## NATIONAL REINING BREEDERS CLASSIC ATTENDEES ENJOY 21ST SHOW

The National Reining Breeders Classic ended its 21st anniversary show April 22, 2018, enjoying more than \$20 million in pay out over the course of 21 years.

The show began on Sunday, April 15 with a church service officiated by Ed Harrison, paid warm-ups, opening riding, a Come and Go Reception for sponsors and an Open

Riders Meeting.

Open riders discussed rider and horse safety and a new eligibility workshop in the annual meeting.
"Safety in how we ride is important to maximize the quality of practice for riders," said Casey Hinton, profes-

Hinton also invited professionals, owners and any other riders who would like to attend, a first of its kind, eligibility workshop to be held in Denton, Texas, June 12 and 13.

Rafacz and Whizenboonsmal topped Wednesday's Rookie Level 1 class and combined with today's win she says she's excited about the shootout. She plans to give it her all in Friday's finals.
"I'm going to run really fast," Rafacz said with a laugh of her game plan for the shootout.

Tesmer rode the 2009 stallion Itsa Last Wimpy (Wimpys Little Step x Itsas Last Chic) to the co-championship.

Tesmer and Itsa Last Wimpy have been partners for a little over a year. Tesmer is new to the game having only been reining for about a year, but her standout partner makes her job as a rider easy.

## VHH/WWS: Do you have any advice for Younger Riders?

After a spectacular run at the National Reining Breeders Classic (NRBC) by many of his offspring, Spooks Gotta Whiz is unofficially an NRHA Million Dollar Sire.

Spooks Gotta Whiz is by NRHA Million Dollar Sire Spooks Gotta Gun and out of Prettywhizprettydoes. Bred by Clint Haverty, the 2007 stallion is owned by Michell Anne Kimball, who purchased the horse from Duane Hicks in 2009 after meeting him at the High Roller Reining Classic. "Baby" currently stands at Cinder Lakes Ranch in Valley View, Texas.

The bay stallion may have crossed the NRHA Million due to his success in the breeding pen, but Spooks Gotta Whiz had his fair share of glory within his competitive career, accumulating NRHA Lifetime Earnings (LTE) in excess of $\$ 345,147$. His prominent wins include:

- 2010 NRHA Level (L)4 Open Futurity Champion ridden by Jordan Larson
- 2012 NRBC L4 Open Classic Champion ridden by Shawn Flarida
- 2012 NRHA L4 Open Derby Champion ridden by Flarida
- Alltech FEI World Equestrian Games ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ (WEG) 2014 Normandy Individual and Team Gold Medalist ridden by Flarida

Baby began his breeding career in 2011 and has produced offspring who have achieved much notoriety within the show pen. The young stallion sired the 2016 NRHA L4 Open Futurity Champion, the 2016 NRHA L3 Non Pro Futurity Reserve Champion and the 2017 NRHA L4 Non Pro Derby Reserve Champion, in addition to numerous finalists within many of the industry's top tier shows

will be preceded by the finals of the reined cow horse Derby, promising a thrilling day of shows.

This year again sees riders competing in the much-loved "Oklahoma style" oval arena in two CRI *** competitions and all the Ancillary NRHA events.

## The staff

As always, presiding over the Derby is a top international jury: Joe Hayes and Nic Baar will be over from the US (respectively Texas and Ohio), Swede Rick LeMay from Spain, where he lives and works, Julie Rossner from Germany, while the Italian Lara Maiocchi will be playing at home, so to speak. Carol Telford, an American now residing in Rome, will be officiating at bit inspection and German Maik Bartmann will be at the monitor.

Last year's efficient secretarial and arena staff will be back this year: Vittorio Gaetano and Federica Caimi, coordinated by Cristina Serra, will guarantee the technically perfect performance of the secretarial procedures, while the doorman will be Nick Puscas, with Alessandro Dezzutto and Harry Quint working as stewards, and the demanding job of ensuring a good ground in the show ring will once again be entrusted to drag master Giorgio Mondini.

Live scoring and live streaming will be guaranteed respectively by Alexander Quinte of showmanager.eu and by the

Andrea Bonaga studio: both will be accessible via the button on the home page of www.salonedelcavallo.com.

## What is there to see?

- The Derby, which is the second-most important Special Event of the discipline after the November Futurity. Reserved for horses from 4 to 7 years, it comprises a division for professional riders (Open) and one for amateurs (Non Pro), both divided into 4 levels depending on the careerearnings of the riders. Level 4 sees the most experienced riders competing in the show ring. The event attracts many top athletes from all over Europe.
- The CRI ${ }^{* * *}$ Senior and the CRI *** Junior + Young Riders consist of a single go-round. The Senior competition will enable riders to be assessed and possibly selected for the Team Italy that will compete at the World Equestrian Games in Tryon (US) next September, while riders in the latter division are vying to qualify for the European Youth Championships to be held at the end of October during Equità Lyon.
- The NRHA Ancillary classes are valid for the prestigious NRHA World Standings that each year crown the strongest pairs of 'sliders' in the world. The Reining World Championship, promoted by the US National Reining Horse

Association, is decided on the results from official competitions held in countries across the globe. Recent years have frequently seen European, and especially Italian, riders stepping up to collect the award, thanks to the excellent prize money offered in Europe. In fact, the 2017 Non Pro World Champion is a young Italian rider from Molise, Enrico Sciulli.

# 2018 NRBC DOUBLE TIME AWARD AND HIGH POINT BUCKLE RECIPIENTS ANNOUNCED 

It pays to enter both slates of ancillary classes at the National Reining Breeders Classic. Some such entries earn cash in addition to the purse and others earn custom Gist belt buckles! High point belt buckles were awarded in a specific selection of classes, and two Double Time Awards are given: one for the highest scoring Non Pro and one for the Open.

A point system is used to calculate the winner for both awards with ten points given for first place, nine points for second place, eight for third place, and so on. High Point buckles are awarded by counting points earned for riders in both slates of designated classes. The Double Time Award is determined by counting the points earned by Open and Non Pro riders on every horse they entered in both slates of each of the ancillary classes.
