News from the NRHA Derby Presented by Markel

2020 NUMBERS ARE UP!

With just two days left until the deadline for the 2020 NRHA Derby draw, the entries seem exceptional. And with the draw deadline not until 10 am on Wednesday, June 3, the entries should still increase.

Currently in the Open Derby, there are 220 entries – up 20 from last year’s total. In the Non Pro Derby, there are 232 entries – up 20 from last year’s 212. In the first year where 7-year-old horses are included, the show will highlight a ton of talent!

Stall numbers have ascended steadily as well and according to NRHA Events Manager Cheryl Cody, the show is going to be a big one. She noted, “We are excited that everyone seems to be so ready to have a reining. We are already right at the same number of stalls we had in 2019, with more coming today as it is the Horse Show deadline for NRHA non-aged event classes.”

Exhibitors and participants should expect this year’s event to feel different than in the past and the show will have a

more utility look this year. Cody continued, “We have been working closely with the Oklahoma State Fair to comply with their guidelines for the show and some of those might seem a little restrictive. But we are all so glad to get to have this show that I am confident our participants will do whatever it takes. From the State Fair side, it is important to understand that at the beginning of the Covid-19 outbreak, they actually had to shut down a very large event and they do not want that to happen again!”

The NRHA team plans to provide strong coverage during the event, including the live stream, which will be available at NRHADerby.com. Watch for the Non Pro Finals on June 19, and the Open Finals on June 20.

Founded in 1966, the National Reining Horse Association is a nonprofit association dedicated to promoting and encouraging the development of and public interest in the sport of reining. The focus is on developing and maintaining suitable standards of performance and judging and in providing a fun-filled, family-oriented atmosphere.

OUR CONDOLENCES: BECKY HANSON

Wife, mother, daughter, sister, coach, trainer, friend, fighter: these all describe Becky Hanson who passed away on May 25, 2020, after a seven-year battle with glioblastoma multiforme. Along with the entire reining community, the National Reining Horse Association (NRHA) mourns the loss of this NRHA Professional who leaves behind a legacy of philanthropy and tenacity, plus a vibrant zeal for life, horses, and family.

Born on September 1, 1971, in Mountain View, California, Becky essentially grew up in Eagle, Idaho. And that's where she graduated high school. Life after that was a roller coaster, in the best way.

Long before the chemotherapy and radiation, Becky graduated from Eastern Oregon University in 1993 with an English literature degree and a minor in secondary education. She intended to teach high school students. Instead, she became a horse trainer.

Married in July 1994, Becky and her husband, David, moved to Italy the very next year. It was clear educating high school students wasn't an option when Becky was training horses for Eleuterio Arcese and family. Becky's love for horses stemmed from her foundation in cow horses, cutting, and college rodeo as a breakaway roper.

David said Becky loved teaching, and that made her a perfect match for working with young horses. She redirected her love for teaching into giving lessons and had an uncanny knack for pairing horses and riders that complimented each other.

Becky and David spent five years training reining horses in Italy before coming back to California. Becky made the NRHA Derby finals and earned several North American Affiliate Championship placings. She also won the rookie pro title in 2006 as well as major event awards across the globe, all while coaching countless non pros to victory.

In 2000, Becky and David made their home in Clements, California, where the pair raised and trained reining horses together as Hanson Performance Horses. They were blessed with two children: Caden, now 18, and Lauren, now 16.



Representing the West Coast, Becky served on the NRHA Board on a recommendation from Rick Clark and was on the Eligibility and Affiliate Committees. During that time, Becky became close with several members, but one, in particular, was Joao Marcos, NRHA Board member. This led Joao to invite Becky and David to serve as instructors at his facility, along with NRHA Professional Ruben Van Dorp, for the first Reining Horse Foundation Rookie Day in Sao Paulo, Brazil, in 2016.

After 20 years' training reiners with her husband, Becky's life was turned upside down with a diagnosis in March 2013. She never let cancer become the story of her life; it simply became a platform. Becky dubbed her dance with glioblastoma multiforme as "My Little Tumor Adventure." Get

In naming this award, the Professional's Committee hopes her legacy will serve as a continuous reminder about what it means to be named Horsewoman of the Year. Becky was honored, proud, and truly humbled by it. Her emotions bubbled to the surface every time it came up.



Behind a lens, Becky was legendary. On a horse, she was iconic. But as a friend, she was irreplaceable. Upon her diagnosis, Becky felt the love of her horse community from near and far. It was the continuous display of humanity that hit harder than cancer ever could. It's what helped Becky fight the good fight. Here is just a small example of the love and support from the reining community.

Becky is known for her incredible photos of the Western lifestyle. The hobby quickly evolved into a business after returning stateside when Becky went digital and started selling her photos. Perhaps she is best known for her image of a large oak tree that sits in the front yard of the Hanson's family home. It helped shape her successful photography business. David said whenever Becky couldn't ride, she would return to writing about her situation and taking photos. This allowed her to connect to a whole new group of people. It shouldn't be surprising to all who knew her that Becky donated her body to science in hopes that she can help save at least one life.

Becky is survived by her parents, Rich and Diane, and is the eldest of three brothers: Scott and twins Kevin and Keith

REINING



Brenda and Dick Pieper

Reining has arrived as one of the horse world's elite events. It's a far cry from the days when it was regarded as "jerk and spur"—a rough, no-finesse type of contest. Much of the credit for reining's evolution goes to the event's governing body, the National Reining Horse Association (NRHA). In less than three decades, the NRHA has grown phenomenally from a membership of less than 100 people to nearly 5,000!

The first NRHA Futurity was held in October of 1966, boasting a total purse of around \$20,000. This year's Silver Anniversary Futurity, scheduled for November 26 through December 1 in Oklahoma City, will pay nearly \$600,000.

Dick Pieper is an Executive Committee member and former president of the NRHA, and has been at the forefront of the Association's growth, both in and out of the arena. Through Pieper's efforts, and those of his contemporaries, the NRHA is fulfilling its mission of "promoting the training, showing, and breeding of reining horses" and reining now has "an excellent shot at being a demonstration event at the next Olympics." Dick and his wife, Brenda, have built their own training business around this progressive event.

The Piepers' stallion, Texas Kicker, exemplifies the "trapezoid" conformation Dick and Brenda look for. The slope of Tex's shoulder equals that of his hip, his back is relatively short, and his underline long. When overall balance like this is combined with a quiet disposition, a performance like that shown at left is often the result.

DICK Pieper is a "great" in the horse training record books. His wins span four decades, and he is a perennial contender at the nation's biggest reining events. Not surprisingly, Dick's competition success is based on some iron-clad principles.

"Number one is that for a horse to be good at reining, he has to be a superior individual. That means he has to have excellent conformation, a great mind, and must be a trainable athlete. Our business is to find such a horse, train him, show him, then market him." The emphasis is on *training*. "We school our horses carefully, taking care to go at a horse's own individual pace and not to ask for more than he is capable of. A horse that is forced to do something instead of being trained to do it cannot win in today's competitive arena," he says.

Unlike many trainers, Dick does not operate a full-scale breeding operation, although a select handful of broodmares graze the pastures at his ranch. The champion reiner says he feels that not being tied to one particular bloodline allows him to focus on the athlete and look for superior individuals wherever he finds them and however they are bred.

Star Qualities

When the Piepers find a potential superstar, "we'll put 90 to 120 days on him. At the end of that time, we're sure or disappointed. If the horse is working right, we have eliminated as much of the risk as can be eliminated." So what does one look for in a reining prospect?

Dick divides the criteria into three categories: Conformation, breeding, and mental attitude. "The first decision is based almost solely on conformation and breeding because we know that certain bloodlines and combinations have been very successful in the past. The Colonel Freckles horses have been great for us, but the last crop is three now and there won't be any more. Probably a prominent producing son of the great stallion's will emerge." The trainer has also been pleased with the Top Sail Cody and Doc O' Lena horses. "We've had several Freckles Hustlers, Colonel Cody, and Corona Codys that have done well for us in the past as well. Basically, we're interested in looking at horses that are about one-quarter Doc Bar with a strong King influence on the maternal side."

The first thing Dick looks for as far as conformation is an absolutely

straight leg. "That means good knees, hocks, and ankles. I also want a good, round foot with some size, and adequate substance and bone. Of course, we look for overall balance and horses with strong hips and a lot of rear-end strength. They should be real strong over the loin and relatively short-backed. Those two things usually go together."

He likes a horse that stands a little higher at the withers than at the hip. "I like the withers set way back and I want a long, sloping shoulder. I've found that a straight-shouldered horse without a lot of slope has trouble turning around." Another important factor is neck carriage. He prefers a horse that naturally carries his head almost at wither level or just slightly higher. "We have found that a high-headed

horse hollows his back when he stops or turns around."

One final conformation point is purely cosmetic. "I want a pretty head. You've heard that horses don't have to be pretty to be good. Well, to win in big-league reining, they do. I want a horse to be striking enough that when he walks into the arena, the judge subconsciously hopes he does well."

The picture that emerges is of a balanced, pretty mover. "When you look at that entire horse's structure, overall

he should be shaped like a trapezoid. The slope of his shoulder should equal the slope of his hip; the back should be short, and the underline long." And, with the horse standing perfectly square, a plumb line dropped from the back of his hip down to the ground should fall behind his hock.

The horse's mind is also evaluated. "We want a quiet, laid-back horse that gives the appearance of being trainable and cooperative." If a horse has all these qualities, Dick is forgiving if he's a little long in the back. "That seems to be the one quality we can overlook. If that is the only mark against a horse, we might try him as a prospect, but other than that, we adhere very closely to our set guidelines."

Says Brenda Pieper, "We might look at 100 horses for every one we select for training." Adds Dick, "It's rare to find a great reining horse with poor conformation. It's even more unusual to find one like that who stays sound."

Starting The Prospect

The Piepers buy their horses as two-year-olds, and they are usually green or

unbroken when they bring them home. The colt determines how fast his own training progresses. "We let the horse go at his own pace. We'll longe him with the saddle, get him quiet, and let him learn as fast as he wants to." Dick works his colts in a 60-foot round pen. "I start all my horses in a hackamore, but that's a personal preference. Other trainers prefer a snaffle.

"Seventy-five percent of our horses go their entire two-year-old year in a hackamore. With some, we go ahead and go to a ring snaffle—it depends on the horse because some are more sensitive on their noses; others in their mouths. Again, other excellent trainers prefer to use a snaffle from the very beginning and they train some great horses. If it fits your style of riding

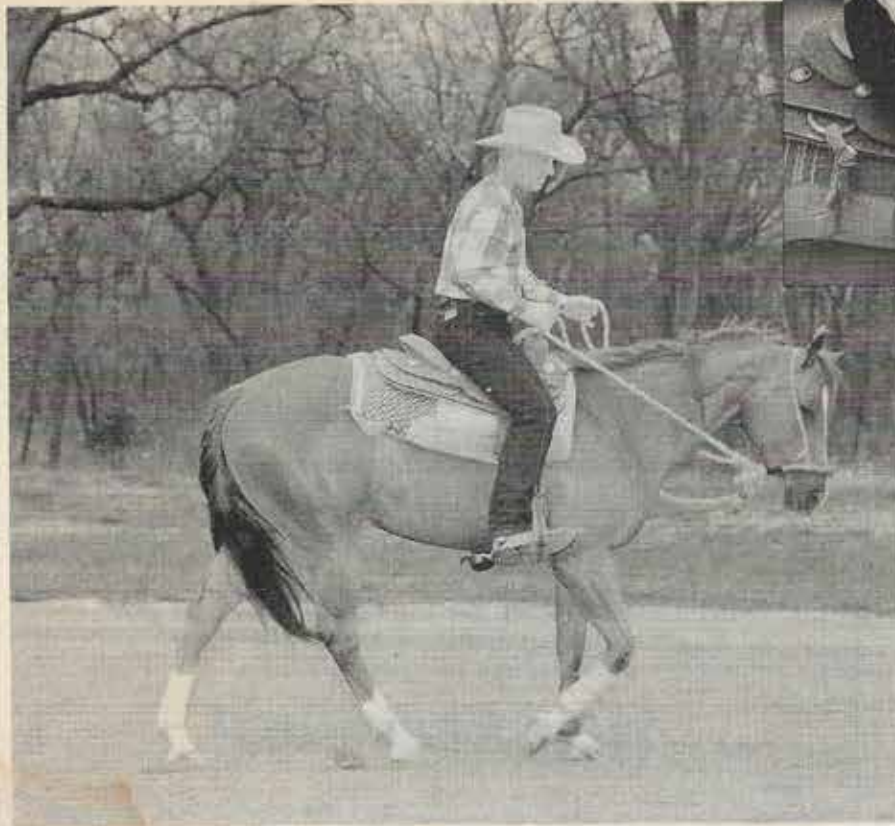

When starting a colt, Dick goes right into walking a lot of circles. To teach flexibility, he lifts the slack rein on one side to take hold of the horse's nose. If the colt resists at all, the tension is held (left), released, and then repeated. Hands should be held low and out to the side, level with the hip (inset). The pull should come from the shoulder with a slight give in the elbow—not by bending the wrist. And remember: Thumbs up and palms facing in and down.

After mastering the side-to-side pull, working on the poll is a matter of pushing the horse forward with the legs then taking up slack with both reins and holding until the horse "softens and gives." The theme is "Ask, and when the horse responds, release."



better, stay with a bit. Personally, I feel I can develop more confidence and keep the horses more relaxed and less stressed in the hackamore as two-year-olds.

"Around the first of January of the colt's three-year-old year, I do start him in a snaffle; about April I will go to a shank bit with a jointed mouthpiece and a curb strap or chain."

Whatever the headgear, after 90 to 120 days, the good prospect is loping nice circles and Dick has "changed leads a few times to make sure it is natural to him and there are no prob-

lems. He won't be reining or stopping, but when we lift on the reins and say 'whoa,' he should get his rear in the ground. In any case, he should have given us an idea of his abilities by that time and we'll have a good evaluation of how he is mentally and how he will train."

When the prospect has earned his chance at the big time, his education continues. During his two-year-old year, he will be taught to move freely forward at all three gaits without any restriction. "We'll spend a lot of time in the pasture, through woods and

streams . . . a lot of relaxing miles with no pressure."

From Side To Side

At the end of his two-year-old year, the prospect should have mastered three responses. "He should be real flexible and soft from side to side. When I pick up on the rein (even with a slack rein) he should start to give his nose without me having to exert any pressure.

"I want him soft in the poll so I can squeeze with both legs, take up slack in the reins, and the horse will step

After the horse is soft from side to side and at the poll, he can be introduced to leg pressure. The rider's leg should be positioned in the center of the rib cage, a little farther back than just behind the cinch.



If the horse doesn't respond to pressure from the calf of the leg, push harder, then push with the heel. If there is still no response, push with the rowel of the spur.



As soon as there is any response, no matter how minimal, drop your leg back to its original position. Keep the horse steady and walking in a straight line. With practice, the horse will learn to move readily away from leg pressure.



forward into the bridle." The horse should also be "moving away from leg pressure. My right leg moves his hip to the left; my left leg moves his hip to the right.

"That's all we require; if they know these things, they'll back, walk, trot, and lope—and they'll have the founda-

tion for every maneuver we will teach them as a reining horse.

"We take these maneuvers one step at a time. When starting a colt, I'll go right into walking a lot of circles. Using a hackamore, I'll lift the slack rein on one side, and take the nose. If

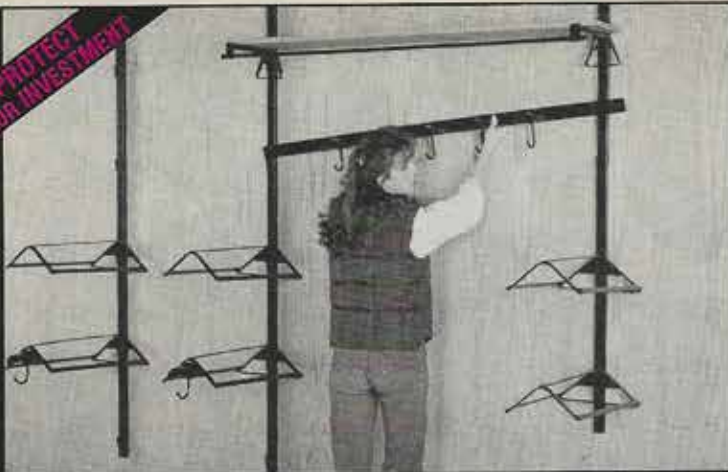

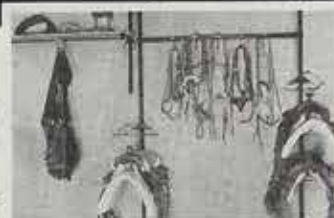

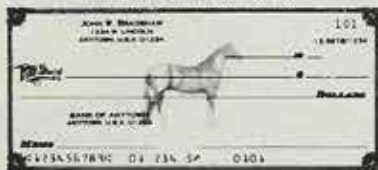

there is any resistance, I'll hold, then give it back, then repeat."

When Dick picks up the rein, he is keeping his hand low, but out to the side—about a foot to a foot-and-a-half out, level with his own hip. "Don't bend your wrist to pull the horse's head; the movement should be in your shoulder joint, with just a slight give in your already bent elbow. Your thumbs should be up, and the palms of your hand facing in and downward." Don't make a quick pull. Take your hand out to the side, lift the slack, and softly make contact with the horse. Then apply pressure."

"In the snaffle bit . . . (if) the horse doesn't respond, you can just hold until the horse releases and gives . . . Be sure to hold your hand steady at whatever position it's in so that the horse is the one that releases the pressure."

If you encounter resistance while encouraging the horse to be light and giving, and the horse tugs or pulls on the rein, Dick suggests trying the following: "In the hackamore, if you pull and the horse is holding against the pressure, you have to give back a little. Relax the rein with your hand and let the horse move his head away (he relaxes and thinks he got away with it.) When the slack gets back into the rein again, you 'bump' him with the hackamore; then hold, then release. He'll soon get the idea to let his nose come into your hand when you lift the slack.

"In the snaffle bit, the method is the same as far as making contact, but when you pull and the horse doesn't respond, you can just hold until the horse releases and gives. When he gives in to the pressure, you release it. Be sure to hold your hand steady at whatever position it's in so that the horse is the one that releases the pressure."

Response is gradual. In the beginning, you will probably not get a total release—just a sign of softening. Even-

tually, as soon as you start to lift slack the horse will start to give his nose.

Soft In The Poll

"We don't do anything about the poll until the horse is soft from side to side. Once he's soft there, you already have the battle won on the poll. He's learned that when you pull one side, he gives to that side; so when you pull both sides simultaneously, he drops at the poll."

Dick cautions against working on the poll before teaching the side-to-side pull. "If you try to get the poll before you ask for the side-to-side, you get too deep. The horse will have a tendency to bend more at the base of the neck than the whole neck."

Working on the poll is a matter of pushing forward with the legs then taking up slack with both reins and holding until the horse "softens and gives," then turning loose. The theme throughout all the reining horse's training is, "Ask, and when the horse responds, release."

Moving Away From Leg Pressure

After the horse is soft from side to side and at the poll, introduce him to leg pressure. Walk forward with slack in the reins; lift the slack, making light contact. The stride doesn't change. Lay your left leg back against the horse and push. If you feel the hip move, or give even slightly, release the leg pressure, then release the hands.

The rider's leg should be positioned in the center of the horse's rib cage, a little farther back than just behind the cinch. To begin, push with just the calf of the leg. If he doesn't respond, push harder, then push with the heel. If there is still no response, push with the rowel of the spur.

As soon as there is any response, no matter how minimal, drop your leg back to its original position. Keep the horse steady and walking in a straight line. The process is reversed to move the horse to the left. With practice, the horse will learn to move readily away from leg pressure.

These three skills, giving to the side and in the poll, and moving away from leg pressure, form the foundation for every maneuver and skill we will ask the horse to do as a reining horse. Mastering them signals that the horse is ready to move into actual reining training.

"Up until a few years ago, we broke our horses in January as three-year-olds. Now I've found that six months of quiet riding when they're two gives them this solid set of basic skills early. There's less pressure and they make

more relaxed, quieter horses because you didn't have to do anything in a hurry."

"Last year, I had the opportunity to ride the stallion Sargeant Freckles (now standing at Carol Rose's ranch in Gainesville, Texas). He had a tremendous set of basics put on him as a two-year-old. But then he was injured and laid up for 90 days during the summer. If not for that early schooling, those three months could have really made it impossible for him to be ready to compete at the All American Quarter Horse Congress Farnam Reining Futurity in October, much less win it. His strong training foundation allowed him to win over \$31,000 at his first two shows." ★

Next month, in our November '90 issue, Dick teaches us the basics of circles and spins.



The name is pronounced "Peeper," not "Piper," but the confusion over pronunciation has not kept Dick's name from being instantly associated with reining superiority. His wins include the NRHA Futurity, a reserve championship at the Reining Horse International (formerly the St. Paul Derby), AQHA Honor Roll, the AQHA Reining World Championship, and the All American Quarter Horse Congress and NRHA World Championships twice each. His horses are so well trained that once, when a headstall broke during competition, his horse finished the pattern without a bridle, with flawless spins and sliding stops.

That performance was such a crowd pleaser that he occasionally demonstrates a reining pattern sans bridle for various exhibitions throughout the world to promote the National Reining Horse Association. It's an exhibition of rider/horse communication that is not soon forgotten by spectators.
