## Team Germany Cruises to Victory!

In the first set of riders, Team Germany had already set the bar with Markus Suechting riding Spotlight Charly to a 218.5. Once the second rider for the team, Elias Ernst, had closed his performance aboard USS N Dun It with a 215.5, Germany was leading 10 points ahead of Team Italy. "It's never over 'til it's over" they say but, in this case, Team Germany held on to the lead until the very end!

"This is the first year that we had to actually make a choice and leave great horses and riders at home because so many tried to qualify; the result is that we have six High-

class horses and riders vying for the Team and Individual medals in the Senior, Junior and Young Riders and today the result sealed the deal," said Nico Hoermann, Team Germany's historical coach. The Team proved him right and once again young Gina Schumacher, past FEI Young Rider World Team and Individual Champion, proved her worth as she rode her mother's [Corinna Schumacher] Shine N Whiz to the highest score of the competition: a 220.5. "I really don't know this horse very much at all, since my mother has always ridden him, but we all are aware of the fact that he is the sweetest ever and does everything, and more, of what

you ask him to do," she said. "He was great and I am super proud of him and this team gold." Just as proud was Corinna: "I had no doubt that the two could make it: I love them both so I could not be any happier," she said.

The second highest score that counted toward making Team Germany ride to the highest step of the podium was the 220 posted by veteran Grischa Ludwig riding Coeurs Little Tyke. "I cannot say enough about this stallion," he said. "Riding for the team always makes me nervous and today he was there for me all the way. I look forward to the individual competition but, however it goes, what happened today means a lot to me." The fourth components of the German team were Elias Ernst and USS N Dun It.

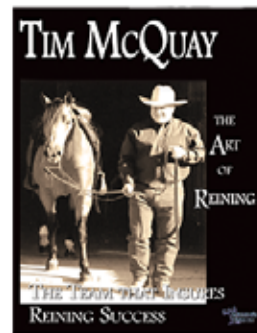
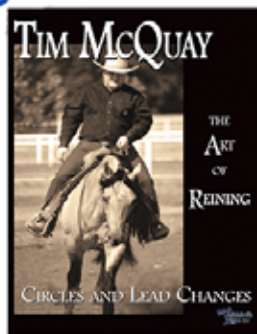
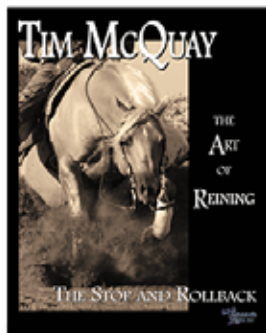
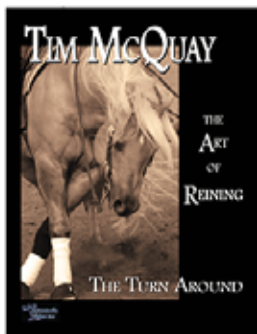
Claiming the Silver medal with 646 points was Team Italy: the three scores counting were RS Nebbiolo Blu and Luca Dossetto's 216.5, The Cocked Gun and Lorenzo De Simone's 215 and Custom Genetic and Davide Brighenti's 214.5. Enrico Sciulli's 214 posted on Snips Gotta Bud was

dropped but, of course he was just as happy for his team. "Anchor rider, Davide [Brighenti] and Enrico [Sciulli] both are experienced riders in FEI competition," said Team Coach Marco Manzi. "I am very proud of the whole team as both De Simone and Dossetto are new to the game. It's a great result and we now look forward to seeing our four riders come back to compete for the Individual medals on Saturday."

On home turf, Team Switzerland slid to the Bronze medal with a final composite score of 640.5. Adrienne Speidel and Arc Walla Smart marked a 218; Sabine Schmid and Gotta Make It Baby closed with a 213 and Annika Riggenbach riding Great Little Gunner, who performed to a 209.5 made it happen. The dropped score was posted by Daniel Schmutz and SLJ Smart Doc (207). "Our team was simply great," said Team Coach Sara Moonen. "This is a wonderful result for our country, thanks to the hard work and great team we had."

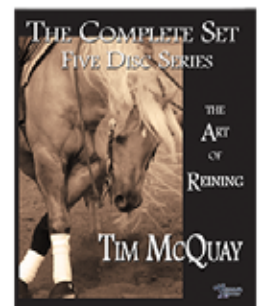

# SVAG FEI EUROPEAN REINING CHAMPIONSHIPS FOR SENIORS



## Ludwig brings home another Gold medal for Germany as Switzerland doubles their Silver and Italy claims the Bronze

Keeping the public glued to their seats until the very end, Grischa Ludwig of Germany laid down an outstanding run riding Coeurs Little Tyke to a 225.5 which slid him straight to the highest step of the podium after Adrienne Speidel of Switzerland and her Arc Walla Smart had set the bar leaving the pen with a 221.5 to beat. Once the curtain fell on the CS Ranch arena, the lady reiner firmly clinched the Silver medal a half-point in front of Italy's Lorenzo De Simone who settled for the Bronze atop The Cocked Gun.

Grischa Ludwig and Coeurs Little Tyke had scored a 220 securing Team Germany's Gold medal. In the Individual Competition, the duo closed their run with a final score of 225.5 which secured them the individual gold medal in the SVAG FEI European Reining Championship. "I asked and he tried as hard as he could," said Grischa about the 9-year-old stallion owned by Georg Hozwarth. "He is a small horse who was there for me all the way in this big arena. We started our pattern really well, his spins were great and his 'trademark' maneuver - the circles - was truly special. I could not be any prouder of him and our nation's double gold."

Adrienne Speidel and her 7-year-old mare ARC Walla Smart had performed to a 218 in the Team Competition pushing Team Switzerland to the third step of the podium. In the individual competition, they raised their score to a 221, enough to earn them the silver medal. "I still cannot believe this," said an enthused and teary-eyed Adrienne following the awards presentation. "Bringing home these medals is a dream come true and I cannot thank my mare and my team enough for this great result."

Early in the draw, Italian Lorenzo De Simone and The Cocked Gun, a 14-year-old stallion owned by Gildo and Giuliano Mercuri, burst into the arena performing a great stop and back required by pattern #10. The pair continued their great performance paid back by the judges with a 220.5, score which earned them the Bronze medal. It was a magnificent way to close the stallion's career as this was the talented sorrel's last show arena and his life now will be between the pasture and the breeding barn. "I could not be any happier and am thrilled and honored to have closed his career this way," said an emotional Lorenzo.

# 2019 SVAG FEI WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS FOR YOUNG RIDERS



## As Team Germany flies to the Gold medal, it takes a tiebreaker to determine the Team Silver for France and the Bronze for USA

An amazingly high level of competition, incredibly talented young riders guiding athletic reining horses kept everybody glued to their seats; literally from the beginning until the end of the World Reining Championships for Young Riders.

Team USA posted a total composite score of 646 thanks to a great performance offered by Taylor Zimmerman and Wimpys Dolled Up, first to go for the United States. The duo nailed each and every maneuver required by pattern #5 closing their run with a great 220.5 score. “I knew riding in the warm up pen, and as soon as I walked in the show arena, that my mare was going to be good,” said Taylor. “She likes the big circles, has a lot of place to run in this big arena and I am on cloud nine, especially being here running for my team. Adding to Zimmerman’s great score was past FEI World Equestrian Games Team Gold medalist Cade McCutcheon’s 218 riding Smart Little Dunit and Dani Latimer’s 207.5 score atop Could You Be Loved, a horse she loaned from Italian Letizia Tosetti.

When the picture seemed to depict Team USA on the highest step of the podium, Axel Pesek and Uncle Sparky, the 2017 SVAG FEI World Championship Junior Individual gold medalists, came back with yet another outstanding performance paid back by the judges with a 220 which brought the composite score to a...646, thus tying with the

American team. Before Pesek, team mate Margaux Legrand and Wound Up Whiz had closed their run with a 214.5 and third team member, Estelle Sole guiding RS Bloody Mary Spat had performed to a 211.5. “My horse was absolutely fantastic,” said Axel who also represented his country with his mount at the past FEI World Equestrian Games in Tryon. But it wasn’t over yet and little did we know that the tiebreaker would have to be used for reserve and third place honors!

In the last set of riders, Team Germany had anchor rider Michelle Maibaum and her Star Sailor Whiz ready to turn the cards on the table. The pair entered the show arena determined to give their best, and so they did. “Nobody told what score I had to post to beat the leading composite score and, although the pressure was on big time, I concentrated on my run,” she said at the end of her go. “On top of it all, since I’ve only had my horse for three months, I don’t know him very well, but he was really good for me and I am super happy that I made my team win the gold.” The total score for Germany, after Michelle and her mount scored a 217.5, went up to a 646.5 and the Gold was all theirs thanks to the performances of Germany’s Johannes Heil and Whizper Lil Gump BB (218), Franziska Engel riding her KD Whizoffthefuture (211). Unfortunately Merrit Neben and Tin Whizin posted a zero. “Once again I can only say that I am extremely proud of my young riders,” said Team Coach

Nico Hoermann who collected yet another medal in the prestigious SVAG FEI World and European Reining Cham-

pionships held in Givrins.

# 2019 SVAG FEI WORLD REINING CHAMPIONSHIP FOR JUNIORS



## Team USA: The Reining Queens take the Gold! Team Germany captures the silver; Switzerland wears the bronze

Sixteen National Federations were represented by 34 riders and six teams (France, Germany, Italy, Spain, Switzerland, USA) at the CS Ranch where the battle for the medals in the SVAG FEI World Reining Championship for Juniors was on!

Draw three in a field of 34, Sarah Armenta made her way in the pen aboard Julia Kraetschmar's Gun Smoke Dennis, a 14-year-old stallion. The first to ride for Team USA, young Sarah gave it all she had and so did 'Dennis' – once the duo walked out of the arena, a 217.5 appeared on the score board along with a huge smile on Sarah's face. "I don't know what to say! It felt awesome, especially since it's my first time really showing him," she said. "Because he wasn't being shown any more, the owners – who are really good friends of ours – had decided to turn him out in the pasture. When they found out that we were looking for a horse for me to try to qualify for the team, they offered him to me. I tried him out at the Red Bud, decided to try to qualify, got picked and...here we are!"

It was yet another Team USA duo that came in to perform

in the third set: Mattie Gustin riding her Guns R Spooky. The 16-year-old has owned the 9-year-old gelding for four years and this is her first FEI team experience and she loved it...just as she loved her 217 score after a wonderful clean run. "My horse has made my whole career and I simply love him...he's my best friend," she said, fresh off her ride. At this point of the competition, with two more horse-rider-combinations left to go, USA was firmly leading with a 434.5 composite score followed by Germany with a 425. Raeanna Thayn and Coded N Karma kept up the reigning trend for Team USA by performing to a 216.5 and bringing the composite to a winning 651. The pressure was off for the U.S. team's Emma Lane who rode her father's Gunner Gump to a 211 and 'stuck the plans' as team coach Jeff Petska said. "This is a great group of young riders and I am extremely proud to be here with them," added Petska.

After wearing the Gold medal in the European Senior Championship, Team Germany took the Silver medal with a 641 composite thanks to Lenya Lamberg and SH Topsail Badger (214.5); Celine Beisel and Gunner Be Good (214.5); Georgia Wilk and A Lunar Revolution (212) and Leann

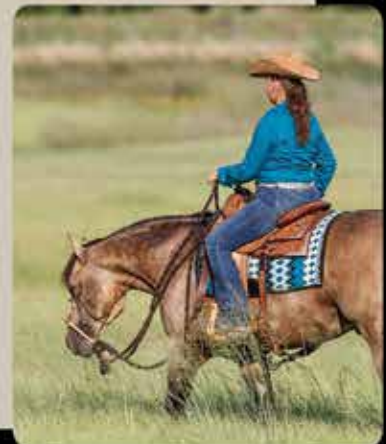

Stein and Litn Up Conquistador (210.5). “I am very proud of my junior riders,” said Team Coach Nico Hoermann. “It’s pretty hard for these young reiners to go to the championships, but this group is really outstanding. My congratulations go to Team USA and, of course, to my riders...they did a great job.”

The very first Junior Team for Switzerland was made up of Flurin Staub and Don With Chrome (210.5), Nanna Staub and Chant For Chics (207.5), Sophia Staub and Gunslinger Lil Step (204.5) and Justin Haeberlin with

Wimpys Cody Step (185). With a total composite of 622.5, the ‘young’ team wore the FEI bronze medals around their neck. “I was very confident our team could make it to the podium,” said Team Coach Terry Schultz. “They are all extremely hard-working, very talented, and I am so proud of them!”

Yet another SVAG FEI World Reining Championship for Juniors is in the books and ... what great emotions we all lived at the wonderful CS Ranch!

### USA Sweeps the Podium in the Individual Competition for Juniors

The SVAG FEI World Championship ‘Queen Team’ from the U.S. not only took the Gold in the World Reining Junior Team Competition, they went on to conquer the three steps of the podium in the Individual Competition which counted 20 finalists.

Raeanna Thayn rode her own Coded N Karma, an 8-year-old gelding, to the Gold medal with a 218 score. “Once again he was super cool today, and I am thrilled for this

second medal,” said Raeanna. Sarah Armenta rode Julia Kraetschmar’s 14-year-old stallion, Gun Smoke Dennis, to the Silver with a 217.5 and Emma Lane guided her Gunner Gump, an 11-year-old gelding, to the Bronze, a half-point behind. “I could not be any prouder of our teams,” said Team Coach, Jeff Petska. “Every time I have the honor to follow a team, my family gets bigger!” Just off the podium, with a 215.5 score, was Andreu Nogué Puig riding Joaquin Font’s Topsail Tinseltown.

### SVAG FEI World Reining Championship Individual Young Riders Competition Cade McCutcheon and Smart Little Dunitt soar to the Individual Gold; It’s Silver for the Netherlands and Bronze for Belgium

When American Cade McCutcheon burst in the CS Ranch Arena to run pattern #10 aboard Smart Little Dunitt, it was clear to all that he had one goal in mind: the Individual Young Riders Gold medal. With the athletic 7-year-old stallion owned by Turnabout Farm Inc. between the reins, Cade

gave a wonderful demonstration of great reining which rode him to a 227.5 and the Individual Young Riders Gold medal.

“My horse felt really good in the team competition as he did today in the warmup pen and in the show arena. I am

For the Netherlands Yessie Van Der Zwan fired the crowd as she rode Suzanne Scharroo’s 10-year-old gelding, Walla Whiz N Tari BB, to an amazing 222 score which firmly secured them the Silver medal. “He’s an amazing horse and he gave me everything he had today,” said Yessie, who was also part of Team Netherlands. “I’ve been riding him for less than a year and I love everything about him.”

Riding What A Wave owned by Gina De Pauw, an 11-year-old stallion that boasts, amongst other feats the 2018 World Equestrian Games Individual Gold medal, young Nimroid Vannietvelt rode to a great 221 score which

earned him the Individual Bronze.

# REINING HORSE FOUNDATION EXPANDS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Reining Horse Foundation (RHF) is announcing an increase in its academic and need-based scholarship program for 2019. The nonprofit charitable arm of NRHA is presenting eight awards—up from seven—and increasing the three top awards from \$2,000 to \$2,500 each. The recipients are: Amber Edmonds of Pepperell, Massachusetts; David Gringeri of West Haven, Vermont; Cassandra Townsend of Andover, South Dakota; Natalie Glydesem of North Loup, Nebraska; Madyson Buchanan of Scottsdale, Arizona; Morgan Knerr of Plain City, Ohio; Liz Blaser of Duncan, Nebraska; and Megan D'Andrea of Fowler, Ohio.

Members of the National Reining Horse Youth Association (NRHyA) submitted applications for the RHF scholarships. The recipients were chosen by an independent committee based upon their academic achievement, finan-

cial need, future goals and involvement in NRHyA and the reining horse industry. NRHyA members must first apply as high school seniors, and once selected, they are eligible to reapply.

“I have been associated with the Foundation’s scholarship program since its inception, and this is our first major expansion in these awards since 2010,” said RHF scholarship committee chairman Mike Hancock. “We know that college costs have increased dramatically, and we are working hard to make a greater impact for those who have spent their youth involved with reining.”

In addition to the expansion in the program, the \$750 award earned by D'Andrea is being designated as the John McQuay Memorial Scholarship. This represents a change in

this fund to support the academic- and need-based program.

Edmonds, Gringeri, and Townsend were each awarded \$2,500 in RHF scholarship monies. Edmonds is in the Merrimack College Honors Program, majoring in elementary education and human development with a minor in business administration. She intends to become an elementary school principal. She received RHF scholarships in 2016 and 2018.

Gringeri attends the University of Vermont. In high school, he had dual enrollment at the Community College of Vermont. He is majoring in business/finance with the goal of a career in agribusiness. He has been named to the Dean's List throughout his college career and is a member of student government. He received RHF scholarships in 2017 and 2018.

Townsend intends to major in human biology in the pre-medicine pathway at South Dakota State University with the goal of becoming a doctor. Farm-raised, she has been involved in 4-H and FFA and the South Dakota Quarter Horse Association. She has been active in her school and performed many hours of community service.

Gydesen and Buchanan each will receive \$1,500 in scholarships. Gydesen plans to major in animal science. A high school honors student, she has been active in FFA and is a four-time 4-H State Horse Show champion and 7-time reserve champion with plans to ride on a collegiate equestrian team.

Buchanan plans to major in business/marketing with the goal of becoming a business owner. She has been captain of her Interscholastic Equestrian Association team and president of the Arizona Youth Reining Horse Association. She has served as a volunteer leader for the PACE Foundation, the national nonprofit patient organization dedicated to improving the diagnosis, treatment, and quality of life of persons with Pediatric Autoimmune Neurological Disorders

through advocacy, education, and research.

Knerr is the recipient of the new \$1,000 RHF scholarship. She attends the University of Findlay with plans to become a pediatric pharmacist. She held multiple positions as an NRHyA officer, including president in 2017, vice president in 2016 and secretary in 2015 and received RHF scholarships in 2017 and 2018.

Earning \$750 scholarships each are Blaser and D'Andrea. Blaser is the current NRHyA president and was vice president in 2018 and treasurer in 2017. While in high school, she has been enrolled in dual credit courses at Central Community College and Nebraska Wesleyan University. She will attend Wayne State College in Wayne, Neb., with the goal of becoming a physician and returning to a rural community to practice.

D'Andrea is pursuing her Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree at Youngstown State University. She was active in the NRHyA Varsity Reining Club and also is a three-time NRHyA Youth of the Year for her affiliate. She received RHF scholarships in 2016 and 2017.

The Youth World Championship Judging Contest sponsored by APHA and ApHC took place June 29 and saw a 44% increase in total number of contestants over last year. - Northeast (Maine, New Hampshire, Vermont, New York, Massachusetts, Rhode Island, Connecticut, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Delaware, Maryland, and District of Columbia)

- Northwest (California\*, Idaho\*, Oregon, Washington)
- East Central (Michigan, Illinois, Indiana, Ohio, Kentucky, West Virginia, and Tennessee)

*\*If a member lives in this state and designates an affiliate for Affiliate Regional Championships qualifying in that region, the member will be given voting privileges for that region. If the member lives in this state and does not designate an affiliate, voting privileges will be given as follows: California – Northwest region, Idaho - Northwest region, and Nevada – Southwest region.*

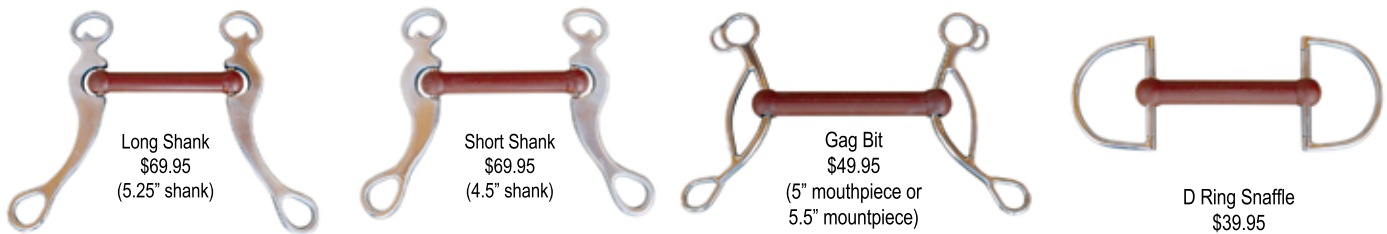
