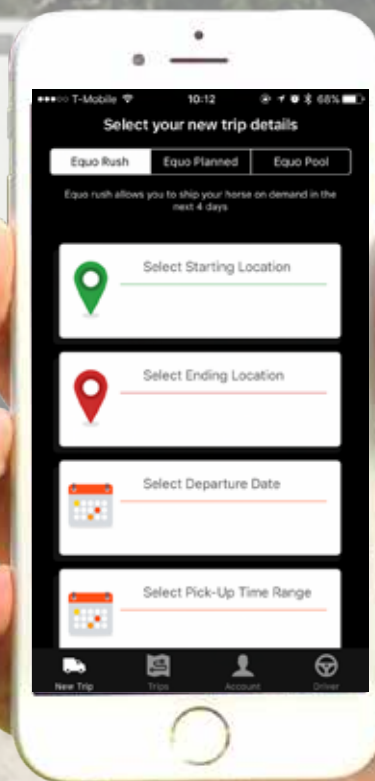

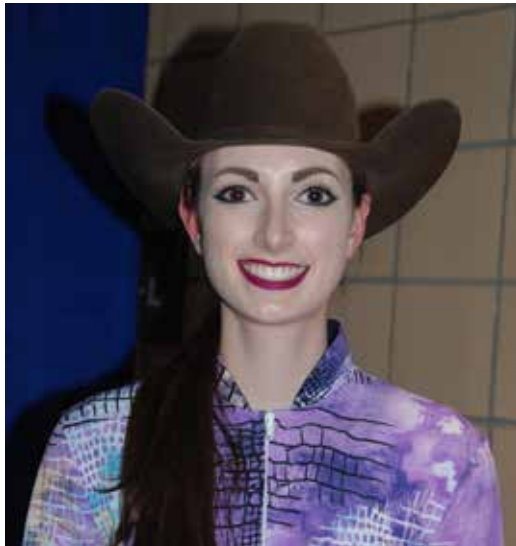
The duo also took reserve in the AQHA Amateur and the NRHA Novice Horse Hon Pro Level 2.

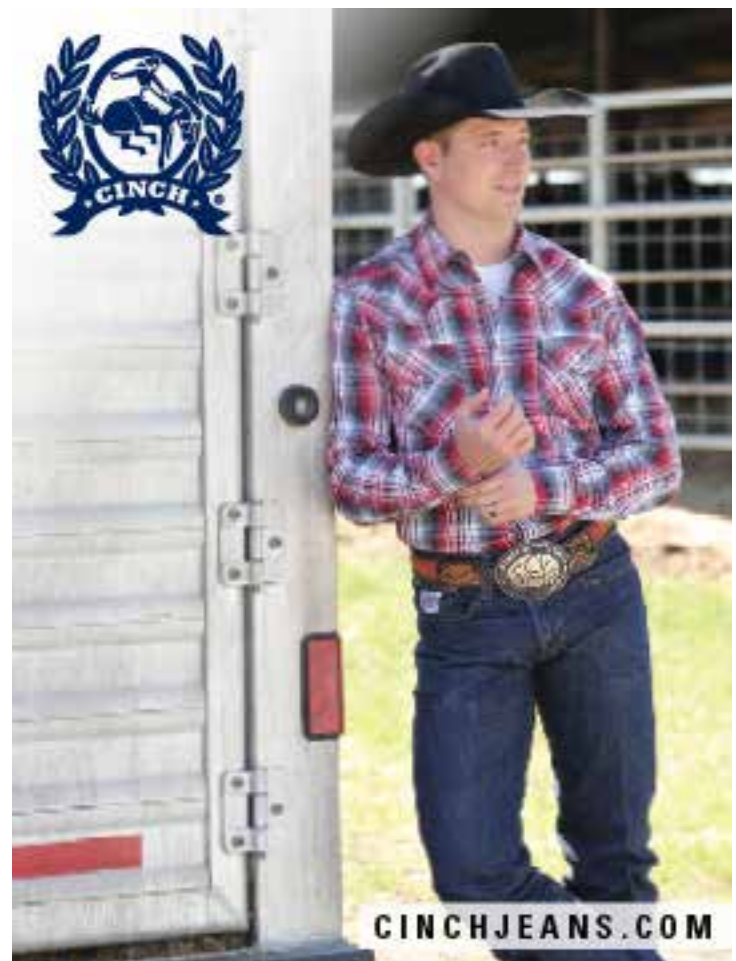

horse's chances of developing colic by 10x! Change hay as gradually as possible, ideally blending the old and new hay for 7–10 days, to ease the stress on your horse's hindgut. Studies have also shown that horses fed large amounts of grain (more than 5lbs/day) are at a greater risk of developing colic. Make sure your horse is receiving 1–2% of his body weight in forage every day. If he still needs grain, feed the minimum amount possible in multiple, small servings throughout the day. ## NRBC FOAL ENROLLMENTS ARE UP

The National Reining Breeders Classic Incentive Program experienced a substantial increase in foal enrollments in 2018. According to the NRBC headquarters office in Byars, Okla., the numbers confirmed a 3% increase in foal enrollments from last year.
