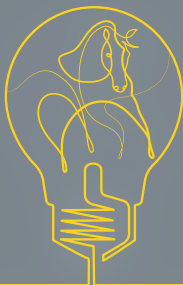

The 2018 NRHA Derby began on June 3 and ran through July 1 at State Fair Park in Oklahoma City. During the Open Draw Party, most competitors hope for a late draw number. Many believe that it is nearly impossible to win with a low draw. Jimmy Van der Hoeven proved this theory wrong when, as draw number 1 in the Level 4 Open Derby Finals, he entered the pen and set the bar high enough, none of the other 31 contenders could beat it. While the crowd roared for him in the background, he skillfully guided Guaranteed A Magnum through the maneuvers. The stakes were high. His mount's owners were also his employers: Casey and Kathy Hinton. He couldn't safety up; it was all or nothing.

Leaving the arena, he knew that his score of 225 could still be beat, so he tried to distance himself from watching the rest of the show as much as possible; however the grueling wait still pained him. "First of all, I kind of went back and exercised him a little bit more. I took him for a bit of spa, so then I couldn't see much." Jimmy said with a smile. "My boss was showing one of the later horses, so I then, I kind of had to be around a little bit more. That was harder, to be honest. You know, waiting it out is one of those things; when you wait it out, you can get passed. This time, I didn't." He finished with a modest shrug of his shoulders.

Jimmy continued, "Casey rode [Guaranteed A Magnum] as a 3-year-old at the Futurity, and showed him as a 4-year-old in the derbies. After that, in August or September, he told me that he was going to let me ride him and see if I can get him ready for next year. And this is my first year showing him." Guaranteed A Magnum is by Magnum With A Dream out of Guaranteed By Amos.

Jimmy's goal was simple, as he explained, "My plan was to come in and do the best job I can, and try to set the bar for everybody else." He executed his plan flawlessly and took home \$80,305 for his efforts.

Jody Puno's mare, ARC Gunna Mark Ya left her mark at the Derby, taking reserve in the Level 4 and the reserve co-championship in the Level 3 with Abby Lengel in the saddle. ARC Gunna Mark Ya is by Gunnatrashya out of Shiney Miss Marker. Lengel pocketed the \$60,000 purse.

Tied with Lengel in for the Open Level 3 Reserve Championship was Trent Harvey aboard SM Steping Junior. SM Steping Junior is a 6-year-old stallion by SM Enterprise Jr out of Top Step Enterprise. He is owned by Coguaik LLC. Harvey earned \$15,471. He and Lengel each scored a 224.

Spook Whiz Jewels and Kari Klingenberg Claimed Level 2 Open Derby Championship

Spook Whiz Jewels whizzed her way into the Level 2 Open Derby Championship with Kari Klingenberg as the pilot. The team earned 216.5 points and \$9,046 for the accomplishment. Spook Whiz Jewels is owned by Foothills Farm. Her sire is Smart Spook and she is out of Whiz Jewels. Klingenberg saw something in the mare that she felt was special, and she pursued Luke Gagnon for the mare for a while before he finally gave in.

Klingenberg spoke fondly of the 5-year-old mare, "I just always liked something about her. She goes around the pen really nice. She has a really good profile. She just does everything really

big. She gives me whatever I ask for. If I don't ride her super hard, she doesn't give a lot. I mean, for most mares, they don't always want to try harder; she's just so gritty that as much as I ask, she'll give me."

Hey Joe guided by Shawna Larcombe slid into the Level 2 Open Derby Reserve Championship with a 216. The horse and rider team also took Reserve in the Open Prime Time Derby as well, taking advantage of a 6.5 point handicap. Rosanne Sternberg's 5-year-old stallion is by Smart Spook and out of Best Stop. The reserve titles brought Larcombe's take to \$8,715.

Dun It At Nite and Debbie Brown Won Level 1 Open Derby Championship

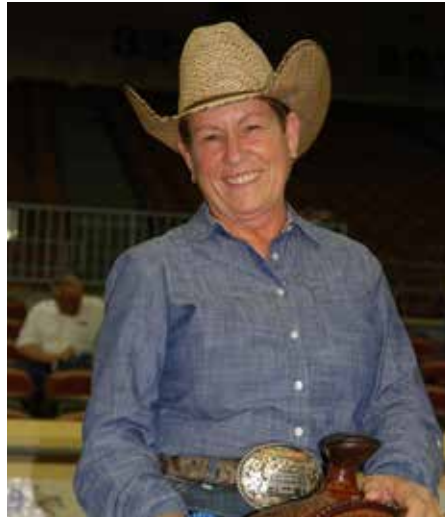
After it looked like Dun It At Nite's owner, Jennifer Greenleaf, wouldn't make it into the Non Pro Finals, the decision was made to enter him in the Open Derby under Debbie Brown. With a twist of fate, the 5-year-old stallion made it into the Non Pro Finals after all and marked a 214. He was draw number 3 in the first go of the Open Derby,

so first thing in the morning after his Non Pro Finals debut, Dun It At Nite was earning his place in the Open finals as well. The unflappable horse stayed true to win the Level 1 Open Derby Championship for Brown with a 218.5!

Debbie said, "We bought [Dun It At Nite] last year at the

Derby from Monte and Ann Anderman. He's just been a real nice horse. He's got a lot of ability, a lot of heart, a lot of personality. He showed four times this week and never missed a beat. He was never bad at all – anywhere.” Brown received \$4,630 for the win.

The reserve Level 1 Championship

went to Xtra Foolish Gun and Carol Metcalf who scored a 217.5. Xtra Foolish Gun is the year-old daughter of Colonels Smoking Gun out of Foolish Little Step. The royally bred mare is owned by Mark Shannon Miers. She earned \$3,653 for Metcalf.

Spooks The Hard Way Carried NRHA Judge Michael McEntire to Prime Time Open Championship Title



Mike McEntire rode Spooks The Hard Way to the Prime Time Open Derby Championship. Way helped him advance that status by \$2,293 when the duo won the Prime Time Open Derby Championship with a 224. The 5-year-old gelding sired by Spooks Gotta Gun is owned by A4L-Equine. His dam is Im So Anson.

McEntire said, “Shawn Flarida originally trained him. I got him right after the first of the year. We kind of just decided to wait on him; get him back fit, and bring him to this horse show. Silver Spurs bred and raised him. He is a nice horse. He's very physical and he's fun to show. This is the first time I've really tried to show him to score, and it's really neat.”

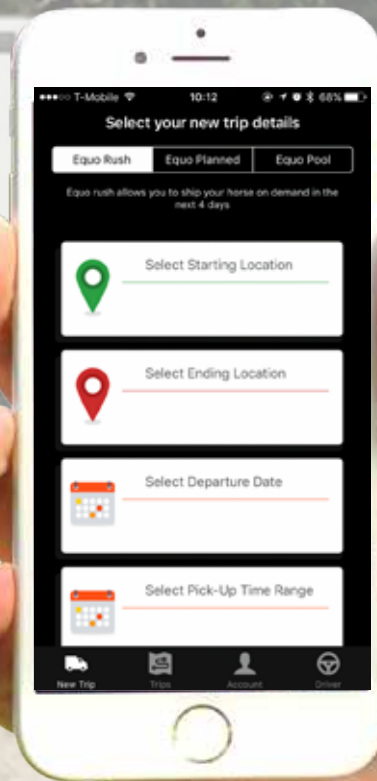

NON PRO DERBY SAW EXCITING FINALS

Sandy Bentien and Gotta Twist It Up Crowned Non Pro Derby Champion

The heat was on and the tension steamed at the close of the Non Pro Derby Finals. Would an old pro claim another or would a new champion arise in 2018? Sandy Bentien was the second to last rider in the draw, she knew the stakes were high. Her life might never be the same. She was well mounted on her only show horse, one she had raised herself. Gotta Twist It Up certainly twisted it up when he and Sandy tied with Jose Vazquez, a tried and true Non Pro champion riding his own home-raised mare, Like Shiner.

Sandy had little time to celebrate this great accomplishment because a runoff was quickly agreed upon. After a short 20 minute break, the pressure was back on. Each horse and rider team laid it all on the line to see who would emerge as the Level 4 Non Pro Derby Champion. The crowd was on its feet, screaming, whistling and cheering the two contenders along.

Bentien knew she was asking a lot of her beloved horse, and she hoped he would be ready and able. She was overcome with emotion when she heard that their previous score of 220.5 had improved to a 224, but Vazquez's score was still under review. Who had won the championship? Sandy felt proud just to have tied with such an accomplished horseman so imagine her shock when Vazquez's score was announced to be a 215, and she was named the

2018 Non Pro Derby Champion in both Levels 4 and 3. Along with the title, came a hefty check for \$31,904.

In Sandy's own words, "I was just happy making the finals and that's always my goal, but to be able to go in and do that and know that I tied with Jose who is an incredible horseman. I'm going, 'Oh my gosh! I get to go in and compete against Jose! What's the worst that can happen? I could be second?! You know, that's awesome!' So I just knew I had to go in and give it my all."

She expressed her concern and amazement for her horse, "I hoped that he had it in him one more time, and oh my goodness, he was better!"

Sandy continued, "I own his mama. I've had her since she was two. She is what I would call my once in a lifetime horse. I showed her to over \$115,000 and some titles. When we start breeding her and flushing embryos, it was always

my goal that I could raise some great babies out of her, and I got him!" Sandy emotionally reminisced, "You know, I was there when his recip mamma had him, and I halter broke him, and did most of the starting on him. I have done almost all of his training on him, and just to be able to show him and do this. It is just extra special to think that I'm able to do this and compete with the best of the best!" Gotta Twist It Up is by Spooks Gotta Whiz out of Sandy's own Make It With A Twist. Sandy could not hug the beautiful, dappled buckskin enough.

Vazquez's gritty mare, Like Shiner is by his own stallion, Smart Like Juice out of a mare that he also shares a long history with, Wind Her Up Shiner. Vazquez was also Reserve Prime Time Champion. The duo enjoyed winning the NRBC Non Pro Derby Championship just a few months ago. Jose pocketed \$14,621 for his reserve title.

Jenanne Overgaard and Dun Spooked Us Took Non Pro Derby Levels 2, 1, and Prime Time Championships

In the Level 3, the reserve champion was Jenanne Overgaard on Dun Spooked Us with a 219. The duo did not stop with the Level 3 Reserve Championship, however, for they were the Level 2, Level 1, and with the help of a 3-point handicap, the Prime Time Champions as well. Overgaard doesn't give in easily as is proven by her ownership of Dun

Spooked Us.

Overgaard explained, "I tried to get him his 3-year-old year, and the lady who owned him didn't want to sell him

– which is completely understandable! So I went to the futurity, and I begged her and said, 'please sell me your horse! I love your horse!' She didn't at the futurity, but a few months later, she said, 'okay, okay she can buy that horse.' I started showing him last year, and he's six unfortunately this year. Luke Gagnon showed him his 3-year-old year, and then Arno Honstetter showed him his 4-year-old year, and he has made every final except one in his career. This is a great way to culminate his career."

Dun Spooked Us or "Special" has a unique story behind his name. Before he was born, his surrogate mother broke her leg in the pasture. He was removed by cesarean section a month early and no one really believed that he would make it. He was bottle fed until a nurse mare could be found. He proved his worth at the Derby. He is a son of Smart Spook out of Always A Dunit. Overgaard's total take came to \$25,834.

Fredrick Christen Won the Masters Non Pro Title

Fredrick Chisten took the Masters Non Pro Championship in the saddle of Xtra Voodoo Step, a 6-year-old mare by Wimpys Little Step out of Voodoo Chic. The team scored a 216 and the \$911 check.

Christen said, "Our run in was good. We had a big stop. We slowed down in our spins which cost me. Then I had

a late lead change. Other than that, it was good. I was glad to be able to control my nerves." Christen went on to describe the nice mare that he

rides, “She is out of the dam of [Shiners] Voodoo [Dr], and she’s a Wimpy. I bought her last year at the NRBC from Xtra Quarter Horses and it’s been a great fit.”

Mark Blake earned the Masters Reserve Championship on his 6-year-old gelding, Hot Hollywood Whizkey. Hot Hollywood Whizkey is a son of Topsail Whiz out of Hot Hollywood Jewels. The duo earned \$716 for their score of 214.5.

Emily Opell on Spook N Reyn Named NRHA Derby Youth Champion

The competition was tough, but two Kentucky friends led the field. Spook N Reyn carried 17-year-old Emily Opell to victory in the NRHA Youth Derby. Opell overcame her friend, Lane Colston’s 217.5. Spook N Reyn is a 6-year-old stallion by Smart Spook out of Reyn Chex.

Emily and her horse also won reserve in

both levels 2 and 1 of the Non Pro Derby bringing her take to \$12,504. The friends were also champion and reserve in the Non Pro Levels 1 and 2 at the Florida Reining Classic in February 2018.

Opell said, “Well we took it a little bit easier in the first

2018 NRHA DERBY CROWNED NEW ANCILLARY CHAMPIONS

Madison Gustin and Guns R Spooky Won Big in Non Pro Morris Kulmer Took Non Pro Prime Time



Madison Gustin and Guns R Spooky won Non Pro, Int. Non Pro and Limited Non Pro during Saturday's ancillary action.

The NRHA Derby began with a wet morning after storms rolled through Oklahoma City on the eve of the first day of classes on June 23. The stormy night didn't affect 8-year-old Guns R Spooky or his rider, Madison Gustin at all, however. The duo kicked off the week

with nearly a clean sweep of the Non Pro Ancillary classes winning the Non Pro, Intermediate Non Pro, and the Limited Non Pro. At just 15 years old, Gustin was a few years short of taking it all, as the Prime Time was won by Morris Kulmer on NVR What A Lucky Joe.

Guns R Spooky is by Smart Spook and out of Berry Yer Guns. The dependable chestnut gelding carried Gustin to score a 144 and \$1,866 for the wins. Gustin has worked hard to make it to the winners circle training her own horse under the guidance of Casey Deary. For the past month, she has had to work through some leaning issues and with the aid of a new saddle, advice from her trainer, and spending hours in the saddle. It all came together at show time!

Gustin gave praise to her horse, "He's in shape now, so that's good. We didn't have to push him as hard. He was so good for me today. He was right where I wanted him: everything I expected him to be."

Kulmer and NVR What A Lucky Joe landed the Non Pro Prime Time win with an impressive 143. The 4-year-old chestnut gelding is by Little Joe Cash out of What A Lucky Hit. Kulmer had the horse entered in the Derby and looked forward to showing him in the preliminary rounds on Tuesday while he attempted to calm his nerves.

Kulmer explained how he gets through a run, "I'm just thinking about trying to take a breath between maneuvers, and just thinking about that one before I go to the next one, and when I'm in the next one, I try to stay in the moment. It's kind of like getting in a rhythm. When you get in the rhythm and kind of feel good about it, all of it kind of comes together. For me, it's probably better when I just get in a rhythm and don't think about it. I just go in and it

flows. If I over think it, sometimes it doesn't work out so well for me." He added with a smile, "If I ever stop getting nervous it's probably time to quit this game!" Kulmer pocketed \$266 for the win.

The Non Pro Reserve champion was Adam Donahue with Thata Shiner. The 9-year-old mare is by Smart Spook out of SLJ Smartlikewhinny. The duo scored 142.5 and \$764. The Intermediate and Limited Non Pro Reserve champion was McKinnon Larcombe who rode Taris Dreamer to a 139 and \$633. The 2009 gelding is by Magnum Chic Dream out of Taris San Cutter. Theresa Holland took the Prime Time Reserve Championship when she piloted Holly Rowdy Whiz (Rowdy Yankee x Ghost Buster Baby) to 141 points. She earned \$207 for the win.

In the AQHA, Thiago Boechat on Silver Spurs Equine's

SG Frozen Enterprise emerged with the championship title. The 9-year-old red dun stallion is by Frozen Sailor and out of RS Rose SJ.

Boechat said, "This is a horse that I'm going to be showing for Brazil at the World Equestrian Games. So I brought him out to kind of test him a little bit. I've been schooling him the last couple of

shows and just kind of cruising and being soft. I decided to go a little harder this time, and he responded really good, so I think we are on the right track for the games."

Jared Leclair and Steppin Down took reserve in the AQHA. Susan Meyer owns the 8-year-old stallion that is by Wimpys Little Step out of GS Shot Gun Wedding.

Garrett Gentry took the title in the APHA aboard Alwaysshineyergunsup. The flashy 5-year-old palomino stallion, recently purchased by Jeremiah Keller, is by Smart And Shiney out of Always Gotyer Gunsup.

Gentry is excited about the purchase as he said, "He's a really special horse. We bought him in January from Carol Rose. This customer that bought him has been looking for a breeding stallion in the APHA community for years. He's been a dream come true for the customer. He's a wonderful horse to have around. He is docile as they come. [Jeremiah] has several little toddlers and when they come to a horse show, I see pictures of all of them on his back in the stall while he has his face buried in the hay."

Rose sold the stallion with one stipulation that Garrett explained with a grin, "His barn name is Jingles. When were in Carol's office signing paperwork, she looked at me with that stern Carol Rose face, and said, 'you are not allowed to change his name.' So he is known to the reining community and everybody that knows him as 'Jingles'."

SHAWN FLARIDA ON OOPS ITSA SPOOKS WON ANCILLARY OPEN



Shawn Flarida and Oops Itsa Spook won the \$6,000-Added NRHA Open Championship.

NRHA \$6 Million Rider, Shawn Flarida didn't let his fans down when he rode Argentina-based AC Quarter Horses' 2013 bay stallion Oops Itsa Spooks to the win in the \$6,000 Open at the NRHA Derby.

Flarida simply said, "[The horse] was really good today, and was

a lot of fun to show." While the owners couldn't make it to the show, they watched the performance on the live feed and were very pleased with the win. Flarida's take was \$2,088 for the score of 148.

Matthew Palmer took Reserve in the \$6,000 Open as well as the USA Reining Open Championship when he rode Dun Alotta Chics to a 145.5. Dun Alotta Chics is the 7-year-old son of Magnum Chic Dream and A Lotta Dun It.

Palmer and the horse had some obstacles to overcome upon arriving in Oklahoma City. Palmer explained,

"When we got here, [Dun Alotta Chics] had a 103 temperature. We were a little bit worried about him. He's one I don't ride a lot. He's just kind of a laid back horse, so when we got here Friday, I didn't even ride him. Saturday, I waited until the end of the day, and then I rode him, and I probably didn't get to ride him as much as I normally would, just because I was worried about him, but everything was fine. I checked his temperature the next day, and everything was good. I didn't push him as much as I normally would before I showed him. He's a great horse, and he just stepped up again."

Cody Sapergia guided George and Carol Bell's horse, Berried Treasure to 141.5 points and the \$1,000 Intermediate Open Championship. Eight-year-old Berried Treasure is by Wimpys Little Step out of Custom Red Berry. Sapergia took \$547 for the win.

Sapergia said, "The horse is really a nice mare. She hasn't been shown very much. I haven't been on her very long. I've only been on her, maybe three weeks. She's an honest mare. She just takes a little bit of preparation for her, and she put a run together, ok."

Fred Thomsson slid into second in the \$1,000 Intermediate Open on Arlosa Whiz. The 9-year-old stallion is by Topsail Whiz out of Dream Olena Chic, and is owned by Euro-Vets Inc. Thomsson pocketed \$378.

Ruf Till The End guided by Luis Eduardo Maranhó Giannasi earned both the \$500 Limited Open and the \$500 Rookie Pro championship titles with a 140.5. The 2013 chestnut mare owned by Cardinal Hill Training Center is by Lil Ruf Peppy out of Remedys Sure Slide.

An excited Giannasi said of the mare, “She is one of the projects that Franco [Bertolani] gave me when she was two, and I started her. I started showing her when she was three, and I showed her last year as a four-year-old. I’ve been trying to win something, and always getting second, third, and... For the first time, I finally got first place!” Giannasi spent the rest of the week helping with Franco’s Derby horses after he earned the \$572 check.

Sean Pulley rode Roseanne Stern-

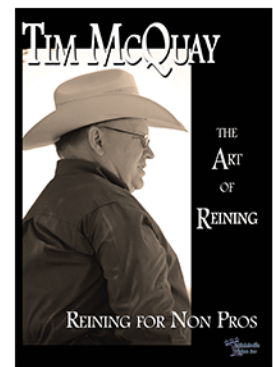
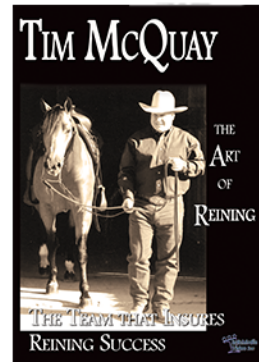
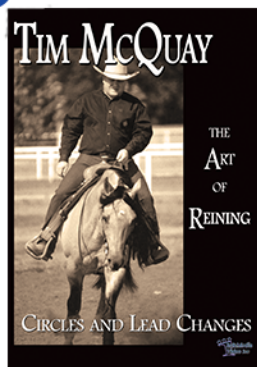
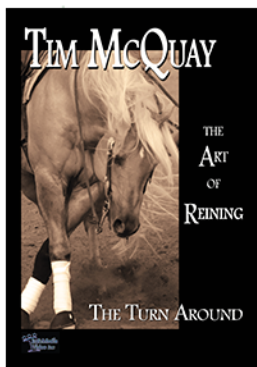

And hopefully you can have a horse that's good enough minded that he's going to help that rider out just a little bit."

Madison Steed, SMU, Won NRHA Collegiate Reining Championships on San Juan Whiz

Collegiate competitors were given about 15 minutes to watch their assigned horse's owner or trainer warm them up while touching on each maneuver and after a short walk on a loose rein, they only have about 5 minutes to check the horse's buttons before they go show them. Madison Steed did it best with a horse known as San Juan Whiz or just "Sandy" that was donated by Kim Burnett.

Steed said, "That horse was a lot of fun. It just felt like he wanted to do everything that I asked him, and do it to the best of his abilities. I just kind of pitched my reins at him and said,

'ok, Sandy, it's time to go and he was so honest with me all around the ends, and turning and stopping. I think my last stop was the best stop on him, and that just felt awesome! Circling, I can remember thinking that its either going to go really well or he's going to fall out of lead really soon. How has reining impacted your life?

Reining is just such a fun sport. You meet so many new people. You grow as a person also. You learn how to interact with adults and children, and everyone else.

Tell us about your trainer, or any other trainers you've been with.

When I first started, I rode with Elijah McQuery, and he still helps me some. I've rode with Marco Formantine; he also still helps me some. Now my two derby horses are at the McCutcheons, and Tom and Fernando help me.

What do you want to be when you grow up, and how has your trainer impacted your dream career?

Most of the people that have helped me, they are positive people. They always have a good outlook on things, and want me to do good. I don't know what I want to do when I grow up yet. I don't know if I want to go to college or learn how to run my dad's business. I don't want to be a horse trainer, but I still want to ride horses. I like riding, but I don't want to ride all the time.

Where do you hope to see yourself in 5 to 10 years?

I'll just be out of high school, so hopefully I'll either be in college or learning how to run my dad's business. Hopefully I'll be successful at something that I like to do, that can support my horse habits!

What is your dad's business?

My dad has a paving company in Frankford, Kentucky.

What major titles and shows have you won?

2016 and last year in 2017, I was reserve in the World on two different horses in the 13 & Under, and this year, I'm 5th in the Non Pro, but that wasn't really a goal, it just kind of happened. Right now, I think I'm in the top 20 Non Pros



for this year. I'd like to stay in the top 20 Non Pros, but my goal for the rest of this year is to make the derby finals.

Lane was not only the youngest rider who made it to the Level 4 Non Pro Derby Finals on two of his three horses, but he placed 5th in the Level 4 on Baileys Not Painted (Gunners Special Nite x Darlins Non Painted) and tied for 15th on One Stormy Nite (Gunners Special Nite x Whatta Royal Vintage). Lane and his two horses were also 4th and 11th in the Level 3, 3rd and 5th in Levels 2 and 1, and Reserve and 7th in the Youth Derby.

What horses have you been riding?

My first horse – my short stirrups horse – he was an older gelding, I don't remember his name, but we called him Redman in the barn. My first competitive youth horse, her name was Chiquita Conquista and we called her Minnie. Now she has babies. She had her first baby last year, and we're going to breed her again next year. Now, I had another youth horse that I showed named Roho. Now I have my three derby horses. I've shown one of them, but this will be the first time I actually show the other two.

The 2018 NRHA Derby where we interviewed Lane was his first time showing Baileys Not Painted and One Stormy Nite.

Do you have any advice for younger riders?

When I first started showing, it took me about a year to really be competitive and I would get so frustrated. But I just kept going. Eventually, as I kept riding, I progressed. I usually ride two or three horses a day in the summer, and then one or two during the day in the school year. And so I ride pretty much every day. It has helped me a lot even though there's not always someone there to help me. There is people that help me a lot, but also the more you ride you with yourself; I think you learn from yourself also.

Lane had never ridden a horse until 5 years ago, when he started reining. His trainer worked with him until he moved about a year ago. Lane has been schooling his horses himself since then until recently spending some time working with the Tom McCutcheon Reining Horses' team.

EQUINE TECH COMPANIES BARNMANAGER, EQUO, JUMPFAX, AND STABLEGUARD FORM COLLABORATION

Launched by BarnManager founder and CEO, Nicole Lakin, the innovators working together on the equine tech collaboration include Lakin, Equo's Steven Bluman, Alicia Heiniger of Jumpfax, and Alexa Anthony of StableGuard.

With the formation of the equine tech collaboration, the four companies are able to work together to develop improved solutions for the equestrian community, while also each continuing to provide a unique service and value to the equine industry.

For BarnManager, that service is a cloud-based software

that offers digitized record keeping for the many facets of horse care, as well as intuitive and simple business tools to make small business management easier and more accessible.

For Equo, it is offering what has been described as a "mix between Uber and Expedia for horses," taking horse transportation to the next level by connecting riders, owners, and trainers with certified drivers through the Equo mobile app.

For competitors, Jumpfax offers a complete, dynamic calendar of events, a comprehensive horse show guide that includes programs, start lists, results, key contacts, and more, as well as a sports data center updated daily with show jumping's statistics.

And StableGuard is often compared to the "Nest home security camera for horses." Through the StableGuard mobile app, users can watch live-stream feed of the horse in its stall, receive emergency alerts, watch event play-back, and track human interaction. Unlike other equine monitoring de-

vices, StableGuard constantly tracks the horses' well-being without needing additional wearable devices such as smart blankets, Bluetooth halters, etc.

“They are all very complimentary, and they all really could be used on a daily basis by any show jumping rider,” said Jumpfax founder Alicia Heiniger. “I’m a rider myself, so I’m a natural user of these apps, and we all really share a vision, a passion, and a wish to make our industry better and stronger.”

Lakin added, “We’re all trying to improve and advance our own specific area of the industry, but ultimately, we’re all using technology to help horse people have peace of mind at the end of the day and to allow them to focus on why we’re all really doing this in the first place: the horses.”

Lakin studied entrepreneurship and received her Master of Business Administration (MBA) from Babson College, and it was her experience there that sparked the idea for the equine tech collaboration.

“At Babson, I was constantly surrounded by other entrepreneurs,” explained Lakin, whose BarnManager application is now the Official Barn Management Software of US Equestrian. “It was a really inspiring atmosphere, and we were constantly thinking of ways that we could help each other – even though we were in completely different industries. It was a really great way to integrate together and to support each other, and I find it extremely important to have community like that.”

In addition to forming their own community to help one another as equine technology start-up founders and better serving the equestrian industry, Anthony, Bluman, Heiniger, and Lakin hope that their collaborative effort will encourage equestrians to embrace how technology can help them navigate in their industry.

“It’s really an exciting time,” said Anthony, CEO of Magic AI, the company behind StableGuard. “Now is a great opportunity for all of us to join together and create awareness surrounding technology in a traditional industry. I believe it will make the adoption a little bit easier if all four of us work together – we’re stronger that way.”

Equo CEO Bluman echoed Anthony’s sentiments: “Just like in any other life aspect, when Uber came out and Airbnb came out, everybody said, ‘No way! I will never get in a car with someone that I don’t know,’ and, ‘I would never go in an apartment that I don’t even know who owns the place.’”

Now, people are realizing they’re both great options. It’s the same with us. People are a little bit skeptical when it comes to using apps for whatever it is for their horses. By our companies coming together and acting as a force, people are going to begin to pay more attention to what’s happening. We’re trying to update the horse industry and really bring it into the 21st century.”

In addition to collaborating to grow and improve together and to introduce equestrians to applications to simplify their daily responsibilities, Lakin hopes that the equine tech collaboration will ultimately lead to greater inter-operability between the applications.

“We all are cognizant of thinking about how the applications are talking to each other, because at the end of the day, if we’re all making a million different products for people, and they have to have 17 apps on their phone, you’re not improving anything, you’re making it worse,” explained Lakin. “If we can work together and make our products work together, we’re not only better together for ourselves, we’re delivering better products for the end user.”

“When each company can focus on their own specific piece of the puzzle, but then we can all also put those pieces together, we’re really able to create something great for the consumer,” concluded Lakin. “It’s a win-win for everybody.”
