Jason Vanlandingham and Nathan Piper are L4 Co-Champions



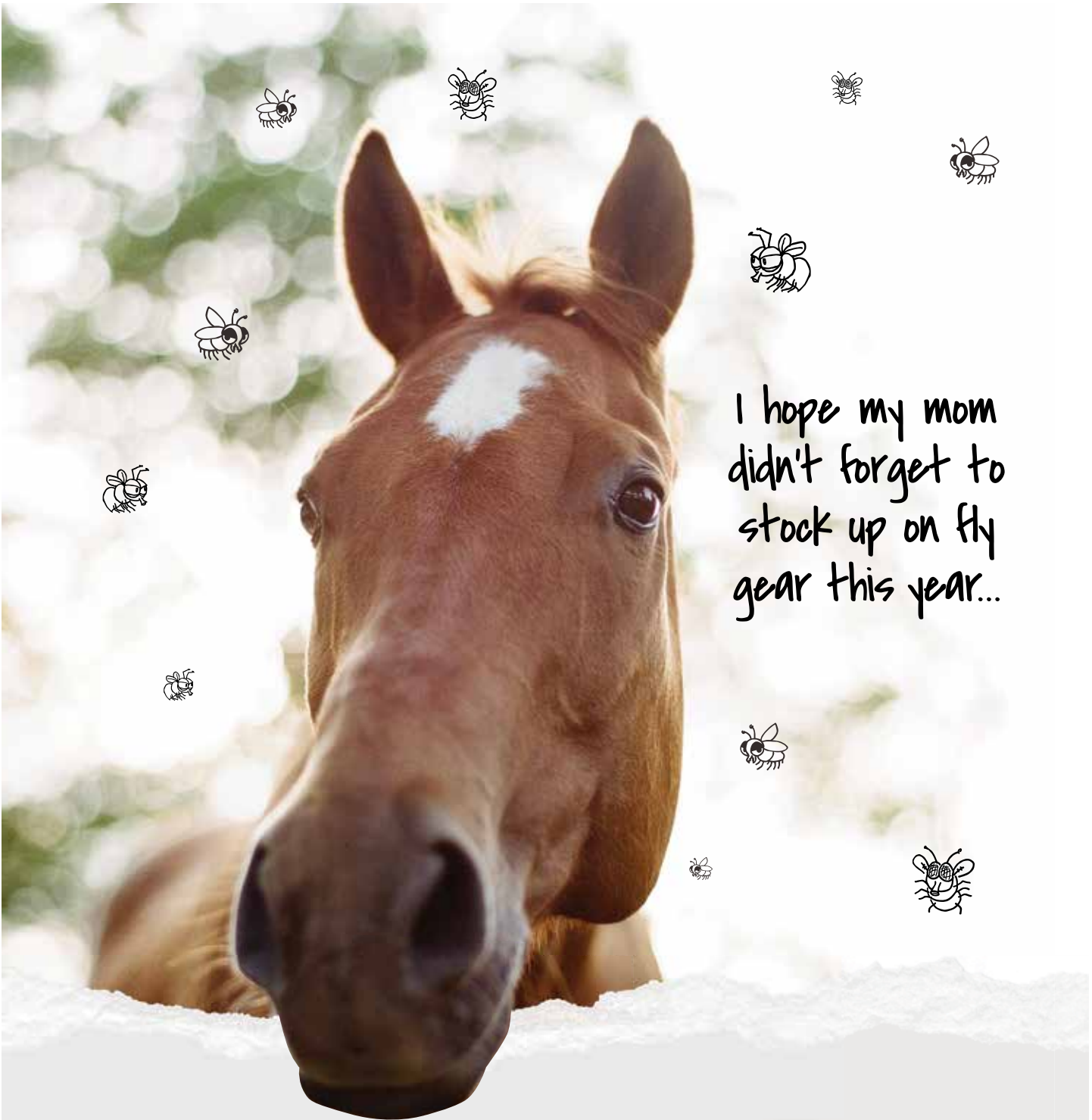

When the curtain fell on the National Reining Breeders Classic Open Finals Saturday night, two outstanding horse and rider team stood as Co-Champions. It started with draw 25 - Jason Vanlandingham and the 4-year-old reigning National Reining Horse Association Futurity Champion A Vintage Smoke. The talented duo marked a 227.5, which spectators knew would be tough to beat as only 11 horses were left to compete. Then Nathan Piper and Patriot, another 4-year-old, rode into the Coliseum Arena. As the run progressed, it was clear the score would be a big one, and when another 227.5 was announced, the chatter started. What would they do?

When the final horse had left the arena, the announcer broke the news that, for the first time in the NRBC's history, there would be Open Level 4 Co-Champions, with each taking home \$63,000. Prizes include a year's use of a custom trailer from Twin Cities Trailer Sales/Twin Cities South, a saddle sponsored by Kyle Tack, an SPH saddle pad, boots from Anderson Bean, a custom vest from Palmer Performance Horses and Glycoguard Paste, product from Santa Cruz Biotechnology and Back On Track, and prizes from NRBC.

Nathan Piper & Patriot



Nathan Piper is an NRBC veteran, but the Open Championship has proved elusive. Patriot proved to be a game changer. “I think I’m still in shock. Before I ran in, I felt pretty good about it. This horse is such a saint and is so good. He comes out every day and does his job,” he said.

“He gives me a lot of confidence because he’s pretty predictable and he was getting better with every ride.”

Pattern 10 provides a great opportunity to make a good first impression with the run-in to a sliding stop. “When I ran in I felt him drop his neck, and I knew he was in a good spot mentally. He gave me it all,” Piper said.

Piper trains out of Toyon Ranch, who bred and raised the young stallion by Smart Spook out of Dunit Lil Ruf. “They bought an embryo from Ann Salmon, and decided to sell him before the futurity. I didn’t want to lose him so I called Shannon and Hershel Reid and they agreed to buy him. It was a blessing; a gift from God, because I knew he would go quick,” Piper said.

The young ages of Patriot and A Vintage Smoke made the decision to stay Co-Champions an easy one. “They have had such a hard two weeks that I think its good just to count your blessings,” Piper said.

Jason Vanlandingham & A Vintage Smoke



When Jason Vanlandingham and A Vintage Smoke won the NRHA Futurity Championship, owner Diane Mesmer was already eyeing a Triple Crown win. “The NRBC was the one that kind of eluded me on Not Ruf At All until his very last year of eligibility. With the group of horses we have, against the group of trainers we have, it’s still not going to be easy to get that done, but I’m glad to have this one out of the way,” Vanlandingham said.

He added, “This is probably the toughest horse show we go to all year, and for us to come in with a 4-year-old - and Nathan’s horse is 4-year-old as well - and come out on top is a pretty big deal. I’m pretty fired up about how good our horses worked,” Vanlandingham said.

A Vintage Smoke is by A Sparkling Vintage out of Lady Smoke Peppy, and Vanlandingham said he’s a natural show horse. “He’s a very strong stopper. He came through the gate pretty hard and he swallowed the ground up on that first stop. He turned as good as he can for me tonight. He did the same at the Futurity. The best he turned around all week was on Finals night like here,” he said.

Vanlandingham was standing by and watched Piper’s run. “As soon as Nathan walked out, I said, ‘We have something to talk about.’ He said, ‘You’re two thirds of the way to the Triple Crown, and I’d like to leave it and save my horse,’” Vanlandingham recalled.

After a quick visit with Mesmer, the decision was made. “Diane said if we could save the horses, we would, and we would both leave as champions,” he explained.

Dany Tremblay and PS Mega Shine Chic Win Second Open Level 3 Championship

Two years ago Dany Tremblay and PS Mega Shine Chic won the Open Level 3 and tied for the Open Level 4 Reserve Championship. For Tremblay, this year's win is just as exciting. "It's awesome. To do it again with the same horse is awesome. I'm so happy. Last time he was a 4-year-old. I remember it like it was yesterday. He had a great run then, and today he was so honest," Tremblay recalled. The pair also tied for seventh in the Level 4, bringing total earnings to \$36,870.

The win also came with a custom saddle from Superior Saddlery LLC, an SPH saddle pad, a custom vest from Palmer Performance Horses, and product from M3 Products and Back On Track.

Competing as draw three, Tremblay knew he'd have to go for it. "I tried to do everything I could, and he was so good. He's a great show horse. He wants to be a Champion - he likes pictures," he said with a laugh.

PS Mega Shine Chic, a 6-year-old stallion by Shine Chic Shine out of Marthas Sugar Baby, is owned by ADH Mor Ranch. "He's owned by Brad and Amanda Kelly. This is



another great moment for them, for me, and for this horse," he said. "This horse has a great future ahead of him. He has beautiful babies on the ground now. They're gorgeous. We can't wait."

Cade McCutcheon Wins First NRBC Open Title on Shes Got Good Guns



It was Cade McCutcheon's first time to compete in the NRBC as an Open rider, but he proved he was ready, qualifying two horses to the Level 4 finals and winning the Level 2 on Shes Got Good Guns with a score of 221. The pair also finished second in the Level 3 finals and tied for ninth in the Level 4. "It went as good as I could have imagined," McCutcheon said following the awards ceremony. All together, McCutcheon's earnings on Shes Got Good Guns for the Open Levels 2 - 4 totaled \$35,198.

Cade also won a custom saddle from Bob's Custom Saddles, an SPH saddle pad, a custom vest from Palmer Performance Horses, and product from M3 Products, Nutrena, and Back On Track.

The NRBC was only the second show for McCutcheon and Shes Got Good Guns, a 6-year-old mare by Colonels Smoking Gun out of A Bueno Poco Dunit. She was trained by Duane Latimer, who made the Futurity finals with her, then shown by Todd Bergen at the NRBC, where she also made the finals. "She's been a good mare for everyone, and she just keeps getting better. Tonight I knew she wouldn't do anything wrong, so I let her stay a little more fresh and it worked," McCutcheon said.

It's early in McCutcheon's open career, which makes the opportunity to show Shes Got Good Guns even more special. "Roxanne Koepsell has been a client of ours for as long as I can remember. She's been awesome. I'm really happy she trusted me with this horse. Not a lot of people would have trusted me with a horse as good as she is this early in my career, but she did, and I'm grateful," McCutcheon said.

McCutcheon noted that Shes Got Good Guns would get some much-needed rest before the NRHA Derby.

Josh Tishman and Magnum Style Claim Level 1 Championship

With a score of 217.5, Josh Tishman and Magnum Style claimed the Level 1 Championship, earning \$2,968. It was the first time for Tishman to make the finals at the NRBC. "It's pretty special to win today. This horse was actually my second of the day to show, and I just wanted to go in and be clean," he explained. "He has tons of talent, so I knew if I was clean he would be good."

The Level 1 title also came with prizes including a custom saddle from Continental Saddlery, an SPH saddle pad, a custom vest from Palmer Performance Horses, and product from M3 Products and Back On Track.

The 6-year-old gelding, owned by Mark Hurd, is by Magnum Chic Dream out of Easy Whiz My Money. "Mark's daughter Elena rides this horse. They're from the east coast, but she goes to TCU, so we have him at Casey Deary's place so she could show him. She was actually at the college finals in Waco, so she asked me to show him," Tishman explained.

While the pair were successful, Elena will likely take the reins back over for the NRHA Derby. "I thank Mark, Elena, Casey and Nicole and the whole Deary crew," Tishman said.



Marie Kleiner riding Xtra Needs A Drink and Billy Williams on Gunners High Roller tied for Reserve honors with scores of 216.5. Each collected \$1,581.

Gunners High Roller, owned by Eitan Abu, is a 6-year-old stallion by Colonels Smoking Gun out of Yoplait Light. Xtra Needs A Drink, owned by Thiago Boechat, is a 4-year-old stallion by Wimpyneedsacocktail out of Ruby Chic Olena.

He's just a very nice horse," Brown said.

Gunnatrashtheplace is by Gunnatrashya out of All Chic N Shiny. "He did really good tonight. He showed really well," Brown said.

There is no other entry fee to enter the Development Division, but to be eligible a horse must not have won more than \$2,000 prior to March 15. The purse is paid out to the highest advancing horses in the Open preliminaries.

Dean Brown and Einsteins Lil Prize marked a 220 in the preliminary round to win the division, collecting \$6,000. "He's a newer horse for me. He got a little stargazed by the crowd tonight, but in the prelims he was focused and easy to show and did everything I wanted him to do," he said.

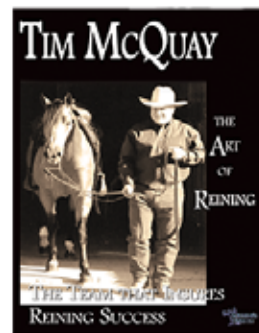
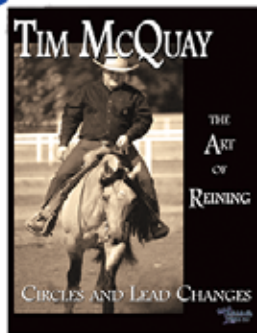
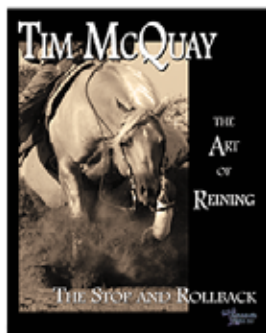
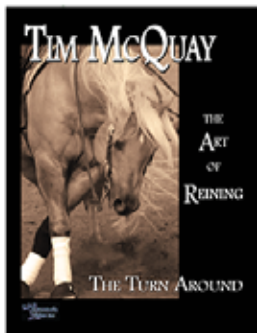
Dean Brown qualified three horses to the finals and won the Prime Time division on Gunnatrashtheplace with a score of 219. He also won the Development Division on Einsteins Lil Prize during the preliminary round.

Einsteins Lil Prize, a 4-year-old stallion by Einsteins Revolution out of the good producing mare Smart Lil Prize, is owned by Robert Santagata. "I thank both Robert and Jeff for the opportunity," Brown said.

Gunnatrashtheplace is a 6-year-old stallion owned by Jeff Levine of Levine Equine Enterprises. "He's been a very good horse for me. I've made the finals at all the major events with him. I've had him since he was a 2-year-old.

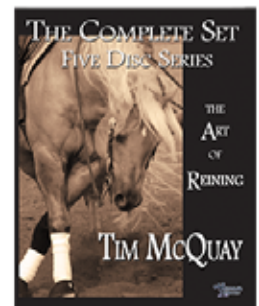

MANDY MCCUTCHEON AND PARTY NITE TOP 2019 NRBC NON PRO CLASSIC



The 2019 National Reining Breeders Classic welcomed a large group of Non Pro competitors to compete for the coveted NRBC Non Pro Championship. Those hopefuls were reduced to 73 finalists in five divisions with Mandy McCutcheon, of Aubrey, Texas, and Party Nite walking away with the title during the Non Pro Finals competition on Friday, April 19.

McCutcheon has now won more NRBC Championships than anyone; her wins total seven. Still, she was quick to point out that each one is special. "It never gets old. Never! I love it," she said following the awards ceremony where she picked up a check for \$30,000. Prizes also include a years use of a custom trailer from Twin Cities South and Gary Raak, a saddle from Bob's Custom Saddles, an SPH saddle pad from SPH Performance Gear, a pair of Anderson Bean Boots, product from San Juan Ranch and Santa Cruz Biotechnology, a Whisper Bit from M3 Products, as well as numerous awards from the NRBC.

McCutcheon and Party Nite were draw 21 in the field of

33 and marked a 219.5. "My game plan was to have a nice smooth run. She's a lot of horse, and I'm just now starting to figure out how to keep it all together," she said.

The 4-year-old mare is by Gunners Special Nite out of Topsail Survivor, and was bred and raised by Sarah Willemann of Turnabout Farm, Inc. "We bought her as a late 2-year-old or early 3-year-old. We won the Best of the West Futurity, but then we had nine penalty points in the preliminaries of the Futurity, and you don't get very far doing that," McCutcheon said.

Despite the bobble at the Futurity, many people were trying to buy the mare; and not for a small amount of money. "Tom said, 'I hope you made the right decision,' because it seems like bad karma to turn down money like that, but I just kept feeling like she had more in there. Actually, I still feel like she has more. Today she was very good and showed very well, but she keeps getting better all the time." Mandy said, then added, "I just think time is what is going to do it for her."

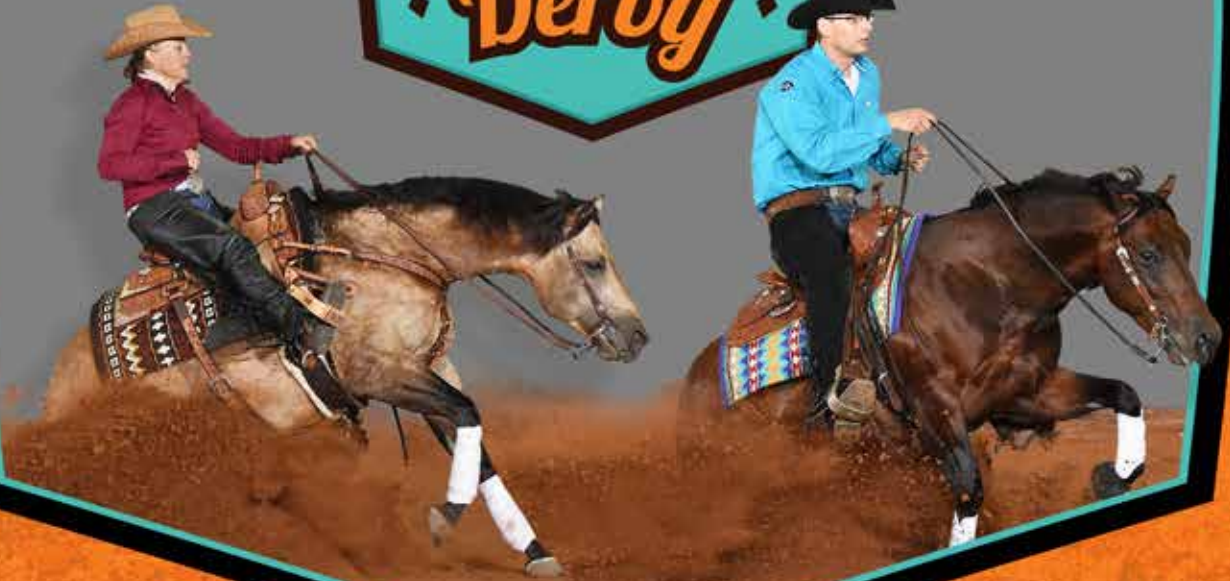

Luca Fappani & Sharp Dressed Spook Claim Non Pro Level 3 and Level 2 Titles



With a score of 219, Luca Fappani and Sharp Dressed Spook claimed the Championship of the Non Pro Level 3 and Non Pro Level 2, and the Reserve Championship of the Non Pro Level 4. All together, his earnings totaled \$29,500.

Fappani also received two Bob's Custom Saddles, two SPH saddle pads, product from San Juan Ranch and Santa Cruz Biotechnology, product from Back on Track, a Whisper Bit from M3 Products, and several other awards from the NRBC.

"It feels really good. To win at such a big event is crazy. It's mind-boggling," he said. "This horse was riding great, but I don't know that I expected him to show as good as he did. He was awesome!"

Jennifer Neudorf Wins Non Pro Level 1 Championship on Shining In Town



It was Fappani's first time to make the finals at the NRBC; his first attempt was in 2018. "Last year I had a bobble in the prelims, but this year both of my horses were really good," he said, referring to not only Sharp Dressed Spook, a 5-year-old stallion by Spooks Gotta Whiz out of Dolittle Lena, but also Spooks N Jewels (Smart Spook x Whiz Jewels) who also qualified for the Level 4 finals, winning an additional \$2,150.

Fappani only began showing reiners a few years ago. He had been more into riding dirt bikes, but after several injuries, decided to follow in his father's footsteps. "I decided I really liked the horses, so I started showing a couple of old geldings. At the beginning of last year, I told my parents I was ready to step up to the derbies, and my mom gave me an incredible horse (Spooks N Jewels). Then they brought me this horse in September of last year," Fappani said. "They support me completely and I can't thank them enough."

He smiled and added, "I thank my parents, brother, and all my friends and family who are here to watch me and get in my win pictures."

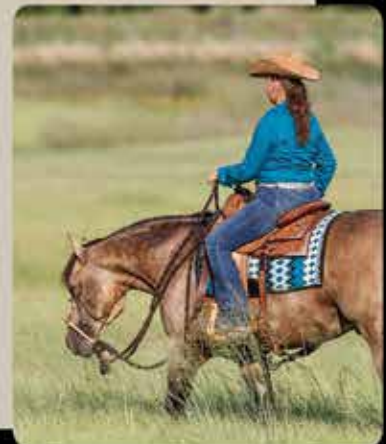

It might have been the first year for Jennifer Neudorf to show in the Derbies, but she managed to qualify for all levels of the Non Pro Finals, excluding the Prime Time. In fact, she would have done that if she'd have been old enough, but she's only fifteen.

"It is unbelievable. I am so happy. I just got this horse at the Futurity and this is my second time to show him," she said.

With a score of 217.5, Neudorf collected \$17,804 for winning the Level 1 and tying for third in Levels 2-4 on her horse Shining In Town, a 6-year-old mare by Hollywoods-tinseltown out of Shine Ann. She also took home a saddle from Continental Saddlery, an SPH saddle pad from SPH Performance Gear, a custom hat can from Shorty's Caboy Hattery and several other awards from the NRBC.

From Canada, Neudorf competes in high school rodeos in

barrel racing and goat tying, but was introduced to reining by a friend. "My friend's reining horses looked so cool, and all her pictures of her stopping with the dirt flying looked awesome," she explained.

About a year ago, Neudorf needed a to step up her game, and bought a horse from Craig Schmersal. "I've come a long way since I started riding with Craig. He helps me get focused," she said. "Today he told me if anything bad happens to not focus on that, just keep going. I missed our first stop, but I didn't focus on that - just the rest of the run."

Although her horse stays in Arizona with Craig, Neudorf travels south as often as she can. "I thank my mom, dad, Craig, and the whole crew. My mom and dad are so great, and the crew is so supportive. I couldn't do it without any of them," she said.

Karen Mills Pilots Pale Faced Dancer to Non Pro Prime Time Championship

It might have been a few years since Karen Mills made the Level 4 finals, but she made the most of it, earning a finals position in every single Non Pro division. Mills and her horse, Pale Faced Dancer, marked a 217 in the finals to win the Prime Time division, place second in the Level 1, fifth in the Level 2, sixth in the Level 3, and tie for sixth in the Level 4. All totaled, Mills collected \$13,837 in finals money, as well as many awards from the NRBC and product from San Juan Ranch/Santa Cruz Biotechnology and Back On Track.

"This horse is so much fun, and I have to say that she dealt with my nerves very well. She's so honest. You know, there are some things I'd do different, but I couldn't have asked her to be better. She was really, really good," Mills said.

Making the wins even more impressive is the fact that Mills has been riding Pale Faced Dancer, a 6-year-old mare by Pale Face Dunit and out of Dancer Nic, for less than two months. "We bought her six or eight weeks ago from our good friend Tommy Rodden who really loves her," she said.

The NRBC is only the second show for the pair, who collected a Non Pro Level 1 win as well as a Prime Time Reserve Championship at the Cactus Classic. "She was awesome there and earned about \$7,000. That was the highest I'd ever marked, so I felt good coming here," Mills said.



"And here she was so good. It's like she's right every time. She is so good minded and a lot of fun. She feels like you can do it over and over again and she'll be the same."

The next show for Mills and Pale Faced Dancer will be the NRHA Derby, but she'll show in the GSEC Coliseum one more time. "I'm going to try to show her and qualify for Las Vegas, so I'll show in the Non Pro on Sunday and see what happens," she said.

MUEHLSTAETTER WINS OPEN CLASSIC CHALLENGE AND \$25K OPEN ON BLO GUN



The NRBC Open Classic Challenge and \$25K NRHA Open made for an exciting evening in Katy, Texas. The field of horses was tough, but in the end, Martin Muehlstaetter and the 9-year-old stallion Blo Gun won both classes with a score of 225. Earnings totaled \$17,687, and a saddle sponsored by Kyle Tack was also awarded.

“This is a great place to bring an older horse. I think this is one of the higher paying seven and ups there is. It’s great. I’m glad the NRBC Board of Directors keeps promoting it,” Muehlstaetter said.

Muehlstaetter and Blo Gun aren’t strangers to the Classic Challenge competition. In fact, they tied for the win of the class in 2017. “He’s a fantastic horse. He has a huge heart and no quit in him. I took him to WEG last year. He’s pretty special,” he said.

Blo Gun, by Colonels Smoking Gun out of The Hot

Jewel, is owned by Michael and Joanne Garnett. “I think he’s going to go to the Select World Show with Joanne, and I don’t know - but hopefully back here next year,” Muehlstaetter said.

Gennaro Lendi and Colonels Dancing Gun tied Craig Schmersal and Hot Hollywood Whizky for Reserve in the \$25k Added Open with scores of 224.5, worth \$6,254. Traveling all the way from Italy, Colonels Dancing Gun, by Colonels Smoking Gun out of Dance Little Spook, is owned by Quarter Dream Italy.

Schmersal and Hot Hollywood Whizky, by Topsail Whiz out of Hot Hollywood Jewels, also finished second in the Classic Challenge, earning an additional \$6,478. Hot Hollywood Whizky is owned by Mark Blake.



BAILEY KOLSUN WINS NON PRO CLASSIC CHALLENGE L4 & L3 CHAMPIONSHIPS

The NRBC Classic Challenge events were created to give horses aged seven and up a chance to continue competing

for big money. The Non Pro Classic Challenge was held Sunday, April 21, and Bailey Kolsun and Diamond Studded Gun won the Non Pro Level 4 and Level 3 Championship, as well as the \$5k Non Pro, with a 220. The wins netted \$12,282.

“He was awesome. We’d been prepping for this all week

here, and he loves this arena. It went as planned,” Kolsun said.

Kolsun and Diamond Studded Guns, a 7-year-old by Gun-natrashya out of Like To Flo, have done well at the NRBC, winning the Level 2 Championship as a 4-year-old. “He’s made the finals just about everywhere. We went undefeated at the APHA World for three years. He’s been a great boy

for me,” she explained.

Kolsun rides with Ruben Vandorp. “I thank Ruben and his family. They’re like a second family. I also thank my real family back in Canada who took time away from Easter dinner to watch me on the live feed, and the NRBC for putting on this great event for seven year old horses,” she said.

McKinnon Larcombe & Designed With Shine Win Non Pro Classic Challenge L2 and L1



McKinnon Larcombe had only shown Designed With Shine once before coming to Katy, but the chemistry between the two is undeniable. Time after time they finished

at or near the top of the leader board, with the goal always being the Non Pro Classic Challenge.

In the end, Larcombe and Designed With Shine, by Smart And Shiney out of Taris Designer Genes, finished as the Level 1 and Level 2 Non Pro Classic Challenge Champions and the Intermediate Non Pro High Point Champions. All together that netted \$6,363.

“It absolutely paid off. My goal was to come in here today and amp up what I’d done earlier in the week with a little more speed and finesse. She was so good for me,” Larcombe said.

The win didn’t come easy. Larcombe had tied for the lead of both divisions with Amy Stoney, who was riding Skeets Whizard. “I figured we were here so we might as well give it a shot and run it off. I tried to be a little better than the first time around, and she was right with me. Even though she was tired, she gave it her all and was really good,” Larcombe said.

Non Pro Classic Challenge Prime Time Champion Jose Vazquez & Like Shiner

In 2018, Jose Vazquez won the NRBC Non Pro Championship on Like Shiner. The mare, now seven years old, has aged out of the Classic, so Vazquez elected to show her in the Classic Challenge, marking a 218 to win the Prime Time plus tie for second in the Level 4. In addition, Vazquez and Like Shiner also won the Non Pro High Point buckle.

“Everyone knows this mare. This is the fourth time I’ve shown her here. She made it to the finals three times, and won it last year, and today she was good as ever. I was very happy to win today,” Vazquez noted. Like Shiner, by Smart Like Juice out of the great producer Wind Her Up Shiner, is a full-sister to Vazquez’s other NRBC Non Pro Champion, Wound By Juice.

All totaled, the pair’s earnings exceeded \$5,606. “I went in and I showed her kind of conservative. She was very good and we had a good time,” he said.

The finalists for the Yellowstone Rookie Shootout were determined by the composite scores from the two rounds. Although Kyla Thurlow and Kachina Olena Tag won the first round, a bobble in round two almost took them out of contention.

“I went down to my first stop and lost my stirrup, so I had a freeze up which cost two points per judge,” Thurlow explained. “It was torture waiting for the final results, but we slid in there in the last spot.”

Thurlow was unsure if she’d bring Kachina Olena Tag, by Whiz N Tag Chex out of Kachina Oak Olena, to show. “I’d never shown in a coliseum like this. I wasn’t sure if we were ready, but he proved me wrong for sure. I had very little horse left today, so we just jogged him and barely loped before we went in. I asked a lot and he answered back. It got more exciting as we went on because he was with me and I could relax,” she said. “I couldn’t have asked him for more. He’s the best thing that has ever happened to me. He is truly wonderful!”

Thurlow noted she was nervous prior to the Shootout Finals, but got a great pep talk before she went in. “I ride with Mark Rafacz. He is the calm voice I need to hear right before showing, and his wife Shannon gives the best pep talks and can make me feel super confident before I go in,” she said.

By making the Yellowstone Rookie Shootout Finals, Thurlow and Kachina Olena Tag also secured a qualification for the Rookie Challenge at the Run for a Million Reining in Las Vegas, Nevada. “I’m going for sure,” she said with a smile. “I’ll give him a well deserved break after this, and



then there are a couple shows we might go to.”

Thurlow received a custom tack box and a custom headstall made by Andrea Archer for the win, and every finalist received several prizes including beautiful buckles, all sponsored by Yellowstone.

MORE ANCILLARY CHAMPIONS CROWNED AT NRBC

Brownshadel and Edgmon Split Intermediate & Limited Open (1) Wins

Patti Brownshadel and Tell Edgmon tied for the Championship of both the Intermediate and Limited Open classes with scores of 144.5. Brownshadel was riding Magnetised, by Im The Chic Magnet out of Gee Golly Whiz, while Edgmon rode Docs Shining Crome by Custom Crome out of Shining Pearl.

This was the first major horse show back for Brownshadel and Magnetised, who’ve both been sidelined for health issues in recent years. In 2016, the two made the NRHA Derby Open Level



4 finals, but health problems kept them out of competition for a couple of years.

“I had so much fun today, even before I went in the arena to show. I trained all my life and didn’t realize what I had until I couldn’t do it for a while,” Brownshadel said. “This was Magnetised’s first show back to actually get dolled up, and he was just like he was when I showed him the last time. He was absolutely honest. He wants to please and gives me his heart.”

It's clear the 8-year-old stallion is special. "He's by my stud. I raised him, and even though he's had a short show career, he's so honest and easy to train. He makes the job fun, and I knew he was special from the beginning," she said.

The NRBC is Edgmon and Docs Shining Crome's first big show together, and if it's any indication of the future, the pair will be successful. "It went really well. He waited on me the whole time and was really quiet," Edgmon said. "I probably could have pushed him a little more, but I'm

trying to save him for a couple days down the road, so I just cruised him through."

Edgmon has only been riding the 8-year-old stallion, who's owned by Michael Marks, for a few months, but said the horse is making it easy. "He hasn't been with me very long, but he's a real nice horse. He's really getting quiet, and it won't take much for him to mark big. He's so easy to turn and stop. No matter how he's running to his stop, he's going to do it every time," Edgmon explained.



Giannasi and Ruf Till The End Win Rookie Professional (1)

Eduardo Maranhó Giannasi rode Ruf Till The End to a score of 141.5, clinching the Rookie Professional win.

"She was really good today. She turned really good and her circles were ok. She's a big stopper, and I just trust her every time," Giannasi, originally of Brazil,

said.

Ruf Till The End, owned by Cardinal Hill Training Center, is by Lil Ruf Peppy and out of Remedys Sure Slide.

Giannasi has been riding the six-year-old mare since she was a two-year-old. "We've been getting better and better every year. I enjoyed showing her today. I have worked for Cardinal and Franco Bertolani for five years, and I just appreciate all the opportunities."

Open (2) Champion Intermediate Open (2) Champion Intermediate Open High Point Champion Colin Fitzpatrick & Chics Love Affair

Chics Love Affair's career might have gotten off to a slower start, but, if the NRBC is any indication, the 6-year-old mare has a bright future ahead.

With Colin Fitzpatrick at the reins, Chics Love Affair placed at or near the top of every class she entered and ended the week as the Open and Intermediate Open Champion, and also won the Intermediate Open High Point Championship.

"We really ended the week on a high note. She's been so rock-solid all week. Every time I've gone in she's been just as pure and just as easy," Fitzpatrick noted.

Still, the large size of the Coliseum arena is challenging, even for fresh horses. "Today she felt tired, and that Coliseum is a lot of real estate to cover, but she hung in with

me and let me show her one more time," he said.

Chics Love Affair is by Shine Chic Shine out of Memorable Affair. "This mare is really special to her owner Victoria Lambert. She's the last daughter out of Memorable Affair, and we've been hoping this mare would come together and we're so happy she finally is," Fitzpatrick said. "I thank Carl and Victoria Lambert for the opportunity they have given me."



Limited Open (2) & High Point Champion Patti Brownshadel & Magnetised

Patti Brownshadel and her 8-year-old stallion Magnetised tied for the win of both the Intermediate Open (1) and Limited Open (1) on Tuesday in the Tellepsen Arena, then took home a win the Wheless Arena on Thursday in the Limited Open. Not only did the duo win the class with a 72.5, they

also claimed the Limited Open High Point Championship.

"This horse never lets me down. He'll make mistakes like any other horse, but he always tries, and he has a heart of gold, and is with me every step of the way," Brownshadel

said of Magnetised, who's by Im The Chic Magnet out of Gee Golly Whiz. "Generally, if there's a mistake, it's on me."

Brownshadel noted that Magnetised was "spot on" in the pen, noting that her husband said the horse was showing off, especially in his backup. "We might enter one more class this week, but I don't want to overdo it with him," Brownshadel said. "I'm trying to build us back up after our time off. I want to get him in better shape so he can hopefully go to some other big shows."

Ever grateful, Brownshadel added, "I thank God, my family, and my friends. You don't do this by yourself; it's

a group effort. I'm just the lucky one that gets to train and show this horse."



Rookie Professional (2) Wade McDonald & Hot Rockin Spook

Wade McDonald had only planned to school Hot Rockin Spook for owner Jamie Walters, who would show the horse later in the day, but he managed to do much more. The pair won the Rookie Professional (2) with a 72.

"Jamie is one of Craig Schmersal's customers. I was just going to school him to make sure he was good for her, and he was," McDonald explained. "He



waited on me everywhere and was very honest."

Walters showed Hot Rockin Spook, by Smart Spook out of Hot Rockin Badger, the day before in the Rookie classes. "She'll show him in the second set of Rookie classes this afternoon. This horse was really good and honest for me today," McDonald said.

Rookie Professional High Point Champion Eduardo Maranhó Giannasi & Ruf Till The End

Eduardo Maranhó Giannasi and Ruf Till The End, who won the Rookie Professional (1) on Tuesday, marked another solid score of 71 in the Rookie Professional (2). While it may not have been a high enough score to win the class, it did put the team in solid position to claim the high point buckle.

"Tuesday, we showed in the Tellepsen arena and she was really good, but I felt I had to work on a couple things with

her. I was happy with her today and how she showed. I had fun with it," Giannasi said.

Ruf Till The End, a 6-year-old mare, is by Lil Ruf Peppy out of Remedys Sure Slide. She is owned by Cardinal Hill Training Center. "I think she improves every time we go in the arena. Now I have to focus on helping Franco (Bertolani) in the Classic as well as helping our non pros," he said.

Non Pro & Int. Non Pro (1) Class Winner McKinnon Larcombe & Designed With Shine

McKinnon Larcombe and her horse Designed With Shine and Jose Vazquez and Like Shiner both marked scores of 148.5 to top the Non Pro ancillary class. The riders elected to have a run off for the win, with Larcombe finishing on top. She also won the Intermediate Non Pro.

"The plan was, if Jose showed I was still going to school, but he went in and had a nice, easy run, and I think he had the same plan. I did the same and my mare was re-

ally good," Larcombe said. "She was really good in the earlier run. I am still saving her for the Classic Challenge on Sunday, but I intended to show her off just not to her full ability. She was



really, really good and did everything I asked.”

Designed With Shine, by Smart And Shiney and out of Taris Designer Genes, is owned by McKinnon’s aunt Shauna Larcombe. “The mare is eight years old now, so there are a few things I could show her in, but I figured for her record and future babies, it would be good for McKinnon to show her. Plus, McKinnon needed a good horse and I knew she could do a good job with her,” Shauna said. “The mare is a

great show horse. She’s doing a great job with McKinnon, and McKinnon is doing a great job with her.”

McKinnon added, “I hope to do well in the seven and up class tomorrow. The Affiliate Finals is a big goal, and maybe even the Youth World. I hope to win some money and have fun.”

Limited Non Pro High Point Champion Kalyn Sanders & Got That Iowa Shine

Kalyn Sanders piloted Got That Iowa Shine to two second-place finishes in the Limited Non Pro at the NRBC, and in doing so won the high-point buckle. It’s the first buckle Sanders has won on the gelding; something she admits was a goal.

“Everyone was asking why I didn’t do the class, but because I’ve only shown him a couple times, I didn’t feel ready. To be honest, it was my goal to come down here and win this buckle, and I’m so glad we did,” she said.

Sanders purchased Got That Iowa Shine, nicknamed Dillon, in July of 2018. “He’s my real-life sorrel unicorn. He has the biggest personality, but when it comes time to



do his job, he’s amazing and I can count on him every time. He’s a past futurity champion with my trainer Josh Murphy, and he has about \$40,000 in lifetime earnings,” she said of the 6-year-old gelding, by Smart And Shiney out of SLJ This Is My Juice.

With two consistent runs under her belt, Sanders plans to enter the NRHA Derby in June. “This gives me confidence and I feel a lot more prepared. He was amazing for me both days. I had a couple little issues I caused, but I think if we can smooth it out, we will be ok,” she said. “I thank Josh Murphy who has helped me so much, as well as all my friends, family, and other trainers who have helped me get this far.”

Paige Pastorino Wins Limited Non Pro (1) on Taylor Made Magnum

Paige Pastorino claimed the first win at the Wheless arena with her score of 73 on Taylor Made Magnum, a 12-year-old stallion by Magnum Chic Dream out of Beaus Liberty Belle.

“My run today was awesome. I think it was the fastest I’ve ever gone in my circles, and it paid off and it looked really nice. I really tried to push myself today because we’ve been working on stepping it up,” Pastorino said following her run.

Pastorino has owned Taylor Made Magnum for a couple of years, and credits the horse’s honesty in the show pen



for their success. “He’s awesome and everything I could ask for. He’s taught me a lot, never pulls any tricks, and when I take him out of his stall, I know exactly what I have,” she explained.

Although Pastorino lives in California, her trainer, Dany Tremblay, lives in Oklahoma. “We bought a horse from him and Fred (Tremblay) a couple years ago and decided that is where we wanted to be. I have to thank both Dany and Fred. They always have everything worked out, and they’re both awesome,” she said.



Limited Non Pro (2) Class Winner McKinnon Larcombe & Designed With Shine

McKinnon Larcombe only recently began showing Designed With Shine, but it's apparent the pair have chemistry, marking a 147.5 to win the Limited Non Pro (2) in the Tellepsen Arena.

"My plan was

to save her for Sunday in the Non Pro Classic Challenge and keep things easy. Today was just more practice for me than for her. She's good. This was the fourth time for me to show her, and she's been great," Larcombe said.

Designed With Shine is owned by McKinnon's aunt, Shauna Larcombe. "My aunt just purchased her recently, but she has shown her quite a lot in the past, and actually showed at the World Equestrian Games on her. She knows her really well and thought I would get along with her perfectly, and she's been a really good match with me," McKinnon said. Designed With Shine, an 8-year-old mare, is by Smart And Shiney out of Taris Designer Genes. "She gives me so much confidence. The first time I rode her I knew we would get along well. She's so much fun."

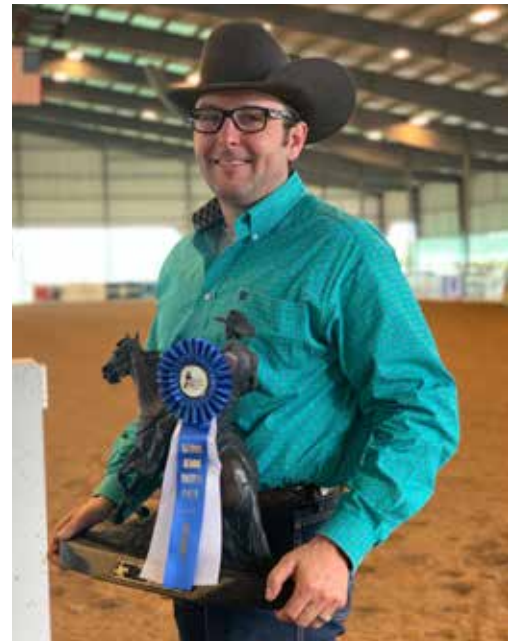
Novice Horse Open Level 2 (1) Co-Champion Jared Leclair & Lime A Rita

patterns to run because you can really show your horse off and take your time. We're going to try to qualify for the affiliate finals in Tulsa." He added, "I really appreciate Susan and thank her for the opportunity to show this mare."



Novice Horse Open Level 2 (1) Co-Champion Novice Horse Open Level 1 Champion Colin Fitzpatrick & Chics Love Affair

Colin Fitzpatrick piloted Chics Love Affair to a 150, claiming the Novice Horse Open Level 2 Co-Championship and the Level 1 win as well. The pair also showed

earlier in the week in the Intermediate Open, finishing third. "She was good Tuesday, but even better today. I had a game plan of letting her choose the speed. She felt really hooked up, so I went ahead and asked her, and she was a machine. I couldn't have been prouder of her," Fitzpatrick said.

Chics Love Affair is a 6-year-old by Shine Chic Shine and out of the blue hen producer Memorable Affair. "She has been a late bloomer because we had to deal with some soundness issues earlier in her career. We got her all put



together, and she just gets better and better every run,” said Fitzpatrick.

Fitzpatrick and Chics Love Affair still have a busy week,

showing Saturday in the Wheless Arena in the second slate of the Novice Horse, and then in the Coliseum Sunday for the Open ancillary classes.

Novice Horse Open Level 2 High Point Champion & Class Winner Jared Leclair & Lime A Rita

Jared Leclair showed Lime A Rita for the first time on Thursday, tying for the win of the Novice Horse Open Level 2 in the Tellepsen Arena. The duo then won the class in the Wheless Arena with a 76, netting an additional \$856 and claiming the high point buckle.

“I showed her Thursday, my Non Pro showed her yesterday, and I showed her today. She’s had a really busy week, but we’ve been doing the spa with her every day. She stays really sound and is the kind of horse that wants to go to the show and be in the pen, and she loves her job. It’s just fun to be part of that,” Leclair said.

Lime A Rita, by Custom Legend out of She Slides Wright, is owned by Susan Meyer. “We bought her in Vegas last year. Arno Honstetter had trained her,” Leclair explained. “Susan and Ron Meyer have been great customers for a long

time. We’ve began flushing embryos. I’m really excited about her future and being able to ride her babies.”

Future plans for Lime A Rita include qualifying for the Affiliate finals at the Tulsa Reining Classic and placing high in the year-end standings for the Southwest Reining Horse Association.



Novice Horse Open Level 1 (2) High Point Champion Colin Fitzpatrick & Chics Love Affair



With two solid runs at the Great Southwest Equestrian Center, Colin Fitzpatrick and Chics Love Affair claimed the Novice Horse Open Level 1 High Point Championship. “She was really hooked up and I really mashed on the gas pedal that day, and it worked out really well,”

Fitzpatrick explained. “Today she was just as good - I just wasn’t as good. I had a little under turn penalty and

didn’t drive her down to the last stop good enough, but she was still a 73.5 and I was super pleased with her.”

Lameness concerns early on kept Chics Love Affair out of the show pen. “We had a lot of trouble with her as a three and four year old with weird soundness issues. It has taken her a long time to physically and mentally mature,” he explained.

Chics Love Affair is by Shine Chic Shine out of the great producer Memorable Affair. “That mare was such a great show mare and this mare seems to follow right in her footsteps. I have ridden a few others out of her in the time I’ve worked for Carl and Victoria Lambert, and I think she is the nicest one I’ve ridden so far,” Fitzpatrick said.

Fitzpatrick and Chics Love Affair will show again Sunday in the Open and Intermediate Open. “After that she’ll get some time off because she’s gotten pushed hard at this show, but then we’ll enter up in the Derby,” he said.

Novice Horse Open Level 1 (2) Class Winner Mirjam Stillo & Big Addy Tude

Mirjam Stillo and Big Addy Tude topped the Novice Horse Open Level 1, pocketing \$586. It was the 4-year-old gelding's third horse show. "He is very green but super talented. I showed him the other day in the novice and showed him pretty slow. We had a glitch with an extra lead change, but that's part of him being green and that's why we didn't show him in the big pen yet. He's just not experienced enough," Stillo said.

There weren't any bobbles the second time in the arena. "He was perfect everywhere today with a 75. Today I put the foot on the gas a little more and he was perfect. He was listening and quiet, and whatever I asked him he did," she said.

Stillo has only been showing Big Addy Tude, by Gunnatrashya out of Miss Lil Addy Tude, for a couple months. "He's pretty extraordinary. I love him. He is owned by Toyon Ranch, and I thank them so much for the opportunity," she said.



Novice Horse Non Pro Level 2 (1) Kristen Avila & Gunnerspecialplayboy

Topping the Novice Horse Non Pro Level 2 class with a 146 was Kristen Avila and the 6-year-old gelding Gunnerspecialplayboy. "He was good today. We had a little bobble with our spins, and he got a little fast in his rundowns, so we'll need to work on that before we show again on Saturday, but I can't complain," Avila said.

Unfortunately, Gunnerspecialplayboy, by Gunners Special Nite out of Shameless Playgirl, was never nominated for the NRBC. "If he was, I'd be showing him in the Derby. We just brought him down here to show him in the Novice and Non Pro classes so I'd have something extra to show," she explained, adding she plans to



show the horse Saturday and Sunday. "Last year we ended third in the world standings. This year, I wanted to get an earlier start so we could finish higher."

Kristen and her husband, Bobby Avila Jr., have owned the gelding since August of his 4-year-old year. "I like everything about him. He's always a really happy horse with his ears forward, and he's quiet and pleasant. You just put your hand forward and he goes right between the reins. He's a big turner and a big stopper, and he just fits me really well," Avila said. "Thank you to my husband for taking the time to train him to fit me and always making sure he's ready."

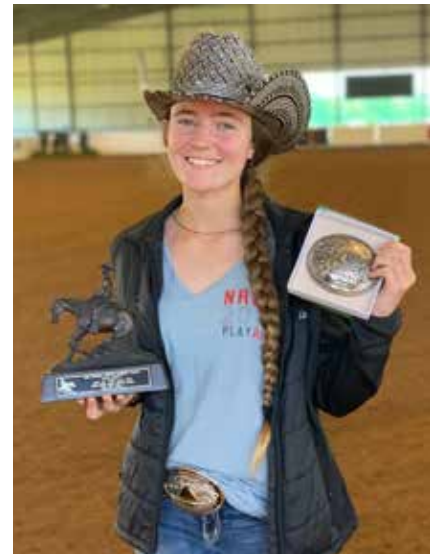

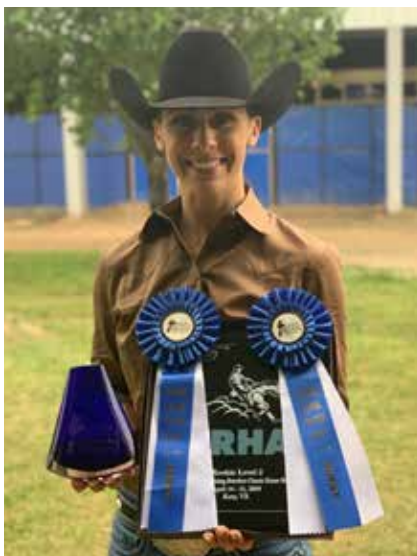
Rookie Level 2 (1) / Yellowstone Rookie Shootout Round 1 Winner Kyla Thurlow & Kachina Olena Tag

Green Reiner Level 2 (2) Class Champion Emilee Radford & Peppy Doc Chic Olena

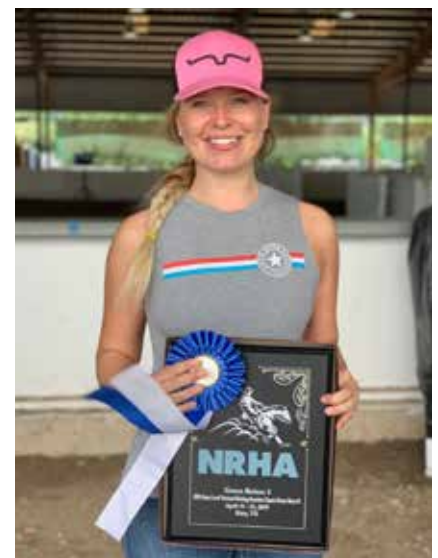

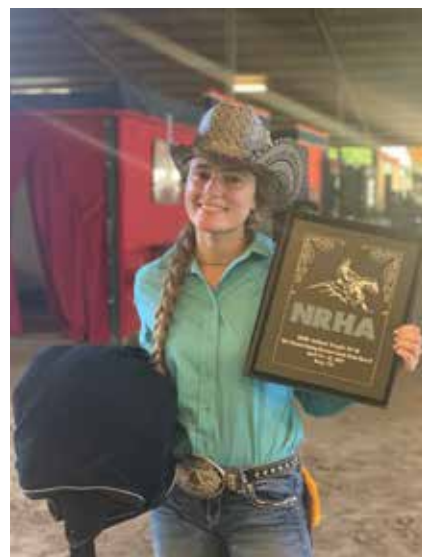
Youth 14-18 (2) Class Champion Lisa Pirtle & Wallas Corona

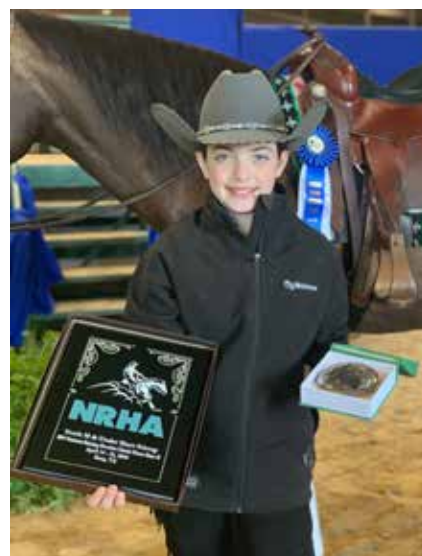
Short Stirrup Co-Champion Becca Schaffhauser & Dun Got My Rest

NATIONAL REINING BREEDERS CLASSIC INCREASES ELIGIBILITY

Now the Classic will include 7-Year-Olds

Right on the heels of another Million Dollar Show at the Great Southwest Equestrian Center in Katy, Texas, the National Reining Breeders Classic (NRBC) has announced a landmark change in the Conditions for its next

yearly event. Beginning with the 2020 NRBC, 7-year-old horses will be eligible to compete in the Classic.

In a Board of Directors meeting held April 25, the decision was made unanimously to include 7-year-olds in the Classic and to change the eligibility age for the Classic Challenge horse to eight and older.

For NRBC President Tom McCutcheon, the decision was based on sound reasoning. He said, “First it gives horses an extra year of eligibility and that is something that we feel our Non Pros especially wanted. It gives real value to those horses.”



He continued, “Second, it allows owners and riders to put the welfare of the horse first – taking away the need to rush horses that might develop more slowly or that might need time to recover from an injury. Overall, we

think it’s the right decision at the right time.”

The NRBC is a stallion incentive program for reining horses. After a stallion becomes part of the program, his foals may be enrolled. Those foals, as 4, 5, 6 and now 7-year-olds, can then compete at the prestigious week-long event which has paid out over \$22 million in its past 22 years. RUBY CAROL TRIMMER WILL ALWAYS BE REMEMBERED

Ruby Carol Trimmer, daughter of Adrie Lloyd Givens and Carol Joanne Alldredge-Givens, departed this world on April 16, 2019 in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. Born in Bloomington, Illinois, Carol and her husband Paul Trimmer made their home in Cresent, Oklahoma.



A loving wife, mother, grandmother, sister, aunt, and cherished friend, Carol will be more than missed by everyone who had the pleasure of knowing her. Throughout her life, Carol went out of her way to make those around her feel like part of her family, and she will forever hold a special place in the hearts of many.

Carol developed a love for horses early in her life. Her father, Lloyd Givens, trained Saddlebreds, and Carol grew up riding Saddlebreds, hunters, and jumpers. When she met her husband Paul, she became interested in American Quarter Horses. Before their marriage in 1967, Paul showed reining horses in AQHA events, even before the formation of the National Reining Horse Association—the association in which Carol later became a major centerpiece.

The couple's shared love of horses ensured they would always be a part of the equine realm. While Paul served in the United States Air Force, stationed in Idaho, they owned one Quarter Horse named Hay Valley Ruth. When Paul was discharged from the Air Force, they relocated to Paul's hometown of Dennison, Ohio, with eight horses in tow. After the birth of their son Paul Lloyd Trimmer, the family found a new home in Fresno, Ohio, that better suited their growing needs.

The Trimmer's new facility was conveniently located near Columbus, Ohio, where they often showed their horses at events including the All American Quarter Horse Congress. For more than 15 years, Carol began to foster her love of writing while working in the Congress press room. In 1993, one of Carol's articles, which she titled "The 1993 Congress Formula," was published in the NRHA Reiner magazine. This piece covering the Congress Reining Futurity was only the beginning of Carol's enduring mark on the NRHA Reiner.

Three years later, Carol's future daughter-in-law, Susie Reidenbach, who was working at the NRHA office in Coshocton, Ohio, told Carol they needed some extra help. Without hesitation, Carol took on a part time position, while still working her full-time job in the logistics department at Colgate-Palmolive.

In 1998, as NRHA prepared to relocate to Oklahoma City, Carol did not want to leave her family and horse farm in Ohio. However, the current NRHA Director Dan Wall persisted in asking her to stay with the association. Eventually, everything fell into place for the Trimmers to move. Paul Lloyd, who was a roper, wanted to be in Oklahoma close to his friends, so when NRHA offered Susie a job, the two families committed to take their 24 horses to Oklahoma.

Frank Costantini, who was president of NRHA at the time, recalls the instrumental role Carol played in making NRHA's relocation an easy transition. "Not very many of the people that were involved with the office when we were still in Ohio planned to move with us to Oklahoma City. Carol and Susie were some of the few," Costantini said.

Once settled in Oklahoma City, Trimmer took on a new role as NRHA Sire & Dam Coordinator and also served as staff liaison for the Hall of Fame Committee. This position came naturally to Carol, who found her passion in helping NRHA ensure the history of the association, its people, and their horses were never forgotten.

As the association continued to grow, so did the NRHA Reiner magazine—and that growth brought some growing pains. When the need arose for in-house assistance with the magazine, Carol's experience writing articles and press releases in the Congress press room made her a perfect fit to help. However, the Sire & Dam Program and the NRHA Reiner were both full-time jobs, and Carol had to make a choice. In June of 2000, that choice allowed her to become the Associate Editor of the NRHA Reiner.

People quickly began to notice Carol's dedication to fact-checking, making sure the magazine included only accurate information, and publishing a top-quality product. By

March 2001, Carol was named the NRHA Reiner Production Coordinator. In January 2003, she shifted into the role of Managing Editor, and by June of the same year, Carol took on the position of Senior Director of Publications.

“Carol has that big-picture perspective and the sense of history that nobody else can bring to the table because of her years and experience with the association,” said Rick Weaver, past president of the NRHA and fellow Hall of Fame inductee. “For anybody that has ever sat in on a meeting with her, there is never a question about her integrity. Her intentions are always to better the association, especially the NRHA Reiner magazine.”

That same integrity and dedication helped the NRHA Reiner become an award-winning publication under Carol’s guidance. She wanted people outside NRHA to know about NRHA’s quality magazine, so she began submitting the NRHA Reiner to the American Horse Publications annual equine media competition. Carol’s efforts paid off, and the NRHA Reiner brought home plenty of awards to demonstrate the quality of work found within its covers.

Many recall Carol saying: “Nobody will ever do a job and not make mistakes, but I would like to be remembered in this industry as someone who took a lot of pride in the product we put out, the association, and the people.” Her love for NRHA and her pride in the NRHA Reiner showed in her staff’s close relationship and their dedication to the magazine’s excellence.

Amidst Carol’s great success with NRHA, the Trimmers suffered a devastating loss in 2006 when their son passed away unexpectedly at the young age of 33. Although nothing could possibly replace the loss of her child, Carol found solace in her NRHA family who supported her through the trying situation. This only affirmed Carol’s firm belief that NRHA functions like a family, and the help she received from fellow staff and NRHA members made a major impact

on the Trimmers.

In 2013, Carol was inducted into the NRHA Hall of Fame. She was quoted as saying she was “absolutely flabbergasted” to learn of the news and cherished the chance to join so many of the people she looked up to in the NRHA Hall of Fame.

Rick Weaver, who was also a 2013 Hall of Fame Inductee, remains honored to have been inducted alongside Carol. “I can’t think of very many people that I would rather share the stage with other than Carol. She is such a good person, and she lives and breathes the NRHA,” he said. “She is just so much about her job and the NRHA; I think she is truly one of the most unselfish people that you will ever meet. She is just incredible that way.”

Carol is survived by her loving husband of 51 years; daughter-in-law Susie Reidenbach Eveland and husband Jeff; three grandchildren, Lincoln, Garret, and Anna Trimmer; her sister, Connie Murray; and her nephew and niece, David Murray and Heather Wojtkiewicz. Carol was preceded in death by her son, Paul Lloyd Trimmer.

Everyone who had the pleasure of knowing Carol recognized her vibrant soul and her passion for life and the many things she loved. She loved her dogs, Max and Simon, who never left her side, and was an avid fan of professional bull riding and NASCAR.

Carol’s passing leaves many with tears in their eyes, pain in their hearts, and a void in their souls, and she will undoubtedly continue to be loved by many around the world. To an NRHA superstar who has turned in her plates, those left behind wish only the best as she spins her way into heaven. Until we meet again!
