## ANDREA FAPPANI WINS HOLLYWOODSTINSELTON OPEN FUTURITY ON ITSALLINTHEGENES



With less than three months to the start of the National Reining Horse Association Futurity, many trainers are actively preparing their prospective horses. Part of that preparation process includes going to events leading up to the big show, and the Tulsa Reining Classic is a stop for many.

With more than \$60,000 in added money, the Hollywood-

stinseltown Open Futurity is a lucrative training ground, and on Saturday night, NRHA \$5 Million Dollar Rider Andrea Fappani won the Open Level 4 on Itsallinthegenes, a horse he owns with his wife Tish. The pair marked a 224, besting the field of 89 by two points. The win came with a check for \$14,593, as well as Bob's Custom Saddle and awards from Oklahoma Equine Hospital and the Tulsa Reining Classic.

“This is a gelding we bred and raised. He’s by Smart Spook and out of Electric Genes, a mare I showed a few years back,” Fappani said. “Pat Warren owned the mare and let us do some extra embryos when she was done getting hers, and we thought it would be a great cross with Smart Spook.”

Although Itsallinthegenes was bred to be a non pro horse for the Fappani family, the gelding showed a lot of talent. “This is his first outing. We think a lot of him, and he didn’t disappoint us today. We’re still trying to figure out what the plan is. My son Luca will show him at the High Roller in the Non Pro, and after that we’ll make up our mind if he is going to go to the futurity in the open or the non pro. He could go in both if he’s that good,” Fappani said.

For Fappani, the Tulsa Reining Classic presents an opportunity to put some pressure on the three-year-olds, while still keeping them comfortable. “Today was just a consistent run. I don’t think we did anything amazing, but that’s my goal the first time out. He was spot on. Everything I asked he was there for me.” He added, “As a three-year-old, I couldn’t ask for more.”

While there are some opportunities to show in futurities closer to home, Fappani prefers the Tulsa event. “I have been coming for the last few years, and there is a reason for that. This is a great place. The Silvas have sponsored this futurity and it’s a great event,” he said. “It’s an amazing arena. It’s big and nice, and there are plenty of places to get ready here. It’s one of my favorite, if not my favorite, for me to take my three-year-olds. It’s a great place for their first time out.”

Tying for second in the Hollywoodstinseltown Open Level 4 Futurity was Fernando Salgado and Shawn Flarida. Both riders piloted their horses to scores of 222, winning \$7,772 each.

Shawn Flarida, the NRHA’s winningest rider, was at the reins of Surprized. Surprized, by Hang Ten Surprise and out of Snow White Dun It, is owned by Mike Vargo.

Fernando Salgado, rode Gunnabeabrightstar. Gunnabeabrightstar, by ARC Gunnabeabigstar out of Abbie Be Tuff, is owned by Big Star Partners.

## Cade McCutcheon & Super Marioo – Open Level 3 and Open Level 2 Champions

It's been a whirlwind month for 19-year-old Cade McCutcheon. He's been a cast member on Paramount Network's *The Last Cowboy*, which chronicled Cade and several notable riders' preparation and path to the inaugural Run for a Million Event. At that event, just a few weeks ago, McCutcheon was crowned the co-champion, winning more than \$300,000!



a pretty special horse. I just haven't ridden him a ton, so there are still some spots that could use some work, but I think he'll be a big-time player."

McCutcheon says it's the three-year-old's natural talent that impressed him. "He's a sweet horse with a lot of stop and turn. The rest of the stuff you can train, but you can't teach that. He's just got a lot of natural stop and turn, and that's a big

deal," McCutcheon said. "I thank his owner Freddie and Gunny. They let me have the horse and that's a great start."

Still in his first year as a professional trainer, McCutcheon has also been preparing his aged event horses for the futurities and derbies, including Super Marioo, with who he won the Hollywoodstinseltown Open Futurity Level 3 and Level 2 Championship with a score of 221. McCutcheon and Super Marioo also placed in the Level 4, bringing total earnings to \$12,868.

"He was solid and honest everywhere. He felt like a show horse. He might have been even more relaxed in the pen than he was outside. I'm really excited to see what the future holds for him," McCutcheon said.

Super Marioo, by Gunnatrashya out of HA Chic A Tune, is owned by Freddie Brasfield. "Gunny Mathison let us buy him a few weeks ago. He didn't really want to sell him, but I think I'm one of the only guys he'd sell him to just because he's that good of a friend," McCutcheon said. "I think he's

David and Bonnie Silva, owners of Hollywoodstinseltown, have strong ties with the McCutcheon family. In fact, Hollywoodstinseltown now stands at Tom McCutcheon Reining Horses. "Dave and Bonnie have been great supporters of the whole industry for as long as I can remember, and especially for my family. I rode a horse for them, too," he said. "They're great friends, great clients, and I'm so happy to have their support."

Finishing in reserve for the Open Level 3 was Trevor Dare and Jerseys Baby Driver, who marked a 220, worth \$3,583. Dare and Jerseys Baby Driver, by Yellow Jersey out of Wind Her Up Chic, also placed in the Level 4, worth an additional \$4,758. Jerseys Baby Driver is owned by Janice Laney.

Taking reserve for the Open Level 1 was Trey Pool III and his horse RR Major Gunslinger with a 219. They also placed in the Level 3 and Level 4, bringing total earnings to \$6,103. RR Major Gunslinger is by Gunnatrashya and out of Starbucks Destiny.

## Hava Vital & Gunna Chic This – Open Level 1 Champions

With a score of 218, Hava Vital and her horse Gunna Chic This won the Open Level 1, and placed in Levels 2 and 3, winning more than \$3,100. Vital purchased the mare, by Magnum Chic Dream out of Gunna Joy, as a yearling, and rode her for a couple years. "I decided not to sell her so I'd have something to show, and obviously that was a good decision," she said.



Gunna Chic This was Vital's only futurity entry, but it paid off. "We went in and our first turnaround was so-so. She can usually turn better, but she was a little ahead of herself. We slowed down for the other side and she nailed it, and the rest was just fun," Vital said.

Next up for Vital and Gunna Chic This will likely be the Southwest Reining Horse Association Futurity in Ardmore, and then the NRHA Futurity in December. "We'll just be

working to get it all together. I think she has everything. We just need to get more confident," she said. "I thank my trainer, Gunny. He let me have her in the barn. He helps me a bunch and I appreciate every single moment."

Sean Johnson and Snipen marked a 216 to win reserve in the Open Level 1. They also placed in Levels 2 and 3, for a cool paycheck of \$1,487. Snipen, by Lil Joe Cash out of Whiz N Snap, is owned by Top Fuel LLC.

## MANDY MCCUTCHEON WINS XCS RANCH NON PRO FUTURITY ON SPECIAL NITE MOVZ



Mandy McCutcheon won the SmartPak Non Pro Derby on Thursday, and returned to the Ford Truck Arena at the Tulsa Reining Classic to win the XCS Ranch Non Pro Futurity.

McCutcheon won the day's title on Special Nite Movz with a score of 216. It was the three-year-old reiner's first event, although McCutcheon used the Toyon Ranch Emerging Horse Futurity earlier in the week for a schooling opportunity. "We did that to practice a bit. We had a few things to fix. The things that went wrong there were little things

I needed to smooth out. Today was the first time I showed him a little bit harder. There were a couple places where he wasn't sure where to go, but he figured it out quick and tried to do what I asked him to," McCutcheon explained.

In addition to a check for \$5,167, McCutcheon was also presented with a saddle from Bob's Custom Saddles, and awards from Oklahoma Equine Hospital and the Tulsa Reining Classic.

Mandy and her husband Tom raised Special Nite Movz, by National Reining Horse Association \$2 Million Sire Gunners Special Nite. The colt's dam, Ms Whiz Dunit, is equally impressive, as she was the horse Mandy rode to win the 2013 NRHA Futurity and the 2014 National Reining Breeders Classic Non Pro Championship. "That mare is now owned by Tamarack Ranch, but we raised this colt and he's been in our program the whole time. I really like him," she said.

Special Nite Movz is nicknamed Pirate because of a small blemish. "He has an eye that's a little funny from an old injury. That flaw is probably the reason we still have him, but it's not a flaw to me. I don't mind it," McCutcheon said.

McCutcheon credits her close-knit team for her success. "For me it takes a whole village to get me where I'm going. My dad Tim (McQuay), Tom, Debbie (Brown), Fernando (Salgado), and my son Cade all have a part in getting me here. I don't just say that. It's the truth. It takes a strong team to be successful," she said.

This year, XCS Ranch joined the Tulsa Reining Classic sponsor family. "As always, we know that these horse shows can't happen without great sponsors. For XCS Ranch to step up and sponsor the Non Pro Futurity makes us all really grateful," She said. "The Schumachers and their team are great supporters of reining and we really appreciate it."

## **Ryan Humphrey & Chics R For Shootin Non Pro Level 4 Co-Reserve Champions and Non Pro Level 3 Co-Champions**



Ryan Humphrey, of Whitesboro, Texas, and Chics R For Shootin were part of a three-way tie for the reserve title in the Level 4, and the Championship of the Level 3. The pair marked a 215.5 to win \$4,370.

Out of Commanderspark-inchic, Chics R For Shootin is extra special to Humphrey. "She is a daughter of Guns R For Shootin that we bred and raised, and is from his first

foal crop," Humphrey said of the stallion he owns and stands at Humphrey Quarter Horses. Guns R For Shootin has lifetime earnings exceeding \$115,000 and was a finalist at all the major reining events.

It was Chics R For Shootin's first event. "I was hoping she would be as good here as she is at home. We went in the arena and she was right there. I probably could have ridden her a little harder, but she was good," Humphrey said. "I didn't have to do a whole lot to prepare her. She was the same in the pen as she was outside warming up, and I couldn't be happier with her."

Humphrey voiced his appreciation for his friend Ruben Vandorp. "Ruben has been helping us with her, especially this spring. With breeding season, we didn't get to ride much, so he was helping a lot," he said. "I thank my wife, and Ruben and all of his team," he said.

## **Tammy Wagman & Cowgirls Good Time Non Pro Level 4 Co-Reserve Champions, Non Pro Levels 3 – 1 Co-Champions**

From the beginning, Tammy Wagman of Tulsa, Oklahoma was a major force in the creation of the Tulsa Reining Classic, so it's only fitting that, when she decided to make a return to the show pen after a three-year hiatus, it would be in the Ford Truck Arena.

Wagman and Cowgirls Good Time tied for the reserve title in the Non Pro Level 4, and the Co-Championships of the Non Pro Levels 3 – 1, winning \$5,895. "I'm super

excited. This is a horse that I raised myself, and is my first foal crop from Redhead Reining LLC," Wagman said. "It's nice to be back in the

## **Andrea Stillo & Gold N Ebony – Non Pro Level 4 Co-Reserve Champions, Non Pro Levels 3 – 1 Co-Champions**

Andrea Stillo wasn’t planning to enter Gold N Ebony in the Non Pro Futurity, planning instead to just use the week in Tulsa for schooling in preparation for Las Vegas. “We were here just for the schooling, because this was her first time at a horse show. The schooling yesterday was really nice, so my wife Mirjam said she thought I should put her in the class. I said maybe, but she entered me. It was a great choice,” Stillo said.

Stillo and Gold N Ebony took home \$5,895 for their 215.5 run. “The run today was very smooth. This mare is very easy to ride, and preparing her is



very easy. I just got in the pen and tried to do it as clean as possible. She was with me all the time, and I think we’re going to have a lot of fun together,” he said.

The Stillos purchased Gold N Ebony, by West Coast Whiz out of Smart Shiny Spook, from Amabile and Strusiner.

“Mirjam tried her for a customer and she didn’t work for them, but she said I needed to try her because she’s so nice. I tried her and loved her right away,” Stillo said. “I thank my wife for everything.”

## **Kelle Smith & Spookadoodlede – Non Pro Prime Time Champions**

Kelle Smith laughingly referred to herself as the Prime Time Circuit Champion of the Tulsa Reining Classic, having won the Prime Time Division in both the SmartPak Non Pro Derby and the XCS Ranch Non Pro Futurity. For the futurity, Smith was riding Spookadoodlede, by Tricked Out Spook out of Tivitos Top Starlet. They also placed in the Level 4 and Level 3, winning \$2,076.

Smith purchased her in March, and showed her in Denver for the first time. “She was very green when I bought her, and the first maneuver there I zeroed,” Smith recalled. “So here I just cruised her through and was



looking for a nice, smooth run. My deal is always looking towards the NRHA Futurity, so I think what she did today was absolutely perfect.”

Smith noted how talented the mare is, saying, “She’s a big stopper. She’s beautiful. It’s crazy how pretty she is. She just does everything. I know I will have a lot of confidence in this horse come November.”

Taking second in the Non Pro Prime Time was Dr. Jim Morgan and Guns R For Girls, another Guns R For Shootin foal out of Dun Its Deja Vu. The pair won \$438.

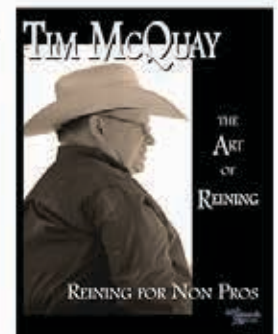
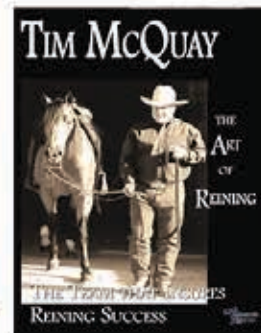
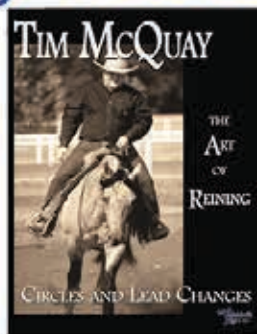
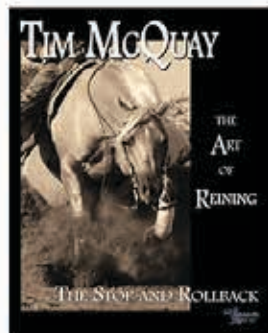
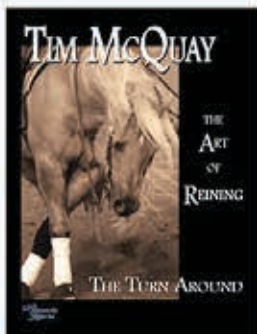
Cee Mr Stop only has a short layover before heading to

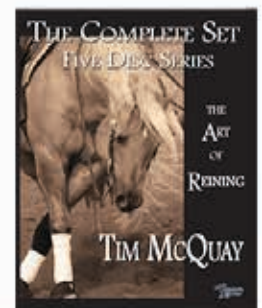

Cade McCutcheon took the reins of Gunnersrufride from his father Tom McCutcheon following the NRBC earlier this year. “My dad showed him last year and gave him to me. This horse just needed to grow up a little bit. This is the first time we’ve shown him since NRBC,” McCutcheon explained. “He’s a good horse. He’s good minded, it just took a little bit of time for him to get where he needed to be to be competitive in the Derbies.”

With a score of 221, it’s clear that McCutcheon and Gunnersrufride, by Gunners Special Nite out of Lil Ruf Showgirl, are on the right track. The pair also placed in Levels 4, 3, and the Novice Horse, earning \$5,956 for owner

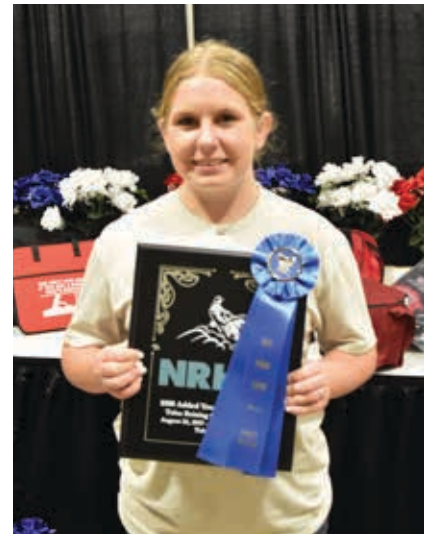
## Natalie Mauzerall & Heavens Bells Youth 13 & Under Champions

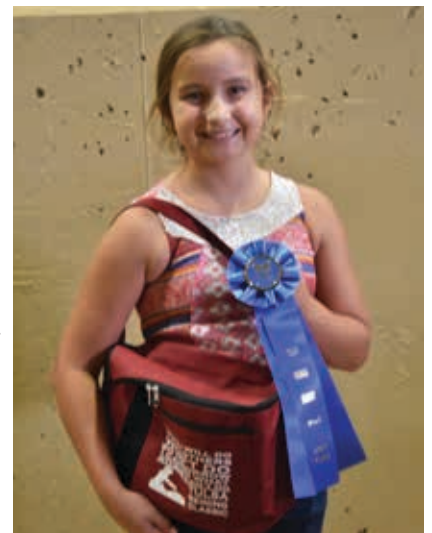
## Emma Vanlandingham, Victoria Watchous, and Sophia Schulman Rookie Youth Co-Champions

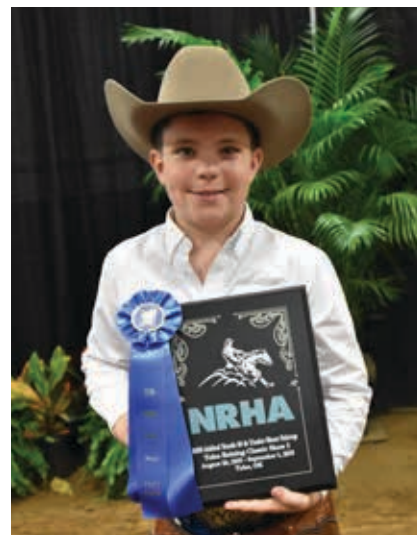
## Colt Mitchell & Playgun Chic Olena Short Stirrup (1) Champions

## NEW VISITOR RECORD MADE AT 2019 AMERICANA

Americana 2021 scheduled for September 8-12

Augsburg is Europe's western riding and western lifestyle capital - Americana 2019 proved this once more. 52,700 visitors were drawn to this still unique mixture of top-class sport, trade fair and entertainment. That was a new visitor record. Many of the visitors covered 300 kilometers or more. Some of the evening shows had been sold out for months, and advance ticket sales had never been better than this year. The importance of Americana was also underlined during by US Consul General Meghan Gregonis, who declared Americana the "largest ranch in Germany": "The biggest export hit is the American lifestyle. The fascination of the Wild West is particularly noticeable in Germany," said Gregonis.

Three hundred twenty-seven exhibitors from 14 countries presented their products. The halls were already crowded on the first day of visitors. But not only were the exhibitors

highly satisfied with their turnover, the 350 riders from 19 nations were also enthusiastic: "We received a lot of positive feedback on the quality of the ground and the good care of the horses," said the Sports Directors Sandra Quade and Joachim Bochmann. "That is always a matter close to our hearts."

In total, Americana 2019 was about 48 classes and about 650 starts, for which prize money of EUR 160,000-added was awarded - plus a lot of prizes. The number of starters in some competitions had increased by up to 60% compared to the 2017 Americana. New in the program were a Ranch Riding Non Pro and a Ranch Speed Trail. Highlights of the event were still the NRHA Bronze Trophy, the European Championship Cutting and the ERCHA Futurity as well as the Ranch Riding Open.

### First class Bronze Trophy Open Final: Ann Fonck rides to the Highscore

The final of the EUR 40,000-added NRHA Bronze Trophy Open was the highlight of the Friday evening show at Americana. In front of a hall sold out to the last seat with 5,000 spectators, some of the best riders in Europe competed in an event that could hardly be surpassed in sporting highlights and excitement. NRHA Two Million Dollar Rider Bernard Fonck, who was one of the absolute favorites, was unlucky: his gelding Missedouttinseltown was injured during the night and had to be cancelled.

NRHA Million Dollar Rider Ann Fonck won on Diego Dalla Gassa's Gunners Specialolena (Gunners Special Nite x Dolly Jac Olena). The 5-year-old mare bred by Luigi Parise, was the



youngest horse in the field and one of three that the Belgian rider had ridden to the final. The mare presented herself fresh with outstanding turns, finest speed control and finally three Mega Stops – the score: 228!

"This mare has a fantastic mind! Gunners Specialolena was with me all the time, and I'm overjoyed with all three horses," beamed Ann Fonck. "All three horses were great, but Gunners Specialolena was the freshest horse with her five years, while the other two were more tired after the long days at the fair."

Even Grischa Ludwig was not able to exceed the high score set by Ann Fonck this time. With his European Championship gold medalist Coeurs Little Tyke (Coeur D Wright Stuff x Shine My Gun) owned by Hans Georg Holzwarth, the FEI European Champion took full risks and made a super run. A 225 was the result, and that was second place. Ludwig also rode Nu Chexomatic for Jacpoint QH with a 224.5 to 3rd place. With the 12-year-old palomino gelding by Nu Chex To Cash he was second in the 2017 AMERICANA Bronze Trophy. "I am totally happy", says Grischa Ludwig. "Both horses ran well and I am in the money twice. This is the best reining show in the world for me."

Ann Fonck and her 8-year-old mare Spook N Perla, with whom she had led the go round, followed in 4th place with a 223.5. Fifth was Markus Süchting aboard Susanne Schöning's Spotlight Charly (222.5). NRHA Million Dollar Rider Rudi Kronsteiner came in 6th with Jennifer Nixdorf's AB Peppy Diamond scoring a 222. Rudi had broken his left foot before Americana and still didn't want to miss the start. But it showed in the final that he could not use his left leg like it should be, especially on the right circles. Therefore

his performance is all the more remarkable!

Also in 6th place was again Ann Fonck, this time aboard Made In Walla for owner Sabine Lisec and Chuck Klipfel, eighth was Klaus Lechner with Cody Rooster Delmaso (221,5), with Fabien Boiron with Jac Whiz (219,5), Patrick Göschl with AC Mark This Slide (217), Markus Morawitz with Gunners Chic Magnet (215) and Nico Siguro with Sugar Little Step (214,5) and Nico Siguro with Sugar Little Step (214,5) respectively. Iam Sailors Brother (210.5) following.

### **Klaus Lechner wins NRHA Int. Open Trophy**

Austrian Klaus Lechner and Tinseltownsmokingun (Colonels Smoking Gun x Miss Tinseltown) won the NRHA Intermediate Open Bronze Trophy sacoring a 219. The 9-year-old sorrel stallion is owned by Julia Gaupmann-Lechner. Reserve Champion was Niklas Ludwig aboard Margot van Doorne's 6-year-old Mr Ricochet (Rochet Rooster x Docs Oak Rosy) who scored a 218.5.

### **Doug Allen and Kevin Gasser Co-Champions in NRHA Bronze Trophy Limited Open**

The Limited Open Bronze Trophy ended with a tie in first place between Doug Allen aboard his 5-year-old gelding Hard Not To Like (Pale Face Dunit x Lost In Tinseltown) and Kevin Gasser aboard A Surprising Dream (Magnum Chic Dream x Surprise Me Gamble). They scored a 216 each becoming Co-Champions. Henry Kühnel and Trudy Sailor Bar (Frozen Sailor x Snappy Bleach) placed third scoring a 215.

## **Celina Bachleitner claims NRHA Bronze Trophy Non Pro**

With a 220.5, 17-year-old Austrian Celina Bachleitner and her gelding Paintball Gun (Colonels Smoking Gun x Darelins Not Painted) claimed the NRHA Bronze Trophy Non Pro. Two riders tied for the Reserve Championship: Julia Gaupmann-Lechner aboard her Tinseltownsmokingun (Colonels Smoking Gun x Miss Tinseltown) and Piet Mestdagh aboard Reining Whiz (Topsail Whiz x Rush N Cat). Both scored a 217.

### **Julia Gaupmann-Lechner wins NRHA Intermediate Non Pro Trophy**

After winning the NRHA Intermediate Open Bronze Trophy with Klaus Lechner in the saddle, 9-year-old Tinseltownsmokingun (Colonels Smoking Gun x Miss Tinseltown) also claimed the EUR 7,000-added Inter-



mediate Non Trophy two days later under his owner Julia Gaupmann-Lechner and also took the lead in the go round for the EUR 10,000-added Non Pro Trophy. A score of 217 points was awarded by the judges for an outstanding run. Julia was the 2017 NRHA European Affiliate Int. Non Pro Champion with the sorrel stallion. Klaus Lechner, who won the Austrian RHA Futurity Intermediate Open just before the AMERICANA, started with the stallion at the FEI EM for Austria and was Maturity Champion in Wels.

"I don't know what to say - this horse is simply unbelievable," Julia beamed after her ride. "Tommy is simply a 150% reliable horse who is always 100% with me. We have only had him back in training since July, after eight months in his breeding station, and for me, the AMERICANA is only the second tournament with him after two years of baby break. You can't really describe this horse, and his babies are the same."

Three riders shared the Reserve Championship scoring a 214.5 each: Attilo Bonarelli aboard GH Dreaming Dirty (Dirty Dancer x OT Taris Minnik), who was already co-champion in the Limited Non Pro Trophy with this horse, Piet Mestdagh aboard his 12-year-old stallion Reining Whiz (Topsail Whiz x Rush N Cat), who already has over \$65,000 NRHA LTE, and Celina Bachleitner with Paintball Gun. The 17-year-old Austrian from Salzburg, who trains with Henson Hasenauer, is multiple national champion and was 2016 FEI European Junior Champion.

### **NRHA Limited Non Pro Trophy goes to Richard Forster**

In the NRHA Limited Non Pro Trophy, the winner was Richard Forster aboard Jacs Royal Boonsmal (Royal Boonsmal x Zans Glenda Jac) who scored a 215. Co-Reserve Champions were Robert Hesse aboard SB Great Rendition (Great Resolve x Hot Rendition) and Attilo Bonarelli aboard GH Dreaming Dirty (Dirty Dancer x OT Taris Minnik) – the scores were 213.5s.

### **Rudi Kronsteiner becomes NRHA Maturity Champion Open 5 years & older**

Scoring a 223, NRHA Million Dollar Rider and multiple past NRHA World Champion Open Rudi Kronsteiner and Jennifer Nixdorf's AB Peppy Diamond (OT Taris San Peppy x Mare Made) won the NRHA Maturity Open 5 years & older. The 10-year-old stallion has got more than \$80,000-added NRHA LTE. With Kronsteiner, he was 2017 NRHA World Reserve Champion Open and fourth in the team competition of the 2018 FEI WEG in Tryon.

NRHA Two Million Dollar Rider Bernard Fonck and QT Red N Run (Dun It On The QT x Moms Lil Ruffian) placed second scoring a 222 for owner Jan Tobias Kock. Two riders tied for third place scoring a 218 each: Niklas Ludwig aboard Mr Ricochet (Ricochet Rooster x Docs Oak Rosie) for owner Margot Van Soorne and Levin Ludwig aboard Walla Whiz Keen (Walla Walla Whiz x Keen Little Katie) for owner Olga Hofmann.
