## THE REINING REVOLUTION

A Triple Crown worth ONE AND A HALF MILLION DOLLARS and many ANCILLARY PRIZES for sires, mares, breeders, youth, para reiners and free-style riders... An all-around project to improve the standing of world reining, emphasizing the role of breeders, rewarding the commitment of the most ethical professionals and helping more judges to gain experience in special events but above all, and this is probably the real revolution, radically changing the viewpoint on competitions for young horses. This is what Elementa Masters is all about.

The official video of the Elementa Masters project was presented yesterday at the NRHA European Futurity in Cremona, Italy: this is the greatest and most futuristic challenge that the world of reining has seen in many years. Innovation is as philosophical as it is economic and organizational. The project's creators, with no false modesty and with great moral clarity, have openly stated two basic concepts that are extremely ambitious: to launch the largest and richest reining circuit in the world and do it with a vision that focuses on the horses' welfare at all levels.



**THE LOCATION:** The venue is a detail of no small importance: the event will be hosted at the superb Elementa Centre near Rome. Following its purchase by entrepreneur Maria Cecilia Fiorucci, the facility is undergoing an in-depth restyling, also in view of its candidacy for the 2022 World Equestrian Games. At its inauguration, scheduled for 2021, Elementa will have five indoor and four outdoor arenas for athletes and visitors, a renewed Eventing course and stabling for over 800 horses. The hospitality section will boast three restaurants, a winter garden with a reptile house, a spa, a bathing lake (also accessible on horseback!), three club houses, and - in a second phase - 22 chalets with private stables and saddlery for those who want to stay at the estate with their horse for a few days.

**ALL OF THIS ON A SITE THAT "TALKS TO YOU":** The website, [www.elementamasters.com](http://www.elementamasters.com), is already up and

running, with a countdown to the moment when the regulations and final timing will be announced; in fact, the details that are currently being finalized will be made public on June 1, 2019. The platform is clear and user-friendly; furthermore, if you submit your email now, you will receive a notification each time that news updates or further services are put online. For example, one of these will enable you to see whether or not you can register your horse for the various special events on the circuit by simply entering its name and date of birth. Because, as we will see, Elementa Masters offers much but asks for something in return, the name of reining's ethical advancement.

**THREE "WHOPPING" COMPETITIONS:** The triple crown is composed of a 4-year-old Futurity, a 5/6/7-year-old Derby plus 5-year-old Stakes, a Maturity for 8-year-olds and over. The added-money: the round figure of one million dollars for the Futurity, three-hundred thousand for the Derby, one-hundred thousand for the Stakes and two-hundred thousand for the Maturity - overall, **THE HIGHEST FIGURE IN THE HISTORY OF REINING WORLDWIDE!** Any horses or riders - where the riders may also ride different horses - who possess sufficient skill, perseverance and luck to win all three trophies, will obtain the Triple Crown prize, which will pay an additional one-hundred thousand dollars each to the rider, the owner and the horse breeder. In addition, the best mare in the Open and in the Non Pro finals of all three events, will receive the Pink Ribbon Award, fifty thousand dollars in total for the Futurity and thirty thousand for both

the Derby and the Maturity.

**BUT THERE IS MORE:** In Elementa's opinion, reining must also give concrete expression to the enjoyment of life, advancement for young people and social support. The response is the highly enjoyable Free-Style event, at last boosted by a "real" jackpot (fifty thousand dollars) during the Futurity, the Euro Youth Team Trophy during the Derby and the Para Reining competition (with thirty thousand dollars added) during the Maturity.

**THE BREEDERS AWARD:** Not limited to the Futurity alone but awarded for all Elementa Masters competitions. The horses entered on the circuit will have to be enrolled in the Elementa Breeders Program (EBP), to which stallions and foals can be nominated for FREE throughout 2019 and 2020. The additional money for breeders (eighty thousand dollars on the Futurity, one-hundred thousand on the Derby and one-hundred and fifty thousand on the Maturity) will go to the top-five winners at each level, both Open and Non Pro.

**THE WATCHWORD: GROWTH:** Not only in regards to the prize-money, but also the skills. The method that Elementa has chosen to select the judges who will sit in the Masters' arena, for example, is once again completely new and aims to expand the currently-limited number of highly-expert judges. Any judges holding NRHA/FEI cards who are interested may communicate their willingness to collaborate at the Masters a few months before each event, using the relevant section on [www.elementamasters.com](http://www.elementamasters.com). All those registering will be divided into AAA judges (who have judged at least two special events in the last two years), AA (who have judged at least one special event in the last two years), and A (if they have judged none), according to a model used by the US National Cutting Horse Association. The jury for each Masters competition will be RANDOMLY DRAWN from these three lists IN THE PRESENCE OF A NOTARY. The final jury will be composed of two AAA judges, two AA judges and one A judge (in addition to the Equipment Judge and the Judges Monitor with the latter strictly of AAA ranking). In this way, judges with less experience will also have the chance to gain greater experience and advance their competence, as well as their chances of being called for further judging.

**HOWEVER...** While Elementary Masters is ready to take on this enormous financial and organizational commitment, something will be required in return, as mentioned earlier. In the words of Domenico Lomuto, Elementa's Director of Communications, the world of reining is called upon to "make an effort to change the specialty in line with a modern approach that responds more strictly to current social sensitivities, thus also improving the sport's image". Lomuto is currently negotiating with a leading TV channel

to create a "reality show" based on the circuit. "The format would have to be fun and entertaining while the substance would be serious and competent. The aim is to shift reining from the fringe area to which the non-specialist media has historically relegated the sport on the few occasions when it has deigned to cover it. This media has, in fact, always portrayed reining as a childish pastime for the eccentric elite "playing at cowboys". It is time to clearly demonstrate the technical essence of this sport, and the elements of excellence that may render it accessible and interesting to the wider public... who could potentially become tomorrow's enthusiasts. However, for this to be possible the sport must demonstrate that it is ethically correct in its treatment of the animals involved. Therefore, one of Elementa's declared and rigorously-pursued goals, and perhaps the most important, is to see the discipline move towards a more wide-spread competitive longevity of reining horses while maintaining the technical and emotional quality of the shows unchanged". Hence the choice to reward breeders of older horses with higher amounts than those awarded to younger horses; hence the decision to start with a 4-year-old Futurity and not one for 3-year-olds and, above all, the circuit's golden rule: to enroll for the 4-year-old Futurity the horse will not have participated in any competition before January of the year in progress, and in the period from January onwards it will have taken part only in events offering limited prize money - the current hypothesis is to fix this limit at five thousand dollars. This would mean that prior to the big debut during which the young horse will have to compete to the limit of its abilities, its only outings will have been for "schooling". Obviously, this condition also applies to the Elementa Masters Derby and Maturity, with the exception of horses that will be old enough to compete in these two aged-events in 2021 and that, therefore, are 3 years or older in 2019 and may have already participated in the 3-year-old Futurity (or are about to do so) and/or other shows with significant prize money. Evidently, this will be the trickiest condition given the current "mood" of reining; yet, it is an essential aspect for Maria Cecilia Fiorucci. It is, in fact, the central element of the "new air" that Elementa aims to bring to the specialty, introducing stricter regulations regarding respect for the animals in line with the changes that were introduced in other equestrian disciplines some time ago - by choice or by force.

**ALL ABOUT WELFARE:** These guidelines are also present in other rules characterizing the Elementa Masters: as far as the protection of horses is concerned, the shows will be regulated in accordance with the FEI/FISE code of conduct and anti-doping rules, which are stricter than those of the NRHA. Moreover, riders and breeders will also have to adhere to the ethical code of Elementa Masters that will govern all the activities on the circuit. The horses will undergo a veterinary pre-check before being admitted to the show pen; the warm-up arenas will be carefully monitored

by stewards (a five-members Commission directed by an AAA judge as a team leader) and by a closed-circuit television system; there will be at least three warm-up arenas for each event to ensure a less-stressful environment for horses and riders, and a set break during which it will not be possible to ride (non-riding time frame), every night from 11 pm to 6 am in the morning. September 2021 is provisionally the date scheduled for the Elementa Masters ribbon cutting with

the 4-year-old Futurity. There is, therefore, plenty of time for breeders, owners and trainers to choose and implement their strategies. The Derby + Stakes should then be held in April 2022 and the Maturity in June of the same year. # TAYLOR SHERIDAN DEBUTS THE RUN FOR A MILLION THIS AUGUST IN LAS VEGAS

In addition to the main event there will be a \$100,000 Shoot Out, open to all Reiners and horses. On top of the tremendous prize money, the top five riders in the Shoot Out Finals will be guaranteed a position in the 2020 Million Dollar Invitational at THE RUN FOR A MILLION.

Other performances include THE RUN FOR A MILLION Rookie Championships, \$50,000 Non Pro Championships

and \$50,000 Invitational Freestyle. Riders can qualify for these Championships at the National Reining Breeders Classic in Katy TX, the National Reining Horse Association Derby in Oklahoma City, OK and the Reining by the Bay in Woodside, CA. # 2019 NRCHA STALLION STAKES CHAMPIONS CROWNED



The NRCHA Stallion Stakes is the second of four NRCHA premier events, and pays out more than \$600,000 in prize money. Held March 30 - April 6, 2019 at the South Point Equestrian Center in Las Vegas, Nev., the event's success is largely due to its tie to the NRCHA Subscribed Stallion program. Subscribed stallion nominators pay a fee so 4- and 5-year-old offspring can be eligible to compete in the limited aged event portion of the show. Besides paying lucrative checks to the Stakes winners, the NRCHA also presents an incentive checks to the nominator of the Stakes

Champion's sire in each division.

In addition to the Stakes divisions, the event offers a full slate of horse show classes, and several Spectaculars, including the \$25,000 added Open Bridle Spectacular sponsored by Holy Cow Performance Horses.

It was a spectacular night for NRCHA non pro competitor and owner Eric Frietas. After capturing the Stakes Non Pro championship title aboard CR Tuff Tornado, Justin Wright

piloted his horse, Scooter Kat, to the prestigious title of Stakes Open Champion.

In an elite field of horses and riders, Wright, of Santa Maria, California, and Scooter Kat topped the Stakes Open by a mere one-half point. Scooter Kat (Kit Kat Sugar X Scooters Daisy Dukes X Dual Smart Rey) and Wright earned owner Eric Freitas \$37,150 and the prestigious NRCHA Stallion Stakes Open championship title. The pair posted a 222 in the herd work, a 221.5 in the rein work and 223.5 down the fence, for a 667 composite. The horse and rider team were also reserve champions at the 2018 NRCHA Snaffle Bit Futurity®.

### Stakes Intermediate Open Champion



Shadd Parkinson clinched the 2019 NRCHA Stallion Stakes Intermediate Open win for owner Bronwyn McCormick. The Arizona horseman piloted Metal Storm (Metallic Cat X CowStruck X Smart Little Lena) to a \$11,351 payday with the composite score of 658.5 (218 herd/218 rein/222.5 cow).

### Stakes Limited Open Champion



Trevor Carter's smoking fence run of 220.5 took him straight to the top of the NRCHA Stallion Stakes Limited Open Finals. The New Mexico horseman rode Mc Cow-Hammer (Metallic Cat X GunSmart Gay X Playgun) to a 653 composite (213 herd / 219.5 rein / 220.5 cow), capturing the Limited Open champion title and \$8,147. The 4-year-old stallion is owned by the Bogle Brothers LLC.

### Stakes Non Pro Champion



The NRCHA continues to see incredible growth in the Non Pro Limited divisions, and the Stallion Stakes is no exception. Over the past two years, not only have entries in the Non Pro Limited Stakes doubled in size, but so has the added prize money.

Eric Freitas and CR Tuff Tornado (Woody Be Tuff X CR Shes Uh Secret X Peptoboonsmal) captured the NRCHA Stallion Stakes Non Pro championship. Freitas, from Santa Maria, California, was a strong competitor throughout the 2019 NRCHA Stallion Stakes. He sealed the deal by piloting his 4-year-old gelding to 216 in the herd work, a 220.5 in the rein and a 213 in the fence work. The 649.5 composite score was accompanied with a \$7,593 paycheck.

Freitas also finished third aboard Cat Snacks (Cats Full Moon X Chic Snacks X Snackbox) with a 646.5 composite (213 herd / 220.5 rein / 213 cow).

### Stakes Intermediate & Novice Non Pro Champion



It was the incredible 222.5 fence score that sent Jesse Spence soaring to the top of the Intermediate Non Pro and Novice Non Pro Stakes Finals. Spence, of Yamhill, Oregon, rode Hes Got The Luck (Smart Luck X Peppys Little Orphan X A Little Shady Jac) to a composite score of 648 (207 herd / 218.5 rein / 222.5 cow).

In addition to being crowned the 2019 NRCHA Stallion Stakes Intermediate Non Pro and Novice Novice Non Pro champions, the pair also finished reserve champions in the Non Pro. Spence collected over \$12,000 for the combined wins.

### \$5,000 Non Pro Limited & Select Non Pro Limited Champion



Winning the \$5,000 Non Pro Limited was Sue Schmitz, of Phoenix, Arizona. She piloted Smoking Red Pepper (Smokeelan X A Red Belle Pepper X Mister Dual Pep) to a 144 in the rein work and a 146.5 in cow work, for a 290.5 composite. Sue and "Pepper" collected \$784 for the win.

### \$1,000 Non Pro Limited Champion



Alexandra Hart and Shadyrools (Shady Lil Starlight X Sheza Roo X Gallo Del Cielo) clinched the \$1,000 Non Pro Limited championship at the 2019 NRCHA Stallion Stakes.

The pair earned an impressive 142 in the rein work and a 144.5 in the cow work for a 286.5 and \$285 win check.

### Youth Bridle Spectacular & Youth Bridle Champion



Douglas J. McDaniel made his debut down the fence at the 2019 NRCHA Stallion Stakes in the Youth Bridle Spectacular.

CR Tuffs Magic Tonic (Woody Be Tuff X Miss Oak Tonic X Little Peppy Oak) and McDaniel, of Portland, Indiana, added two more premier event wins to their already impressive show record.

McDaniel rode CR Tuffs Magic Tonic to first place in the Youth Bridle Spectacular and Youth Bridle horse show class. The scores of 143 in the herd work, 144 in the rein work and 147 down the fence paid nearly \$900.

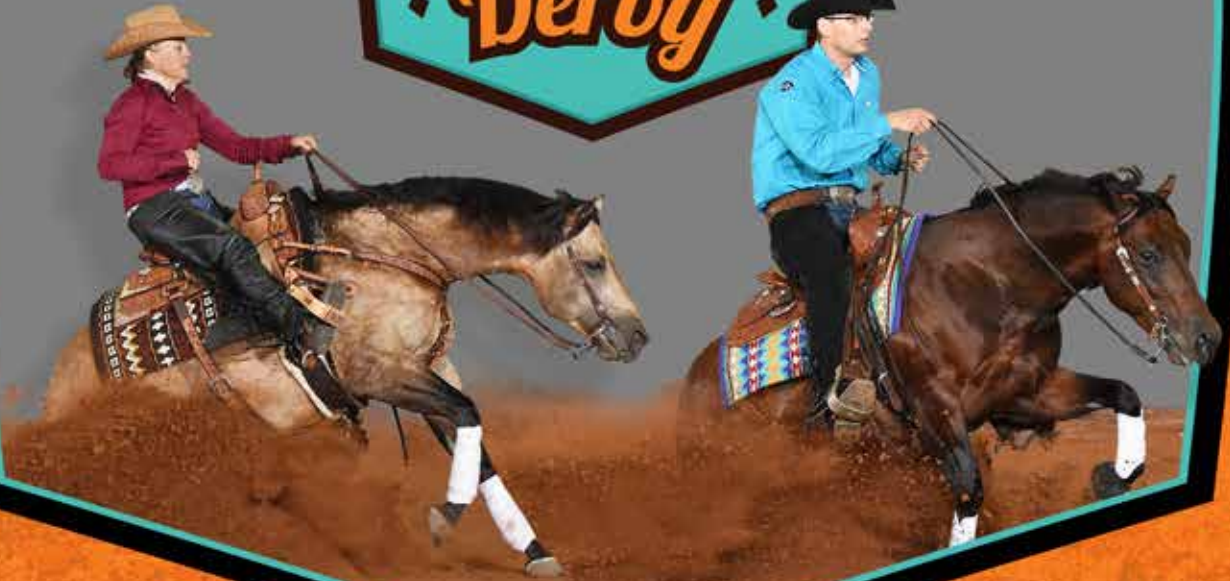

### Youth Limited Spectacular & Youth Limited 13 & Under Champion



Landri Lisac, of Pueblo, Colorado, and Soulanova (Soula Jule Star X Round Oak Annie X Smokum Oak) entered up in their first spectacular and rode away with the win.

Landri guided her sister's gelding to a 146 in the herd work, a 146 in the rein work and a 142.5 in the cow work. In addition to the Youth Limited Spectacular win, Landri and "Bucket" finished second in the Youth Limited horse show class and first place in the Youth Limited 13 & Under.

### Youth Limited Champion



Braelynn Weaver's first NRCHA premier event was a success. Weaver, of Enterprise, Utah, piloted Sheza Stylish Player (Playin Stylish X Pretty In The Pink X Peptoboons-mal) to the Stakes Youth Limited championship title. The 290 composite scored the duo a \$180 win check.

### Open Bridle & Intermediate Open Bridle Spectacular Champion



It was a salty day of competition in Las Vegas, Nevada,

at the South Point Arena and Equestrian Center. On Friday, April 5, when the National Reined Cow Horse Association Stallion Stakes Open and Non Pro Finals got underway, in the Priefert Arena, with the herd work. In the main arena, champions were determined in the spectaculars and horse show classes.

In a stacked field of 34 entries, it was Shane Steffen and Gunna Be A Smartie (Very Smart Remedy X Gunna Be Mine X Gunna Smoke), owned by McSpyder Ranch, that came out on top. Steffen, of Powell Butte, Oregon, piloted the 7-year-old mare to a 219.5 in the herd work, a 222.5 in the rein work and an incredible 224 down the fence. In addition to being crowned Open Bridle Spectacular champions, they were also crowned champions of the Intermediate Open Bridle Spectacular. The dual wins earned \$13,864 for owner Linda McMahon of McSpyder Ranch.

It was just one year ago when Steffen and Gunna Be A Smartie were crowned Open Two Rein Spectacular champions at the NRCHA Stallion Stakes.

### Non Pro Limited Spectacular & Non Pro Limited Champion



Danny Perez posted large scores in the \$5,000 added Non Pro Limited Spectacular that resulted in winning two championships and a \$5,225 paycheck.

Perez, of Westley, California, piloted Red Carpet Style (CD Lights X Stylish N Shiney X Shining Spark) to a 146 in the herd work, a 147 in the rein work and a 144.5 in the cow work. Perez was crowned the Non Pro Limited Spectacular and Non Pro Limited champion at the 2019 NRCHA Stallion Stakes.

Perez is a longtime NRCHA non pro competitor and promoter of the sport. He is also a devoted owner, and more specifically the owner of great cow horse Brother Jackson.
