ISABELLA HALL SHINES AT FIRST WCRHA SHOW OF YEAR!

Eight-year-old Isabella Hall and Reeboks Rerun had a particularly good showing at the first show of the season for the West Coast Reining Horse Association. The Affiliate #1 was held on March 6-8, 2020 at the Rolling Hills Equestrian Center in Corning, California. “Bella” rides under the tutelage of her proud grandmother, Jeanne Levine, who hails from Nevada. Bella and “Reebok” came away with wins in the Short Stirrup, 13 & Under Youth, and WCRHA Youth classes as well as sharing the Championship honors in the Unrestricted Youth class with scores from 68 to 72.

Levine relates that Bella is “a natural” when it comes to horsemanship. She has been riding since she was about eight months old. She would ride in the saddle in front of her Grandma Levine at WCRHA shows, and as soon as she could talk, she would say, “Lope, Gramma, lope!” She loved to go fast!

Bella is home schooled and gets to ride every day. Her favorite maneuver is the stop. She doesn’t get to practice the stops very much at home, so she really enjoys the extra stopping at the shows.

Levine reported that winning the 13 and Under class at this show was probably Bella’s most memorable win to date



as 2020 is only Bella’s third year of showing reiners and her second with Reebok. She was “a bit intimidated” to show in her first 13 & under class as she had only shown in 10 and under classes before. Normally, she would leave the show pen asking how she can do better; however, this time, “she was speechless!”

Seventeen-year-old Reeboks Rerun is owned by McLeod Family Farms, LLC. Jeanne has nothing but wonderful things to say about Reebok, who has carried many riders to great success over the years. She says that she has never seen another horse like Reebok. “He is such a happy horse. He loves his job and looks forward to getting in the trailer and heading to the show.”

Bella’s success with Reebok has “changed her life.” Levine said that Bella is much more confident, talkative, and is much more social since she has been riding Reebok. Levine expressed her gratitude to the McLeod family for their generosity in allowing Bella to ride and show Reebok. Bella’s goal for 2020 is to qualify and show in the 13 and Under class at the AQHA World show and at the NRHA Futurity. The outlook is promising as she couldn’t have a better partner than Reebok!

2020 COMPETITION CALENDAR IRHA AND ELEMENTA, AN OUTSTANDING SEASON!



The Prime Ministerial Decree published in Italy on March 9, indicates that the Covid-19 health emergency affects the whole nation. We are all closely following the evolution of events from the perspective of health, social and economic effects with concern. We are also aware that the various problems we are facing, including the “false start” of the competition season, has affected our sport as well as others.

Driven by the desire to boost confidence in our sector, so necessary in moments like this, Italian Reining Horse Association (IRHA) and ELEMENTA, in the wake of

the collaboration sanctioned by the Members' Meeting of February 22, have decided to respond by resetting the Italian show calendar as required by these early months of the health emergency. This progressive idea is to focus on the second half of the year by preparing a sparkling summer and autumn for athletes.

Having notified the NRHA, IRHA and Elementa thus announce the 2020 Calendar will be structured as follows:

All events are NRHA approved. Membership of the NRHA for 2020 will, therefore, also be required for the Finals of the Italian Championship.

The April, September and November events will be organized by the IRHA with the technical support of TFY (Giancarlo Doardo), a company that has been working alongside the Italian Reining Association for many years. The events in June and October will be organized by Terra Communication (Domenico Lomuto), the Elementa group company that deals specifically with events management and which demonstrated its quality more than adequately at the 2019 Fieracavalli with the Elementa Masters Premiere. The Show Secretary office will be organized jointly by the

IRHA and Elementa for all events.

The IRHA expresses satisfaction with the agreement reached and the calendar resulting from it that ensures the continuation of the 2020 competition season, despite the difficulties imposed by events relating to the health emergency. In particular, the fact that the European Futurity will remain in Italy is considered extremely important. This outcome was obtained thanks also to the collaboration of Elementa which will contribute 50% of the added money and has also decided to finance the reconstruction of the ground of the Cremona arenas. IRHA also wishes to underline that for the first time, the added money for the Finals of the Italian Championship has reached the figure of €150,000 thanks to the support of Elementa, Eleuterio Arcese and other partners.

For its part, Elementa wishes to stress that its considerable economic input for the NRHA-IRHA events (Maturity €150,000, EuroFuturity €200,000, part of the €150,000 added money for the Finals of the Italian Championship), as well as the purses of the events it organizes, is intended

as a clear sign of the shared desire to move in unison for the well-being and growth of the sport.

Some details are still to be defined, such as the venue for the Elementa event in October which will be held in a prestigious sports facility in Italy's capital, while the IRHA is evaluating the possibility of combining the European Futurity, class in class, with a 4YO IRHA Futurity open to horses not enrolled in the NRHA Nomination Program and therefore, as things stand, currently excluded from the added event.

The new program, jointly defined by the IRHA and Elementa, invests in the 2020 season beyond the health emergency, expressing confidence in a recovery of the Italian economy to which our sport also contributes with its activities. Hence, the hope is that the changes introduced will allow everyone to fully recover their season's commitments.

NRHA THREE-MILLION DOLLAR SIRE NU CHEX TO CASH PASSES

Over the weekend National Reining Horse Association (NRHA) Three Million Dollar Sire Nu Chex To Cash (NU Cash x Amarilla Chex) passed away. At 30 years old, Nu Chex To Cash's contributions to the reining industry can't be denied.

Before entering the breeding shed, "Chex" built himself a reputation as a big stopper in the show pen. Born in April 1990, Chex was shown from 1993 to 2002. With Jessicah Keller at the reins, the pair won world championships in the

Intermediate and Limited Open divisions. They were also the reserve champions in the freestyle reining at the 2002 All American Quarter Horse Congress.

Showing his versatility and athletic ability, Chex was the first horse to nab the AQHA High Point awards in both the reining and working cow horse in the same year.

For the last 25 years, Chex spent his life at Hilldale Farm raising kids and foals alike. The earner of more than

\$57,000 in NRHA lifetime earnings (LTEs), Chex found his perfect match in NRHA Million Dollar Dam and Hall of Famer Snip O Gun. The two produced some of the greats, including Hot Smokin Chex, Chexmaster, and Big Chex To Cash.



comparable to few others. He also sired household name Lil Joe Cash (out of RS Lilly Starlight) who was the 2011 NRHA Futurity Open L4 Champion with NRHA Five Million Dollar Rider Andrea Fappani aboard. "Joe" has earned more than \$279,000 in NRHA LTE.

Inducted into the NRHA Hall of Fame in 2010, Chex is best known for siring NRHA Eleven Million Dollar Sire Wimpys Little Step (out of Leolita Step). Wimpys Little Step went on to be the 2002 NRHA Futurity Open Level (L) 4 Champion as well as the All American Quarter Horse Congress freestyle champion. Both titles were achieved with NRHA Six Million Dollar Rider Shawn Florida.

The iconic palomino set the standard for throwing offspring with ideal conformation, athleticism, and a mind

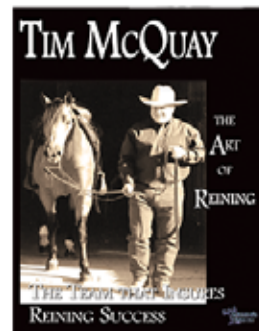
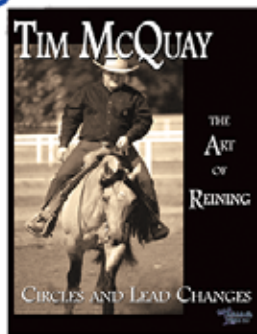
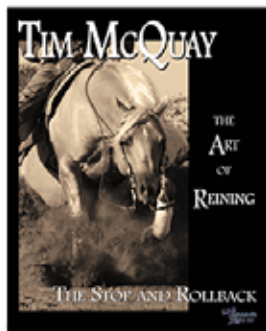
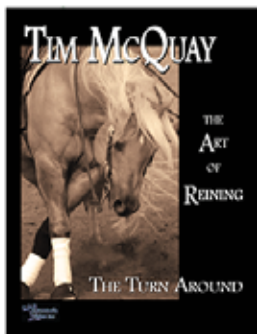

NRHA LOOKS FORWARD TO RETURNING TO THE SHOW PEN

March 28, 2020 – Oklahoma City, Oklahoma – Just two short weeks ago, the National Reining Horse Association (NRHA) made swift decisions regarding COVID-19, including instructing the office team to work remotely for at least two weeks and issuing a statement strongly encouraging event producers to postpone or cancel all NRHA-approved events through March 30, 2020. NRHA officials carefully considered both of these decisions and understand their far-

reaching implications on the industry as a whole. Following is an update on those situations as well as decisions made this week by the NRHA Executive Committee and Board of Directors.

The NRHA team will continue to work remotely for at least two additional weeks, keeping in line with mandates in place by the State of Oklahoma and maintaining the safety



of NRHA employees, their families, and the Oklahoma City community at large. The remote situation is made easier thanks to the new ReinerSuite™ system, which allows members to conduct many types of business transactions online, 24/7. NRHA team members are ready and willing to help you with all of your needs during regular business hours, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., CT, Monday through Friday. Please find their contact information at nrha.com/staff. Initiating contact with emailed documentation will allow tracking of requests to ensure that all needs are met.

Just like our members, NRHA is excited for approved events to resume, subject to local, state, and federal government restrictions. The two NRHA-owned events in Europe have new dates: The NRHA European Futurity will commence November 20–28 in Cremona, Italy, and the NRHA European Derby will take place October 28–November 1 in Lyon, France. In addition, the NRHA Derby presented by Markel is on target for its established dates, June 13–21, 2020, in Oklahoma City. Find a regularly updated list of canceled and postponed events at bit.ly/COVIDEventsUpdate.

NRHA’s Executive Committee and Board met this week to evaluate the situation and made the following decisions to ease pressure on members and even the playing field for the entire international membership.

- The 2019 awards banquet, which was to be held during the 2020 NRHA Derby presented by Markel, unfortunately, is canceled. While many people look forward to this event, it is more prudent to reduce the uncertainty and handle it differently this year. Awards will be mailed to all recipients, and winners will be recognized during the 2020 NRHA Futurity. Coverage of all the award recipients can be found in the March and April issues of the NRHA Reiner as well as online at reiner.nrha.com.

- The 2020 NRHA World Champion title races won’t include earnings from March 14 to April 30, 2020, due to shows being postponed or canceled. NRHA-approved events may occur during this time, but the earnings won’t count toward the titles.

- Qualification for 2020 Affiliate Regional Championships (ARCs) will be waived. Affiliates won’t be required to offer three qualifying shows nor provide designations and membership rosters. When a horse-and-rider pair qualifies for the Adequan® North American Affiliate Champion-

ship show at an ARC, that pair may not enter the class they qualified in at another ARC.

“One of our main focuses is the NRHA Derby presented by Markel,” stated NRHA President Mike Hancock. “We’re excited for that event to happen in June. As we’re all becoming increasingly aware, there are many unknowns and things can change, but the NRHA Board and office team are exploring all avenues to keep this event on track. Rest assured that all entries will be refunded if the Derby must be canceled or postponed.”

NRHA’s Executive Committee, Board, and office team aim to make the best decisions for the organization as a whole, and especially for the members. These are uncharted waters, which require smart decision-making for the best of the sport and our horses. To share feedback, email memberships@nrha.com. 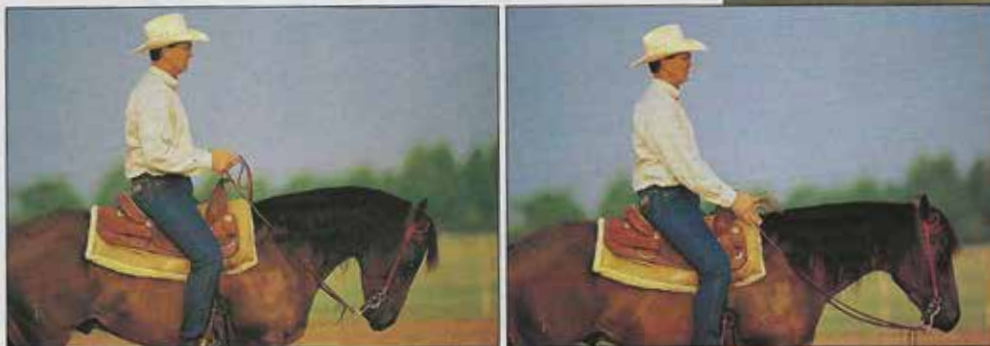

I JUST WANT him to slow down," admits one frustrated rider. "Why can't my horse lope without pulling on the bridle and trying to go faster?"
"That's exactly what we need to know to help this rider," says Jeff Petska. "Knowing *why* the horse is going too fast will help us determine *how* to correct the problem."

Getting Charged

And, according to the Texas trainer, there are many reasons a horse might have too speedy a lope.

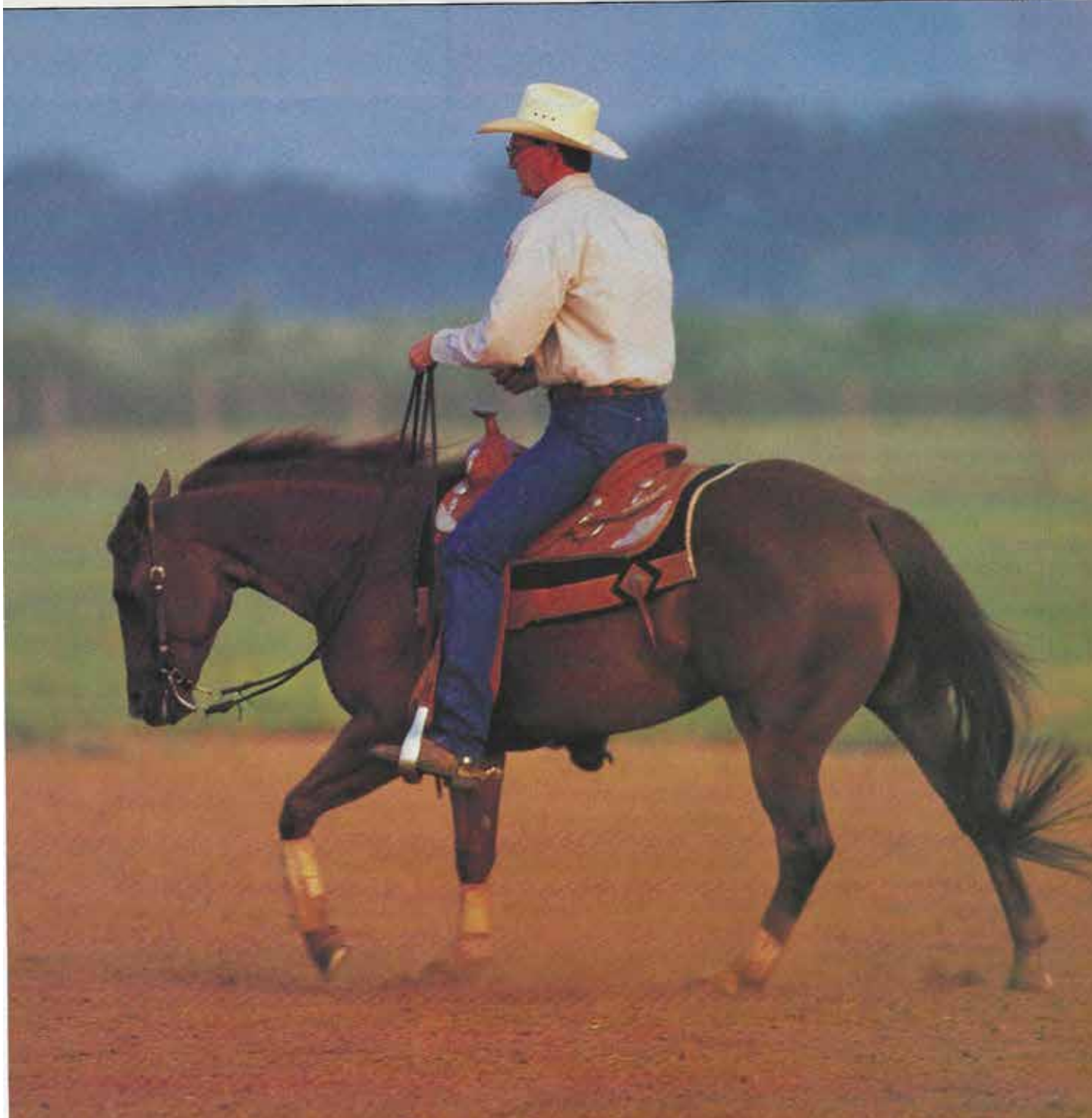
"It might simply be inexperience," he explains. "When you start a colt and he's not used to having someone on his back, he can be a little scared. A horse's natural fright response is to run, and he can be trying to get away—to anywhere but where he is. Or he could be just insecure enough to want to go back to the safety of the barn, loping faster when he's going in that direction. You can help a young horse gain confidence by taking your time and making the riding time not intimidating. Once he's no longer frightened, he'll

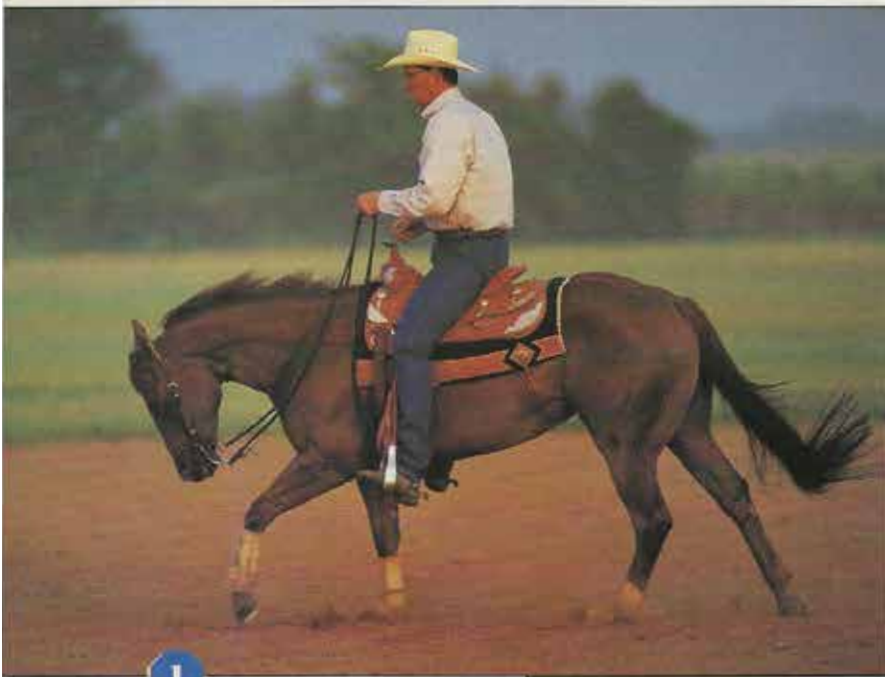


In these two close-up photos of Jeff and his horse standing still, Jeff shows how he would correct a horse who is going too fast. On the left, he picks up the reins until the slack is out and increases the pressure until the horse slows his speed. After the horse slows down, Jeff would release the pressure to reward the horse, as in the photo on the right.

The ideal is a horse who's steady at any gait, especially the lope. When signaled for a lead departure, he responds smoothly and travels on a loose rein in a collected, controlled manner—never gaining any speed unless cued to do so by the rider. Unfortunately, for many people, attaining this type of "cruise control" can seem impossible!

Loping level, collected, at the desired speed, and on a loose rein is an achievable goal.

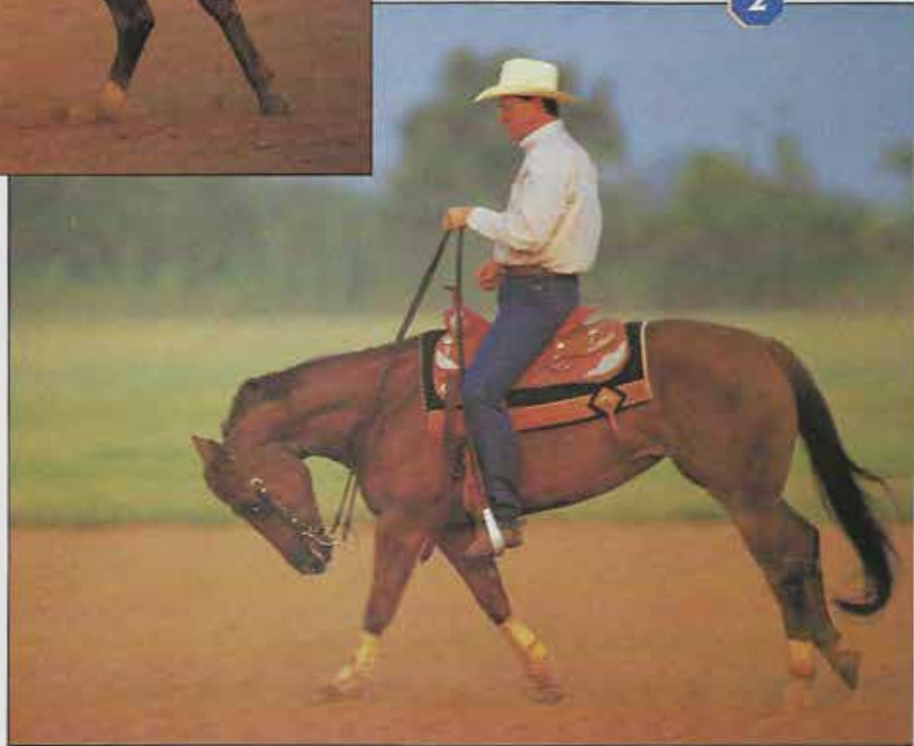




In this action sequence, Jeff demonstrates how he corrects the chargey horse.

relax and his speed at the lope will decrease.”

Another factor can be management. “Some people who can’t get their horses to slow down have created a situation that makes it difficult for them to do just that. Take, for example, the person who keeps the horse in a stall, gets home after work in the evening, then rushes to get the horse out to ride. She wants the horse to relax and be nice, but he’s just jumping out of his skin. He’s been cooped up all day and he’s bursting with energy. She’d be better off to turn him out for a few minutes before she rides or to longe him. Then, after he’d had a little time to use some of that energy, he’d be ready to pay attention to his rider.”

Sometimes people magnify the problem by trying to fix it.

“I’ve seen riders get fresh horses out of the stall and move them right into a long trot to get them a little tired. In my opinion, if you make a horse trot fast, he’ll lope fast. When I long-trot a lazy horse, it’s to lengthen his stride and speed him up. If my horse is fresh, and I want to emphasize control, I’ll ask him to jog until he’s quiet.”

Jeff points out another facet of horse handling to remember. “A horse will come out of his stall like he was put in. If you get him

in a fight and he’s scared and nervous when you put him up, he’ll remember that and be that way when you get him the next day. If he’s quiet and comfortable with what you’ve been doing when you put him up, he’ll be more receptive the next day.”

Set the stage for what you’ll do tomorrow. Emphasize control and always try to end on a positive, relaxed note. Then build on that in the next session.

Typical Solutions

In most instances, dealing with the horse who tries to go faster than

the rider wants can be frustrating. Usually people resort to one of the following options:

- 1/ Wearing the horse out so he’s tired and doesn’t want to go fast.
- 2/ Holding him back all the time.
- 3/ Putting more severe headgear on him.

The problem with these tactics is that they don’t solve the real problem. You can wear him out today, but when the horse is rested, he’s still going to be chargey.

You can hold him back all the time, but eventually it gets harder to hold him. “You see a lot of horses who have learned to pull on the bridle all the time because people

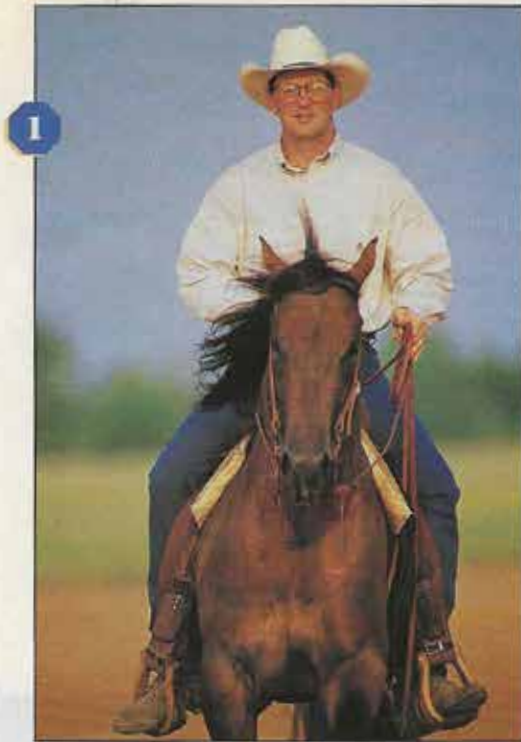

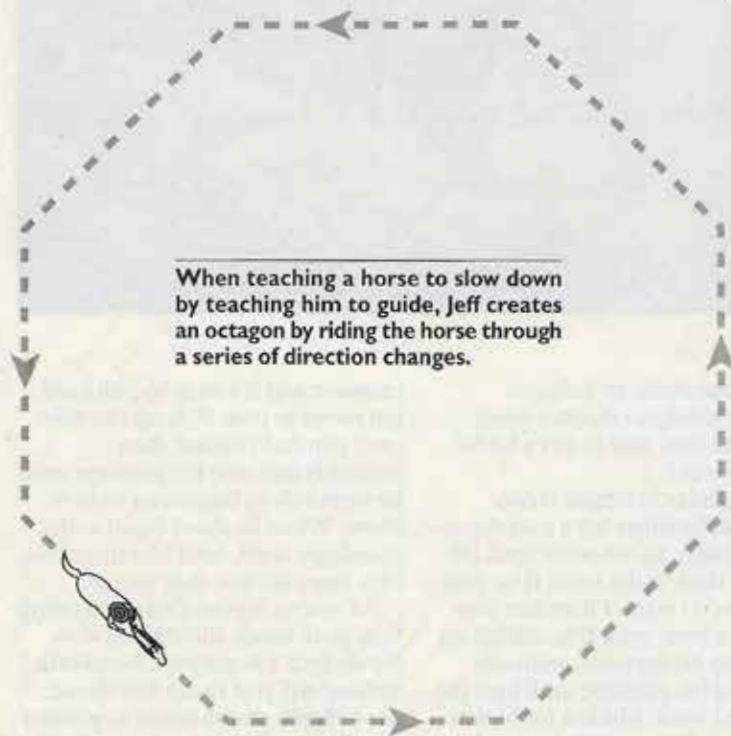
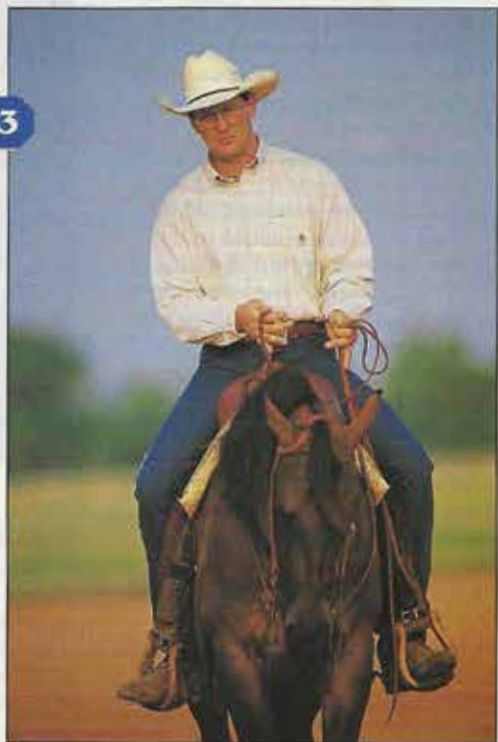

rigid and stiff.

It's essential to release the horse when he slows to the desired speed. Your release lets him know that he is now doing the right thing. If he makes a mistake again—speeding up—you'll correct him again. Then release again. Even if you know the horse is going to speed up again as soon as you loosen the reins, drop them. He'll make the mistake over and over and you'll correct him over and over, but that repetition is what finally lets him begin to understand what's right and what's wrong.

The key is repetition. It may take 10, 20, 30, 40 times before you feel a response. But to give him confidence and fix the problem, you must cue him exactly the same way over and over. If you do it smoothly 25 times, then get irritated and jerk on the reins, you've just undone all the good you did.

"And, remember," Jeff emphasizes, "the horse doesn't learn from the *pressure*, he learns from the *release*! There has to be a beginning and an end—pick up, slow down, release. If there's no reward, he'll push against the continued pressure.

"It's not rocket science," Jeff stresses. "You cue the horse for one thing. When he responds correctly, you quit cueing him so he knows he made the right response. Then you repeat. Don't try to prevent him from making a mistake: just correct it when he does, then release him."

Guiding Down

Another method for getting a horse to slow down is by simply teaching him to guide. If the horse will guide off the rider's rein and leg cues, both to the inside and outside, he usually won't try to accelerate.

In the process of gaining control of a horse during training, a rider constantly handles the horse's face with his hands and his body with his legs.

"While this is a necessary part of training," Petska explains, "we are still creating a lot of drive with his hindquarters." He continues, "Sometimes we create more impulsion than we can control so that the horse begins to accelerate; and when the support from the bridle stops holding him back, he goes faster and faster. You might compare it to driving a car with the accelerator stuck. As long as you hold the brake, you

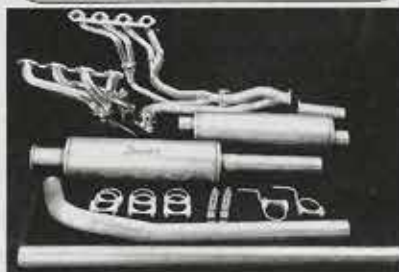

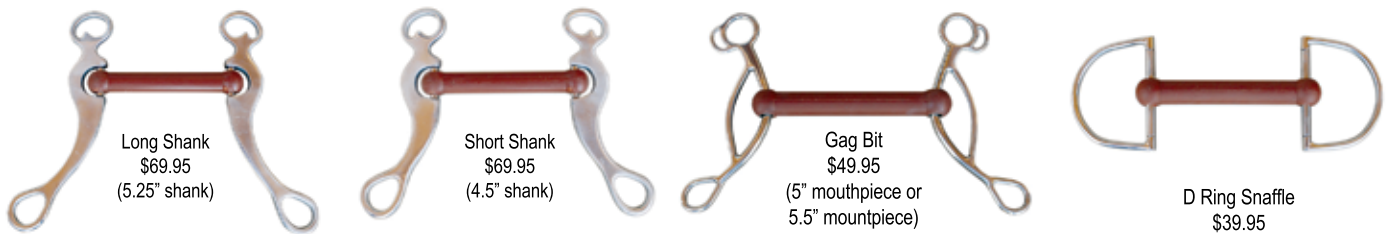

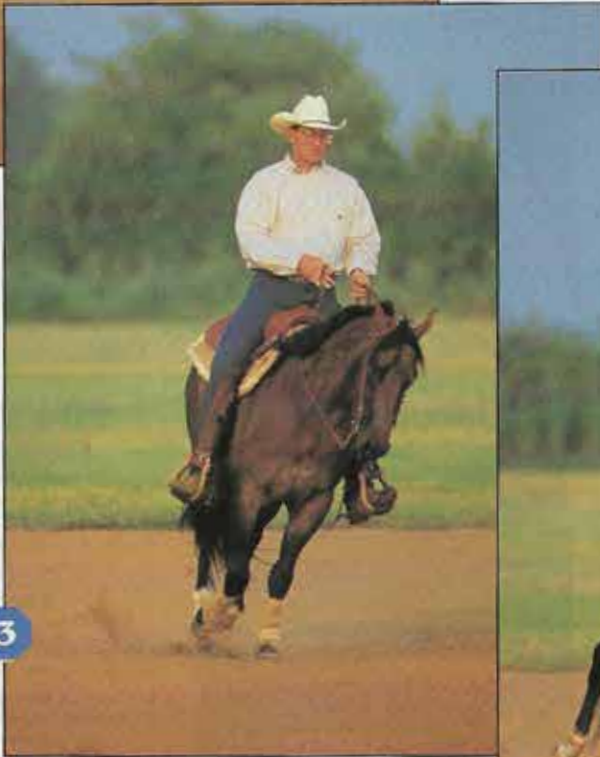
Here, you get a full view of Jeff and his horse as they perform the lateral-moving or octagonal-shape exercise to slow speed.

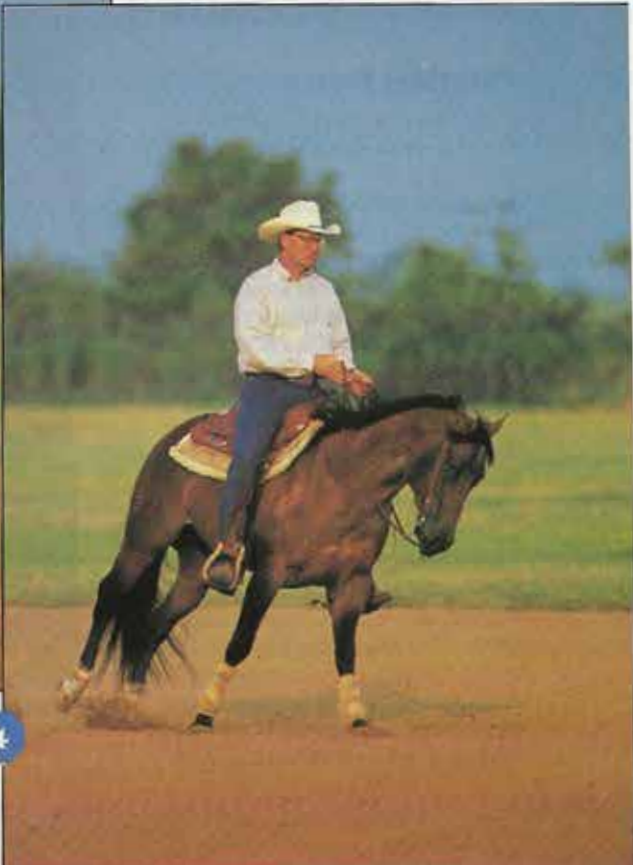

can no longer hold it back and it goes faster and faster. The same is true when you hold your horse back with bridle contact. Eventually that type control wears out and the horse goes as fast as he wants to.

"That's why we want to teach the horse to guide laterally off the legs and reins. Not only does this make him less reliant on the bridle, but it also helps us gain control of his mind."

Jeff begins by trotting the horse in a circle. "If he speeds up, sight in on a place about 10 degrees to the inside of the direction you're heading. Use your leg to cue the horse to move to the inside. Of course, in the beginning, he probably won't respond to that cue, and may even speed up from the leg pressure, so you follow that cue with just picking him up and moving his front end over so you collect and redirect him into that new direction. Then release the rein pressure and the leg pressure. When he speeds up again, find a spot, correct him to it, first with the leg, then following up with the hands. When he's redirected, release.

"The change of direction will slow the horse down a little. If he starts building speed and begins to accel-

erate, I'll take him up again, then release. I want him to think 'go left (or right)' and 'stick around.'"

At a lope, this change of direction is usually to the inside. For example, in the right lead, Jeff will steer to the right.

Ultimately, the horse will move off the leg cue, without needing the reinforcement from the reins. When he masters this at a trot, try the same thing at a lope.

"As he gets softer to your hands and legs, he'll relax mentally. Keep up with this until finally you ask and the horse makes no response other than moving laterally when you cue him with the leg.

"I start this exercise at a jog because that's a gait the horse can do for long time without wearing out. Also, at a walk or a lope, the horse's head is moving; but at a trot, the horse's head is steady. If I keep my hands and body steady, I can communicate clearly.

"At either pace, when I finally feel that he relaxes and moves off my cues instead of trying to shoot forward, I'll reward him by stopping and standing quietly, then going off in the other direction."

Relaxed Repetition

In his years as a trainer, Petska has rehabilitated lots of horses, and he feels that the key to success in any of these situations is understanding the horse's mind. "Try to

figure out where the horse's behavior is coming from."

For example, "We've all seen lots of chargey heading horses. Many ropers balance on the reins coming out of the box. If you do that long enough, the horse will learn to run against that bit, getting more chargey until he's almost impossible to hold back."

A similar scenario exists with other timed-event horses. "You'll see them backed into the corner of the box and they just sit there. Then all of a sudden they explode out. Let's consider why. A guy walks the horse in, and rides to the back of the box. When he turns around, that chute will open and he's got to go, so the only time the horse looks down the pen is when someone is going to make him run at top speed."

Knowing that looking straight down the pen means *run* to the horse, Jeff will work on convincing him that being aimed in that direction doesn't always result in a speedy departure. He'll ride the horse into the box, setting him in the corner. Predictably, he'll burst out in about 20 or 30 seconds. When he does, Petska keeps him facing down the pen until he can stop him.

"It may take three-quarters of the pen to stop him at first; but when I finally do, I'll make him stand there until he relaxes. I repeat the process over and over and eventually it will only take half the pen to stop him, then less, until he can stand quietly

Jeff Petska

Jeff Petska grew up in a ranching family in Ord, Neb., and, since childhood, has wanted to be a horse trainer. After earning his degree in marketing and management from the University of Nebraska at Kearney, he went to work for Jim Brinkman on Howard Pitzer's ranch. He stayed there 5 years and "learned a lot about getting a horse broke and what a horse can do." In 1990, Petska moved to Gainesville, Tex., to work for Carol Rose. He was hired to ride colts and rope with Bobby Lewis. Jeff took full advantage of the opportunity to work with Lewis and other Rose-affiliated trainers he calls "the best in the business." He was soon competing himself, posting such wins as the Lazy E limited open reining championship and the Southwest Reining Horse Association limited open futurity championship, as well as an American Quarter Horse Association reserve world championship in junior heading, to name a few.

In early 1997, Jeff went out on his own, basing his Petska Performance Horses training operation at Tin Cup Farm in Whitesboro, Texas. He and his wife, Lisa, have two small children: Chelsea and Tanner.

in the box facing the pen without panic. If the horse is thinking when he leaves the box, he will run to a cow better and rate better. It's important to have patience here and do lots of repetition. Remember, you're changing a learned response."

Jeff explains another interesting aspect of this cycle. "Sometimes timed-event horses are literally holding their breath in the box. They think the only way they can get air is to jump out. I teach them to back into the corner, then relax. I just hold the horse straight, until I feel him take a breath. Once the horse can tolerate the box, and can face the pen, I eventually get where I can let him come out, run up behind a steer, and stop. Finally, he can take the pressure of competition again."

Many horses learn to pull against the bridle because they were asked for top speed or put through difficult maneuvers before they were fully trained. They had a lot of mental pressure before they understood what their jobs were. In such cases, going too fast is an avoidance behavior that comes from stress. The key here is to go back to a skill level that the horse has mastered, to let him regain his confidence, then increase the degree of difficulty.

People can unwittingly put too much pressure on a horse by attempting to teach him too much all at once. "Break it down. Whether it's a reiner or a rope horse, teach one thing at a time. Let him build confidence, then ask for more."

No doubt about it, installing cruise control can be time-consuming, but the payoff comes with every ride.
