XTRA QUARTER HORSES AND BLUEBONNET FEED DERBIES NEARING \$100,000 ADDED MONEY

The 2018 Oklahoma Reining Horse Association Ride & Slide is proving that Tulsa is the place to be in early March. Last week over 170 entries ran hard in the Xtra Quarter Horses Open Derby and the Bluebonnet Feeds Non-Pro Derby, competing for nearly \$100,000 in total added money. Both derbies featured the popular Novice Horse Division which gives horses with less than \$10,000 in earnings a chance to run at \$15,000 of their own added money. Many professionals, non-pros and youth riders used the event to kick off the 2018 show season and get ready for upcoming events.

Sarah Ganser, OKRHA board member said, "Lots of

people took advantage of the great schooling, but they also brought their A-games for the derbies. The great purse money really made it worth running hard."

The Ride & Slide is quickly becoming a reiner favorite. It's the perfect time of year to get derby horses out for a test drive, and Tulsa Expo Square's facility has pretty much everything you need to put on a great equine event. From plenty of nice stalls, to tons of covered riding and practice arenas, to ample parking, and lots of options for nearby hotels and restaurants, Tulsa makes for a great host city. "We offered two full slates of ancillary classes, and tried to provide plenty of schooling opportunities for people wanting

to get their horses tuned up for the NRBC,” said OKRHA Board Member and Event Coordinator, Heidi Arvidson.

While the Ride & Slide is a great schooling event, the big scores in the derbies proved that people came to show!

The Open Derby, sponsored by Xtra Quarter Horses, had steep competition at nearly 100 entries. When the dust settled, NRHA Million Dollar Rider, Jason Vanlandingham of Whitesboro, TX and John and Norma Sather’s 6-year-old stallion, Shining In Town (Hollywoodstinseltown x Shine Ann), topped the Level 4, marking a 227 ½ .

The Level 4 Open Reserve Championship went to Thiago Boechat of Purcell, OK and Ruf Lil Magnum (Magnum Chic Dream x Dunit A Lil Ruf), owned by Silver Spurs Equine after marking a 227.

In the Level 3 Open, reining veteran and Million Dollar Rider, Rocky Dare and Xtra Goodstep (Wimpys Little Step x Miss N Becky), tied with Gabriel Diano and Tunes In Hollywood (Hollywoodstinseltown x Shiney Tari) for the title. They each pulled off some dynamic maneuvers to receive their respective scores of 225. Dare’s horse is owned by B & A Enterprises and Diano’s by Margarita Buey Arietti, of Paraguay.

Dare and Xtra Goodstep also earned the Level 2 Open Championship for their efforts. The Level 2 Reserve Championship went to Josh Visser and the five-year-old mare, Candy Coded (Electric Code x Smartest Sister), owned by Daniel

The concurrently run Novice Horse Open Derby, for horses with no more than \$10,000 in lifetime earnings, also had some great competition. It was NRHA Million Dollar Rider, Jordan Larson on Coquaike LLC’s The Rey Gun (Colonels Smoking Gun x Prettywhizprettydoes) and Gabriel Diano on his second mount, Diamonds Tinseltown (Hollywoodstinseltown x Diamonds Sparklette), owned by P & P Quarter Horses LLC who tied for the top spot. Both teams marked a 223 ½ to share the win.

In the Non Pro Derby, sponsored by Bluebonnet Feeds, two young guys bested the other 70 plus contenders. Cade McCutcheon, (age 17) on Customized Dually (Mister Nicadual x Customized Gunner) and Jack Medows (age 20) on Frame Draggin (Einsteins Revolution x Coronas Major) earned a 222 ½ from the judges to tie for the Level 4 Championship.

Sandy Bentein and her homegrown stallion, Gotta Twist It Up (Spooks Gotta Whiz x Make It With A Twist) took home the Level 3 Non Pro Derby title, with a 220 ½. There was a tie for the Reserve spot in the Level 3 between Kay Gould and Cromed Out Sunset (Cromed Out Mercedes x Sunset Whiz) and Taylor Zimmerman and Hide Your Magnum (Magnum Chic Dream x Hide N Cita), each marking a 218.

Kay Gould and Cromed Out Sunset also won the Level 2 Non Pro, outright. Kathy Thompson and her gelding, Baileys Sidekick (Gunnars

INTERNSHIPS AVAILABLE FOR NRHA DERBY

The application period is now open for 2018 National Reining Horse Association (NRHA) Derby interns. Qualified candidates will have the opportunity to gain hands-on experience within the horse industry, learn essential knowledge on event organization and be a part of the third-largest reining event in the world. Internships with NRHA also provide individuals with real-life experiences that create lifelong skill sets.

Many current NRHA employees began their careers as show interns at the NRHA Derby or Futurity. "I had already fallen in love with the sport of reining, which is what led me to apply for the internship with the NRHA," said NRHA Member & Show Services Representative Riley Jordan. "Although the shows can be long and demanding, working alongside the NRHA employees truly caused me to fall in love with the company and the way they treat their employees and members. I had never worked in an environment where I loved and respected people that I barely knew so much. I never saw myself being one to move across the country for any reason. NRHA turned out to be the one exception."

Internships are available in three categories: general, marketing and youth. All internships are based at NRHA headquarters in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, and include participation at the NRHA Derby June 23 – July 1, 2018*. Selected candidates should meet the following criteria:

- Able to assist with all functions of the departments listed, including early mornings and long days during the event
- Willing to work closely with youth members, leaders and NRHA staff
- Demonstrate an interest in the livestock or horse industry, and have the ability to work collaboratively
- Creative, energetic, patient and reliable

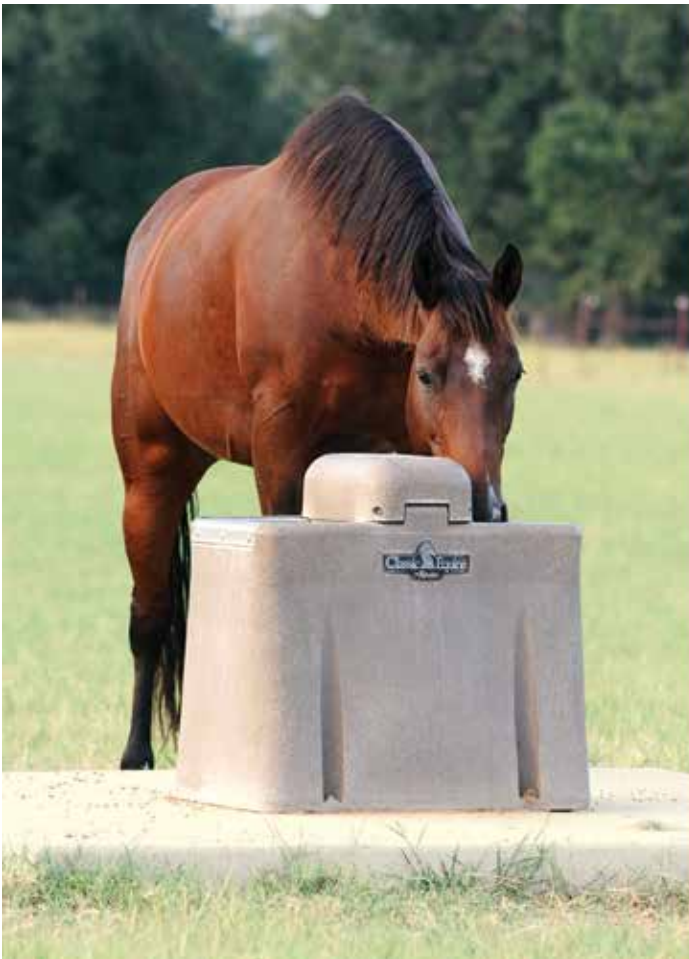

MERLE WOOD HUMANITARIAN AWARD

Cathy Hanson received the 2017 Merle Wood Humanitarian Award at the 2018 AQHA Convention in Jacksonville, Florida.

The Merle Wood Humanitarian Award from the American Quarter Horse Foundation was awarded on March 4 at the 2018 AQHA Convention.

Cathy Hanson of Fallbrook, California, received the 2017 Merle Wood Humanitarian Award from the American Quarter Horse Foundation March 4 at the [2018 AQHA Convention](#) in Jacksonville, Florida.

Established in 1997 in honor of the late [Merle Wood](#), this award recognizes an individual who exemplifies an ethic of kindness and benevolence in providing opportunities for young people to be involved with the American Quarter Horse.

Hanson grew up with horses her entire life, learning from her father, Don Blazer. She competed as a youth and fell in love with the American Quarter Horse. She was drawn to their athleticism and heart. Hanson showed in the open

division as a youth, and earned the title of AQHA reserve world champion in western riding in 1988 aboard the mare Lo Lindo.

Hanson is an AQHA Professional Horsewoman and was named the Most Valuable Professional in 2007. She is an AQHA director for California and serves on the youth committee, as well as the AQHA Animal Welfare Commission. She has also held various positions with the Pacific Coast Quarter Horse Association – voting past president, youth adviser and youth committee chairwoman, and currently serves as president of the Southern California Quarter Horse Exhibitors Association.

Hanson continues to impact the lives of the equine industry; however, her reach is far beyond the show ring. She has donated countless hours and energy to Mustard Seed, a Southern California faith-based organization that addresses the needs of foster children by using horses to establish confidence and compassion. She is also an avid supporter of the “My Horse, My Journey” program, providing clinics to horse owners who are financially unable to afford full-time training. Proceeds from this program go to support “Ray of Sunshine,” another organization that utilizes horses to help cancer patients and their families build confidence, comfort and self-esteem in the face of life-changing and threatening diseases.

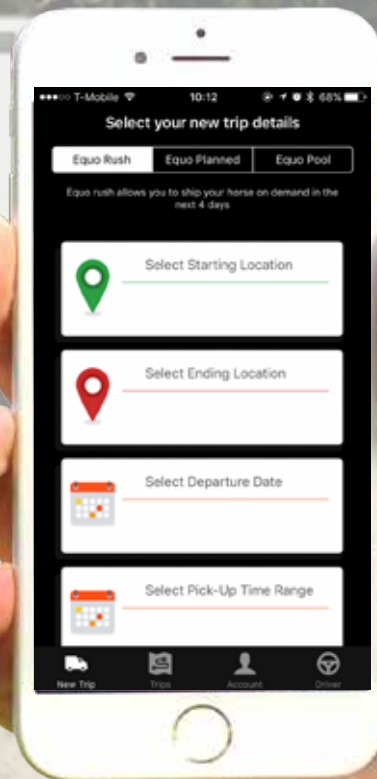

NEW PROTOCOL FOR NRHA PROFESSIONAL OF THE YEAR AWARDS

In the fall of 2017, the National Reining Horse Association (NRHA) Professionals Committee unanimously voted to modify the nomination and voting procedures for their yearly awards. The intention of this modification is to gain more participation from NRHA Affiliates and broaden the pool of deserving nominees.

The new nomination and voting process will be implemented this year and will follow the procedures below.

1. NRHA Affiliates will submit one nomination for each of the five award categories. It will be up to each affiliate to determine how they select their nominees. Nominations for each category will need a separate form.
2. Nominations will remain at the current due date of November 1. Once the nomination period is complete, the NRHA Professionals Committee Staff Liaison will collect and compile all nominations for

3. The NRHA Professionals Committee will review all nominations, selecting the top five professionals for each category.
4. Once the top five are selected, an electronic vote will be sent to all current NRHA Professional members.
5. After the voting is closed, winners will be announced. Any ties will be broken by the NRHA Professionals Committee.

The NRHA Professionals Committee strives to strengthen its current programs through constant evaluation. They hope this change will afford more of the industry's best professionals the opportunity to receive the recognition they deserve through a more structured nomination and voting processes.

AQHA RECOGNIZES 2018 HALL OF FAME INDUCTEES

The 2018 American Quarter Horse Hall of Fame inductees were honored at the Hall of Fame Banquet on March 4 at the Hyatt Regency Riverfront in Jacksonville, Florida.

“Induction into the American Quarter Horse Hall of Fame is the highest honor possible in our Association, and we welcome these deserving individuals into the Hall of Fame,” said Craig Huffhines, executive vice president of the American Quarter Horse Association.

The horses inducted into the Hall of Fame are the stallions Otoe, Runaway Winner, The Ole Man and Smart Chic

Olena; and the mare Maroon (TB).

The horsemen are AQHA Past President Gene Graves of Grand Island, Nebraska; Dr. Tom Lenz of Louisburg, Kansas; Robert Sutherland of Overland Park, Kansas; Georga Sutton and her late husband, Raymond Sutton, of Gettysburg, South Dakota; and Hawaiian Princess, breeder and horsewoman Abigail Kawanakoa of Honolulu.

Otoe

The 1960 stallion was bred by Bud Warren, who owned such sires as Sugar Bars, Leo and Jet Deck. Otoe was

purchased by Dr. Jack Donald's Donald Ranch at El Paso, Texas, for \$20,000 as a yearling. Throughout his career, the stallion succeeded in everything he did. On the track, he won five of 13 races, finished second or third in another five and finished off the board only twice. As a halter horse, he won 20 out of 23 classes he was shown in and was an AQHA world champion in halter in 1962.

Runaway Winner

Bred by Chris Cox of Austin, Texas, the gray colt was a son of Beduino, the all-time-leading Thoroughbred sire of racing American Quarter Horses. Runaway Winner was foaled April 1, 1985, out of the stakes-placed Fast Jet mare Miss Fast Chic, a half-sister to the stakes-winning Real Easy Jet mare Real Easy Chic. Runaway Winner earned his place in the American Quarter Horse Hall of Fame for being an exceptional racehorse and an astounding sire of broodmares that pass on speed. Runaway Winner's daughters have been represented by 79 stakes winners, 785 other winners and the earners of more than \$33.8 million from 1,463 starters, to rank him as the 11th all-time-leading broodmare sire.

The Ole Man

Bred by Frank Vessels Sr., The Ole Man was by Three Bars (TB), arguably the most all-around influential Thoroughbred sire in Quarter Horse history. The Ole Man won eight of 33 races, finished second or third in 11 others and earned \$21,156 at seven tracks in two seasons of racing. The stallion sired 554 horses that started in official Quarter Horse races, with 250 returning as winners and 15 of those in stakes, for earnings of \$1,077,061. In the show pen, the stallion is represented by 10 AQHA Champions; 78 horses that earned 1,335.5 points in open halter and 106 earners of 1,439.5 points in open performance, for a total of 4,555 points.

Smart Chic Olena

The sorrel stallion was foaled in 1985 on the B.F. Phillips Ranch in Frisco, Texas. Initially trained as a cutter, Smart Chic Olena is one of few who has stepped into both the cutting and reining world. His mind set and athleticism allowed him to become a bloodline staple in National Reining Horse Association competition. The stallion has sired 11 open world champions, four amateur world champions and two youth world champions in reining. To date, Smart Chic Olena's offspring have earned more than \$14 million. His daughters' foals have earned more than \$14 million and more than 16,000 points.

Maroon (TB)

Foaled in 1949 on the Alcorn Ranch, Maroon was bred by Mary Pearson. Future Hall of Fame member Suzanne Norton acquired the mare from Pearson as a 2-year-old and sent the mare to R.C. "Punch" Jones of the A.D. Jones Ranch at Tatum, New Mexico. Punch and Suzanne would

later marry. In four seasons of official Quarter Horse races from July 1953 through October 1957, Maroon earned \$14,016 while compiling a record of 52-12(4)-8(3)-10(5). As a broodmare, she built a legacy that spans on through today.

Dr. Tom Lenz

As a boy, Tom Lenz dreamed of becoming a veterinarian. As a man, he became one of the world's most prominent advocates for the American Quarter Horse and humane, sensible treatment of all horses. Dr. Lenz has been an AQHA honorary vice president since 2009. He currently serves on the nominations and credentials committee and the AQHA Animal Welfare Commission. He was part of the search committee in 2014 that hired Craig Huffhines as AQHA executive vice president. Dr. Lenz began writing the monthly Horse Health column in The American Quarter Horse Journal in 1992 and continues to this day.

Gene Graves

The late AQHA past president had a passion for members and engaging them in AQHA activities. Graves, who was 75 the year he was AQHA president, thought 70-&-Over exhibitors at the Select World deserved a special all-around-type award. So, at the 2012 Select World, AQHA presented the first Gene Graves Super-Select Special Recognition Award to the Super-Select exhibitor, age 70 or older, who



earned the greatest number of points in competition at the show. Not every AQHA president has an award named in their honor.

Raymond and Georga Sutton

Mention the name “Sutton” to anyone who has been in the horse industry any length of time, and that person will know you are talking about a hard-working family raising top-quality American Quarter Horses, Hereford cattle and Bison on their ranch in South Dakota. The Raymond Sutton Ranch has been home to working American Quarter Horses since 1948 and remains home to the oldest continuously produced Quarter Horse sale in the world.

Robert Sutherland

Robert Sutherland was a man ahead of his time and long overdue for induction into the AQHA Hall of Fame. One of the founders of the Hall of Fame, Sutherland in 1953 helped found the Missouri Quarter Horse Association. He served

as its first president and was on the board of directors for years. Most of his life was dedicated to the preservation and promotion of and devotion to the American Quarter Horse.

Abigail Kawanakoa

The Hawaiian Princess is a leader in all aspects of her life, including on the racetrack. She is the industry’s all-time leading female breeder at the reins of an operation that has produced the earners of more than \$10 million. Miss Abigail bred Florentine to Chicks Beduino to create This Snow Is Royal, who sired champion Blazin Fire, 43 other stakes winners and the earners of more than \$13.9 million. She also bred Evening Snow, who became the first Quarter Horse in history to break the 21-second mark at the quarter mile when he clocked 20.94 in the AQHA West/Southwest Challenge Championship (G2) in October 1996 at Turf Paradise in Phoenix.

Dr. Scott Myers of Sharon Center, Ohio, has been an AQHA life member since 1993 and an AQHA director since

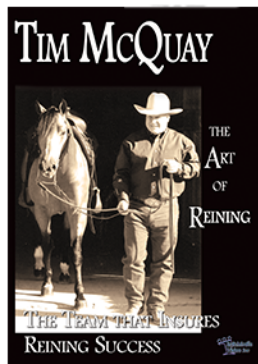
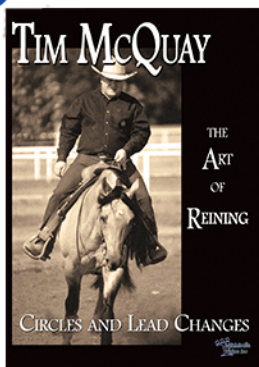

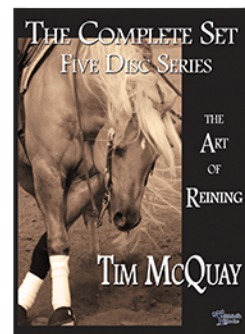

While more detailed qualification criteria will be available soon, know that the rider, horse and horse's owner must have current memberships in the USEF and USA Reining.

The horse and rider must also have current FEI registration, and the horse will need a valid FEI passport. A USEF National Passport with a FEI Horse Registration can be used in FEI Junior and Young Rider divisions if the competition is in the rider's home country.

US Equestrian Director of Reining Programs Bryn Wells is excited about these opportunities for young people. "2017 was the inaugural year for the FEI World Reining Championships for Junior and Young Riders and it was a huge success! There were 14 countries participating and the CS Ranch in Switzerland made it a memorable experience for all," Wells explained. "This program is for riders 21 years of age and younger. It provides this younger of group reiners the opportunity to represent their countries on the international stage and can serve as a great experience along the

way to making a WEG team. We are looking forward to 2019 and the chance to participate in these championships again. Qualifying has already begun and we are excited about the number of riders that have shown interest in representing the US. "

2018 WEG US REINING TEAM FEI QUALIFYING CRITERIA

Having begun January 1, 2017, the FEI qualifying period is in full swing until August 13, 2018. During this period, the FEI*3 reining athlete must complete three different CRI*3 competitions, scoring a minimum average of 70 at two, during the qualification period. One must be completed in 2018 (excluding the championships), and all must be completed with no elimination, disqualification, or withdrawal.

The rider must be at least 18 years old, and the horse must be at least 7. The rider must have current USEF and USA Reining memberships, and a current FEI registration. The horse must have current USEF Lifetime and USA Reining Recording, and have a valid FEI Passport with FEI Registration.

The US Team Selection Trial will be held at the Tryon International Equestrian Center in Tryon, North Carolina on May 11-13, 2018 in conjunction with the WEG Reining Test Event. However, before the selection trial, riders must have completed the following:

- Application of Intent (Due April 1, 2018)
- A minimum score of 70 at one of two different

CRI*3 competitions between January 1, 2017 and May 11, 2018.

Director of Reining, and Eventing Programs, Bryn Wells said “We are looking forward to the 2018 World Equestrian Games coming back to our home turf at the Tryon International Equestrian Center. It’s going to be an exciting September with the action kicking off in May when the qualified US Reining Riders will compete at the US Team Selection Trial for the chance to represent the US, which will also be at Tryon.”

The World Equestrian Games will take place September 11-23, 2018 at the Tryon International Equestrian Center in Tryon, North Carolina. The World Equestrian Games have been held every four years since 1990; however, WEG 2018 will only be the second to take place on American soil. The first time was in Lexington, Kentucky in 2010 which also marked the first time that the games were not held in Europe.
