NRBC IS PROUD TO HOST THE SOUTH CENTRAL AFFILIATE REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP IN 2020!

In this year of constant changes, the Global Reining Sport Group, which produces the Tulsa Reining Classic, graciously opted to sit out a year and let the National Reining Breeders Classic take place on its dates.

That change and the move to Tulsa have given the NRBC the opportunity to host the South Central Regional Affiliate Championships for 2020.

It's an important component of this year's NRBC as there are 17 Regional Titles to be earned during the South Central ARC. Plus, anyone who enters and earns a score higher than a zero will qualify for the Adequan® North American Affiliate Championships held during the NRHA Futurity!

Global Reining Sport Group Treasurer Anne-Marie Burns has been key in the production and support of the



South Central ARC and its activities and generously continued her involvement for 2020, working enthusiastically to maintain the ARC sponsorship support with the group known as the Affiliate Corral. This group

of sponsors is committed to supporting the championships -especially the youth programs and activities.

Burns said, "We appreciate the continued support of the Affiliate Corral at the South Central ARC from our many generous donors. Every year they help make this very important part of the show amazing!"

Along with the championships and the NAAC qualifications, the Youth Team Tournament held during Affiliate Regional Championship shows is one of its most engaging activities! Each team is drawn at random and consists of

four youth, with at least one 14-18 rider and one 13 & under rider, along with two other members from either age group. A scoreboard tracks the progress and the top three scores of each team are combined to calculate each team's overall score, with the lowest score being dropped.

NRHA provides buckles and medallions for first through fifth place teams in the Youth Team Tournament and the Affiliate Corral funds prizes for every participant! Each YTT competitor is also eligible to complete the NRHA scholarship application and could potentially win a \$1,000 scholarship or \$800 scholarship based on their leadership skills, sportsmanship, and their community service activity.

2020 CONGRESS SUPER SALE GOES ONLINE

“The 2020 All American Quarter Horse Congress Super Sale will be held as an INTERNET auction. The Ohio Quarter Horse Association’s Congress Tri-Chairmen and Sale Committee made the decision to go forward with the Super Sale in an online format in order to provide breeders and owners with a strong marketplace for their horses this fall. This auction will allow continuity of the popular Yearling Sale Stakes classes as a marketing incentive,” announced Mike Jennings, of Pro Horse Services. “The bidding for the Super Sale will close on October 17th, which is the date the sale was scheduled to be held.”

Yearling Western Pleasure and Hunter Under Saddle prospects offered in the 2020 Congress Super Sale can be nominated to the Sale Stakes classes that will show as 2-year-olds in 2021.

OQHA made the decision to change the 2020 Yearling Sale Stakes Western Pleasure and Hunter Under Saddle 2-year-old classes to 3-year-old classes that will be held at the 2021 All American Quarter Horse Congress.

“The internet auction format will allow sellers and buyers from more parts of the United States, Canada, and re-



ally everywhere, participate in the Yearling Sale Stakes program and the best show horse auction in America. Several auctions that were moved to our internet auction platform for this year have set new records,” adds Jennings. “Sellers and buyers can avoid travel this year. Horse haulers are considered an essential business, so transportation for horses will not be a problem.”

Sellers will have the advantage for this year to put a full color photo in the sale catalog for no additional cost over the consignment fee. The catalog will be printed and mailed to proven, recent buyers and to those who request a catalog. Sellers will be required to provide four conformation photos for the buyer to shop from, as well as at least one video for Yearlings, show horses and prospects.

Sellers MUST ENTER BY AUGUST 25, to be included in the full color catalog. Entries received after that date can still be included in the online catalog, if approved. Early entries receive the benefit of extra promotion and advertising. All entries are subject to approval by the OQHA Sale Committee. many horses we had in training, how many babies on the ground, how many yearlings. Between the two of us, we had a dozen really great mares. It was time to take SBS to the next level and go big time. We have Arno Honstetter training out of our facility and he is doing a great job for us as well as his own clients. We also keep a few horses with other trainers which keeps it exciting."

Story Book Stables is committed to a small but elite breeding program with their two stallions, Star Spangled Whiz and Wimpys High Bid, and an exceptional band of broodmares. "We are focused on our mares. People think we only breed to our own stallions, but we breed to outside stallions like Gunnatrashya, Voodoo and a few more. We have a great crop of twos and yearlings this year."

In 2019, Brenda realized it was time to seriously begin developing an Open program. "I'm not sure when we were bitten by the Open bug, but for sure, in 2019, I wanted trainers on Open horses, especially at the Futurity, not trying to make the Open Finals on my Non Pro horses."

In the fall of 2019, Story Book Stables purchased the 3-year-old Super Marioo. The rest is history with Cade McCutcheon's historic win on Super Marioo at the Futurity in not just the L4 Open, but in Level 2 and 3 as well. "What a way to end the first year of our Open Program!"

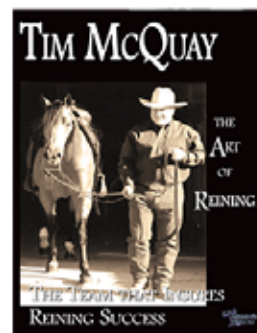
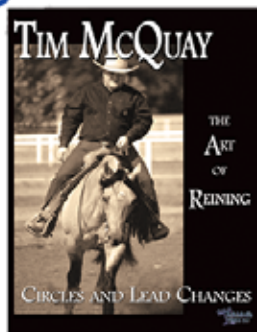
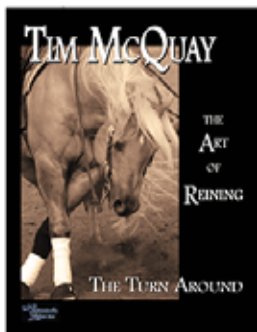

DEVELOPING A HEADSET

The controversial headset. What's too low? What's too high? What is the best way to put a headset on a young horse without resorting to gimmicks?

Regardless of how much or how little collection is ultimately desired, the horse must react to rein pressure by giving his head and allowing the rider to drive him forward into the bit. Acquiring that type of willing response takes time and training.

'For me, the key to developing a good headset on a young horse is in communicating clearly what I want him to do,' says Gisela Festerling, who uses dressage principles and techniques to train horses for a variety of Western pursuits, from reining to barrel racing. For Gisela, the ability to communicate with a horse depends on being able to maintain her posture so her signals are understandable.

'My body position is critical,' she says. 'When a rider is out of position, it affects his or her ability to correctly use the two major devices of communication, the legs and hands. Constantly having his legs out of place because of balance problems keeps the rider from using them properly for cues. He can't use them to signal the horse because he's hanging on with them, or he can't control them. If a rider has bad hands, there will be too much or too little contact with the horse's mouth. Even worse is the rider who uses the reins for balance. 'There's no finesse. It's just pull, and pull some more.'

Gisela Festerling trains at Jack Brainard's ranch, just outside Aubrey, Texas, where she uses dressage-based techniques to establish the training groundwork for her western horses.

Once the horse gives his head laterally in both directions while he is moving forward, Gisela teaches him to flex at the poll. She starts by positioning him against a fence or wall so he can't back up.

Effective horse training is based on the principle that horses learn by repetition. If a rider's lack of skill prevents him from being able to consistently repeat the same cues, it's difficult for the horse to understand what is expected.

'To train a horse to have a good headset, you must be consistent with him—showing him exactly what you want. Your hands and legs should be controlled and speak clearly to him. Throughout, you must ride the horse—not the saddle,' Gisela stresses.

In this area, Gisela's strong dressage background is an asset. She uses the same basic posture whether riding English or Western. English riding teaches balance and control—and an English saddle has nothing to help the rider hold on. The rider must learn to sit correctly and support himself with his thighs. This control translates to a more solid seat and

steady hands, crucial components for excellence in any riding style.

Therefore, evaluating your own riding abilities is the first step in developing a headset on a horse. Ask yourself the following questions.

1. Can I use either hand independently to cue my horse, without having the other hand moving with it?
2. Can I maintain a soft, even contact with the bit, never jerking the horse, but not throwing his head away either?
3. Can I maintain my seat on the horse, and still be able to use my legs to cue, with no body movement?

If the answer to any of these questions is 'no,' consider getting some professional assistance. If that's not possible, try making a video and critiquing yourself.

'To correct a problem, you have to be aware that it is a problem,' Gisela points

out. 'Most bad body position is due to not paying attention. Elbows and legs flop—the rider's seat is out of position so the feet are not in contact with the stirrups. Bad habits develop when no one is around to critique you.'

Find your own personal weaknesses and work to correct them. Try placing a piece of paper or a dollar bill under your elbows to help remember to keep them close to your body. When you see the paper or dollar fly out, it's a reminder that your arms are out of position. If your legs are a problem, put a dollar bill under each knee to help you learn to keep them snug against the fenders.

Says Gisela, 'In English riding, we drill, 'shoulders up, elbows in.' You are constantly reminded to sit up straight and look forward. You can even practice riding with a book balanced on your head!

'Make sure to keep your back upright—shoulder blades back and together, tummy in, chest up, shoulders straight and elbows and arms close to your body. A line from your shoulder through your



hip should line up with your heel, and the ball of your foot should be on the stirrup tread.

'The front of your shin should be in the center of the cinch area; heels should be down since that causes your legs to lengthen and makes it easier to keep your feet under you.'

Watch your horse. Jerky, inconsistent

hands usually result in the horse responding erratically by throwing his head, or pulling against the pressure. Transitions reflect the rider's skill level. If the horse charges from a trot to a run when cued for a lope, that's a sure sign of a problem, as is a gait change that takes four or five strides to execute.

According to Gisela, once a rider has a good seat and balance, developing a natural headset on a horse begins with teaching him to give to pressure laterally. 'The horse should listen to the bit and not resist, even when you ask him to do something he would not ordinarily do.'

'When I get a colt, he is usually already in the snaffle bit,' she explains, 'and I continue to use the snaffle bit throughout much of his training.'

With her elbows close to her sides, and arms extended forward, she has a rein in each hand, with the loose tails of the reins crossed over the horse's neck.

The distance from her hands to the bit

is short to allow her to take advantage of the full range of motion. 'I have about a foot of leverage that way, from where my hands are to bending my elbow all the way back. With a longer rein, it takes the horse more time to receive the message, and the more slack there is in the rein, the more surprised he can be from the cue. A surprising pickup on a too-loose rein is more severe on the horse's mouth.'

Gisela's upturned palms face slightly inward. To cue the horse to give his head to the side, she bends her elbow, pulling to the side and back toward her hip. 'I do this from a standstill, in the beginning. When I put pressure on one side, it is a slight pull. I'm asking the horse to yield to the pressure and follow it with his nose. When the horse gives, I release, so he knows that he has responded correctly. As he learns, it takes less and less pressure for him to give his head, and the cue becomes more of a pickup than a pull to the side. After he begins to flex to the side, I sometimes take his head and hold it there for 4 or 5 seconds, so he gets comfortable with my holding his head. This prevents him from getting into the habit of giving his head, then taking it back.

'Remember to have soft hands,' she cautions. 'Hold the reins like you would a bird. If you hold it too tight, the bird will die; too loose and it will fly away. And relax. When you stiffen your body and arms, your movements become jerky, and you can't get the cues across clearly.

'Any time you're trying to think what to do with a horse, stop and ask yourself. "Will this work for me? Does it work without abusing the horse?" Think, and have a purpose for all your actions.

'A lot of times people see a horse trainer doing something to a horse and they don't understand why, but they don't ask either. Later, they try the same thing on their own horses. Unfortunately, they may not have understood either the problem or the correction. The best thing is to watch, ask questions, then store the information away for a time when you might be able to apply it to your situation.'

As the horse becomes more adept at responding, just a pickup on the reins with the wrist is enough to cue him. 'You

want to give enough of a cue to be understood, but not a bit more than necessary.

'Once the horse is giving a little to the pressure, I move him into a walk next to the arena fence or wall, and have him flex to the inside (away from the fence) as he continues to walk forward.'

When the horse is soft from side to side, the next step is to teach him to give at the poll when you pick up both reins at the same time.

Gisela prefers to initiate this technique with the horse at a standstill, with his hindquarters against the fence or wall. That barrier prevents him from responding to the pressure by backing up. 'Ask the horse to give his head by picking up both reins at the same time, bending at the elbows, and moving both hands back

knee up, but I sit independently. I don't grab with my legs, but I don't let them hang down either.'

Once the horse flexes vertically at a standstill, it's time to ask him to bridle-up at a walk. 'I do this by moving him into a walk, then picking up the reins while I squeeze him forward with my legs. I want rein pressure plus legs to mean bridle-up. Rein pressure without legs means stop.

'The horse needs to know the difference between my pushing him into the bit to flex and picking him up to stop. I maintain leg contact all the time when I push him forward. If I don't, he should stop. But I vary the amount of pressure. I use more, then less. If I clamp the legs and hold them tight all the time, he'll

toward your hips. When he gives, release the pressure. Later, ask him to hold the position longer. Maintain equal pressure with the calves of both legs at this point, in preparation for supporting the horse with the legs later. Your goal is to reach the point where the horse gives his head lightly and lets you keep it in position,' explains Gisela.

Your legs should rest close to the horse, and you should be able to see about 3 inches of toe in front of your knee. 'I like some bend in my leg because that allows me to get more leg on the horse. Therefore, my stirrups are somewhat short. I already have contact from the

get dead-sided or irritated because I'm holding him too much.'

When the horse is soft from side to side and in the poll, Gisela uses the following exercise to continue the horse's headset education.

'At a walk, I ask the horse to bridle up (flex at the poll) with my legs and hands by squeezing lightly with both legs as I pick up the reins. Then I remove the leg pressure and sit down deeper. The horse should stop. When he does, I move my hands up to make him back a few steps, then I drive him forward again and repeat. This teaches the horse to back off the bit and stay off, and also teaches head

position. The horse should keep his head in position throughout. The big no-no is to raise the head. Ideally, throughout all the steps of this exercise, the horse should keep his head in position and stay off the bit.'

Gisela starts this exercise slowly and easily, and gradually increases the pressure as the horse gets more secure and is able to maintain his position. Once the horse has mastered the exercise at a walk, he is asked to perform at a trot.

'I allow the horse to trot with his head free, then I apply leg pressure. When older horses feel my legs, they tuck a little, as if to say, 'I know what's coming, okay.' Then I use my hands to pick up the reins. When I do this, I'm activating the horse's hindquarters and pushing them under him. My hands restrict him from going forward. My legs push him underneath. Once he gathers himself, I hold him and then release him. On younger horses, though, you have to use the reins and legs simultaneously or else they'll speed up.

'As the horse progresses and learns how to bridle-up, I start to steady my hands. Before, they moved with the motion of the horse. Now they become more steady.

'On stiffer horses that have trouble bridling-up, I alternate pressure back and forth on a loose rein in rhythm with the walk. Sometimes that helps "bump" them down a little, without resorting to a pull. Make sure to do that on a loose rein. If you do it with too much pressure, it might cause a horse to rock from side to side.'

As she increases speed, Gisela alternates rein pressure in rhythm with the two-beat rhythm of the trot-back and forth-one-two, one-two. Then she does it with the rolling motion of the lope. At that gait, there is a hesitation phase in the rhythm. When the leading leg goes forward, she picks up the inside rein and bumps with both legs at the same time.

'In an older horse, I set my hands—holding them steady and in the same position. I let the horse bounce himself off the bit. In any case, I always use my legs to maintain forward motion and drive the horse under himself.'

An aid to the rider is the running martingale. 'I use a martingale temporarily as an additional teaching tool. If the horse raises his head too high, he bumps

himself, and that helps bring his head down. I want the martingale to correct a problem. It's real important that it be fitted so that it can do its job. If the horse is doing everything right, I don't want contact with the martingale. I only want contact if his head goes up out of position. If the martingale is too loose, it has no effect; if it's too low, it's in effect all the time and doesn't teach or correct.'

Another point to remember when using a martingale, Gisela adds, is that it restricts your ability to pull to the side.

Many riders run into problems with making the transition from riding with two hands to riding with one. Says Gisela, 'There's a saying, 'You have to ride them like you show them; and it holds true. After the horse is bridling-up real well with two hands and he knows that leg pressure means bridle-up, I gradually move my hands closer together toward the saddle horn. You're going from two tools to one, so I give the horse time to gradually become comfortable with this transition.'

As the horse progresses in his training, his response time should improve. He should react more quickly to your signals, that should become increasingly more subtle.

The finished product is a horse that is willing to respond to rein pressure by giving you his head—and a headset that lasts throughout a horse's career, regardless of what he is used for.
