2018 NRHA CONVENTION CLOSES A HISTORIC YEAR

Held February 6-9, 2019, the NRHA Convention is an annual event full of meetings to review the previous twelve months and plan the upcoming year. The venue isn't only meetings and work, however, because at the close of the week is the much anticipated Reception and Awards Banquet held at the Cox Convention Center in Oklahoma City. This suit and tie event featured a delicious catered meal and comedic entertainment by Todd Justice of Dallas, Tex. Year-End awards were also given to high-achieving horses, riders, breeders, and owners.

Turnabout Farm Makes History in 2018

Turnabout Farm will go down his history as the first owner/breeder to take home three prestigious awards: 2018 AQHA Leading NRHA Sire, 2018 Leading NRHA Dam, and the first ever award given to the Leading Breeder according to the Robin Glenn Pedigrees' report presented by AQHA.

With a long history in the Hunter/Jumper disciplines, Turnabout Farm is experiencing things anew from the reining world. Gunners Special Nite better known as "Bailey" is the first breeding stallion that Turnabout Farm owner Sarah Willeman has ever had. With offspring earnings surpassing the \$2 Million milestone midsummer this year, he is the All-Time Leading Siring son of Gunner. In 2010, the dynamic stallion made history as the only western horse ever chosen as the USEF Horse of the Year after he, with Tom McCutcheon at the reins, won both team and individual Gold at the

World Equestrian Games. With over \$235,000 LTE, and now the honor of becoming the 2018 AQHA Leading NRHA Sire, Gunners Special Nite is one of the most decorated horses in modern reining.

Willeman said, "Watching his offspring out there is such a thrill, and it's a new experience for me, because I've never owned a breeding stallion before him. To have him be the one that I get to own is just... it's incredible!" Then of what she saw in Bailey, she explained, "He was such a competitor. He always went out and tried to do his job. I come from the Jumper world, so I think there are certain qualities that transfer between disciplines and seeing a horse with that kind of talent and that kind of a mind to always be that consistent – that was something that always impressed me."

Turnabout Farm places a strong emphasis upon mare-power, and the standout broodmare band is proof of that. Turnabout Farm's Taris Modern Design was honored with the AQHA Leading NRHA Dam award at the 2019 NRHA Convention. The 2000 Palomino mare sired by Mr Boomerjac had an impressive performance record of her own having earned over \$87,000 in Lifetime Earnings and 7.5 AQHA reining points and her own dam, Taris Little Vintage, was also an NRHA Leading dam in 2013.

Sarah said, "Unfortunately we lost her a couple of years ago so it's really bittersweet to have her receive this honor. She was such a wonderful horse, and her offspring that did so well this year are just really amazing horses!"

Between a high-achieving breeding stallion, and top of the line mares, it is no wonder that Turnabout Farm also earned its place at the top of the AQHA Top Breeder's list. Through an excellent breeding program, raising quality foals, and putting them in good hands, Turnabout Farm met this success.

One thing that is really cool about this happening this year is that the vast majority of them are horses that we bred and sold" Sarah commented. "I didn't necessarily know when I was going to see them show or what they were doing and,

in a way, it is even more exciting to see all of them out there, in all these different hands making all of these people happy. For me, to suddenly see a result or see a great run or a cool picture, you know, it kind of comes out of the blue because I haven't been able to see them day in and day out to know what they are doing. So it was just really exciting to see all of these

horses that I knew as foals in the pasture go out and do so well for all of those people, and certainly all of those riders and trainers have done a beautiful job, and that has been great to see!"

Sarah thanked the whole team at Tom McCutcheon Reining Horses where her reining program is based out of. She expressed special gratitude to Tom and Mandy themselves for a mutual friendship and fantastic working relationship that remains strong through both good times as well as more challenging times.

Each year, the National Reining Horse Association (NRHA) affiliates are invited to nominate their favorite NRHA Professionals for top honors in one of the following categories: Professional Horseman of the Year, Professional Horsewoman of the Year, Non Pro Coach of the Year, Youth Coach of the Year, and Up-and-Coming Trainer of the Year. Nominees must exemplify excellence in the reining community and are chosen for their mastery and contribution to promoting the sport of reining and NRHA. Below are the winners for each category, who received their award at the 2018 NRHA Convention & Awards Banquet.

NRHA Professional Horseman of the Year – Dan Huss

Dan Huss' career in the saddle began over 30 years ago. Pursuing his passion, he double majored in science and equestrian studies at the University of Findlay, where he

stayed to teach for 20 years. It was in the early 2000s when Huss and his wife, Wendy, decided to instead pursue the training process he had developed at Findlay (breaking

down each maneuver into a few steps, allowing a client to master it, and then moving on to the next). Their first stop was Double Run Farms in North Carolina, where Huss trained Wimpys Little Step, a well-known sire in the reining industry who went on to win the 2002 NRHA Futurity. The adventure didn't stop there; Chicago, Illinois was where they then spent the next three years, developing a successful training program for Non Pro rider, Jose Vasquez.

In 2006, Dan and Wendy Huss were able to set up Even Odd Farms, their own training facility. Here, they made a name for themselves before moving to Scottsdale, Arizona for its potential to grow their business in the reining industry. Huss continues to coach top level non pros and youth riders at Huss Performance Horses while also bringing home big NRHA titles himself. His NRHA Lifetime Earnings (LTE) exceed \$550,000 with many championship titles and finalist qualifications in the NRHA Derby, NRHA Futurity, All American Quarter Horse Congress, and many more. He also helped the U.S. Reining Team bring home a gold medal in the



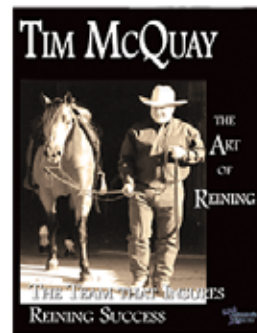
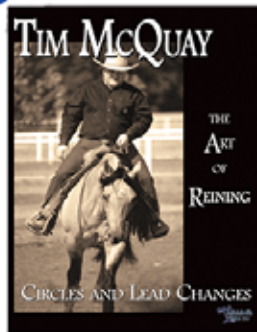
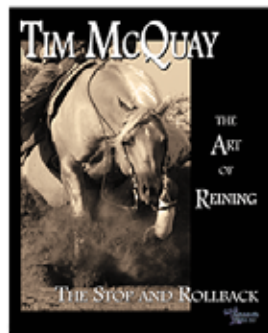
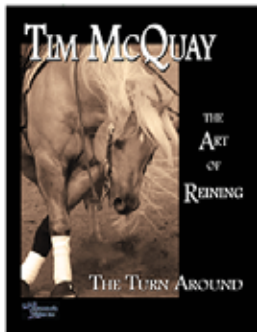

FEI World Equestrian Games (WEG) in 2018 where he also took home an individual silver medal. To top off his accomplishments, not only a reiner but also as a horseman, was his crowd-wowing, bridless run on Ms Dreamy at the AQHA World Championship Show in the Senior Reining. That moment will remain a part of reining history.

“It started with the trials for the World Equestrian Games where I started showing Ms Dreamy. She did really well there, so obviously, we made the team. Then went on to the World Equestrian Games and scored consistently high. Then we went to the Senior Reining in the World Show and on to the Futurity.” He then went on to

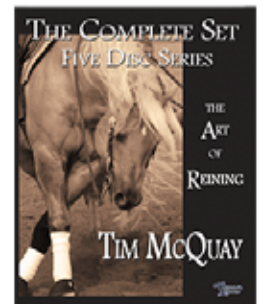
thank his wife saying, “She puts the team together. We have the normal team – like the vet and farrier, but we also have a nutritionist and an equine physical therapist that comes out. She orchestrates all of that and pushes me in the right direction and keeps me improving. She is my biggest critique. If it wasn't for her, I wouldn't be receiving this award. “

NRHA Professional Horsewoman of the Year – Abby Lengel

Abby Lengel's passion for reining was sparked by a chance lesson taken on a reining horse with Drake Johnson, a Colorado NRHA Professional. Since 2007, when her reining career got its start in youth 14-18 and rookie competitions, the Colorado native has had great success in the show arena as an assistant trainer and as a non pro coach.

"I started out the year showing in Scottsdale, Arizona at the Cactus Classic. I got to show a horse named Magnum Style. I marked my first 226 on him. So that started off the show season pretty good," Abby shared. "And then obviously, the mare Arc Gunna Mark Ya has just been a blessing to me all the way around. The owners, Jody and Jolan Puno, have been amazing and supportive letting me show their mare and trusting me with her. In 2017, we did good at the NRBC, and then this year, she just kept getting stronger and stronger. At the NRHA Derby was the highlight when we won the first go of the

Level 4 with a 226.5 and then ended up reserve over all in the Level 4. Then she won the Tulsa Reining Classic Level 4 and 3 Derby. So she was probably the biggest part this year of everything."

Lengel graduated with a degree in Equine Industry and Business at West Texas A&M University. Shortly after she started working as an assistant trainer for NRHA Million Dollar Rider Casey Deary. Between the trust Deary instilled in her early on with training high-end prospects and the passion she brings into the sport – from mucking stalls to training a horse off of the release of pressure – her talent is evident. She credits a great deal of success to the "corrective criticism" and encouragement Deary has provided since 2014. She continues to excel, placing high in the biggest NRHA competitions, all while keeping the trust of the horse as well as the horses' mental health front of mind.

NRHA Non Pro Coach of the Year – Dave Moore

With over 20 years of experience and dedication to the sport of reining, Dave Moore has been said to "exemplify what NRHA stands for." This is demonstrated through his promotion of reining from the local to national levels. Moore and his wife Kim live in Southwest Ranches, Florida where their ranch, Sheridan Oaks Stables, exists as a hub to many reining clinics and lessons.

Dave said, "Not everybody enjoys teaching, but we have this great group of athletes and this great group of people. So many of the people are really committed to learning what really goes on. So I see a lot of guys that are really talented, and they just kind of go, "go out there and ride it around," and then they stand there at the back gate and go, "well, that was ok." I think that we owe people more. What we really try to do is take these people that are really interested. If they'll commit time to us, and they'll commit to the guidance, then we owe them really good words and really positive coaching and that's what we try to do."

Moore has coached numerous youth, open, and non pro circuit champions; however, he "does not place emphasis on winning, but being the best that you and your partner can be on any given day." His nomination said, "He teaches his students to respect the sport and their partner." His talents extend past teaching the skills needed to be a good horseman and successfully show in reining. The passion Moore holds for horses and reining show every time he is with a student as "he has no clue what a one-hour lesson is." The time spent with his students always exceeds the allotted time; he even makes himself available on his days off from work. He "is very selfless and is always encouraging all exhibitors, not just the members in his barn, to be the best they can be." During his involvement within NRHA, Moore has had much success in the show ring as an exhibitor, a judge, and most importantly, a coach.

NRHA Youth Coach of the Year – Dean Latimer

Dean Latimer of Marietta, Oklahoma first showed with NRHA in 1985. With over 30 years dedicated to the sport as an exhibitor, judge, and trainer, Latimer's knowledge of NRHA Rules and Regulations accentuates his credibility in teaching youth reiners. As an "excellent, patient mentor," the lessons taught in the arena by Latimer carry through to other parts of life for many. His ability to never miss a step on top of his "articulate and detailed" explanations cause him to be an impeccable coach. He is known to talk his students through each maneuver of the pattern they are about to run, provide encouragement before go-time, and end with "now go have some fun."

Dean said, "I have several youth kids that have worked with me over the years. We've been real fortunate to have wonderful horses and wonderful parents, and we just

go do what we do, and here we are."

Latimer not only excels in coaching, but also in being a skilled rider in the show pen. Boasting an NRHA LTE in excess of \$160,000, he has worked for both Loomis Ranch and Arcese Quarter Horses as well as shown in the NRHA Futurity, NRHA Derby, and many more elite shows. Latimer has also had individual success at the All American Quarter Horse Congress and has had many students achieve accolades in prestigious events as well—an exhibition of his premier coaching abilities! His passion for the sport doesn't stop there. He raises, trains, and sells his own horses, sits on the NRHA Judges Committee, assists with the NRHA Judges School, and has been a large advocate in NRHA's Respect the Horse. Respect the Sport. campaign.

NRHA Up-and-Coming Trainer of the Year – Trent Harvey

Trent Harvey became a member of NRHA in 2013 and has had much success within the industry as both a trainer and rider. Spending a combined five years working as an assistant trainer to NRHA Million Dollar Riders Casey Deary and Jordan Larson, he has learned from some of the best in the industry. Not only does his training combine the finest techniques from Deary and Larson, but his family's longstanding roots in the sport ignite a separate passion altogether. Dale Harvey, Trent's father, was an NRHA Member for over 20 years, and remains a big inspiration to the reining community as a whole, even after his passing in 2017. "Following the death of his father, [Trent] has easily stepped into his shoes."

"I've never quit being a student of the sport and never will. There have been a lot of influential people in my life along

the way, too many to even count. I owe them all a big thank you." Trent said, "Going forward, my goal for myself is to strive to be the best individual I can be for this industry, and to pass along the knowledge I've gained to others."

Beyond helping future generations of reiners in Marietta, Oklahoma, Harvey continues to make big marks in the show pen. He has won many awards and titles at NRHA events such as the NRHA Derby and NRHA Futurity with over \$100,000 in NRHA LTE. There is no doubt that he is qualified to earn the Up-and-Coming Trainer of the Year title as "a knowledgeable horseman and all-around good guy."

NRHA WORLD CHAMPIONS ANNOUNCED AT 2018 CONVENTION

Bernard Fonck and Missedouttinseltown Crowned NRHA Open World Champions

The 2018 NRHA World Champions were recognized during the festivities at the NRHA Convention. Taking the highest laurel as the Open Level 4 World Champion was Belgium rider Bernard Fonck on Missedouttinseltown owned by Golden Paint Ranch of Putte, Belgium. Missed-outtinseltown is a 5-year-old gelding by Hollywoodstinseltown out of Miss Sliding Peppy.

Among their successes of the year were making the finals at the Italian Derby, winning the reserve championship at

the Open Lawson Trophy, and taking the Co-Championship of the CS Classic. Bernard wasn't able to attend the Convention to comment on the award.

Morey Fisk on Chicks Smokingun earned the Open Reserve World Championship. Chicks Smokingun is by Colonels Smoking Gun out of Dun It By Chick and is owned by Sabine Schmid.

Little Spooks Wicked Carries Paolo Fabbri to the Intermediate Open World Championship Title

Italian Paolo Fabbri rode Little Spooks Wicked to the Intermediate Open World Championship. The 8-year-old son of Spooks Got A Gun and Topsail Little Missy is owned by Biagio Di Marzio who purchased the horse for the sole purpose of helping Fabbri win this title.

Translated Fabbri said, "Little Spook Wicked has a big heart! I am very proud of him. He has made my childhood dream come true!" The duo won Reserve at the Rome Shoot-In, they were Champions at the Verona Fiera Cavalli and won reserve in the Intermediate Open at the NRHA

European Derby.

Great King Jack (Great King Pine x Great Red Jackie) with owner Bill Thomas, Jr. of Saginaw, Michigan in the saddle slid into the reserve spot.

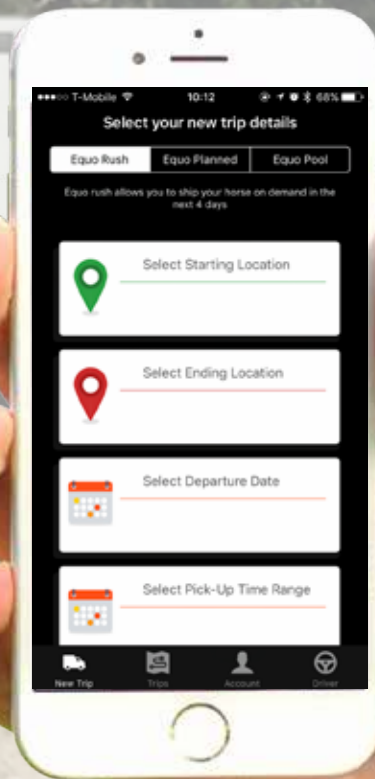
Roebuck said, "I found [Gunners Lil Shooter] for a client of mine. This

Something big is going to happen. It always does.' Then right away, the next year, this horse falls in my lap and we win a world title!"

The gritty little mare beat lots of boys in 2018 winning two NRHA World Championships with Mark in the saddle: the Novice Horse Open Level 1 and Level 2. These were the first World Titles won by the horse, the owners, and the rider!

A man of few words, Mark simply said, "We showed all year, and she's a very nice mare. She got better and better as we went along and we won a lot!" The 7-year-old mare is by Colonels Smoking Gun out of Taris Little Whiz.

Courtney was enthusiastic about the accomplishments as she said, "Mark was able to pull it all together and turn six

strong and healthy.” Dan remarked, “It’s kind of neat because I showed her father and won a world title on him in 2012. So to win that title and then to win another title on a daughter is pretty exciting for us!” Her sire is Wimpys Tinseltown and she is out of A Prize Package.

Dan plans to show Coconut in some of the 2019 derbies while he shares her with his grandson who will show her in youth classes.

Debi Murnan of Grass Valley, Cali. rode Jacs Red Pine to the Reserve Prime Time Championship. The 10-year-old mare is by Jacs Electric Spark out of Shes Flamin Hot.

That was really amazing for me." Describing himself, he said, "I was really a rookie to be riding that kind of horse."

Andrea earned over \$60,000 for his feat, skyrocketing him to twelfth in the 2018 NRHA Top 20 Non Pro rankings!

Southwest Reining Horse Association (SWRHA) is participating in the campaign during its SWRHA Futurity Show, October 22-27, in Ardmore, Oklahoma.

Fundraising is expected to continue at the 2019 AzRHA shows, including the AzRHA Mother’s Day Slide, May 14-

19; AzRHA Inside Slide, August 13-18; and AzRHA Best of the West/Southwest Affiliate Regional Championships; October 1-6. All shows will be held at WestWorld in Scottsdale, Arizona.

“We are thrilled to have these prominent shows represented through the show entry campaign,” said Tim Anderson, RHF vice president “This represents significant new funding. He was even friends with my father before me. He jumped in as a sponsor in the beginning when we really needed him, and has stayed with us all of these years." The decision is based in large part on increasing the window between the Congress and the AQHA World Show. In the past, these shows have been back-to-back with very few days in between to recover and prepare for the Open/Amateur AQHA World Show. In 2018, there were three days in between the shows. The new date implementation will take effect in 2020 in hopes that exhibitors and attendees will have time to plan accordingly.

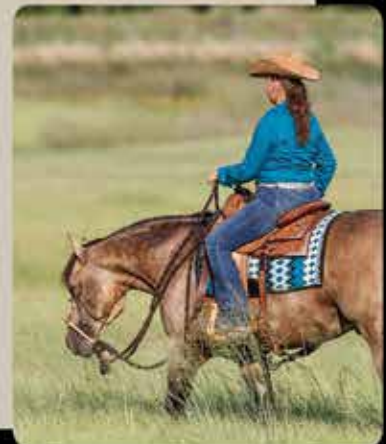
