2019 USA REINING YEAR-END CHAMPIONS ARE ANNOUNCED!

The 2019 came to a close and a 12-months' worth of USA Reining points were culminated to decide the year-end champions in ten different divisions: Open, Amateur, Youth 19-21, Youth 14-18, Youth 13 & Under, Para Reining Over-All, and Para Reining Grades 5 – 2.

Kellmer tops the USA Reining Open Standings on ARC Trashin Yer Chic

Battle Ground, Wash. resident Kyle Kellmer earned 14 points and was awarded the USA Reining Open Championship title aboard ARC Trashin Yer Chic owned by Greg and Kathy Goodlin. Kellmer has had the 8-year-old gelding by Gunnatrashya out of Whimpys Little Chic in training for 3 years and won the High Roller Reining Classic Level 2 Open Derby Reserve Championships with him.

Kyle said of the horse, “[I really love] the amount of try and focus that he has. He really likes to have a job and has gotten better and better every year.” The Goodlins purchased ARC Trashin Yer Chic from Shawn Florida/Arcese Quarter Horses.

Kellmer grew up training and showing in many disci-



plines with his father who was an AQHA Judge and Professional Horseman; however, his passion was reining and cow horses. In 2006, he changed his training program to focus solely on reining horses. He said, “The athleticism and minds that we are breeding into these horses. They have amazing talent but are also very smart with grit and determination.”

Kyle states, “I am extremely grateful to the Goodlin family. They have been long time clients and I have had the privilege of showing some very nice horses for them including this gelding.”

Hailing from Whitesboro, Texas, Francesco Martinotti slid into the reserve spot on El Capatan with 11 points. The 5-year-old horse is by Hollywoodstinseltown out of Spooks Peppermint.

Kulmer and Burns share the USA Reining Amateur Year End Championship



The USA Reining Amateur Championship was split between Morris Kulmer and Anne-Marie Burns who each



accumulated 18 points. Hailing from Aubrey, Texas, Burns rode her own 8-year-old gelding REF Sturgis. She has been

riding the son of Custom Harley out of Chics Time To Rein for five years.

Anne-Marie contributes her success to the help of her trainers, Tim McQuay and Cade McCutcheon. She says that Tim inspires her because “he is exceptionally patient and always willing to help me. He is an awesome coach.” She added, “I want to thank Tim and Cade! I'm most fortunate to be able to ride with Tim!”

Morris Kulmer won the co-championship with his favorite mount NVR What A Lucky Joe. The 5-year-old gelding is by Little Joe Cash out of What A Lucky Hit. Morris purchased NVR What A Lucky Joe from European AQHA president Roberto Cuoghi as a 4-year-old after Fappani had shown him in the 2017 NRHA Futurity.

Although native to Louisville, Ky., Kulmer now splits his time between summers in Bountiful, Utah and winters in Scottsdale, Ariz. He has been reining since his wife got him involved in 1994 and has since earned over \$175,000, an AQHA World Championship and Reserve Championship. He said, “I love competing and challenges, and reining gives that to me in spades! God has blessed me far more than I deserve with great horses, great trainers, and a loving and supportive wife and family.”

“I'm inspired by my grandchildren who are far better athletes and performing artists than me. Andrea Fappani, Dr. Jim Morgan, and Jose Vazquez are my mentors. Dan Huss is my trainer and has really helped me improve.” Morris added.

USA Reining Year-End Youth 14-18 Champions Named

From her mother's roots in reining, sprang Caitlyn Upham of Boerne, TX who was raised on the back of a horse. This year, Caitlyn was both 6th and 10th in the NRHA World Standing in the Youth 14-18 division. She also won the Youth and Rookie divisions in three different divisions, qualified for the Run For A Million Rookie, won two saddles and finished in the Top 10 in the Youth 14-18 at the NRHA Futurity.

She watched close friend and mentor John Edd Tucker show a gamey little horse for a few years, when her trainer, Nathan Piper, made arrangements for her to purchase the Wimpys Little Step gelding out of Miss Hollywood Whiz named Wimpys Lil Hollywood.

She said, “I always loved him and was ecstatic when I had the opportunity to purchase him. Wimpy has a lot of look and a lot of character. For a little horse, he has a lot of “go” and a huge heart. He’s truly one of kind and he loves the show pen as much as I do.” Now, at 11-years-old, Wimpy carried Upham to the top of the USA Reining 14-18 standings with an astounding 92.5 points!

My favorite thing about riding and showing horses is the challenge to always do better.” Caitlyn explained, “I set high goals for myself and have worked hard to achieve them and continue to reach for bigger goals. Going in the show pen is my favorite thing in the world, and I especially love doing it on Wimpys Lil Hollywood. The athletic and mental capability that horses in this discipline possess will never fail to amaze me.”

“I look up to both of my incredibly hard-working parents, Chad and Krista Upham. They work tirelessly to ensure that I can do the things I love and give me the tools to be successful in every area of life. They both constantly make sure that I know they love and support me no matter what and show me what it means to be unconditionally loving Christians and good people.” Caithlyn shared, “I would like to thank my parents and the rest of my family for their continued support. Also - to Nathan and Jean Piper, thank

you for believing in me and supporting me every step of the way. And to our barn family, “Team Unicorn”, thank you for always cheering me on!”

At 8-years-old with her first pony Lisa Pirtle, of Davie, Fla., began taking lessons with NRHA Professional Dave Moore. She was soon hooked on the exciting sport and now is the 2019 USA Reining Youth 14 – 18 Reserve champion. She rode three horses to the championship accumulating 80 points total on Wallas Corona (Walla Walla Whiz x Coronas Major), Xtra Sparkling Step (Wimpys Little Step), and Pryce Tag (Whiz N Tag Chex x Chic Lil Ruby).

Wallas Corona was her highest point earner. She has been riding the 8-year-old gelding purchased from Brian Bell for two years. She said, “He is a very talented horse who loves his job and what he does.”

“I am inspired by many people in the reining world but some of the main ones include my trainer, Dave Moore, Craig Schmersal, Jason Vandlandingham because I would like to grow up and be able to ride as good as them,” Lisa said, then added, “I would like to thank my parents who inspire me to always try my best and also my trainers, Dave Moore and Niki Tyndall, who teach me how to improve my riding.”

USA Reining Youth 13 & Under Year-End Champions

Topping the Youth 13 & Under standings with 15 USA Reining points was Anais Goedertier and her 10-year-old mare Check Out My Guns, better known as “Darlin”.

Shown by Mandy McCutcheon in her early career, the mare earned around \$17K LTE and then was turned out as a broodmare. Anais’s mom owned the daughter of Colonels

Goedertier said of the mare, “She has half an ear and a super quirky personality. I can’t imagine my life without her, and she will always be a part of our family.” Early this year, Darlin had back surgery so their year started slowly. Still, they won the 13 & Under Youth Maturity at the Best Little Derby in the West.

“I look up to and am inspired by Mandy McCutcheon. Reining is really a male-dominated sport and Mandy is right up there alongside them and even beating them. My mom likes to say before I show ‘Channel your inner Mandy.’ I’m still working on that!” she said with a laugh.

Like Mandy, Anais started out riding hunter/jumpers. She shared, “My mom always tried to get me to ride her reining horses, but I wasn’t interested. Loping in circles didn’t look fun. One day my mom asked me if I would be interested in attending a youth clinic with Jordan Larson, Casey Deary, and Jason Vanlandingham at Larson Ranch in Texas. I decided to apply and was able to attend. That clinic changed my life, I loved the way everyone interacted so positively with each other and the trainers were so patient, kind, and fun. Reining was way better than anything I had imagined. I was hooked!”

Anais added, “I’m thankful to the NRHA and my reining family for the opportunities and great experiences I’ve had in this sport. I’m excited to continue learning and improving. I still need to work on channeling my inner Mandy!”

One and a half years ago, Emily Berry, from Farmersville, Texas, had the opportunity to hop on a reiner during one of her riding lessons. Under her Instructor’s guidance, she ran a few circles and spun the horse a few times. Berry was hooked and now she is the 2019 USA Reining Youth 13 & Under Reserve Champion, having earned 10 points with her own reiner, Red White And Wimpy. The 13-year-old gelding is by Wimpys Little Step out of Sheza Bonita Whiz, and as Emily says, “He’s like a thousand-pound lap dog who will give his heart for you in and out of the show pen and can give a side eye like nobody’s business!”

Emily and Red White And Wimpy have had a successful year in the show pen including a SWRHA Green Reiner Reserve Championship, a WTRHA Youth Reserve Championship, an AQHA Top Ten Championship, multiple Green Reiner and Youth wins, and AQHA Youth World Qualification! She rides with Mark How of Visionary Equine in Pilot Point, TX.

Emily is passionate about reining and gains her inspiration from some very special people in her life. She stated, “My mom has been with me every step of the way and has believed in me when I’ve doubted myself. She is my biggest fan. I’d be lost without her guidance, love and support. She’s taught me that it doesn’t matter how great the challenge may be - you face it, work for it, trust the process, believe in yourself along the way and see what happens. If you don’t like the outcome, keep working it out and try again, we don’t quit!” She continued, “Mark How and his wife, Jessica, have been a tremendous level of support through my transition into their program and a world of knowledge

for me. I knew immediately during my first lesson with him that I was going to grow so much as a rider. They've created such a fun, peaceful and respectful training environment for not just me but for all of their clients. Mark has taken the

time to figure out how I learn, my strengths and weaknesses, as well as, my horse's, to bring out the best in us through training and competition. That is priceless to me."

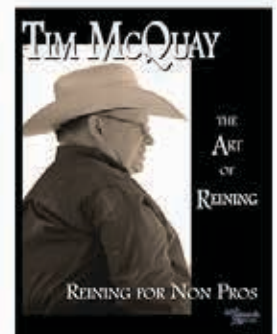
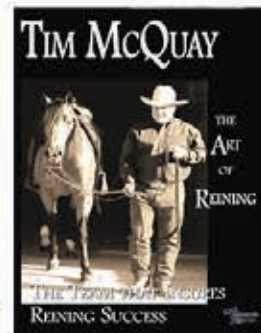
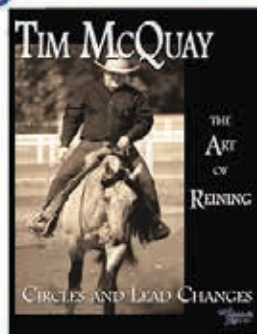
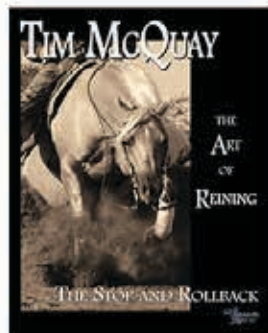
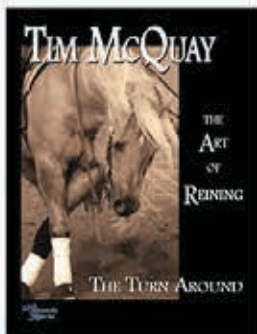
USA Reining Year-End Para Reining Champions Recognized



Through a challenging year, Melinda Davis managed to pull off the Para Reining Over All and Grade 4 USA Reining Championships - with 90 points - for the second year in a row. She started the year off strong with Royal Chexy Lady (Nu Chex To Cash x Shotoe Bobbie) because her gelding, Outlaw Whiz (Topsail Whiz x Genuine Starbright) or "Ozzie," was recovering from a hoof issue. Melinda owned the mare from 2010 to 2012, then sold her to Nick and Camiel Taylor for their daughter, Emma, to show. Royal Chexy Lady, better known as "Reba" served the girl well until Emma's basketball schedule got to hectic for her to ride.

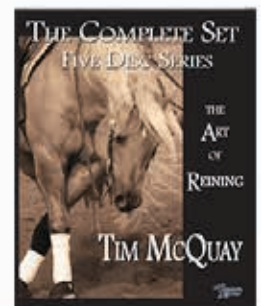
As luck would have it, when Ozzie was laid up last year, Reba was available, and Melinda jumped at the chance to renew her partnership with the mare on which she won both the NRHA and the AQHA Equestrians With Disabilities (EWD) Reining at the Dixie Nationals. She said, "Ozzie is a big, laid back, strong, gentle giant that is pretty much the same every time, and Reba, who rides more like a sportscar, has always taken care of me." out for me. They both are solid in their skills and have the right kind of work ethic that I believe a good Para horse needs to possess.”

Melinda’s luck seemed to run out when she had to have surgery preventing her from riding for almost 5 months; however, she is not one to take life sitting down. As soon as she was able, she began to work her way back in the saddle. She relied on Kip Ply who is a trainer local to her Little Rock, AR home to bring her horses back up to speed so she could finish the year with reliable Ozzie who earned the most USA Reining points of any horse in 2018.

Melinda believes that it takes a village to keep her showing at her best. She credits Andrew Fox and Bennie Mullins from Darling 888 Ranch, as well as Sam Schaffhauser, Garrett Gentry, and Tim Anderson for helping her at various venues. She even rode with Casey Deary in 2011 and ‘12.

“My favorite thing about riding a reining horse is the level of control, precision and the thrill of accomplishment after each maneuver.” She said, then added, “I would like to thank the shows for putting the Para classes in to include riders with disabilities. If it wasn't for that, I probably would be still riding my recliner instead of a reining horse! I would like to thank every single person that has helped me continue on this path.”



The Para Reining Over-All Reserve Champion, with 81 points, was Elizabeth “Beth” Kelley of Jamul, Calif. on her long-time partner Custom Birdie. She has owned the 10-year-old mare by Custom Crome out of Boomernics Birdie for six years. The dynamic duo also clenched the Para Reining Grade 5 Championship to top off a very successful year. They also won the Novice Amateur buckle at the Cats Ranch Horse Challenge, were reserve All-Around Ranch Horse at the Del Mar Nationals and won the Southern California Reining Association Year End Non Pro Reining Award for 2019. Even with all of those accolades, Kelley is most proud for her horse being named the Overall Highest Point earning horse in USA Reining!

“I saw reining for the first time at the Hollywood Charity Horse Show and wanted to try it. Once I started – its like eating potato chips – you can’t stop!” Beth, who has been reining for 15 years said, and then added, “I like the speed, and I love it when everything comes together and you plus your maneuvers. It's like dancing. Being limited in mobility on the ground, when I'm on my horse, I feel freedom. We can go anywhere together.”

Beth is grateful for the help she gets at Rancho Los Amigos in San Diego, Calif. from Melissa Shanholtz and Lori Riis, however, the most inspirational figure in her reining life is Manuel Campos from the same facility. She said, “He

has a great work ethic and has a great feel for the horse. I love watching him ride.” She also thanked USA Reining for giving Para Reiners the opportunities that they do.”



Sliding into the Grade 4 Reserve spot was Holly Jacobson of Ipswich, Mass. As an experienced Para Dressage rider, Jacobs had never ridden western before. She got involved with USA Reining’s para reining demonstrations several years ago both to see what it was like and help expand the mindset that disabled riders can actually ride. It was her horse, Shiney Juice’s (Smart Like Juice x Wind Her Up Shiner), that sealed the deal two years ago for her to transition fully to reining.

She said, “His athleticism, smoothness and personality are the reason I totally changed direction and disciplines.” She added, “He is a sensitive soul, a bit quirky but I have never seen him pin his ears at anything. He was a Futurity horse with Jose Vasquez (who bred him) but he allows me to learn on him and never gets upset at my mistakes.” Shiney Juice was also named the USA Reining Reserve Over-All Horse with 58.5 points.

NRHA Professional Tom Hoyt of Manlius, N.Y. was paramount in Holly’s introduction to reining. She said, “He also helped me pick out Juice and worked on slowing Juice’s brain down so I could safely ride him. Tom has been instrumental in our USA Para Reining Reserve National Championships the past two years. I’m also very fortunate to work with Dave Moore in Southwest Ranches for three months during the winter. As a judge who is also an incredibly patient, articulate teacher, it has been a great opportunity to learn the how and why of what I should be doing.”

“The pros are cool to watch but I really enjoy seeing the youth, the non pros, older riders, and other para riders striving to lay down those consistently good runs. Para rider Fred Win is a friend and a great example of determination and skill, plus an all-around great sportsman.” She said. “It has been an unexpected detour for me to gear up and start over in a new discipline after years in hunter/jumpers, and then dressage. I do enjoy the more relaxed and friendly reining atmosphere. My horse is my guide, he has all the moves, I’m trying to catch up.”

Jennifer Flanagan, of Bethpage, Tenn., earned most of the 54 points that won her the Para Reining Grade 3 Championship on Cromed Out Swagwagon (Cromed Out Mercedes x Gettin Er Dunn), but Dun It In A Blizzard gets credit for one USA Reining show.



The reserve championship in the Para Reining Grade 3 went to Heather Smith and Tivios Lil Dun It, better known as “Digby”. The 15-year-old palomino gelding is by Hollywood Dun It out of Tivios Lil Queen. Smith leased him for a year from Anne Dunnam before she recognized a unique connection with the horse and purchased him in 2018. Since then, they have been named World Para Reining Reserve Champions, MassQHA All-Around Reserve Champions, and MassQHA Champions in Para Reining, EWD Horsemanship and EWD Showmanship.

Smith’s affection for the horse was apparent as she said,

Smith was an avid athlete before being diagnosed with Sjojgren’s Syndrome which left her muscles unable to function properly. As she scrolled through social media, she came across a Para Reining demo. She said, “I fell in love at first sight and decided that is how I was going to achieve my athletic pursuits. In 2015, I rode in a few World Para Reining events and catch rode a few phenomenal reining horses. MassQHA was also gracious enough to add Para Reining to their class list; I entered my all-around horse into those classes, and we did respectably. Fast forward to 2020 and I have one stellar equine partner that is exemplifying what a para equestrian can achieve.”

Heather continued to gush about the horses who fills her competitive drive, “Reining horses are some of the most patient and forgiving equines I have ridden. All the reiners I have had the opportunity to ride have been fantastic teachers. My own reiner will always give 100% while keeping me safe (even on one of my off days). With such a solid training foundation, Digby has easily picked up in-hand classes and horsemanship to become a great ambassador in multiple para equestrian disciplines.”

When asked about her inspiration, Heather replied, “My Mom. She taught me to dream and set goals. Through-out my life she has shown me how to handle all situations with poise and grace as well as how to achieve my goals and dreams with humility. Mom has always been supportive of my siblings and I in the pursuits of our interests – no matter how crazy or short-lived a few may have been. She is a true Wonder Woman; at one point she was pursuing a bachelor’s degree in nursing, working part-time, driving the three us to our activities and still managed a spotless household that was full of love and warmth. I am fortunate to have my Mom [and best friend] travel with me all over the country (and even to Europe in 2017) for my para reining adventures. Always lending a helping hand, she can be found hauling a suitcase, hanging stall curtains or holding horses. As an inspiration, she began taking horseback lessons at the age of 68 and completed her first full show season at 69 winning a top 10 year-end award. My Mom has taught me to never act my age, to see the positive in EVERY situation, and to follow my dreams.”

With a grateful heart, Heather added, “I cannot the ask for a better village to be supporting me. As a para, you sometimes need a bit of an extra help, from the daughter that is my wonderful groom, to friendly trainers that are willing to offer up advice when I get stuck. I ride with Sabrina Obremski at Lower Maple Crest Stables who gave me the foun-

ation and tools to communicate with any horse as a para equestrian.” Then she added, “I aspire to inspire. My hope is that anyone that sees me, or another para equestrian, will be inspired to go for a ride regardless of physical ability. World Para Reining, USA Para Reining, and AQHA have given a great platform for how a horse can give you the freedom of four hooves.”



The Para Reining Grade 2 Championship went home to Haydenville, Mass., with Leslie Leblanc and her 8-year-old gelding Giddyup Go Stevie, better known as “Einstein.” The horse and rider team earned 9 USA Reining points for the title. While Leblanc has been partnered with Einstein for three years, she has only been reining for a year.

Leslie said of her mount, “He takes care of me and keeps me safe. Also he has great ground manners, is polite, loves to work, is very curious, and likes to play!” She added, “My reason for buying a reining horse was to get a horse who would have a good stop. Being a para rider, that makes all the difference. Einstein is capable of so much and always wants more.”

She credits Jill Haas of North Eastern Performance Horses in Deerfield, MA for helping to foster her love of reining and her relationship with Einstein. She feels like enjoying riding is her greatest accomplishment and she loves the continuous opportunity to learn more through her lessons

with Haas.

“I encourage everyone to try and never give up.” Leblanc

stated. “It’s been a long road for me, but perseverance is paying off. I find peace and calmness being with my horse.”



IEA BREAKS MEMBERSHIP RECORD AGAIN

Celebrating its 18th season, the Interscholastic Equestrian Association (IEA) has again set a record for membership. This season (2019-2020), membership numbers topped out at 14,444. While the highest concentration of members is East of the Mississippi; the Western states are experiencing a greater percentage of growth – especially in Zone 10 in California where IEA will hold the 2020 Hunt Seat National Finals in Burbank, California this April. The recent addition of the 4th and 5th grade Intro Rider Program as well as the explosion of interest in the new Dressage program has attracted many new IEA participants.

In 2002, IEA started with 175 riders on 13 teams and has become the largest youth equestrian organization in the Country and the largest feeder organization to collegiate equestrian programs – offering tens of thousands in scholarship awards and opportunities each season. Importantly, there is no need for any rider to own a horse to participate in the IEA. However, the participating teams and barns are expected to provide horses and equipment for the competitions. The IEA utilizes a draw-based form of competition whereby riders are given an unknown mount on which they compete – leveling the playing field and challenging the rider’s ability to adapt to different horses each ride.

“Our goal was never to become the largest ‘anything,’ said Roxane Durant, IEA Co-Founder and Executive Director.

“We have, however, stayed true to our core of introducing young horse enthusiasts to equestrian sport. We also wanted our student-riders to be recognized as the athletes they are. The success is a testament to delivering equestrian sport to a previously under-served marketplace demand. We have seen tremendous success in our first year of the Intro Rider Pilot Program and look forward to expanding it even further next season.”

The IEA Board of Directors, management and staff credit the thousands of volunteers who assist the organization, coaches and riders in making the organization successful. “It is a wonderful sense of Community among those associated with the IEA,” stated Durant. “With over 800 IEA horse shows across the nation and more than 92,000 rides each year – it would be impossible to operate without tremendous volunteer support.”

IEA Membership rates are very affordable and are the same for all disciplines – Hunt Seat, Western and Dressage. Fees are \$60 per individual member for the season. Teams are \$150. final leg of the sudden-death, four-event finals is where Swales and Metallic Cat Rose soared to the No. 1 spot. Their high score of 227.5 in the cow work combined with their 217.5 out of the herd, 218.5 in the reined work, and 215 in steer stopping for an 878.5 and \$42,000.

Swales, who had amassed \$693,143 in NRCHA lifetime earnings prior to the Celebration of Champions, has joined an elite group of only a few horsemen to have earned the title of World's Greatest Horseman twice. He first earned the honor in 2017 riding Heza Diamond Spark.

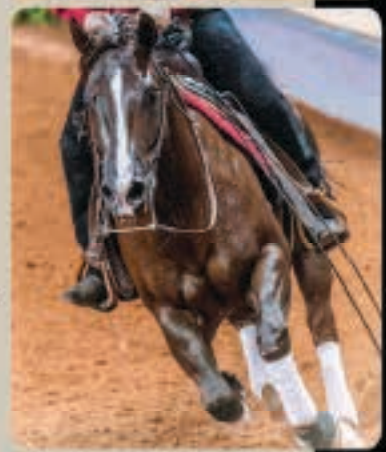

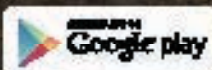
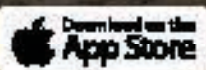

Savvy Circles

During a reining pattern the largest amount of time devoted to any single maneuver is given to circles. Presenting correct, eye-appealing circles is an essential skill for a reiner.

For Corey Cushing circles are fun! "If I have a really nice horse that will circle correctly, I know he's really with me," he explains, then adds, with a grin. "People in the reining horse industry know how important it is to have great circles. If they see you're in control in the circles, they really get loud!"

He continues, "If your horse doesn't want to circle it takes away from the whole picture, even if he stops good and spins good. Circles show control of your horse. A pretty set of circles is one where the horse guides good—is really moving forward, staying between the rider's hands—and stays correct on a loose rein, then comes back to you when you go from the fast to slow. A perfect example was Dell Hendricks on Hangten Peppy when he won the USET qualifier at the National Reining Breeders Classic last year."

Cushing, assistant trainer to National Reining Horse Association Futurity Champion John Slack, and himself the 1999 NRHA Intermediate Open Futurity Champion, has the opportunity to start a lot of colts. In his estimation, teaching circling skills is a priority.

"When I'm starting my colts circling—or anything for that matter—I try not to scare them. But it's especially important in circles because any time you scare them it's the first thought in their mind for a long time and their reaction to being scared in the circles can be to go too fast."

He continues, "So when it's time to start loping circles I want them to learn to stay relaxed. At any time, if I feel my horse is getting excited I'll slow things down and back

off a little. The more excited you get horses in circles the more problems you can expect in the show pen. Out there when they're by themselves without other horses, they're not thinking as straight, so from the beginning I spend a lot of quiet time in circles trying to not get them excited."

Corey explains that his first priorities for circling are getting the young horse to lope without dropping his shoulder and to respond to speed control cues.

"At this point I'm not really concerned about the horse being framed up as much as I am that he is keeping his body right. I want him to stand up in the circles. Any time he drops his shoulder I'll pick up on the inside rein while supporting him with the outside rein, use inside leg pressure and elevate the inside shoulder by moving him to the outside. When he picks up his shoulder I'll release the pressure."

The cues to increase or decrease speed will ultimately be given by the riders' body position. Corey begins the horse's speed control education by emphasizing this. "I'll get the horse loping then wave my legs and bump him up to a medium speed. I'll keep my hands right in the middle above the horse's neck and

put my hands forward a little to ask for speed. Then when I take my legs away and relax my body and sit down, the horse should come back to a pleasure lope or a walk.

"When I relax my body and legs, 80 per cent of the time they'll come back to me, but in the beginning a lot of them just stop. The idea goes through their heads when I stop asking them to go fast, that it means to stop. That's okay. They're getting the idea. If they stop I'll just reach forward and pet them on the neck. Then I'll lope a couple of small circles and try again."

Initially, increasing speed can be disconcerting to a young horse. "Sometimes I'll speed them up and they'll get a little looky and a little tense because they're not used to going that fast. And they don't notice when I ask them to slow down. If a horse really doesn't get the body cue I'll help him with my hands. If he's getting really scared or falls out of lead I'll pull him back down to a walk, let him get composed, then try again. I'll do the same things again, but maybe the next time I'll not go so fast."

How slow he wants the horse to go varies from horse to horse. "When I ask my horses to come back to me, I want him to slow down and lope as slow as he can, but not so slow that it looks stiff. I want it pretty – so that he is striding out and it looks natural. The slowest speed where a horse still has a pretty stride varies from horse to horse. I watch horses a lot so I can learn what looks pretty. Then when I'm on one I can usually feel if it looks good too."

Only when the horse has mastered the twin skills of staying correct without dropping his shoulder and letting the rider control his speed, does Cushing ask for the next component of the circles. "I'll start to teach him the frame I want him to maintain."

One key to that frame is that the colt will move his hip when cued. "A lot of colts are better with their hips. I want them to keep the inside shoulder lifted and to keep their hip underneath them," Cushing says.

"Some get out behind – especially when they increase speed – and when they do, they tend to fall out of lead behind. If I have one that does that, I'll slowly pull him into the ground and break down to a walk, then put my outside leg in the horse's outside rib cage

and push his hip to the inside while I'm holding the inside shoulder up. Once he gets the position I'll move him back into a lope, then when I push him into a faster speed, if he makes the mistake again I'll correct it again."

After a lot of repetition Corey will be able to move the horse's hip to the inside in the circles as he lopes, with cues that are increasingly subtle.

Concurrent with installing the body controls, Corey is teaching the correct head position. "I want a comfortable position for him that also fits me. I don't like one really rolled over with his nose in his chest. That doesn't look natural to me. I prefer a real level and comfortable position for my horses."

From the beginning the horse has been taught to give to pressure. When he moves his head in the direction of pressure laterally or straight back, he earns a release of that pressure. In the beginning the pressure is a kind of seesaw with Cushing's hands. "I don't really use my whole arm even at first. If they're really soft I might just use movement from my fingers."

Corey explains, "I'm teaching them from the beginning, when I pick up, 'this is where I want you to be.' If the horse resists I might get



The first priority in teaching correct circles is to teach the horse to keep his body correct, so that he's not dropping his shoulder. If the shoulder drops to the inside, Corey picks up on the inside rein, tipping the horse's head slightly to the inside as he moves him to the outside, picking up the inside shoulder.



When teaching speed control, Corey bumps the horse with his legs to move up to a medium speed. The rider's hands and body are slightly forward.



When he takes his legs away, relaxes, and sits down in the saddle, he's asking the horse to slow down.



At the early stage, if the horse translates that to stop, that's okay. He'll just move him back into a lope for a couple of small circles, then try again.



Finally the horse interprets the cues as a signal to reduce speed.

a little more aggressive, but as soon as he says 'I'll soften up for you' I loosen up."

He's been steering the horse in the circles all along but "I won't try it at first in the large fast circles until he's comfortable with it. Whenever he gets comfortable with that in a slow lope I'll do it at a medium pace and increase the speed from there."

When he teaches his horses to steer to the inside he picks up on the inside rein as he brings the outside rein against his neck. In the beginning the horse responds to the inside rein, then when the horse is really comfortable with that Corey lays the outside rein against his neck first.

"If he responds to that, fine. If not I'll reinforce the cue with the inside rein. Ultimately

they'll respond to the outside rein and that's good, because when you go to one hand that neck rein is what they're going to feel first."

To move to the outside he pushes to the outside like he did to elevate the shoulder, keeping the horse's nose tipped to the inside and gradually progressing to the point that the horse responds to the inside rein moving against his neck.

From then on, circles are just a matter of repetition as the horse learns to respond to even slighter cues. "We just take it one step at a time. When we get something done one day I'll quit and start working on something else. Next day we'll review what we did yesterday. Then if the horse is ready you can go on and ask for a little more."

Corey summarizes, "Although I'll lope every day, I don't work on circles over about two or three times a week. If you drill on the same thing every day in the same order, the horses get tired and sour."

Reining horses are usually shown for the first time midway through their three-year-old year. "I really try to take my time in that first show. I'll run the circles in what is just a comfortable speed for my horse. I want to stay away from getting him scared so he'll come back and be right there with me, rather than lose what we've taught at home."

Corey adds, "If the horse is really hooked up he'll likely circle well, but if he doesn't come back to me I'll pick up on the reins and ask him to slow down. I try not to let the horses

get scared the first time I show. It seems if I get them scared the first time they'll continue to be uncomfortable when you show them."

And, the more you show a horse the more potential there is for mistakes in the circles. Avoiding those mistakes requires maintenance. Corey gives an example, "Say I have a horse that tends to drop his left shoulder a lot. I'll overdo correcting that at home because I won't be able to fix it in the show pen."

He continues, "I'm going to exaggerate slowing down at home, where the horse is comfortable and understands it. I'll really make him rock back on his hocks and really slow down because in show pen he'll likely be a little excited and not come back as well."

Even with the right training and handling, horses get show smart or ring smart. Corey explains, "Some horses are perfect at home. Then when they get to the show pen, they know they won't be corrected and think they can do what they want. So, the older the horse gets the more schooling you have to do. Besides the home maintenance, we occasionally have to remind them we can fix them in the show pen, so we'll go to a schooling show and correct them in an actual class. Then when you show they'll be there with you."



Profile

Corey Cushing grew up in Sandy, Utah, riding with Noel Skinner and later Doug Milholland. From the beginning his interest was in riding reiners, although he does enjoy roping for fun.

For years he spent summers riding with John Slack, then, right before he graduated from high school, Slack asked if he'd like to work for him.

"It was a dream come true," says Cushing. He graduated from high school in 1998 and went to work for Slack at his Cave Creek, Arizona facility as soon as he got back from his senior trip. He celebrated his 20th birthday on February 14.

Corey was an Intermediate Open finalist at the National Reining Horse Association Futurity in 1998, then won the Intermediate Open title at the 1999 NRHA Futurity on Twice As Shiney, owned by J & W Quarter Horses of Sherman, Texas. He also qualified two horses for the 1999 Open Futurity finals.

"Paid warm-ups are good too. If he's going too fast, for example, you can bring your hand up and bring him all the way to the ground in a stop, then let him set until he's not rattled then do it again. Of course in a schooling show you can't do that much. You

can do it one time then go on. Try to get things fixed but don't overdo it and waste the judges' time."

With a solid foundation, clear cues, lots of repetition and maintenance, savvy circles can be any reiner's ticket to the pay window! ■



◀ If the horse lets his hip get out behind him as he's loping, not only does he not travel as pretty, he also risks falling out of lead.
