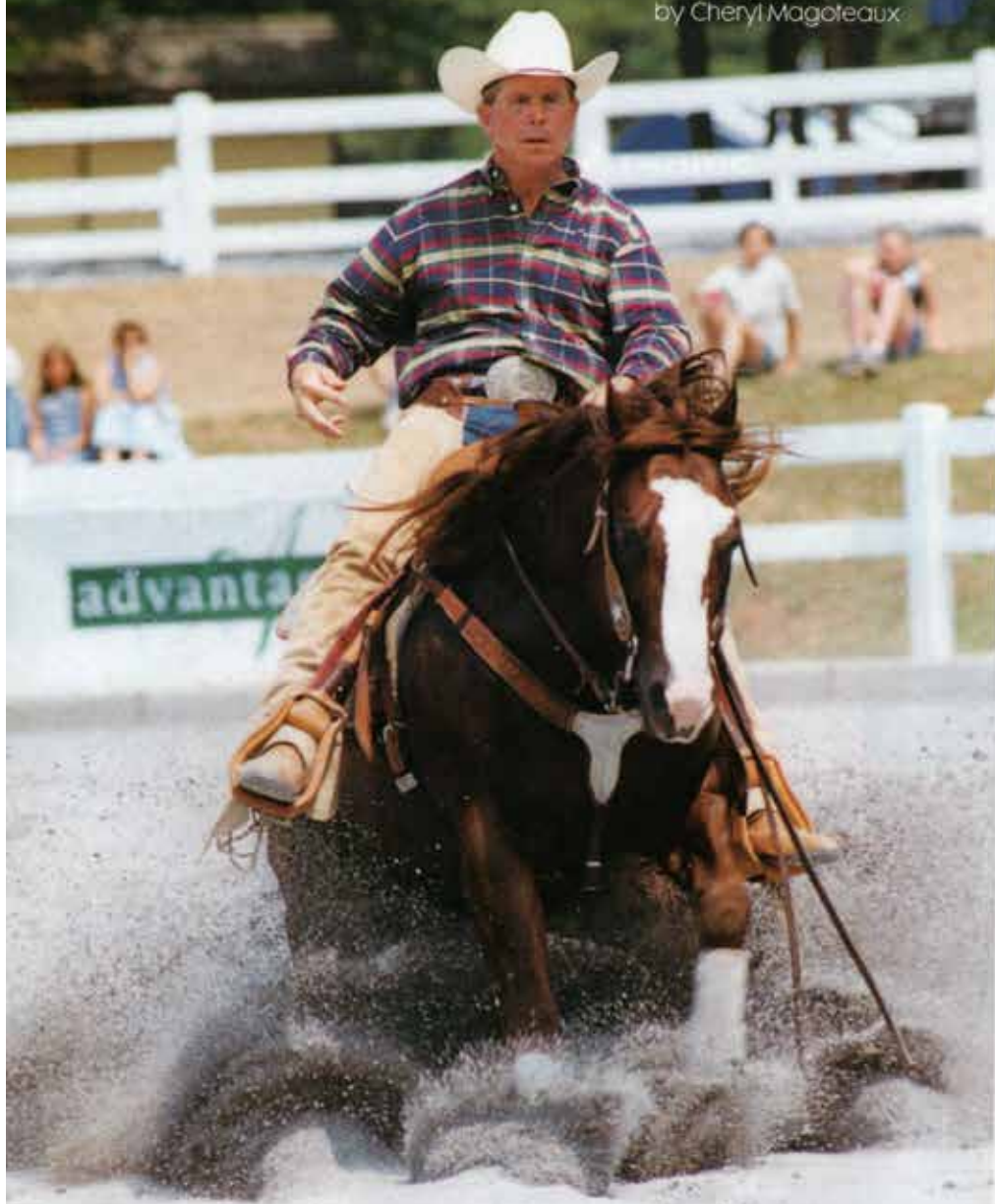

The Day the Dream Came True

Dr. Jim Morgan, a leading all-time money earner for the National Reining Horse Association, made history as the first reiner ever to compete at the Festival of Champions. Then he and partner Pete Kyle finished up as the Pro/Am Reserve Champions.

When Morgan rode into the arena on Friday afternoon, it made history.

Dr. Jim Morgan, always on or near the top of the National Reining Horse Association's leading Non-Pro list, became the first reiner ever to compete at the US Equestrian Team's Gladstone headquarters. In prior years, exhibitions had been held, and there had been preliminaries at other locations, but this was it. All the hoping, the dreaming, the planning, negotiating and waiting were finally paying off.

Reining was taking its place at the US Equestrian Team's premiere event, the Festival of Champions.

Located in the heavily wooded New Jersey landscape just outside of Gladstone, New Jersey, on an historic piece of land that was once Hamilton Farm – a facility that, when constructed near the turn of the century, was described as the largest and most lavish in the United States.

Flashes of color – red hunt jackets glimpsed through the trees, a splash and spraying foam as a driving team powered through a water obstacle – gave an entirely new background and flavor to this reining.

And when the National Anthem was played to start the competition, there were few totally dry eyes.

It was a day that meant much to many and the culmination of years of work by dedicated reiners and AQHA members.

It began, decades earlier, with the dream of seeing the Western event of reining take its place alongside the traditional English disciplines of the United States Equestrian Team in Olympic competition, and a look back over the years provides a vignette of images...

National Reining Horse Association President Dick Pieper performed a bridle-less reining demonstration in front of Princess Margaret and 50,000 spectators at the Calgary Olympics.

Also in the '80s, the NRHA St. Paul Derby began the Nations Cup, which followed the format of indoor jumper shows where four member teams from different countries competed.

The International Reining Council was another step, holding special competitions during the NRHA Futurity, featuring two-member teams from different countries.

A star-studded reining demonstration performance was given by Doug Milholland, Rocky Dare, Bob Loomis and Mike Florida at the 1996 Olympic Games in Atlanta, Georgia.

By early 1998, reining was accepted as the sixth discipline recognized by the United States Equestrian Team, and that year saw 2,268 AQHA approved shows featuring reining and 302 NRHA approved shows.

Another taste of reining came at the 1998 Bayer/USET Festival of Champions, when Bill Horn and Trashadeous gave a demonstration. Another special reining demonstration followed at the World Equestrian Games, in Rome, Italy.

The next step in the joint goal of having reining approved as the first Western equestrian Olympic event is to have the event approved by the Federation Equestre Internationale (FEI). To accomplish this, reining must be adopted by 30 National Federations within the FEI.

Currently, officials of the AQHA and NRHA are contacting representatives in 36 countries and calling on them to become official representatives for reining. These representatives will have the task of initiating the process for affiliation within their country. When this aim is achieved, reining can be introduced as an FEI discipline and will be one step closer to becoming an official Olympic event.

On June 27, after six qualifying classes and a semi-finals, the field of 93 horses had been narrowed to 21 (top 20 plus ties) reiners who had qualified for the \$100,000 Cosequin/USET Reining Championships presented by Bayer.

They had gone through the first round two days before and now it was time for the final performance, where the championships would

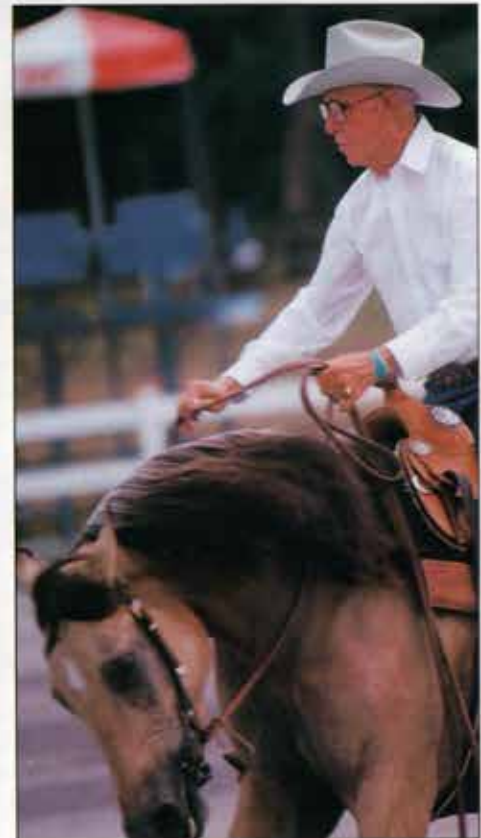

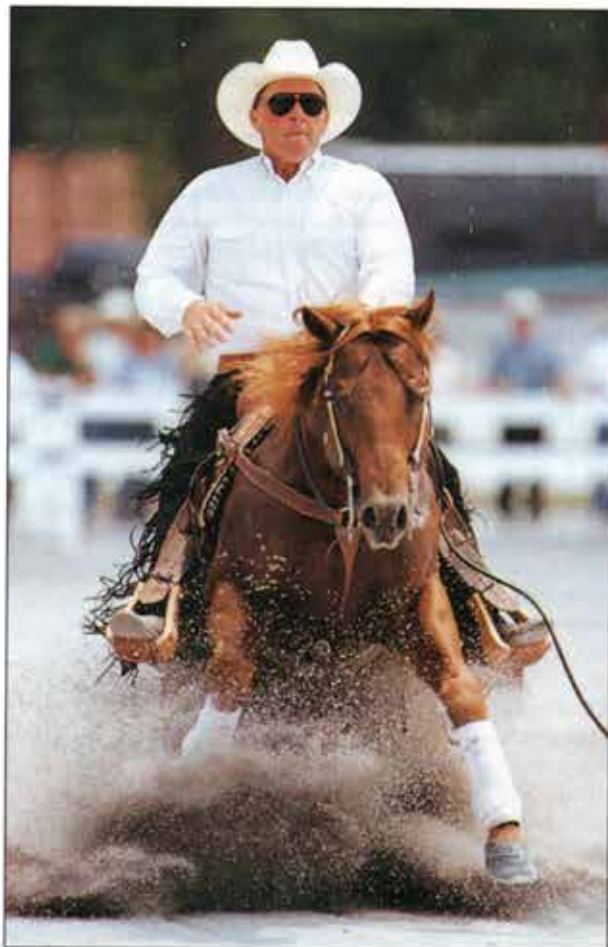

be decided. The light gray ground was gleaming on the arena the AQHA had donated to the USET, and when the ceremonies began it was dedicated with a special ceremony, with USET Executive Director Bob Standish, AQHA President Ken Smith and AQHA Executive Vice President Bill Brewer.

NRHA Hall of Famer Dale Wilkinson set the pattern, aboard Dun It The Hard Way, and he reflected, later, about the significance of the day. "It's a great honor for reining to be recognized. I'm proud of the event and proud to be a part of it."

New Jersey Secretary of Agriculture Arthur Brown was also on hand to formally welcome the discipline of reining to the USET and the state of New Jersey.

Finally, all the preliminaries were over, and the competition began.

Champion and Reserve Champion

Mike Florida and NRHA Futurity Champion Whizard Jac, owned by Dawn and William Pohl of Carroll, Ohio, had scored

226.5 to tie for the win in the first round, then they bettered that score by four points for the second round, to finish with a total of 457 and take the championship.

"Today was one of his best runs," said Florida, who added, "Friday was very good, too." Then, he said, "I love him. He's made me look great, many times!"

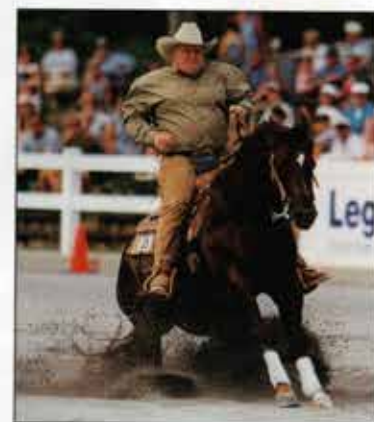
A two-time NRHA Futurity winner, Florida won one of his \$100,000 NRHA Futurity titles on Whizard Jac. How did this win compare to that one?

"My futurity win on Whizard Jack was a surprise. I knew I had a nice horse, but I was surprised I had as much horse as I did. Here, I knew I could lean on him and he never says no.

"When I pulled out of the driveway in Minster, Ohio, to come here, I didn't know I'd win, but I did know I had a lot of horse."

He continued, "He's more mature and a lot stronger."

Although official records were not available from the NRHA, an informal look shows that the \$34,022.50 paycheck likely made Whizard Jac the leading all-time money earning horse

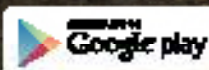
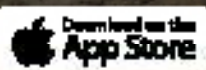

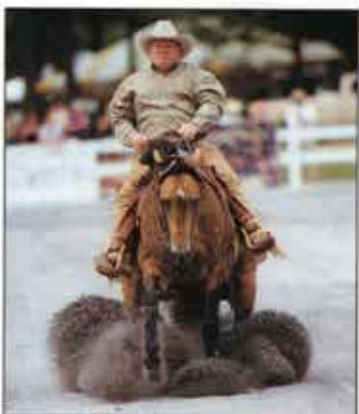

for the National Reining Horse Association. Whizard Jac and another Topsail Whiz sibling, Topgun Whiz, had been jockeying the position back and forth.

Now the title was his and he would be retired with it.

In an emotional moment during the awards ceremony, Flarida unsaddled the little sorrel stallion and the announcer revealed that the audience had seen Whizard Jac in competition for the last time.

Scott McCutcheon and Marthas Mega Jac scored 225.5 in the first round, and 229 in the second to finish with an aggregate of 454.5. Their Silver Medal finish earned \$24,145.

Marthas Mega Jac, owned by McCutcheon-Brotten, LTD was the 1997 Saddle-Smith Open Champion and the eight-year-old stallion has been a consistent winner. McCutcheon, who has won the championship or reserve title at every major National Reining Horse Association event, said simply, of the Hollywood Jac 86 son, “He’s been a great horse for a lot of years!”

Like many of the finalists, Mega Jac’s 1999 breeding season was regularly interrupted by preparation for, and competition at the preliminaries and semi-finals on the road to Gladstone, but there was no doubt in his owners’ minds that the sacrifice had been worth it.

Co-owners, Neal and Sally Broten, of River Falls, Wisconsin, are well familiar with competition on a world-class level. Neal was a member of 1980s miracle team, when he and his teammates beat the Russian hockey team to win an Olympic Gold Medal. After 17 successful years in the National Hockey League, he holds 12 Dallas Stars team records, and played on a team that won the Stanley Cup!

The Bronze Medal, and a paycheck of \$14,267.50 went to NRHA Million Dollar Rider Bill Horn and BH Backsplash. Horn, who had given a reining demonstration at last year’s Festival of Champions, was clearly a favorite with the crowd. He also claimed fourth place, and another \$9,877.50, with Trashadeous, owned by Horn and Mitch Zuckerman.

In an informal session after the Sunday performance, Flarida, McCutcheon and Horn were questioned about the event.

One reporter asked about the ground in the arena. The arena – besides being outdoors – was different than the ones at most high-money reinings. Did that have an effect?

Scott McCutcheon quipped, “It sure didn’t effect Mike’s horse!”

On a more serious note, Flarida observed, “We normally have more sand; here there’s more gravel in it and it’s more abrasive.”

But, it wasn’t the ground that was on the champions’ minds. The event, its magnitude and its effect on the industry were.

Flarida said, “This is different. We’re here and this is history we’re making. This is a whole new field of opportunity for reiners to show their seven, eight, nine, ten-year-old horses. It’s a big deal and I knew I wanted to try to take advantage of it.”

He continued, “The level of competition in being here or just getting here is tough – you come down to the 20 top horses in the nation. Everyone has to step their programs up and

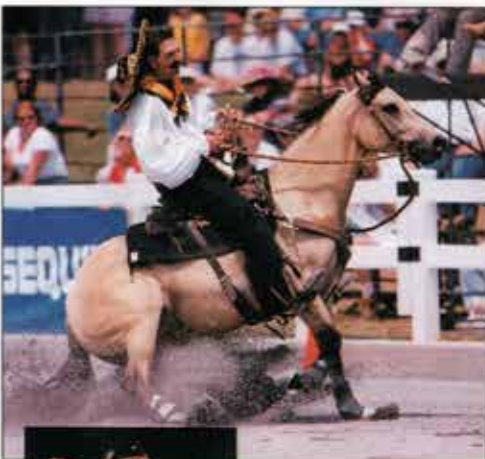

get better. I knew, going in, it would be tough, here. You've got Bill, Scott, Tim, all those phenomenal riders. You've got to get better, and as the years go by and this continues, it will just get tougher."

McCutcheon observed. "Already it's hard to find a horse to buy that's good enough to be here. You just can't find them. All the horses here are great."

All three reiners confessed to a certain awe about the event.

"Everyone knew it was tough," said McCutcheon. "These horses — all the top 20 horses that made it here — are all special. We didn't know until the end who'd win. In a way, I'm relieved to have the first one over."

Bill Horn added, "I was thrilled to be here. This means everything to me. It's an honor. It's wonderful."

When someone asked Horn if he would be back next year, he answered that he would probably not do it again with Trashadeous. What about BH Backsplash?

Horn replied, "He belongs to my wife, Kim. If he comes back Kim will ride him!"

One of the reporters who was a special guest in the press tent was a 10-year-old, covering the event for his local newspaper. When he was given the floor, he looked at all three reiners and asked, simply, "How did it feel?" He looked at Mike Florida, first, and waited expectantly.

Florida grinned, and eyed the other two reiners as he said, "I was glad I beat 'em."

As the tent erupted in laughter, the young reporter looked next at Bill Horn, who never missed a beat, saying, "I was mad I didn't win."

His gaze shifted to McCutcheon and Scott was quick with his own answer, "I was mad, too."

\$25,000 Pro/Am Team Classic

The top 20 horses and riders in the Semi-final competition during the NRHA Derby in Oklahoma City qualified to compete in the Championship reining. The next 15 were eligible to choose a partner and compete in the Pro/Am Team Classic.

If the rider was a professional, he was required to select a Non-Pro for a partner. If he was a Non-Pro, he must select a professional.

Like the Open event, the competition was based on two rounds of competition and the team with the highest combined scores from the two rounds would win.

Ohio reiner Shawn Florida rode Shannon Raymond's good horse, Freckles Top Prize, to a Semi-finals slot, but missed making the finals cut. Of course, he chose Raymond as his Non-Pro partner. Since he had qualified on Freckles Top Prize, he competed on him and

For Florida, getting ready to compete in the Pro/Am Reining couldn't have been easier. "I just warmed up for about 15 minutes, made sure he was soft in the poll and listening," he said.

His partner, Shannon Raymond, laughed. "If we could have switched horses, it would have been easier!"

"It's an honor to be here," said Raymond, at 22, the youngest reiner competing. A May graduate of Elan College in North Carolina, she's just gone to work for Mariott International in Washington, D.C.

She continued, "I've always wanted reining to be an Olympic event. This is the first step and it's also a huge goal for any rider. Coming here and riding in the US Equestrian Team event is a dream come true. I started showing a Paso Fino pony and look where it's taken me."

Shannon began riding reiners when she was 12, and seven NRHA World Championships attest to the fact that she's done it very well. She's also the third highest dollar earning Non-Pro in NRHA history.

Although there was no question which partner Shawn would pick for the Pro/Am, there was, however, some logistical problems regarding practice. "I'd work five days, take a plane to Ohio on Friday, ride the weekend and be back for work Monday. Shawn and Michelle were great; they opened their house to me."

When asked how Raymond was to coach, Shawn joked. "Does the name 'Dennis Rodman' give you an idea? No, joking aside, she's easy. She has a lot of natural talent and she wants to win. I just help her understand her horse."



Oh Mandy!

Mandy McCutcheon, of Pilot Point, Texas, was the only Non-Pro rider who qualified for the \$100,000 Cosequin/USSET Reining Championship, presented by Bayer.

"I'm honored to be a part of the first-ever USSET Reining Championship," said Mandy. "It's neat to compete with my dad and my husband." Her father, Tim McQuay, the National Reining Horse Association's all-time leading money earner, and her husband, Tom McCutcheon, a top NRHA trainer, both garnered top ten finishes.

Mandy was also the only reiner in attendance who had competed at the Festival of Champions before. In 1995, she won the Cosequin/USSET Youth/Amateur Show Jumping Talent Derby, the most prestigious event for Amateur or youth jumpers. At the 1999 Festival of Champions, she returned to the Gladstone jumping arena to show her 12-year-old AQHA gelding, Savin Face, to a fourth place finish in this year's talent derby.

Mandy remembers. "When I was getting ready to ride, I looked up and all my reiner friends were there to watch. I'd never had to jump in front of all them."

A look at the crowd confirmed her observation. Scattered throughout were big hats, wide-soled boots, and lots and lots of reiners. Although they weren't as unrestrained in cheering for Mandy as they are at a reining pen, their enthusiasm was contagious.

And, surprisingly to some, the polar opposites of traditional English discipline devotees and true-blue western reiners found lots of common meeting ground. The blend, the meeting of east and west, was working.

"Last year there were about ten cowboy hats here at the Festival of Champions," said Former AQHA President and current USSET Reining Vice President, Don Burt. "This year, everyone wants to be a cowboy!"

He smiled, then added, "We are one unit behind the horse. Everyone appreciates a good horse."

On a more serious vein, he reflected. "It's an honor to be here. Plus I knew I had one of the best Non-Pros in the country.

Shannon added, "This has been fun."

Shawn agreed and added that he needed to get to the driving competition to watch a friend, champion driver Chester Weber.

Shawn and Weber met when they both gave demonstrations at Equitana, entertaining a crowd of 30,000 plus that Shawn's performance inspired to a standing ovation. "He let me drive his team, there."

His friendship with Weber gave a clue to the interaction between riders of different

events and how much the other disciplines have begun to accept reining.

"When we all went to the jumping to watch Mandy (McCutcheon) it was a special thing. There's a communication. Maybe we do it differently but they like horses; we like horses."

What about the ground?

"It worked okay - it was maybe a little harder than we are used to." He grinned, "But my horse would stop on concrete."

The Silver Medals in the Pro/Am Team event went to Pete Kyle on Seven S Mimosa

and Dr. Jim Morgan on Hesa Smart Chic. They earned \$7,645.

Gaetan Gauthier and As Smart As Charley teamed up with Dr. Kim Sloan on Cowboy to claim the bronze medals and \$4,865.

\$10,000 Invitational Freestyle

"This is the fifth and last time I'm doing La Bamba," laughed Pete Kyle, shortly after winning the Freestyle Reining class.

It was a little hard to take the Whitesboro, Texas trainer at face value, though, since the sultry, humid conditions kept making his fake mustache fall off. "I should have never taken it off after the Freestyle. Now it won't stay on!"

Although he had presented the routine previously, it was the first time for Kyle, the USET Active Rider committee chairman, to present La Bamba without Peppy Sol Anson, the stallion that his wife, Tamra, owns. He rode Dun It The Hard Way, his 1999 NRHA Derby Intermediate Open Champion.

"Anson" had been a USET semi-finalist and was slated to compete in the Pro/Am at the Festival of Champions, but was injured when he became cast in a stall at a layover stop on the way to New Jersey.

Pete has won the freestyle event at the NRHA Futurity, the All American Quarter Horse Congress, the Denver Stock Show, and gave an unforgettable performance in a special demonstration during the 1998 AQHA World Show.

"This feels great," Kyle said, then added. "The arena was so nice and big and the sound system was great. The crowd loved it." Kyle scored 232.5 and earned a \$3,682.50 payday.

Reserve winner Rocky Dare, of Salem, New Jersey, has twice won the freestyle reining at the All American Quarter Horse Congress, but his history with the event goes back to its beginning.

Dare won the first-ever NRHA Freestyle, when the event debuted during the NRHA Derby at St. Paul, Minnesota, then won it five times after that. He even did a freestyle demonstration during the Dressage competition at the Festival of Champions in the mid-80s.

At the 1999 Festival of Champions, his brand new routine on Miss Lena Gyrotor featured bridle-less maneuvers that thrilled the crowd and earned a score of 228.5. That was good for the silver medal and \$2,761.88.

Bronze winner, Robert Johnson, has won the freestyle twice at the All American Quarter Horse Congress and five times at Canada's Quarterama. He rode Reeboks Kid to a 223.5 score and collected \$2,148.13. ■

"I see the future containing exactly what the past has, but the difference is, I won't be sitting in the saddle as much," Sternberg laughed. "I've been beaten by both of my children

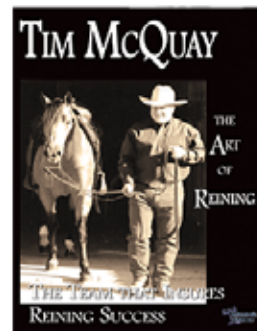
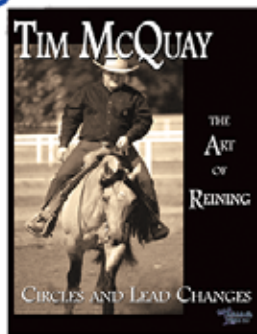
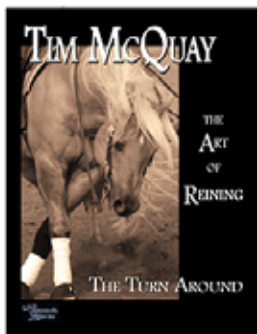
