardy Murphy Coliseum with the Open, Intermediate Open, Limited Open, Rookie Professional and the Novice Horse Non Pro.

Brian Bell rode Maximum Dream to the Open championship with a score of 74.5. Maximum Dream is by Magnum Chic Dream and out of Betch Boots Lizzie owned by Frederick Christen. The SWRHA Futurity marked the pairs first show together and their performance Thursday foreshadows a successful career for the 5-year-old stallion.

"I wanted to show him to be able to tell the customer how that horse shows and he marked a 74.5 and so obviously he shows really well," Bell said.

Bell and Maximum Dreams' weekend is complete, but Bell will come back Saturday with two Open Futurity horses in the Billingsley Ford Open Futurity.

Josh Tishman had a big night aboard Chics Love Me

Wimpy, who is by Wimpys Little Step and out of Dream About Magic, owned by DAG Ventures LLC. The pair topped the Intermediate Open, Limited Open and Rookie Professional with a score of 73.5. The duo has been showing together all year with a goal of winning a world title.

"I just wanted to go in and have a clean run and try to do the best we could," Tishman said of his game plan. "I think I'm in second by \$100 so I was trying to win enough to get [to No. 1 in the NRHA standings] and I think we did that so it was good."

Tishman and Chics Love Me Wimpy have teamed up well and continue to enjoy their time in the show pen. "He can turn really big," Tishman said of one of his favorite maneuvers with the 2010 gelding. "He went in [to the arena today] and he was really good for me like he always is."

The Novice Horse Non Pro Level 1 champion was Mandy

months now and she was a little green as a 3-year-old and we've just been [slowly moving] along with her and she gets better all the time."

"It was mostly just a test to see where I'm at before the futurities," McCutcheon said. "She's just a 3-year-old that's never been anywhere. So I didn't want to go in there and try to futurity I just wanted to bring her here and get her comfortable and make a nice run on her and she went in there and wanted to play."

The Novice Horse Non Pro Level 2 champion was Greg Hall and Shesmylilwhiskeygirl, who is by Whizkey N Diamonds and out of Relaxin With A Bud. The pair scored a 72.5 on Thursday which was a extra special, because the pair have only been partners for a short time, but are making consistent progress in the show pen.

"She was very soft [today] and listened to me all the way through," Hall said. "We've had her for about 14

MANDY MCCUTCHEON CLAIMS NON PRO FUTURITY CHAMPIONSHIP

The competition was hot at the Southwest Reining Horse Association Futurity held at the Hardy Murphy Coliseum. Big stops and fast spins took over Ardmore, Okla., during Friday's action.

Scottsdale Western World Non Pro Futurity was full of top-shelf competition with five competitors taking home championship honors.

Mandy McCutcheon topped the Scottsdale Western World Non Pro Futurity with an outstanding score of 218 aboard Gunner Be Custom, who is by Colonels Smoking Gun and out of Custom Made Dunit.

McCutcheon says the win was special because of the long history she shares with Gunner Be Custom and her bloodlines.

"She is a family horse. She's the same breeding as Cade's – Custom Made Gun – and the mare I was second on in the [NRHA] Futurity last year and then the mare I won the [NRHA] Futurity on several years ago – Custom Made Gunner." McCutcheon said. "It's been a good family, a good

bloodline for us, so I'm excited about her."

McCutcheon and Gunner Be Custom, who's owned by McQuay Stables, did have a few unforeseen obstacles in Friday's Non Pro Futurity, however

Gunner Be Custom never made a bobble and carried her rider to the win.

“Everything’s real easy for her, she’s a big turner and a big stopper. She actually lost a slider in the last stop, so it helps to have full sliders when you’re stopping a reining horse,” she said with a laugh.

Cade McCutcheon took the Scottsdale Western World Non Pro Futurity Reserve Championship riding Customized Dually (Mister Nicadual x Customized Gunner) with a score of 217, for owners McQuay Stables.

In the Intermediate and Limited Non Pro Teresa Putman and Ryan Humphrey shared the co-championship with a score of 214.5 in Friday’s Scottsdale Western World Non Pro Futurity.

Humphrey rode Gunology, who’s by Colonels Smoking Gun and out of Hollywood Footprints, to the co-championship and the win is extra special to Humphrey because of the journey Gunology has taken to be successful in the show pen.

“I didn’t know what to expect, because this is the first time he’s been shown, but I went in and he was super honest and a blast to show,” Humphrey said. “He wouldn’t be here

without Tom McCutcheon’s rehab facility. He got injured his 2-year-old year and because of their care they were able to get him going again and bring him back to health.”

Putman rode Gunnersshineybrunett, who is by Colonels Smoking Gun and out of Scats Ebony Shiner, and the duo shined in Ardmore on Friday when they marked a 214.5 to share the co-championship with Humphrey.

“I went fairly early and I was real happy with her there’s definitely lots of room for improvement and I need to run a little harder, but this is a great show to get prepared for the NRHA Futurity. I’m happy to go to the Futurity with her now. I feel like I’ve got to know her a little better and what we need to do to prepare,” Putman said adding her appreciation to her trainer. “I ride with Sebastian Petrol and he’s got be above and beyond where I was.”

Tina Ellis topped the Non Pro Futurity Level 1 with a score of 213.5 aboard Whatacromedmercedes, who’s by Cromed Out Mercedes and out of What A Sunrise. Whatacromedmercedes is Ellis’ first futurity horse and she enjoys each moment showing.

“It was total excitement through the whole thing,” Ellis said. “I feel very, very blessed. I showed [Whatacromedmercedes’] mother, What A Sun-

rise, and I'm excited to ride another baby out of her. It feels like home."

Ellis thanked her trainer Mathieu Buton with both WhataGunnercromedmercedes as well as a 4-year-old out of What A Sunrise. Ellis looks forward to her future with both her horses.

"[Buton] has been helping me with [Whatacromedmercedes] mainly getting me to relax and not works so fast," she said with a laugh.

James Morgan took home the Non Pro Futurity Prime Time championship with a score of 215.5 aboard Sugaway Spooks. The win was extra special to Morgan because not only of his relationship he's built with Sugaway Spooks, but also because it's a stepping stone for his goal to achieve million dollar rider status.

"The fun part about [Sugaway Spooks] is that I rode the full brother to the mother of Sugaway Spooks and he's the horse I won the most money on in my entire life," Morgan said. "It's been an interesting trial for me, because she's the first deaf horse that I've ever ridden. I have to give

credit to Clint Haverty. When I found out that she was going to be deaf I called Clint and I said, 'Clint, how do you ride a deaf horse?' and he gave me a lot of pointers."

Sugaway Spooks is by Spooks Gotta Whiz and out of Graceful Getaway and has been a successful mount for Morgan and the pair have plans of competing at the NRHA Futurity in November.

The SWRHA gave away a golf cart Friday night preceding the Non Pro Futurity Finals to the sire of the highest scoring Non Pro Futurity horse for sires that participated in the SWRHA Stallion Auction – in this case, Mister Nicadual owned by Jerry Kimmel. In Level 3 buckles were awarded

to Pale Face Dun It and Whizkey N Diamonds, in the Level 2 Pale Face Dun It earned the buckle and in Level 1 Wimpys Little Step took the buckle.

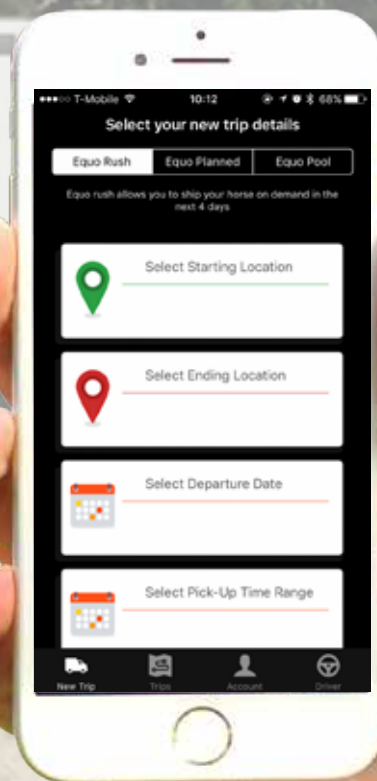

“My run was pretty good. [Whatta Royal Vintage] ran in there and stopped pretty good. She was a little fresh in her stops, but other than that it was good,” McCutcheon said of her mare and her run today.

Robbi Falls topped the The Incredibullz/ Merrill’s Salon & Spa Rookie Challenge Prime Time with a score of 212.5 aboard Epic Surprise, who’s out of Jerry Lees Surprise and out of Shine On Retsina. Falls almost went home and didn’t enter the Rookie Challenge, but with some encouragement from Casey Deary and Josh Tishman she ended up staying and says she’s glad she did.

“Here they all stood and they were saying ‘Just go in there, you can do it and next time go faster, because you can.’ That’s what Casey [Deary] said. Josh [Tishman] told me to be cautious. ‘Go out there have a good time, but I want you to do like you did all week and end it on a good note,’ and that’s what I did,” Falls said. “I’m really glad I came, I’m quite pleased.”

“She was really good all the way through. I trusted her and she did everything I wanted her to do,” Hall said. “I couldn’t be more happy with her.”

The Limited Non Pro champion was Warnetta Martin riding Adorable, who is by Inwhizable and out of Darlin Dun It, to a score of 143.5 for the win. Martin has owned the mare for three years and they continue to progress together as a team.

“We’re finally clicking well and having a lot of fun,” Martin said. “Our run was amazing she was so good. I circled really good and she really came back to me on a loose rein.”

Martin plans to compete in the maturity classes with the mare in the future and continue showing in ancillary classes.

BERTOLANI WINS OPEN FUTURITY CHAMPIONSHIP SPONSORED BY BILLINGSLEY FORD

The Southwest Reining Horse Association Futurity has seen top-shelf competition throughout the week. Reiners from across the country have traveled the miles, put in the hard work and showed up in Ardmore in top form to battle it out for championship prizes and bragging rights. Saturday the Open Futurity Finals, sponsored by Billingsley Ford was the highlight of the day featuring the top scores from the two-section qualifying round.

Franco Bertolani riding Chex For Nite marked an impressive 223 to clench the Open Futurity Level 4 championship, worth \$15,788. Bertolani and Chex For Nite also won the go round aboard the 3-year-old stallion by Gunners Special Nite and out of Dun It For Chex.

“It’s hard when you show and you feel like you had enough horse to win so it’s a little more pressure in the finals, I had to go a little harder,” Bertolani said. “Craig Schmersal showed before me and marked a 222 so it puts a little pressure, but the horse was really good. I tried to show a little harder, but not make any mistakes and that’s what happened and I’m very happy for that.”

Bertolani and Cardinal Hill Training Center has trained the stallion from the ground up and his bloodlines have been successful for them in the past, which makes the win extra special.

“We started him from the beginning. He’s by Gunners

Three buckles were awarded to the sires of the highest placing Open Futurity Finals. The Level 3 champion was Gunner Special Nite, the Level 3 winner was Einsteins Revolution and the Level 1 buckle when to Gunnatrashya.

a lot for him."

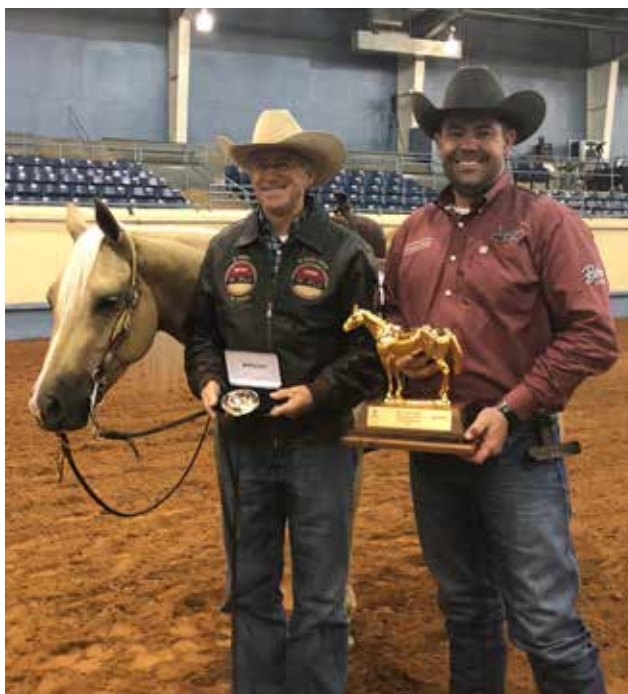

Beppe Prevosti Rides Magnum Chic N Chex to win IRHA/NRHA Futurity 3-year-old Open Championship

Exactly one year ago we saw this rider crowned as the Open Futurity Level 4 Champion aboard Firstjabacoffee-whiz. And now he is back, once again Open Futurity Level 4 Champion but this time with him on the top step of the podium is Magnum Chic N Chex. The reiner is Giuseppe “Beppe” Prevosti, a reliable and sober athlete, but a rider who also possesses the flair needed to reach the top. And on the big night here at the 2017 IRHA/NRHA 3-year-old Futurity Open Beppe entered 39th of 43 aspiring champions to snatch the throne with a score of 224.5, leaving some of the top names of European reining in his wake for the second consecutive year.

But this year's trophy has an added charm because Magnum Chic N Chex, daughter of Magnum Chic Dream and Buenonics Daughter, is a mare produced on the small facility that Beppe runs together with his girlfriend Lara Lorengo: “She’s

the daughter of one of our broodmares and she was born and raised here with us,” says the Champion, “and I would be happy if this result encouraged other small breeders to persevere in their research and passion. Champions can be born anywhere; in my opinion the most important thing is the quality of the mother. Buenonics Daughter, Magnum Chic

N Chex's dam, was a strong athlete; I've been riding her for a long time and I really know everything about her; together we have won over \$ 40,000. She was the go-round leader at the IRHA Derby, Champion at the European Derby Level 2 and placed in many big Open competitions - one of the best horses I've had the pleasure to ride... She belonged to Enzo Gola and Lara Maiocchi. We really believed in her, so I first bought Enzo's share and then my girlfriend purchased that of Lara.”

The neo-Champion's move-

ments express a refreshing naturalness in the patterns: “I always try to let my horses express themselves with minimum constraint; Magnum Chic N Chex, for example, has strong spins and stops, but does not have a particularly strong lope, so if you leave her to run freely she expresses herself better,” explains the rider from Lombardy.

“Prior to the Futurity, I only took Magnum Chic N Chex out to a small regional competition for schooling and then in September we competed in a more demanding Pre-futurity Open where we won with a good 149”. Then, three weeks of absolute rest before the demands of Cremona, where the mare positioned well in the two go-rounds, with the fourth-best composite score of 438 on a par with that of Gumpatrashya (shown by Cira Baeck). When talking of character, Beppe describes his companion as “quiet, but with personality ... I think a mare must have a strong personality to withstand the pressures of a high-level sports career. Magnum Chic N Chex has presence, she’s strong-minded but honest, just like her mother”. The plans now foresee a first embryo transfer and then preparations for the European Futurity: “Afterwards we’ll decide if she will continue her career as an athlete with me or if Lara will ride her, as I am sure she’d make a great mount for a non-pro”.

Prevosti also took fourth place Level 4 with his second horse in the competition, Jordy Gotta Whiz (Prize Rooster x Snappy My Magic, owned by Gina Cipolat), while only half a point behind the leader, and thus gaining the IRHA/NRHA Futurity 3-year-old Open Reserve Championship, was the talented Belgian rider Cira Baeck, who now works out of Corinna Schumacher’s CS Ranch, the facility that owns the stallion she was showing, Sb Special Nite sired by Gunners Special Nite out of Shiny O Lady, bred by South On The Border Horses LLC.

Finishing a great week at the Futurity 2017, Matteo Cuniglio confirmed he was ready for the limelight by snatching the Champion title at Level 3 with a score of 216.5 as well as Co-Reserve Champion at Levels 2 and 1 where he shared the second step on the podium with Nico Sicuro, standing half a point behind the leader at Levels 2 and 1, again Nico Sicuro though obviously on a different horse! Matteo and his show partner Gv Capitan Artu, a gelding by Ab Captain Badger out of Smart Little Gold, owned by Gabriele Visetti and bred by Angelucci QH had finished the eliminatory go-rounds as leaders in the Level 1 rankings and standing a close second at Level 2.

Matteo had everything to ride for when he entered the show ring, but his final score left him anxious, knowing that he had secured a second place at Levels 2 and 1 but unsure whether, with another 10 competitors qualified for Level 3 still to enter the pen, his place as Level 3 Champion would hold: “Now I feel great,” he commented at the end of the competition, “but I felt awful for over an hour; I knew there were horses that could improve on my score, but these are three-year-olds and you just never know - sometimes it goes well for others, but this evening it went well for us.”

Matteo started Artù at the age of 2 and more recently took him to Roberta’s Stable to continue his training. After the first outing it was decided to castrate the horse as he was very tense; the choice proved justified as further work on the maneuvers brought the desired results, with a win in the Intermediate and Limited open at the APCR Regional Futurity “with encouragement from Claudio Rizzo at the side of the arena!” Matteo adds, “Strangely enough this is a horse who calms down once he has his own space in the show ring; he does not like working with other horses around and on his first venture into the warm-up pens here

he was scared by the sight of two palominos. He doesn't like blondes" jokes Matteo, "unlike me, my wife is blonde!" Matteo made sure Artù was relaxed and fresh for the final, and the experience both horse and rider gained through this Futurity can only have increased their confidence.

Matteo has returned to a professional career in reining after a period away and has proved his worth over the past year, coming second at Level 2 of the German Breeders Futurity Open 3-year-olds on RS Twitter Jac and winning the NRHA European Futurity Open 4-Year-Old Level 1 and, earlier this week, the title of IRHA/NRHA Futurity 4-year-old Open Level 1 Co-Champion aboard RS Canaletto Jac.

A point behind Cunigli, on 215.5 was the Futurity Open Level 3 Reserve Champion, Germany-based Israeli Guy Zemah riding Star Wallawhiz Dunit, son of Walla Walla Whiz and Player N Hollywood, bred by Shooting Star Quarter Horses and owned by Johanna Wagenbauer.

Level 2 and 1 Champion, aboard Mistys Tinseltown, a mare belonging to Emma Villa and bred by F. Bonadeo was 21-year-old Nico Sicuro, who was thrilled by his success, especially as he was also crowned Co-Reserve Champion at both these levels on the second horse he was showing, Jm Topsailenium a gelding owned by Giorgia Valzasina and bred by Mirko Piazzi. Just half a point distanced the final score of the two horses, 217 and 216.5 respectively,

Manuel Bonzano and Zedd Sunburst top Futurity 3-year-old Non Pro Double Triumph for Enrico Sciulli

Just one step away from the Big One in this exciting IRHA/NRHA Futurity 2017, a Friday night final draws a conclusion to the dream of so many non-European riders, at least for this season. And one man whose dreams finally came true, and perhaps unexpectedly despite being go-round co-leader, is Non Pro Futurity Champion Level 4 Manuel Bonzano, many times past Reserve Champion in the Italian Big One and now at last claiming the top spot on the podium with a mare that he himself still considered green and perhaps a little too sensitive to achieve such a result.

Crowned Champion (with a score of 216.5) out of a field of 28 finalists is Zedd Sunburst, by Great Sun Burst and Ms Sanditch Whiz, a mare raised at 23 Quarter Horses that Bonzano had exhibited for the first time with rather disappointing results at the Belgium Futurity. The mare's second outing was between the reins of Ann Fonck at the German Breeders Futurity Snaffle-bit where the mare marked a good 218 in the first go (but unfortunately did not follow through in the final).

"I was thrilled, absolutely. Winning a Futurity brings a special emotion. It is a difficult competition, but sometimes

and coincidentally they both shared a common weakness on the left spins, but apart from that were very different. Mistys Tinseltown, by Hollywoodtinseltown and Mistys Enterprise improved consistently through the week; after the two go-rounds the mare was standing second in the Level 1 rankings while Jm Topsailenium (Mifillenium x Im A Topsail Star) was placed third. "I was happy with how the second go went with Mistys Tinseltown and I basically wanted to perform equally well in the final though pushing a little bit further, especially a regards speed. These are two good horses and I was very happy with both runs.

The mare is perhaps more constant in all her maneuvers while Jm Topsailenium has bigger stops." Nico, who has been generously encouraged by Davide Brighenti with whom he works as assistant-trainer, is grateful to both his mentor and clients for the opportunities he has had to ride quality horses. The results have not been long in coming over the last year: Rome Shoot-In Limited Open Reserve Champion on Frozen Saturday Night; Level 1 IRHA/NRHA Derby Reserve Champion riding Cromed Whiztress and a second place in the ARHA Futurity Level 1 on AB Magnolia Taris as well as Silver Medallist with Team Italian at the 2017 FEI World Reining Championships for Young Riders and Level 1 Co-Champion here on Thursday night in the IRHA/NRHA Futurity 4-year-old Open Level 1 riding GH Dreaming Dirty.

there is a special magic, and everything goes well, and you can really enjoy it. You can never take it for granted that the best horse will win, or the one that seems strongest: Zedd is a generous mare and she has given a lot, but I never thought she would really go on to win. To be honest, there were times when I thought of leaving her aside. These are young horses and there are days when, through no fault of theirs, you are unable to interpret them. It is easy to say that the horse is not right but if you work differently with them then you might get the sort of surprise we had tonight," Manuel remarks. "Zedd rose to the occasion and I now know just how well she can perform: she has a special mom of whom I am very fond and a dad that's phenomenal". However, the Piedmont champion adds, "she had not shone at home but that may well be my fault because she was not pushed and perhaps needed a little more attention. Bernard and Ann brought her on (unfortunately my work commitments meant I was only able to rider her maybe a dozen times), but they have so many horses and competitions to prepare for that sometimes it is hard to devote the same time to all of them, But maybe working them less is a good idea, if these are the results! Zedd unexpectedly made amazing progress while here in Cremona. More than that I could have asked

for.” The future for this Champion must surely include the European Futurity: “if all goes well. She is a strong mare - you will be hearing more about her”.

With 214.5, the Level 4 Reserve Champion went to the man who has garnered a thousand trophies, Claudio Risso, the veteran of Futurity Championships who already has a few under his belt, performed well with RS Apple Lena, a promising product of Roberta’s Stable sired by the great Spat Olena out of RS Linkwood Jac.

After qualifying for the final with two horses via a repechage through the Consolation class, twenty-year-old Enrico Sciulli took the oval arena by storm on Friday night by claiming both the Champion and Reserve Champion titles at both Levels 3 and 2 with two products of his family’s own facility, Staffoli Horses in Molise. Only second into the show ring, he thundered in with the SH Oak Atomic Peseta, his gelding by Que Peseta out of Arc Latest Sophie BH and climbed a massive 10 points from the go-round to finish on a strong 213.5 that set an early challenge for the other competitors to meet. Enrico, who returned just a month ago to prepare for the Futurity here, fresh from securing the title of NRHA World Champion Non Pro, could hardly describe the emotion after concluding the competition.

His first words were of gratitude to father Tiberio Sciulli and his partner Antonio Mastrostefano and the trainers that helped him in the two months he was away from home, Davide Brighenti and Bernard Fonck, and Guglielmo Fontana who was of great help in preparing the three-year-olds. “My first competition with the horses I rode tonight was at the first go here; for the last two months I rather neglected them as I was following

other objectives, but the way they responded was amazing.”

To then come back into the pen and find the same serenity with his second horse, SH Que Best Step, a daughter of the same stallion Que Peseta out of Footworks Best Step and give almost a repeat performance to reach a score of 213 and take the Reserve Champion title at Levels 3 and 2, shows an exceptional spirit and a great maturity, especially in such a young rider. “Both horses performed really well, and the fact that I have followed them from birth, perhaps particularly Best Step as she lost her mother and had to be hand-fed”, commented Enrico “makes this win really special”.

Enrico’s promise showed early, as a member of the gold-medal winning Junior Team Italy in the SVAG FEI European Championship Junior in 2013, and a year later winning the Individual Gold Medal and Team Gold, 2015 Young Rider Gold and individual Bronze medals and 2016 Silver medals in both the team and individual events. He won his first Special Event in 2015, the IRHA Maturity Intermediate Non Pro and in 2016 followed this with the NRHA European Derby Non Pro Level 1.

The excitement of winning a Futurity, especially the Italian Futurity that encapsulates the special appeal of a European win, is hard to measure. Imagine what it is like if this is the first time you compete in this competition with a 3-year-old horse! The young Level 1 Champion Alessia Simoncini from Lucca can now tell us. Like the Level 4 Champion, she too was riding a son of Great Sun Burst, OT Great Sun, a horse bred at OT Horses Oliviero Toscani (dam: OT Tarisme): score 208. Nineteen-year-old Alessia has recently finished studying

languages at school and now works in the family business. In the last few months Gennaro Lendi has taken her under his wing and she purchased this talented gelding from the Neopolitan trainer last April. Alessia is quick to recognize the help her new trainer has given her (as well as the support of her friend Andrea Davettano who helped her keep her nerves in the run up to the competition).

“A result like this repays all the work you do through the year. It’s an incomparable competition, so different from a Derby or any other event in which you show older horses,” Alessia said, who has been in reining for seven years and gained a team and individual silver medal at the 2016 European Young Riders Championship on Ready to Spook, says OT Great Sun is a good horse and gives no problems

despite his size, which makes him seem rather daunting. But her instructor argues that this young rider has “a sensitive touch and a lot of feeling. We first went out to competitions together in September, so we are just starting now to get to know each other, but she uses her instincts well, and I look forward to helping her develop”. And what about OT Great Sun? “A horse with a lot of talent, in my opinion, he could be competitive in the Open categories, with big stops and good spins,” Lendi concludes.

Reserve Honours Level 1 went to Martina Fosco, born in Milano and currently living in Bergamo, and her Split Sophie Doll, the first duo to enter the show ring tonight, who completed their run with a 207. The mare was sired by Spat Split and White out of Flashy Jacs Doll.

Guglielmo Fontana and Whiz Wild West win Italian Reining Horse Association NRHA Open Futurity 4-year-old Championship

What a fantastic run for Guglielmo Fontana in this four-year-old Open Futurity Final. Entering last as go-round leader on Whiz Wild West he drew together a series of circles and spins that brought the crowd to their feet and was awarded an impressive 226.5 by the judges, over 5 points clear of the duo’s nearest rivals. The superb run provided a fitting end to a year marked by a series of “near misses”, with the combination taking the titles of Open Level 3 Champions at the NRHA European Futurity (after leading the go-round), the Belgium Futurity and then the NRHA Germany Breeders Futurity but failing to follow through to win Level 4.

After winning both Levels 4 and 3 here in Cremona, an emotional Guglielmo described the very special relationship he shares with ‘Mosè’, a gelding by Spark N Whiz and West Coast Oak, bred by Mattia Camisi and owned by Luga QH Srl: “I know him, and he knows me. When we enter the pen, I can be sure he is there with me, striving for the same result – we are working together, more like best friends.”

Fontana pays a special tribute to the professionals that have steered him towards this result: “My work as assistant trainer for eight years has brought me where I am today; I started young, at the age of 17 with Adriano Meacci, who I greatly admire as a trainer and a man, and then worked with Davide Brighenti a real friend, who also gave me the possibility to train briefly with Andrea Fappani. I finally moved on to assist Bernard and Ann Fonck, who instilled in me the

determination needed to win at the highest levels.” ‘Gully’, who has now settled in as trainer at Luga QH dedicates this win to all the staff and friends there: “They have had great faith in me, and I am delighted to repay them with these successes; I am especially grateful to Gianni Lugarà and my companion Annamarta for everything she does to support me.”



Guglielmo Fontana riding Whiz Wild West Italian 4-Year-Old Futurity Open Levels 4 and 3 Champions two combinations finished the final on Thursday night with a score of 221.

Reserve Champions at Level 4 were two professionals who need no introduction, Gennaro Lendi riding SG Spat Lena King, a stallion by Spat Olena x Dreaming California, crowned AIQH Open Futurity 4-year-old Champions here last Saturday, and Belgian Cira Baeck on the palomino mare Xtra Step N Diamonds, Wimpys Little Step x Ha Ruby Diamonds, owned by CS Ranch Management SA and bred by Xtra Quarter Horses LLC. The

Israeli professional Guy Zemah, who entered the show ring on Spookslimitededition, also completed his run on 221, but the pair were not entered for Level 4, so their final score earned them the title of Reserve Champions Level 3 and Champions at Level 2. The athletic mare, by Spooks Gotta Gun out of Checkmate Lady Lena, is owned by Melissa Peter. Guy, who has lived and worked in Germany since 2003, started western riding at the age of 13. His professional career began as assistant for George Maschalani and Morey Fisk; he then went on to open his own business in August 2010. Since January 2017 he has trained with his team at La Mesa Performance Horses in Prichsenstadt. Earlier this year the pair placed #4 in the NRHA Germany

Breeders Futurity Open Level 2.

Reserve honours at Level 2 went to Giacomo Poli Barberis aboard the bay gelding Justanother Lil Kid by HA Stardust out of Justanother Lil Ruf, owned by Chiara Nicolai. The pair scored a final 218, improving on the first run of 215.5 in the go-round. The 36-year-old reiner from Tuscany surprised the crowd here in Cremona last year by making a clean sweep at all four levels of the IRHA/NRHA Open Futurity 4-year-old aboard Doc Magic Brown, a gelding by Arc Magic Enterprise x Doc Sugar Brown.

Just 21 years, of which 5 dedicated to reining, an enthusiastic Nico Sicuro has wasted no time in making a name for himself. Level 1 Co-Champion with a score 217, on a par with Matteo Cuniglio, the young professional was showing a horse he has been riding for just over a month, GH Dreaming Dirty a stallion by Dirty Dancer and OT Taris Minnick owned by Luigi Trevisan and Giulio Petruzzellis. The young Apulian reiner has generously repaid the faith of his mentor, Davide Brighenti who he has been assisting since January, by stacking up the results this year: Rome Shoot-In Limited Reserve Champion on Frozen Saturday Night; IRHA/NRHA Derby Level 1 Reserve Champion riding Cromed Whiztress and a second place in the ARHA Futurity Level 1 on AB Magnolia Taris and Silver Medallist with Team Italian at the [2017 FEI European Reining Championships for Young Riders](#).

Describing his run here Nico comments, "In the go-round we had some problems with the spin, but for the final we had that sorted and Dreaming Dirty gave a great performance. I knew I had to push him a bit further and he responded well. He's got lots

of style and is really enjoyable to ride." Nico, who started his professional career as assistant to Giovanni Masi, appreciates all the help he has had from both "Dido" and Brighenti and all the team who supported him here, as well as the faith of the clients who have entrusted him their horses.

Level 1 Co-Champion Matteo Cuniglio had decided to take a break from reining, but it is hard to resist the pull of this sport and a year ago Claudio Riso welcomed him back to Roberta's Stable, where he had first started as a youngster. Having gained experience in the show ring, competing independently in 15 Regional competitions in just one year, Matteo was ready for the big time and Riso has entrusted him with the quality horses needed to triumph at reining's top levels.

His partner in in this event was red roan mare RS Canaletto Jac, owned and bred by Roberta's Stable and sired by RS Great Jac Feona out of RS Red Moon Olena. Cuniglio started riding this horse in January and together they won the title of NRHA European Futurity Champions Level 1, then taking it quietly until the outing a month ago to win a Regional Futurity Intermediate Open in preparation for this event. "She rides like a stallion but has a sweet character" comments Matteo. "She is a great worker and has continued

to improve over the year. The 212 we marked in the go-round was due to a mistake I made on the right spin, but her performance in the final reflects her true talent." The pair scored 217, almost a re-run of their Euro Futurity win. Matteo is especially grateful to the Capello family who hosted him during his pause from reining as well as the team at Roberta's Stable and the man himself: Claudio Riso.

Edoardo Bernardelli and Spooks Gotta Cowboy Earn Level 4 Italian Reining Horse Association NRHA Non Pro Futurity Championship

The first rider to confirm his supremacy in this 28-strong field, was go-round leader Edoardo “Edo” Bernardelli, who had demonstrated that he was in great form by qualifying with a 219.5 and then capturing the title at Level 4 with a score of 217.5, that was enough to finish half a point ahead of the young Reserve Champion, Carlo Ambrosini aboard Django Whiz.

Edo’s companion on the podium was the beautiful bay stallion Spooks Gotta Cowboy, born in the US and sired by Spooks Gotta Whiz out of Marq Of Cita, who thanks to the go-round leadership had already secured the 2017 AIQH Futurity 4-year-old Non Pro Championship. Edoardo bought him last summer from Jordan Larson. Finalist at Levels 2 and 1 at both the NRHA Futurity and the NRBC, Edo showed him earlier this year, in September, at the High Roller Classic in Las Vegas before bringing him to Italy where the pair competed for the very first time last Saturday here in Cremona.

The 27-year-old Milanese reiner who rides at the Abati stables also took fourth place in this Final aboard RS Gaudi Jac, a gelding by RS Great Jac Feona cast and RS Shadow Olena, born at Claudio Risso’s facility, Roberta’s Stable and previously crowned 2017 NRHA European Non Pro Futurity Level 4 Champion and AIQH 4-year-old Futurity Non Pro Reserve Champion.

Just behind Bernardelli, but above all at the head of Level 3, is an eighteen-year-old who has already proved his worth in the field of international reining: IRHA/NRHA Futurity 4-year-old Level 3 Champion & Level 4 Reserve Champion is Carlo Ambrosini. His family owns the well-known breeding facility near Bergamo, Ambrosini Quarter Horse, and

young Carlo has been riding quality reining horses since the tender age of thirteen, thanks also to father Paolo’s passion. Just last year he won the 2016 NRHA European Derby Non Pro Level 2 Champion and Level 3 Reserve Champion titles and IRHA/NRHA Derby Non Pro Level 2 Reserve Champion titles, while in 2014 he had already claimed the Ma-

turity Reserve Championship. Django Whiz, a gelding by Topsail Whiz x Custom Snapper Lena was bred by Serafino Soldo (a customer and friend of the Ambrosini family) and was trained by Marco Pettinari, with whom he was finalist in the 2016 Austrian Futurity. For the last month the gelding’s training was entrusted to Cody Sapergia, recently arrived in Lombardy from America, who Carlo comments “has worked miracles both with this and with other horses”. Since his outing in Austria the gelding has been shown only by Carlo, who took him to both the Italian and European Futurity finals: “He’s a really good horse”, says Carlo, “perhaps he’s not a great-looker, but he has real talent and a big heart. In the show ring he gives everything he has to give”.

Greta Sordelli, who took her place on the podium of the 3-year-old Futurity Non Pro last year as Reserve Champion at Levels 3 and 2 and as Champion at Level 1, was back again with her stallion Riconquistador, son of Conquistador Whiz and My Ricochet Bomb, bred by Remo Cardì, to claim the Reserve Champion title Level 3. The duo completed the final just half a point behind the Level 3 leaders with a strong 216.5, an impressive improvement of

their go-round score.

Linda Rebecca Martinelli also turned up the heat in the final today, producing a performance that improved on the

go-round by a massive 5.5 points, to ride her bay mare Hot Miffy Cd (Mifillenum x Hot Tamale Baby) bred by Vittorio Rabboni, to the top spot at both Levels 2 and 1, with a 216.5. Linda, who bought the horse from Rabboni in July, put the strong finish down to her determination to perform well, encouraged by her two biggest fans, Mum and Dad who were whooping from the stands as she entered the pen. Linda is no newcomer to the podium, having contributed to the Italy Junior Team's triumph at the FEI European Reining Championships in two successive years, 2013 and 2014 on Playgirl On The Rocks, a horse that still holds a very special place in her heart. Hot Miffy Cd had previously gained the title of Reserve Champion in the 2016 Pre Futurity Open Level 2 and was finalist in April this year at the European Futurity here in Cremona.

Olena Broc showed enviable consistency: the duo produced the second 216 since the beginning of this Futurity, a score that the judges awarded them firstly in the go-round and with which they had previously led levels 3, 2 and 1, and that today earned them the IRHA/NRHA Futurity 4-year-old Non Pro level 2 and 1 Reserve Championships as they narrowly missed the top spot (just half a point). The mare is a daughter of Steadys Dude and Broc Olena Joe, bred by Luigi Santus and was bought by 22-year-old

Giovanni, together with the dam, when she was just a yearling. Zucchi personally trained her with the help of Davide Brighenti, who also assisted him during the competition. Last year they won the LR Prefuturity limited Non Pro class and then went on to become the Reserve Champions Level 1 at the IRHA/NRHA Futurity 3-year-old. In 2017, they repeated the feat at the LR 4-year-old Futurity (intermediate Non Pro category).

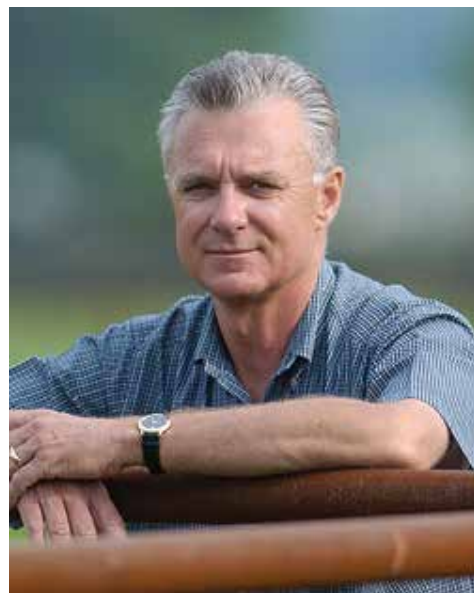

NRHA TROPHY CHANGES EMBRACE QUALITY

In 2009, the National Reining Horse Association (NRHA) Board of Directors voted to change the NRHA Lawson, Morrison, and Morgan (formerly known as Pewter) trophies' manufacturing process. Rather than the traditional metal alloy, trophies were switched to a resin-based composite material in hopes to reduce cost for show management and exhibitors.

Since the change, many questions have arisen about the trophies. While cost was improved with the resin material, durability in shipping was not ideal—diminishing the perceived value of the coveted awards. As a result, the NRHA Executive Committee has unanimously voted to change all NRHA trophies back to their original makeup of metal alloy.

Over the past eight years, NRHA staff and Corporate Partner Montana Silversmiths have been working to find better options and pricing for show organizers. At the time of the resin change, a bronze trophy would have cost nearly three times as much as we are able to offer it for today. NRHA has worked diligently to bring back the original metal format and is proud to provide these higher quality trophies at a better price margin than in 2010.

"The Executive Committee felt it was a perfect time to make the switch to metal trophies, as our current contract with Montana Silversmiths was nearing its end and resin costs were rising. Montana worked with us to find a great price margin for the trophies. We hope that this change will improve both the quality and image of NRHA," said NRHA

President, Mike Deer.
