## **RUF LIL MAGNUM AND THIAGO BOECHAT WIN THE 2018 LUCAS OIL AQHA WORLD SHOW LEVEL 3 SENIOR REINING**

Held November 1 – 17, the 2018 Lucas Oil AQHA Select World Show took over the State Fair Park in Oklahoma City. Nearly 4,500 entries from the United States, Belgium, Brazil, Canada, Mexico, Switzerland and the United Kingdom competed for 99 world championships and 90 Adequan Level 2 Championships titles. Some of the most elite quarter horses in the world proved the versatility of the breed in a wide array of classes ranging from halter to pole bending; however, in the sport of reining, the American Quarter Horse equates royalty.

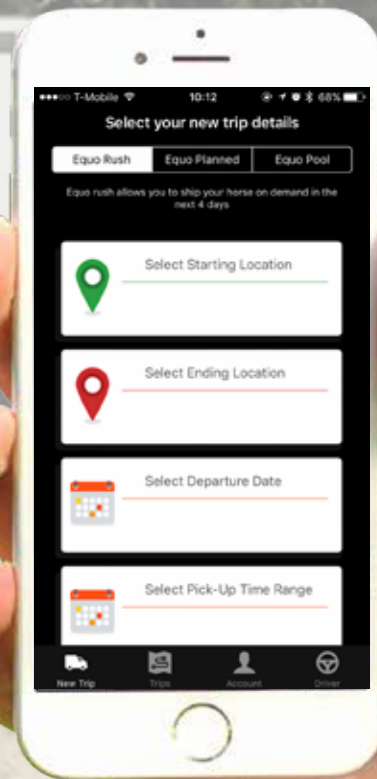
With the world show's total payouts exceeding \$2.3 million, the Level 3 Senior Reining sponsored by Silver Spurs Equine ranked 3rd based on its \$41,436 purse. While many

reining competitors don't like to be early in the draw, it certainly worked in the favor of the first and second riders in the Level 3 Senior Reining Finals. Draw 1 Martin Muehlsteatter on Wimpy Little Buddy and Draw 2 Thiago Boechat on Ruf Lil Magnum led the field with 224.5 each. There are no ties for the World Championship, so a runoff came next.

In the runoff, Boechat from Purcell, Okla., guided Silver Spurs Equine's Ruf Lil Magnum (The Rock) to a 218.5 and the Level 3 Senior Reining World Championship. The 2012 sorrel stallion is by Magnum Chic Dream out of Dunit A Lil Ruf. The Rock has enjoyed a successful career, finishing at the top of the NRHA Futurity prelims in 2015 and then in 2017, he won the Intermediate Open Championships at both

the High Roller Reining Classic and the NRHA Derby. Now this talented stallion has added an AQHA World Championship title to his accolades.

While Boechat would have liked to have won without a runoff, he said the experience was amazing and couldn't compliment his mount enough. "He's an awesome horse. I just love him to death! He is probably one of my all-time favorite horses that I've had the chance to show. He's very, very consistent He's always showed awesome for me as long as I stay out of his way. He has always done well; he has always made the finals; he has always placed well." Boechat remarked, and then added, "The cool thing was that this is the last run of his career. He's six. Now we are going to breed mares to him, and now he has a title. You know, he didn't have a title until this point, so this is a great way to finish his career and he sure deserves it."

Owned by Madalyn Roberts of San Diego, Cali., Wimpys Little Buddy piloted by Martin Muehlsteatter finished with the reserve world championship after scoring a 215.5 in the runoff. The 2004 gelded son of Wimpys Little Step is out of All Thats Dun.

## Spooksgottachicolena and Pedro Baiao Top the Level 2 Senior Reining

Hailing from Scottsdale, Ariz., Pedro Baiao rode Michael

A. Garnett's Spooksgottachicolena to the Level 2 Senior Reining World Championship with a 220.5. The bay gelding by Spooks Gotta Gun out of Braz Us also finished third in the Level 3 finals with a 221.5.

At the close of a full show schedule this year, Baiao was a little apprehensive about his last show with the 6-year-old horse. Baiao said, "That horse has been so good all year for me. I showed him a lot this year, and I was a little bit afraid about how he was going to be at the last show of the year, but he just did what he does every time. He was very, very nice."

It was a good show for Muehlstaetter Performance Horses from Scottsdale, Ariz., with Martin Muehlstaetter earning the Level 3 Reserve Championship, and Pedro Baiao – who works with Martin – earning this championship. Spooksgottachicolena is also familiar with the winner's circle having won the NRBC Intermediate Open title earlier this year.

Magnum's Guns R Reddy carried Dany Tremblay to the Level 2 Reserve World title with a 219.5. The steady sorrel mare is owned by Ruth Hamlin of Quinte West, Ontario, Canada, and is by Magnum Chic Dream out of Guns R Reddy.

## Guaranteed A Magnum and Jimmy van der Hoeven Crowned Lucas Oil AQHA Level 3 Junior Reining World Champions

Competition was fierce in the Casey Hinton Quarter Horses AQHA Junior Reining, and the scores were close; too close in fact when the Level 3 Competition ended with a tie between Jimmy van der Hoeven on Guaranteed A Magnum and Shawn Flarida on Oops Itsa Spooks who both scored a 225.5. The ensuing runoff resulted in Whitesboro, Texas, resident van der Hoeven keeping a consistent score of 225.5, and Flarida falling a few points short with a 223.5.

Van der Hoeven's mount was a 2013 bay gelding by Magnum With A Dream out of Guaranteed By Amos. Owned by Chad and Molly Cherry of Guthrie, Okla., the consistent reiner won the NRHA Derby with van der Hoeven in the saddle earlier this year with a 225.

Van der Hoeven appreciated the horse's honesty as he said, "He had a long year, you know, with a lot of runs and they were good runs. To be so honest after so many runs, I think that's a pretty good horse!"

Van der Hoeven went on to discuss his feelings about the runoff, "This is the second runoff I've had. I think it's always pretty fun. You have it out of the way, and then you

can't really work on much between there anymore. You can kind of walk him around and let him catch his air, and then you just got to do it again and hope it works one more time." Van der Hoeven's first run was draw 9 out of the 15 horses that made the finals. He won \$26,368 for the win.

Claiming the reserve world championship, Shawn Florida of Springfield, Ohio, was on the 2013 bay son of Spooks Gotta Gun out of Tejons Finally Dunit. Oops Itsa Spooks, owned by Silver Spurs Equine, and Shawn scored a 223.5 in the runoff.

## Customized My Gun and Fernando Salgado Take the Junior Reining Level 2 World Championship

Fernando Salgado has always held the AQHA World Championship show in high regards, but this year was the first time he was able to show there. He made the opportunity count when he scored a 222 on Customized My Gun owned by Oswaldo Chazaro. The 2013 mare is by Colonels Smoking Gun out of Custom Made Dunit.

Fernando expressed his appreciation of the show and the association that backs it when he said, "[This run] was pretty special for me. This was the first time I've shown here at the AQHA World Show. Since I moved from Brazil to here, for me just the name of it and the whole AQHA... I really wanted to do this. I really need to thank Mandy and Tom [McCutcheon]; it's Oswaldo, their customer that owns this mare. Everybody stayed home. I just qualified her here before the derby, and they entered her and I came by myself. It worked out great. I'm very excited because of that." Although he was solo at the show, Fernando said that everyone back at the barn was watching the live feed, call-

ing him as soon as he left the pen, and continued to support him fully.

Customized My Gun was born at McQuay Stables and shown to the NRHA Non Pro Derby Reserve Championship by Mandy McCutcheon. Chazaro bought her shortly after that and she went on to finish 2nd in the NRHA Intermediate Open Derby and in the Tulsa Reining Classic Intermediate Open Derby with Fernando in the saddle.

The reserve championship went to Baileys Sidekick and Josh Tishman of Weatherford, Texas, who scored a 219. The 2013 gelding sired by Gunners Special Nite out of A Shining Sidekick is owned by Kathy Hotz Thompson of Amarillo, Texas.

# MS DREAMY RETIRES WITH A BANG!

Eight-year-old Ms Dreamy has enjoyed a long and fruitful career having earned a wide range of titles with a variety of different riders. The gritty sorrel mare possesses a desire to win evidenced by the amount of heart and soul that she pours into each and every run. In 2013, she was the NRHA Level 2 Non Pro Futurity Reserve Champion. In 2014, she was the AQHA Amateur Reining World Champion. In 2015, she won the High Roller Reining Classic Level 3 Open Derby Reserve Championship. She continued her winning ways in 2016 with the NRBC Level 3 Non Pro Championship. This year, when most mares would have been retired to the broodmare band, Ms Dreamy has just reached the pinnacle of her career.

In 2018, with the enthusiastic approval of her owner, Rick Christen, Dan Huss took the daughter of Magnum Chic Dream and A Gal With A Gun to the World Equestrian Games (WEG) and made history with her as she became the first reining mare to earn Gold at the WEG with Team USA.

A few days later, the phenomenal mare earned Individual Silver at the same event.

Huss compared Ms Dreamy to wine. “The older she gets, the better she ges!” he said with a grin.

Ms Dreamy enjoyed a well-deserved break after her success at WEG, and with over \$172,000 in earnings, the decision was made to go for one more title before retirement: an AQHA Senior Reining World title. Plans in general, but especially in the horse industry, have a way of becoming undone, and such was the case for Dan and Ms Dreamy.

Ms Dreamy has a habit of rubbing her face on her forelimb after her spins. Dan said that he allows her this behavior because it always relaxes her. This time, the last ride of the mare’s long career, she rubbed the clasp loose that holds the headstall to the bit. The duo loped off in their first set of circles, and the bridle fell out of the mare’s mouth. The reliable mare stayed on course and kept up with her job. The audience cheered their approval and even awarded the horse and rider team a standing ovation after they aced their last stop.

Dan explained what he was thinking when it happened, “My first thought was, ‘well, I need to pull up.’” My second thought was, ‘I need to get a score,’” He continued, “I said to myself, ‘you know what? She’s being really good. She’s a really nice mare.’ So I just went ahead with the pattern. I went real aggressive to my stops, and went a little conservative in my circles. I love showing that mare. I was trying to think of a way to get a score, but before I did that, I switched hands on my bridle reins so they would have no-scored me because of that.”

The score sheets showed that the judges also loved the team’s performance which would have been a 228.5 bridle-less, but for this technicality, they rightfully stood by the rulebook. Dan is looking forward to training his 2-year-old daughter of Ms Dreamy, and watching her other offspring continue her legacy.

# AMY STONEY AND SKEETS WHIZARD CONQUER THE AQHA LEVEL 3 AMATEUR REINING FOR THE THIRD CONSECUTIVE YEAR

When the right horse is united with the right rider, it is a beautiful thing; add the right trainer into the mix, and great things will happen. Amy Stoney found her dream horse four years ago, and now for three years in a row, the duo has championed the AQHA World Show Amateur Reining, sponsored by Shortys Caboy Hattery, with the help of her trainer/farrier/mother, Connie Stoney.

A thoroughly excited Amy said, “I’ve always dreamed of winning one [world title], but to win three is just... I don’t think it has even occurred to me yet! I mean, it is still like I am living a dream!” For many, a single world title remains just beyond their grasp, so Amy is in fact enjoying a dream come true.

Owned by Connie Stoney, Skeets Whizard, lovingly known as “Wilson”, is a 2009 sorrel gelding by Skeets Peppy out of Whiz And Smoke. “[The run] felt incredible!” Amy stated, “He stopped so big, turned really good, and circled like he always does. He’s an awesome little horse!” The dynamic duo scored a 223.5, a full 4 points above their closest competitor. Next year, Amy plans to take Wilson to the NRBC, the NRHA Derby, and then back to the world show to try for a fourth Amateur title!

Dun Its Shiny Son slid into the reserve championship scoring a 219.5 with Samantha Smith at the reins. Dun Its Shiny Son, owned by Smith’s father, Lance Griffin, is a 2014 palomino gelding by Hollywood Dun It out of Shining N Sassy. Smith also won reserve in the Level 2 Amateur Reining with a 218.

## Chandler Winard on Tags Golden Star wins AQHA Level 2 Amateur Reining Championship

In her first competition after aging out of youth, Chandler Winard took the Level 2 Amateur Reining by storm scoring a 218.5 and securing the world championship title. She was riding her 2010 palomino gelding “Leroy” also known as Tags Golden Star by Whiz N Tag Chex out of Boogies Smart Star.

“I actually didn’t even know I was eligible for level 2 even though I did the paperwork, so I was just happy that I had a good run. Then they told me to go down there for awards, and I was like, ‘oh, ok!’ So I was really excited!” Winard said with a laugh, and then added, “Leroy is the best horse! He’s been the best horse for a long time so he’s really special.” Chandler and Leroy have won the 2015 NRBC Level 2 Non Pro Championship and have made the finals every time they have shown.

The AQHA World Championship show completed Chandler and Leroy’s season, but they will be hitting the show ring again next year.

The Lucas Oil World is a pinnacle event for American Quarter Horse owners and exhibitors across the globe. Competitors must reach a predetermined number of points to secure a spot in each of the classes. Competitors and their American Quarter Horses compete all year long to qualify for the honor of exhibiting their quarter horses this annual event and represent the disciplines of English, western and halter. # 2018 HIGH ROLLER REINING CLASSIC

## Riders win big at the 11th Annual High Roller Reining Classic, Las Vegas, Nevada

The High Roller Reining Classic (HRRC) wrapped up the last of Brumley Management Group's premier West Coast reining events for the season. One reporter wrote, "There is something for everyone at the High Roller Reining Classic."

The HRRC, held at the South Point Arena and Equestrian Center in Las Vegas, is unusual in that the event has multiple divisions of competition. Two slates of Ancillary divisions, a 3-Year-Old Futurity, a 4-Year-Old Futurity, a 4-Year-Old Stakes, a 4, 5, & 6-Year-Old Derby, a 7 and Up Maturity, Arabian and Half Arabian 4 and 5-Year-Old Futurities and Ancillary divisions are all packed into this incredible nine day event: a feat which is not duplicated at any Reining competition worldwide. All these add up to the tremendous added prize money offered: \$477,900 to be exact. Wait, there's even more! Management made the decision to change the event's retainage percent for the Aged Events to only 30%! This equates to 70% of the entry fees collected went back into the prize money for the 3-Year-Old Futurity, 4-Year-Old Futurity, 4-Year-Old Stakes, and 4, 5, & 6-Year-Old Derby increasing the overall payout to just under \$1,000,000.

The High Roller Reining Classic is all about maximizing everyone's positive event experience. It is always exciting to watch exhibitors enjoying themselves at this unique show as well as seeing new faces who have never been to the High Roller or any Brumley (BMG) event. Some new competitors drove from as far away as Wisconsin, Florida, and a father and his daughter flew into Vegas from Europe to compete.

The days were smooth, competition tough, extracurricular activities plentiful and the parties were just awesome. A Build Your Own Pizza station was part of the well attended Tamarack Ranch Judge's Seminar. A new event sponsor, Firestone & Robinson Distillery, offered the 'Taste of Texas Whiskey' party offering sample tastings paired with appetizers and cocktails. The last day of competition hosted the 'Celebration of Champions' offering the popular "best fresh" made to order sushi in town, provided by Zenshin, the Japanese sushi restaurant located in the hotel.

The High Roller is known for not holding back when it comes to awards. Prizes included 20 custom trophy saddles crafted by Scottsdale Western World and Bob's Custom Saddles; as well as custom Gist Silversmiths trophy buckles; Markel Insurance embroidered fleece coolers; beautiful sterling silver earrings & necklace sets from Sami's Fine Jewelry; Tamarack Ranch embroidered blankets and stall

bags; embroidered "Top Ten" Aged Event stall bags provided by SmartPak; large, beautiful trophy ribbons; quality equine products from Ultra Cruz/Santa Cruz Animal Health, SmartPak, Pards Western Shop and Equine Oasis gift certificates; and a fun "dice game of chance" provided additional cool prizes including a variety of gift cards.

*Saturday*

There were 18 custom Gist Silversmiths buckles awarded on the first of nine exciting days of competition which started with the Novice Horse Open and Non Pro classes competing in the Lucas Oil Arena and the Open Ancillary divisions showing in the Priefert Arena. Each arena saw more than 90 competitors show their horses. Mike Boyle captured the Open Novice Horse Level 2 Championship on Hollywood Voodoo, (Dunnit In Hollywood x Peppys Royal Gal), riding for owner Ken Hamilton. While Jared Leclair was Reserve Champion on Steppin Down, (Wimpys Little Step x GS Shot Gun Wedding). Jared also took the Open NH Level 1 Champion on that same horse for owner Susan Meyer. Cody Cowdell riding Melody Of The West, (West Coast Whiz x Melon Kalibaby), for Jewlene Howland and Jimmy Nichols on Peptos Lil Step, (Wimpys Little Step x Peptos Lil Melody), for Nancy Wheeler tied for the Open Novice Horse L 1 Reserve Championship.

In the Novice Horse Non Pro classes, Melinda Cresap rode Melodys Steppin Out (Wimpys Little Step x Spooks Melody) to a Level 2 Championship. Kelsey Nichols-Rhyne was Reserve Champion in that class and was Champion in the Level 1 class on Streetsoftinseltown, (Pale Face Dunnit x Lost In Tinseltown). Donna Rogers claimed the L 1 Reserve Championship riding Hellomercedes, (Cromed Out Mercedes x Hello Starshine).

Mike Boyle picked up another Champion Buckle for the day, in the NRHA Open class on Chics Dream, (Magnum Chic Dream x First Ex Flame) for owner Elizabeth M. McHugh, while Matt McAuslan was Open Reserve Champion riding Chicsdigthewestcoast (West Coast Whiz x Juanita Chis Olena) for owner Carla Spackman.

In the Intermediate Open, Gabe Garrison won the Championship on Walla Whiz Affair (Walla Walla Whiz x Memorable Affair) for Alison Bendale while Dallas Wedel was Reserve Champion riding Shinestein (Einsteins Revolution x Shiney O Lady) for owner Pat Kafeetzopulos.

The High Roller Reining Classic proudly welcomed Eleanor's Arabians to their team of terrific sponsors with the \$10,000 Added HEZA ZEE Arabian and \$10,000 added Half-Arabian Futurities. The HEZA ZEE Arabian Futurities, presented by Eleanor Hamilton Arabians, were the first Aged Events of HRRC and the Lucas Oil Arena was perfectly prepped for the action. #### *Sunday*

Sunday's exciting competition was highlighted by the popular High Roller Youth Team Tournament with many fun activities sponsored by Markel Insurance Company. The Futurity action continued with the \$40,000 Added Silver Spurs Equine 3-Year-Old Non Pro Futurity on Tuesday and the \$75,000 Added Silver Spurs Equine Open 3-year-Old Futurity on Wednesday. Tuesday morning ended with Whizkeymakesmefrisky (Whizkey N Diamonds x One Smart Pepto), or "Jackie" as owner Dana Avila calls her mare, sweeping all three levels of the Non Pro 3-year-old Aged Event with a score of 215, winning \$24,436. The great run and successful outcome were extremely special to Dana because "Jackie is home bred and raised by myself and my husband Bob, (an Equi-Stat Elite \$1 Million Rider)." Jackie's dam, One Smart Pepto (by One Time Pepto) is the beloved mare that Dana won all four levels of the 2013 Reining By The Bay Non Pro Derby and Jackie's sire is, Rhodes River Ranch's Whizkey N Diamonds. "It has been a lot of fun for us to see our hopes for Jackie come to fruition. She is a big stopper just like her mom," and "she is quirky, beautiful and has great movement." Avila plans to take her mare home for a "good rest" and then on to the NRHA Futurity in November.

Tish Fappani and Icecube (SG Frozen Enterprise x Taris Designer Genes) were the Reserve Champions of Level 4 Non Pro 3-year-Old Futurity taking home \$4,777 for her efforts. Sheley Brien rode to the Reserve Championships in Levels 2 and 3, and third in Level 4 Non Pro Futurity divisions riding Shine Your Pistol (Shine Chic Shine x Aim Your Pistol) winning \$7,042.

The \$75,000 Added Silver Spurs Equine Open 3-Year-Old Futurity was packed with talented young horses. Diane Mesmer, proved that dreams can come true when the plan she made three years ago became fruitful. Diane said that when she retired, she wanted to own reining horses. She was raised working cattle with her family so she understood the importance of genetics and what she wanted in her yearling purchases for the sport of Reining. She said that "it was di-

vine intervention, and we've been incredibly blessed to have two talented 3-year-olds this year." The one that captured the Level 4 Open 3-Year-Old Futurity Championship and \$17,054 with a score of 223.5 was her stallion, A Vintage Smoke, A Sparkling Vintage colt out of Lady Smoke Peppy (by Mister Dual Pep) ridden by NRHA Million Dollar Rider Jason Vanlandingham. Jason said that the horse was "always physically talented. He's a huge stopper, good in his turn-arounds and has a unique presence."

Craig Schmersal rode The Star Jersey (Yellow Jersey x Nicastar Lite) for owner Timothy J. Anderson earning the Level 4 Reserve Championship and \$10,381.

Tracer Gilson and Brent Naylor were Co-Champions of the Level 3 Open Futurity. Tracer rode Guns N Dreams (Tinker With Guns x Brennass Dream x Magnum Chic Dream) for Loren Booth, who owns, bred and raised him at home on the Booth Ranch in California. Tracer is proud of the horse and the Booth Ranch's breeding program saying that, "It's pretty cool to have Guns N Dreams's first show be so successful," then adding, "He sure went out there and horse showed." Their 219 earned a \$3,304 paycheck.

The Level 3 Co-Champion, Brent Naylor, also claimed the Open Level 2 Championship riding KR Retro for owners Three Forty One Group. Naylor described the Magnum Chic Dream stallion, which is out of KR Legacy (by Tejons Peppy Doc) as "a quick learner with a big heart and lots of try." Brent was pleased with the horse's performance saying, "I know there's a lot more there, but it was important, for his first show, to set a good foundation for the shows coming up at the end of the year."

Linde Von Koeding riding Midnight Whizkey Run (Whizkey N Diamonds x KR Miss Oxbow x Tejons Peppy Doc) for owner Sarah M. Dawe and Erik Caddeo on Trigger Happy a Gunnatrashya stallion (out of HA Lenas Tune x Lena spark) for Marilyn Overgaard/Wright tied for the Open Level 2 Reserve Championship. Von Koeding and Caddeo were also the Open Level 1 Co-Champions.

Linde described Midnight Whizkey Run as a gentle horse that tries hard every day. Sarah Dawe has raised her horse from day one and brought him to Linde as a 2-year-old. They say the gelding is mature for his age and "handled his first show like a veteran show horse."

Caddeo said that he has been riding Trigger Happy almost from the time he joined Equi-Stat Elite \$5 Million Dollar Rider Andrea Fappani's team. The stallion proved he's a talented competitor and Caddeo said he is "grateful for the tips and training that he has received from Andrea and Ricky," and that he was "able to have good results in the arena with this young horse to reward the two men for the time they

have spent with him." Caddeo expressed a "special thanks to Marilyn for the amazing opportunity to ride her young horse."

The \$65,000 Wild Card 4-Year-Old Futurity Presented by Tamarack Ranch added excitement and opportunity for riders to show 4-year-olds that did not compete in an NRHA-approved, Category 2 aged event as 3-year-olds. In the \$40,000 Open Futurity's Level 4 division, three riders shared the Championship honor. Justin "Gunny" Mathison rode Its All On The Line (Shine On Line x Teresas Twist x Dun It With A Twist) for owner Mary Jansma. The gelding came to Gunny as a 2-year-old and he encouraged its owner "to be patient and give the horse a chance" and it paid off. Joining Mathison was Dallas Cunningham who rode Krista Marshall's Mi Mercedes (Cromed Out Mercedes x Mi Mega x Marthas Mega Jac). Dallas noted that the horse was shown in both the Open and Non Pro classes, "the horse is, just that talented and good minded enough to be in both levels of this Futurity." Arno Honstetter joined the trio of Champions riding his own Gunshot Whizkey (Whizkey N Diamonds x Gunners Sureshot by Colonels Smoking Gun (Gunner), a horse he bought as a yearling for a client and re-purchased him as a 2-year-old. Each rider collected a \$6,160 check for marking 217s. This trio also shared the Open Level 3 Reserve Championship. Gunny and Dallas shared the Championship in the Open Level 2 as well.

The Champion of the Open Level 3 division with a 218, was Jesus (Chuy) Chavez who rode for owner Karin Di-Napoli on Spooks Got Style (Spooks Gotta Whiz x Stylish Lena). Chuy also captured the Open Level 1 Championship while Dallas was the Open Level 1 Reserve Champion. Chavez noted that he regretted not entering all divisions to be able to claim a clean sweep of all four Open divisions, but was very grateful to have had a great ride on a talented horse for a very happy owner.

Reid Fady rode Homeschooled Baby (Spooks Gotta Whiz x Smart Blonde Chic x Smart Chic Olena) to a win in all four Non Pro Levels of the Tamarack Ranch \$25,000 Non Pro 4-Year-Old Futurity. After a five year hiatus from showing, Reid entered the show and scored six points ahead of second place marking a 214 and winning \$13,027.

Fady said that his mare was "very honest" and "went in and performed the way she told me she was going to when she was in the warm up pen." Reid purchased his mare as a yearling and she was still small as a 2-year-old because she was foaled in May so Reid decided not to start her until June of her 2-year-old year.

Fady said, "I knew she was not big enough to tolerate it as a 3-year-old," and he "couldn't be more happy about that decision," noting that "this is an awesome event with very

Tami Ferguson captured the Prime Time Rookie on Nu Chex Surprise and Dana Pastorino won the Reserve Championship in the class on Jac Bee Whiz.

The National Arabian Reining Horse Association Non Pro Maturity was captured by Maria Danieli-Krueger riding VLO Friendly Fire and Cotton McNutt won the Reserve Championship on All Maxed Out RA.

The \$78,000 Added Protect The Harvest Non Pro Derby excitement exploded when Indy Roper rode into the Lucas Oil Arena on her flashy 5-year-old buckskin gelding “Raymond”, also known as Spooks Show Time (Spooks Gotta Whiz x Dolittle Lena x Shining Spark), and scored a 221.5 to capture the Derby’s Non Pro Levels 4, 3, 2, and 1 Championships winning \$39,073. Indy admitted that Raymond’s big stops were the “fun part” of the winning run. Indy plans on taking Raymond home with her to Indiana while her 4-year-old stays in training with Andrea Fappani.

The \$37,000 Added Whizkey N Diamonds Non Pro Stakes saw Gina Maria Schumacher score a 219.5 to capture the Level 4 riding All Right Magnum (Magnum Chic Dream x the Right Motion) \$9,731 and Kylie Warn on Lenas Shining Gun (Gunners Special Nite x SI Lenas Chic) won the L4 Reserve Championship and \$5,924. Kylie's score of 218.5 also gave her the Level 3 and Level 2 Championships.

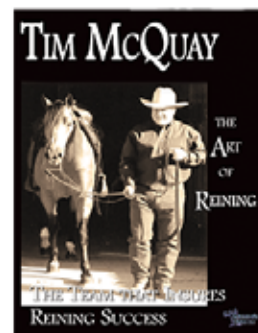
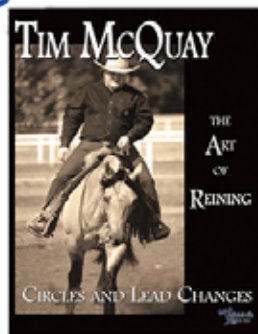
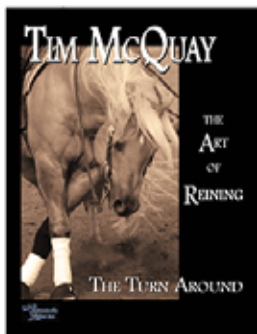

The pair marked an impressive 224 to win the top prize and a check for \$22,673 for owners, Rancho Oso Rio, LLC. Leroy, also known as If Whizswereguns (Spooks Gotta Gun x Ifwhizsweredollars x Topsail Whiz), is now three for three at the High Roller Reining Classic. His previous wins were the Open Futurity and the Open Stakes.

Fappanni noted that patience has paid off with Leroy. His original owners knew he was talented and thought that he could fit Fappanni. When Rancho Oso Rio, LLC purchased him, Andrea said that his mind didn't match his potential and he needed time to mature. The light-sided, quick-footed stallion has come into his own and "will last well beyond his derby years and will likely go into the FEI program."

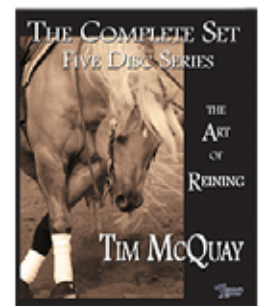

#### NUMBERS AND LOCATION

At the helm of the gigantic mechanism in Cremona is, once again, Team For You's Giancarlo Doardo (left) who has confirmed that the expected number of horses that will make their way to the event are over 700; 20% more than in 2017. Over 90 sponsors, along with the presenting sponsors MS Diamonds TX - who will offer the precious 'Open Futurity Champion's Ring' - and Santa Hill Ranch, sponsor of the Non Pro Futurity with \$50,000.



As the Futurity Facebook page attracts the attention of all European

fans who do not want to miss the ticket pre-sale, Doardo and his team are working toward an extraordinary venue; all the arenas, stalls, horse and rider services and passages between commercial and sport areas will be completely covered.

The large oval arena, renowned for being one of the most beautiful and reining friendly arenas in Europe, offers the perfect size and great ground. Four arenas will be available to the riders on top of the pre-check and warm-up pens; over three thousand cubic meters of dirt and sand will cover these. The event is developed over 110,000 square meters, half of which are covered; 6,500 square meters will host over 120 vendors.



The food mart offers seven points during the whole event; snack bars, pizzeria, restaurants and a music pub which is open from 6 p.m. onwards. In a separate pavilion, the fun and
