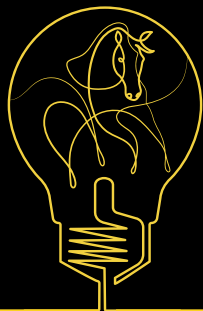
REINING HORSE FOUNDATION AWARDS \$10,500 IN SCHOLARSHIPS

The Reining Horse Foundation (RHF) announced the recipients of \$10,500 in academic and need-based scholarships for seven youth members: Nicholas Muir of Lynnwood, Washington; Amber Edmonds of Pepperell, Massachusetts; Morgan Knerr of Plain City, Ohio; Jarid Walton of Riverdale, Michigan; Terri-June Granger of Dothan, Alabama; David Gringeri of West Haven, Vermont; and Hope Hampton of Granville Ferry, Nova Scotia.

Members of the National Reining Horse Youth Association (NRHyA) submitted applications for the RHF scholarships. The recipients were chosen by an independent committee based upon their academic achievement, financial need, future goals and involvement in NRHyA and the reining horse industry.

Muir, Edmonds and Knerr were each awarded \$2,000 in RHF scholarship monies. Muir attends Washington

State University—Pullman where he is a student in the Honors College seven-year veterinary program. He also received an RHF scholarship in 2016 as a high school senior, making him eligible to reapply. Edmonds is in the Merrimack College Honors Program, majoring in elementary education and human development and intends to become an elementary school principal. She also received an RHF scholarship in 2016. Knerr attends the University of Findlay with plans to become a pharmacist. She held multiple positions as an NRHyA officer, including president in 2017, vice president

in 2016 and secretary in 2015 and also received an RHF scholarship in 2017.

Walton and Granger were awarded \$1,500 each in scholarships. Originally a student at Mid Michigan Community College, Walton transferred to the University of Maine at Fort Kent last year, where he played varsity men’s basketball and was named a 2018 Academic All-American. He also received RHF scholarships in 2015, 2016 and 2017. Walton is majoring in business management with plans to become a professional horse trainer. Granger is a member of the equestrian team at Auburn University, where she was named to the Dean’s List in 2017. \$60,000-ADDED HORSE ACADEMY TROPHY IN MOOSLARGUE


**August 15 – 19
Deadline for entries: July 27**

Daniel Straumann's Horse Academy in Mooslargue, France will host another big reining event this year: the 2018 Horse Academy Trophy August 15 – 19. The \$60,000-added show includes a \$24,000-added Lawson Bronze Trophy Open, a \$12,000-added Non Pro Trophy as well as the \$15,000-added NRHA Swiss Derby.

The event will be judged by Eugenio Latorre, Nicole Kubli, Uli Kofler and Sylvia Katschker. Deadline for entries is July 27. Entry forms are available beginning on June 19 at showmanager.eu, NRHA.ch and horseacademy.net.

Horse Academy is one of Europe's most beautiful and modern reining facilities. It offers excellent conditions for high class reining events with its 40 x 80 m show arena, a 30 x 70 m Warm up Arena, a 40 x 80 m outdoor arena as well as 140 box stalls. The facility gained international reputation with its \$100,000 World Reining Trophy (2004 – 2006) which attracted international top reiners, like Shawn Florida. Currently, Horse Academy hosts nine shows each year including the NRHA Swiss Derby and the 3-Nations-Circuit.

The 2018 Horse Academy Trophy starts on August 15 with the Any Horse, Any Rider classes. The Intermediate and Limited Trophies will follow on Thursday, August 16. On Friday, August 17, there will be the Swiss Derby Open

GAGLIANO ELECTED AS CHAIRMAN OF AMERICAS HORSE COUNCIL BOARD

Chrystine Tauber Named Vice-Chair

James L. Gagliano, President & Chief Operating Officer of The Jockey Club, was elected as the next Chairman of the American Horse Council's (AHC) Board of Trustees during the AHC's Annual Meeting and National Issues Forum. Gagliano succeeds Dr. Jerry Black who served as Chairman for the past three years.

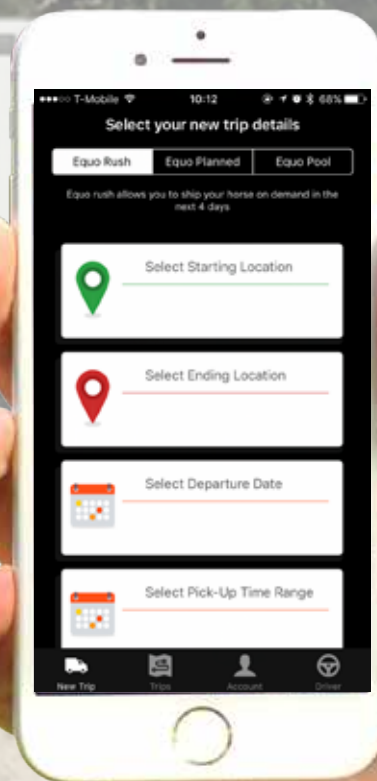
"I'm honored to lead the American Horse Council Board and follow the very successful tenure of Dr. Jerry Black," Gagliano said. "Dr. Black set a very high bar for the AHC, leading the successful transition from longtime President Jay Hickey to current President Julie Broadway, updating

the organization's strategic plan, and completing the first comprehensive Economic Impact Study of the United States Equine Industry in 14 years."

Gagliano became President and COO of The Jockey Club in 2010, where he had previously served as Executive Vice President & Chief Administrative Officer since 2005. Prior to joining The Jockey Club, he served as Executive Vice President of Magna Entertainment Corporation's Maryland racing operations, where he was responsible for the day-to-day operations of the Maryland Jockey Club. Prior to this role, Gagliano served as Executive Vice President and

General Manager of Greenwood Racing Inc., and worked in various roles during a ten-year stint with the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority.

Since October 2010, he has also served as Vice-Chairman on the International Federation of Horseracing Authorities' Executive Council, representing the Americas. Gagliano was also elected to the Thoroughbred Aftercare Alliance Board of Directors in December 2016.

"It's critical that the horse industry continue to work to confront crucial issues collectively. The challenge for the AHC in the coming years will be to work to continue to foster collaborative relationships and move the industry forward as a whole," Gagliano continued.

Christyne J. Tauber, Past-President of the United States Equestrian Federation (USEF), was elected as Vice-Chair-

man of the Board. Tauber was a founding officer and Vice President of the U. S. Hunter Jumper Association (USHJA) for eight years. Tauber is a Board member of the U.S. Equestrian Team Foundation, the Show Jumping Hall of Fame, and the USHJA Wheeler Museum. Tauber served as Team Manager for all U.S. teams at the 1984 and 1988 Olympic Games, the 1983 and 1987 Pan Am Games, and for the Show Jumping World Championships in 1982 and 1986.

"The USEF is a strong supporter of the AHC's mission to advocate for the social, legislative, and economic interests of the United States equine industry," Tauber said. "As we move forward to confront emerging issues that affect our diverse industry, ensuring that we have a voice on Capitol Hill is more critical than

NRCHA DERBY CHAMPIONS CROWNED IN PASO ROBLES, CALIFORNIA

A thrilling week of reined cow horse action in Paso Robles, California, at the Paso Robles Event Center was topped off with the crowning of the 2018 National Reined Cow Horse Association Derby Champions. Champions were designated in three Open and three Non Pro Derby divisions. The show took place June 10-17.

The NRCHA Derby is one of the largest and richest events for 4- and 5-year-old reined cow horses, with the total payout in 2018 exceeding \$300,000. Shown two-handed in a snaffle bit or a hackamore, horses are judged in three events: rein work, herd work and cow work.

Humble is not a word you would expect to hear from a competitor with three horses qualified for the clean-slate finals of the Open Derby but, that is how NRCHA Professional Justin Wright described his week in Paso Robles, California. The 2017 NRCHA Jack and Phoebe Cooke Memorial Derby Champion returned to the Heart Equestrian Center working towards another opportunity to win the coveted title, and that is exactly what he accomplished.

“It was a very humbling week and it was just fun,” Wright said. “Last year we had a great year, but this week has been so much fun, just enjoying doing good and enjoying the ride and the good horses.”

All eyes were on the Santa Maria, California, horseman and Shiners Diamond Cat (WR This Cats Smart x Shiners Diamond Lady x Shining Spark) as they maintained a solid lead throughout the preliminary go-rounds with an overall score of 665.5. Come finals time, the team seemed to find a new level of performance, marking an incredible 672 in the Derby Open Finals composite (225 herd / 221.5 rein / 225.5 cow).

“I knew I had to be big. I had to make something happen. My mare was great. She tried her guts out and I was just along for the ride. She handled everything,” Wright said.

Mike and James Draper bought the 2014 mare from Roger and Cynthia Bias in her three-year-old year. The Drapers owned horses in the past, but they never made it to the show pen. “They are the greatest owners that you could ever ask for,” Wright said. “They are the nicest people.”

They say it takes a village, and that could not be more true for Justin Wright Performance Horses. Wright thanked his team back home, his help here at the show, his herd help and

his good friend/ mentor, Clayton Edsall whom he ran neck and neck with through much of the prelims. "If it was not for them, I would not be here doing this," he said.

Wright, eager to praise Shiners Diamond Cat said, "That's what means the most to me about this show, is having her win it. It is all about her. She's supposed to win this and I'm basically along for the ride."

The Championship paid \$30,989 and came with prizes including a saddle from Bob's Custom Saddles, a Gist buckle, boots from Lucchese and product from Platinum Performance.

To say Clayton Edsall, Oakdale, California, is a fierce competitor with horsepower underneath of him would be an understatement. The California horseman piloted six horses to the Intermediate Open Finals and five horses to the Open Finals, and collected winnings that exceeded \$92,000.

The 2018 NRCHA Jack and Phoebe Cooke Memorial Derby Intermediate Open Championship belonged to Clayton Edsall and Bet He Sparks (Bet Hesa Cat x Sparking Train x Shining Spark) owned by K & L Phillips, LLC. The pair scored a 219 in the herd, a 223 in the reining and a 228 down the fence for a composite of 670, giving them a first place finish in the Intermediate and second place finish in the Open. Edsall said, "He's a really good horse and he's got a great personality. He stops hard and cows great. He's easy."

After winning the NRCHA Stakes Open and Intermediate Open Championships, Edsall had high hopes of achieving

the same accolades at the NRCHA Derby. He took first, second and third place in the Intermediate Open, while scoring a 228 down the fence, twice, during the Open Derby Finals performance.

"We needed a lot of cow and that's what we got," Edsall said. "I put a lot of trust in him. The horse is pretty special, because I bought and started him. Then, I sold him to a great customer and friend and got to keep him."

Knowing what it took to guide four horses through the Stallion Stakes Finals, Edsall went home and began to prepare to take six horses through the triathlon of finals. "Not bogging myself down in one event or one maneuver. Just making sure I could get through everything smooth and keep them all happy and trying," Edsall said.

Horse shows are a true family affair for the Edsalls. His wife, children and mother were at the show all week to cheer him on. Edsall thanked his family, customers, Don Murphy and his herd help throughout the week. "When you have so many great athletes, it takes a lot of care and a lot of people to care for them," Edsall said.

Making the drive from Calhan, Colorado to Paso Robles, California was well worth for the newly crowned NRCHA Derby Limited Open Champion, Dave Dillman.

The NRCHA Professional piloted his own horse, Playing With Rey (Play Dual Rey x Arc Holly Cee Lena x Smart Little Lena), to a combined score of 645.5. Dillman and his 2013 mare earned a 214 in the herd work, 215 in the rein work and 216.5 down the fence, taking a permanent lead in the Limited Open Finals and winning a paycheck of more

Making frequent appearances in Non Pro Finals, Bart Holowath and Smart Lookin Nurse (WR This Cats Smart x NurseWare x Dual Rey) captured two titles, the Non Pro and Intermediate Non Pro Derby Championships, with an overall score of 653.5 (219 herd / 215.5 rein / 219 cow).

With dual wins, comes dual prizes, including a Bob’s Custom Saddle, two Gist buckles and product from Lucchese, Shorty’s Caboy Hattery and Platinum Performance, along with a win check totaling more than \$11,000.

Holowath and his 2013 gelding “Finn” have been partners since the horse’s three-year-old year. “This horse is a great horse. He knows his maneuvers. He knows what to do,” Holowath said. “I just have to keep up with him.”

Holowath said, “When you have a horse as good as that one, you go down the road because you may not ever get another one.” Over the years, the NRCHA Derby has been good to the Holowaths. Bart explained how special it is that he and Terri share

After falling just short of NRCHA premier event wins over the past year, Garrell Williams and Sparks On The Fence (Smart Boons x Spark Chic Olena x Smart Chic Olena), took home the title of 2018 NRCHA Derby Non Pro Limited Champions.

The pair managed to stay in the top five through all three events, winning the herd work with a 213.5, marking a 212.5 in rein work and sealing the deal with a 218.5 in the cow work. With an overall composite of 644, Williams took back a plethora of prizes to Scottsdale, Arizona, including a Gist custom buckle, a DM Tack headstall, a Platinum Performance gift certificate, a straw hat from Shorty’s Caboy Hattery and winnings totaling more than \$2,600.

When Williams purchased the 2012 mare from fellow non pro competitor, Clark Weaver, last July, she transitioned into a new barn. “Carlee” was in training with NRCHA Professional Brad Barkemeyer, at the time of purchase. Williams’ decision to join the new training program has been nothing but a positive experience. It’s about horsemanship. They put the horse first and the rider first. It’s a great program,” Williams said.

Next on the list of achievements for this team is qualifying for the NRCHA Celebration of Champions in the Non Pro Two Rein. Earlier in the week, Williams and Sparks On The Fence finished second in the Non Pro Two Rein Spectacular, sending them over the \$750 earnings mark and

Topping the preliminary chart of the Non Pro divisions after two preliminary events, Emmons and “Nicci” ran into some tough luck in the fence work, leaving her to wonder if she was tough enough for this sport. “When I got back in the Novice Finals, it made me happy that I could at least try and go down the fence one more time. Today it felt really good, we got it set up right and for me it was really good,” Emmons said. It was the opportunity to go down the fence one more time, that lead Emmons and her 2013 mare to the 2018 NRCHA Derby Novice Non Pro Championship title and earnings exceeding \$1,500. The pair marked a 213 in the herd work, a 215.5 in the rein work and a big 220.5 down the fence for a composite of 649, sealing the win.

Bridle Spectaculars at NRCHA Premier Events were created to showcase the ultimate reined cow horse - the bridle horse. These seasoned veterans have spent years in programs that follow the traditional vaquero training methods.

The CD Survivor Memorial Open Bridle Spectacu-

lar, named in honor of the late, great stallion owned by NRCHA breeder sponsor Holy Cow Performance Horses, is a \$25,000-added event that is filled with some of the best horses and horsemen and women in the country.

With entry numbers nearly double over last year, twenty-eight of some of the most elite reined cow horses and trainers took center stage at the Paso Robles Event Center, completing the triathlon of herd work, rein work and fence work in one afternoon. Energy and excitement filled the air, as owners, riders and fans searched for an empty seat or place to stand and watch the thrilling fence work.

An incredible fence score of 227.5 came from CSR Lay Down Sally (Dual Spark x Look At Her Glo x CD O Cody) and NRCHA Professional Chris Dawson, giving them an eleven point lead over their fellow competitors. The team’s composite of 670 (219 herd / 223.5 rein / 227.5 cow) secured the coveted title of 2018 CD Survivor Memorial Open Bridle Spectacular Champion, along with a CR Morrison resin trophy sponsored by Will Rogers Memorial Center, a Gist buckle, product from Platinum Performance and an \$11,675 paycheck.

The 2011 mare is owned by Non Pro competitor Meredith Graber, who just six days earlier, captured the Non Pro Bridle Spectacular Championship at the NRCHA Derby, aboard “Sally.” Graber bought the mare as a five-year-old and showed her in the boxing Derbies through her six-year-old year. According to Graber’s trainer, Dawson, Graber is the one who has spent the most time putting CSR Lay down Sally in the bridle.

Sharing an Open and Non Pro horse does not come without its challenges, but CSR Lay Down Sally, Graber and Dawson seem to make it work well. “Meredith is such a great rider. Sally keeps Meredith safe while learning to go down the fence, then I can put more pressure on her for the Open,” Dawson said.

“Everything felt aligned today. Sally always feels good,” said Dawson. “She found some gears tonight I wasn’t even sure she had. Every time I show that mare she just gets better. She is a super horse and she has a lot of heart.”

“They [Holy Cow Performance Horses] have been such great supporters of the bridle horses. The purpose of this is to build bridle horses,” Dawson stated. “These bridle horse classes are so nice to be able to give the owners an incentive to keep a horse in training and let the horses progress through the stages of training.”

Dawson Performance Horses has had a very successful week, so far, at the NRCHA Derby, taking several championship titles back to Perrin, Texas, making tonight’s win

When I went into that fence work I was telling myself we can do this. There was not any doubt in my mind we weren't going to mark a 225. I wasn't going to accept, mentally, anything but that. I really believe in mental imagery and setting your goals.” The pair exceeded the expectation of 225, scoring a 226 down the fence.

Daniel Perez, a client of Wold's for over a decade, felt very satisfied with tonight's performance and win. When asked what he enjoys most about the NRCHA professional's training program, Perez stated, “He is an honest man. His

The Non Pro Limited Champion prize package included two C.R. Morrison trophies, sponsored by the Will Rogers Memorial Center; romal reins from Dennis Moreland Tack; a straw hat from Shorty's Caboy Hattery; and product from Platinum Performance.

The non pro competitor, who regularly travels from South America to compete at NRCHA premier events, rode the 2012 mare to a 144.5 in the rein work and a 147.5 in cow work, for a composite of 292.

The team also finished third in the Non Pro Limited Spectacular and tied for fourth place in the Non Pro Limited. Gonzalez took home a combined paycheck of more than \$2,000, a CR Morrison trophy and products from NRCHA sponsors, such as Shorty's Caboy Hattery and Platinum

Daddino's introduction to reined cow horse began by showing a bridle horse in the boxing. Her love of the sport quickly escalated her desire to show a limited aged event horse down the fence. Daddino's trainer, Monica Caetano, suggest she try Mister PBR, a horse previously owned by John Pascoe that had been in Caetano's training program from the start.

The pair clicked and the rest is history. "Fence work is my favorite. He makes it easy and he makes it fun. He takes good care of me," Daddino said beaming with pride.

Wearing a red shirt, in preparation to work a fast cow, “Corban” and Daddino handled the fence work with ease, scoring a 216. The Amateur Championship was accompanied with a \$1,900 paycheck, a Gist custom buckle, Platinum Performance, a headstall by DM Tack and a Shorty’s Caboy straw hat.

Daddino is looking forward to next step of taking Mister PBR, and his big personality, into the Two Rein and Bridle. Daddino thanked her parents for all of their support, her trainer for all her patience and knowledge and her Lord Jesus Christ.

trees off. It was kind of cool because they were right there in the middle of everything and it really made things hit home for people – why we are doing what we are doing.”
