NRBC TEAMS UP WITH REIN IN CANCER FOR SILENT AUCTION AND FOOD DRIVE

Imagine trying to decide between gas to get to a cancer treatment or a meal to build your strength.

Or the choice could be between hay for your horses or dietary counseling to stop the endless nausea that accompanies chemotherapy.

The horrible truth is that these are not uncommon choices for those diagnosed with cancer.

“Facing cancer is a battle no one should have to fight, but unfortunately that horrible disease affects millions of people each year, including those in the reining industry. Helping those in the industry is the reason 501c3 Rein In Cancer was created,” noted Rein In Cancer co-founder and NRBC Sponsor Shorty Koger of Shorty’s Hattery.

The tumultuous year that was 2020 created even more of a hardship for many battling the disease.

“Food insecurity has become a major problem for cancer

patients because of loss of income due to the pandemic,” noted NRBC Media Director Savannah Magoteaux. “Nutrition can be the key to survival when fighting cancer, and there are so many patients who are struggling now. That’s why NRBC and Rein in Cancer are teaming up again to bring relief to the ones who need it most.”

In addition to the annual Rein In Cancer Silent Auction, which brings in substantial funds each year, the NRBC is asking its participants to bring storable food items as well. “Rein In Cancer is run by volunteers, so nearly 100 percent of money raised goes directly to cancer patients. Still, if a person would still like to help but isn’t sure about giving money, bringing canned or boxed food to the NRBC Show Office is a great way to help,” Magoteaux noted.

Rein In Cancer Silent Auction items can be dropped off at the NRBC Sponsor/Media Office, or shipped to the NRBC Office prior to the event.

Best donated food items for cancer patients include nut butters, low-sodium or no-salt-added beans, canned meats and fish in water, no-sugar-added applesauce and dried fruit. Canned vegetables are always welcome, as are brown/wild/white rice, no-butter popcorn, plain oatmeal, whole grain crackers, and canned soups.

“Other items that are commonly forgotten are can openers or even simple blenders for patients being fed through tubes

who have to blend their food. There are so many needs.” Magoteaux added, “Anything we can do to help, we want to do it. I don’t know anyone who hasn’t had someone they know be diagnosed with this disease. Our reining family is generous, caring, and we can help make a difference in many lives.”

SHORT STIRRUP RIDERS TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR SWRHA YEAR-END AWARDS IN 2021



The Southwest Reining Horse Association announced on April 1 that, beginning in 2021, Short Stirrup riders will be eligible for year-end awards. Points will be tracked on the SWRHA website from the affiliate’s approved 2021 shows and awards will be given through 8th place.

The SWRHA Board members unanimously voted to include this class in recognition of the youngest competitive reiners and one of those board members, Lindsey McCutcheon, spoke about the mindset leading to that decision. “Our goal is to be inclusive of every level of rider starting with this 10 and under group. We are glad to have these classes so everyone gets the best opportunities to begin showing in reining. You never know who might begin there and grow to be a serious competitor or trainer.”

Of course, the obvious example would be Cade McCutcheon, an SWRHA member who literally came up through the ranks of short stirrup and youth competition to million dollar rider status. Lindsey adds, “Whether they will ultimately have a career as a trainer or simply enjoy reining as a lifelong passion, what better way than to begin. They can start early and maybe even earn a college scholarship later on!”

Before the advent of the short stirrup class, very young reiners had to show against much older youth exhibitors – on more complex patterns. Now these 10 and under riders have their own starting point for them to feel special while making lifelong friends, learning the responsibility of horse care and experiencing competition.

The qualifying shows for 2021 include a few shows which have already taken place and are The Winter Slide and the History & Champions shows in Ardmore, the Warmup I in Waco, and the Spring Fling in Hamilton, Texas. Upcoming shows where points will be also counted are the National Reining Breeders Classic, set for April 18-25 in Katy, Texas,

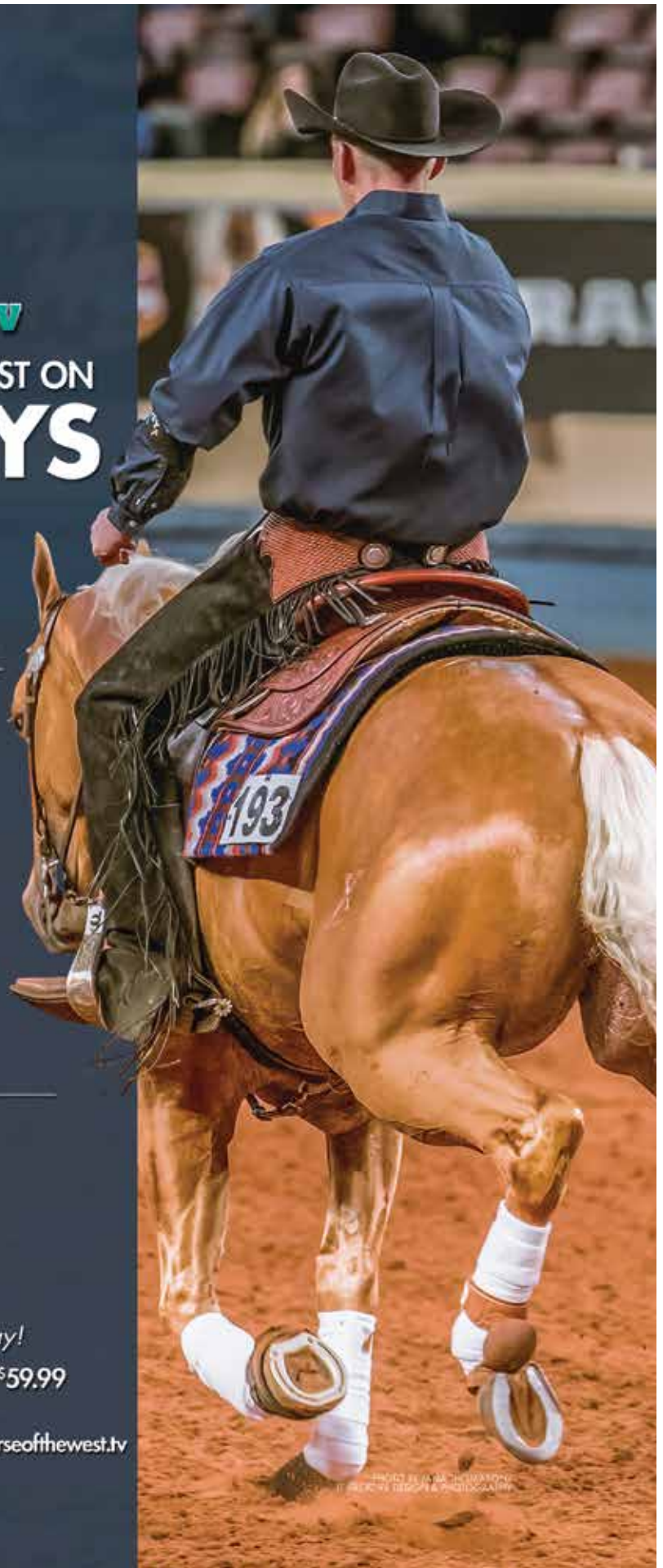

Tom McBeath



The 2020 Nutrena Don Burt AQHA Professional Horseman of the Year is Tom McBeath of Union, Mississippi. McBeath is a reputable AQHA Professional Horseman, approved AQHA judge and AQHA director. He previously served as chairman of the AQHA Show Committee and Show Council, served as a member of the AQHA Animal Welfare Commission and currently serves as part of the Mississippi Quarter Horse Association affiliate. Additionally, he is a member of the 2020-2021 Team Wrangler, a joint initiative between AQHA and Wrangler that promotes educational outreach for the horse industry.

McBeath has been an AQHA Professional Horseman since 1994 and AQHA judge since 2002. He has judged the Farnam AQHA World Championship Show; Built Ford Tough AQHYA World Championship Show; AQHA Select World Championship Show, presented by Adequan® (polysulfated glycosaminoglycan); AQHA Versatility Ranch Horse World Championships; and All American Quarter Horse Congress. McBeath operates Tom McBeath Quarter Horses, in addi-

tion to volunteering his time educating the next generation of horsemen and -women through judging initiatives, riding instruction and volunteering with universities and Equestrians With Disabilities initiatives. McBeath is passionate about teaching people how to ride and connecting people to the equine industry, while also encouraging his fellow AQHA Professional Horsemen to advocate for all aspects of the equine industry as a unified group.

Debra Cooper



The 2020 Nutrena AQHA Professional Horsewoman of the Year is Debra Cooper of Cave Creek, Arizona. Cooper is a longtime American Quarter Horse enthusiast and one of the original members of the Arizona Quarter Horse Youth Association. She has a passion for teaching people to enjoy horses. Her primary motivator is creating a journey of learning between horse and rider and applying her judge's perspective to instruction. Cooper has instructed and shown more than 20 AQHA world and reserve world champions across various disciplines.

Cooper has been an AQHA Professional Horsewoman since 1999 and an AQHA judge since 1989, while also holding a judges card with the National Reined Cow Horse association. She has judged every major AQHA event in the United States, including the Farnam AQHA World, Ford Youth World, Adequan® Select World and All American

Quarter Horse Congress. Outside of the United States, Cooper has judged the European Championship of American Quarter Horses. She has served on the Arizona Quarter Horse board of directors, is a member of the AQHA Professional Horsemen's Committee and has been an instructor for multiple Nutrena Ride the Pattern Clinics.

Eugene Spagnola



The 2020 Most Valuable Professional is Eugene Spagnola of Harwinton, Connecticut. Spagnola is a dedicated horseman who has been involved with the American Quarter Horse since he was a youth and remains active in all aspects of the industry today. Spagnola has coached AQHA competitors since 2000, became an AQHA Professional Horseman in 2001 and an AQHA director in 2021.

Spagnola is the manager and co-owner of Powderbrook Farm, where they focus on training quality all-around performance horses, while also teaching youth and amateur horsemen and -women to be better stewards of the American Quarter Horse. He has trained AQHA world and reserve world champions throughout his career in various events. Additionally, he is active in his local affiliate, serving as president of Region 6

According to APHA Member Care Representative Freddie Alexander, the highest scoring APHA-registered horses in the Non Pro and Open divisions at the 2021 NRBC will receive a beautiful Gist Silversmiths trophy buckle. The high-point paints in the Youth, Rookie, and Non Pro classes will also receive Gist buckles.

"I really enjoy coming to Katy, because you get to see the best horses in the world," noted Alexander. "I work with a lot of the breeders, trainers, and owners over the phone, so it's always great to meet those folks and form those good relationships."

It's a partnership that began several years ago. "When I took over this program in 2018, there was already a partner-

ship between APHA and NRBC. This is a cool program, and it has been a benefit for everyone involved. Reining is such an international sport that it really expands our footprint. There are so many reining horses that are either double-registered or eligible for it, and we can give the owners and riders the opportunity to win even more money and prizes," Alexander shared.

To be eligible to win one of the Gist buckles, exhibitors must sign up either in person at the event or by e-mailing falexander@apha.com. "I'll arrive on April 20 and have my mobile office set up, so in addition to signing up for the Buckle Incentive Program, owners will be able to register or transfer their paint horse, or even join the APHA while at the NRBC," Alexander shared. "We can also visit about what opportunities are available to reiners at our World Show this summer. We have grown the purse for reining from \$67,000 in 2018, to more than \$107,000 in 2020."

NRCHA STALLION STAKES OPEN & NON PRO CHAMPIONS AWARDED



Six set of finalists put on a show worthy of the Las Vegas lights on Saturday, April 3, at the South Point Arena & Equestrian Center for the 2021 NRCHA Stallion Stakes Open and Non Pro Finals! When the last cow was circled Erin Taormino and Hazardouz Materials, owned by Linda Mars, were the Open Champions, and Hope Mills and A Gritty Kitty took home the Non Pro Championship.

The event saw riders of all levels compete in reined cow horse classes in three arenas at the South Point. It was a record number of entries this year, and while a large show, the cow horse family spirit was still as evident as ever. On Saturday afternoon, NRCHA professional Shadd Parkinson, of Scottsdale, Arizona, donned an Easter Bunny suit to entertain the youngest of our youth enthusiasts during an egg hunt immediately before the Finals began.

Though there were minimal bodies in the stands due to COVID-19 restrictions in place in the state of Nevada, every seat emptied when cow crew boss Lloyd Faria carried the American flag to John Wayne's classic "America, Why I Love Her." NRCHA member Lexi Kastanis sang the National Anthem to kick off the Finals and that uplifted spirit carried into the Non Pro, and then Open, rein work.

The night wrapped with the crowd favorite fence work. The top three from each division—Non Pro, Intermediate Non Pro and Novice Non Pro as well as Open, Intermediate Open and Novice Open—reentered the arena to learn who



was taking home top titles.

In addition to awarding the horse, rider and horse's owner, the NRCHA Stallion Stakes pays an incentive to the stallion owner that subscribed to the NRCHA Subscribed Stallion Program. The program is open to any breed stallion and stallion nominator must be NRCHA members in good standing. Stallion owners can annually nominate that stud's foal crop so that it can be eligible for the incentive that pays as a portion of the Stakes event's added money.

The Stallion Stakes has \$198,970 in added money for the events. Horses entered in the limited age event must be sired by stallions nominated into the NRCHA Subscribed Stallion program.

Open Stallion Stakes Champion

Winning \$43,789.40 as your 2021 NRCHA Stallion Stakes Derby Open Champion is Erin Taormino riding Linda Mars' 2016 stallion Hazardouz Material (Metallic Cat x Scooters Daisy Dukes x Dual Smart Rey). The red roan and the Lipan, Texas, NRCHA professional scored a whopping 666.5 composite score to best the reserve horse and rider team by a half-point.

"I kept telling myself to work with what [cow] they kick out; work with what you get and that's what I did," she said of her fence run. "That cow was good and my horse felt phenomenal."

Receiving the win was emotional for Taormino, whose son joined her in the saddle for her dirt floor interview with Russell Dilday after the event. She was brought to tears discussing her support system.

“I couldn’t do it without them, they’re amazing people. They’re the reason I can do this,” Taormino said through tears. “My family hasn’t been able to come down from Canada [because of COVID-19] my friends, my family, I have the best support system in the world.”

Earlier in the week, Taormino rode the stallion to a 218.5 in the herd work. In the Finals rein work a 224 and a matching 224 down the fence carried the win. There were big scores during the four sets of cow work, but it was Hazardouz Material who saved a show for near to the end of the night, with his go in the fourth set.

The Open Stallion Stakes Champion was awarded a Bob’s Custom Saddle and a Gist buckle from the NRCHA, a straw hat from Western Legacy, a gift certificate for product from Platinum Performance and an UltraCruz prize pack from Santa Cruz Animal Health.

The Stallion Stakes champion sire, Metallic Cat, receives \$3,500 from the Subscribed Stallion Incentive and a C.R. Morrison NRCHA trophy.

In reserve was Saddling At Sunrise (WR This Cats Smart x Sunshine Ingredient x Mr Sun O Lena), a 2016 stallion owned by the Burnett Ranches LLC, winning \$32,263.66 for the title with Kelby Phillips, of Weatherford, Texas, in the saddle. Their composite score of 666 (Herd 219 /Rein 221.5 /Cow 225.5) included the high cow score of the night. Phillips was reserve and third place in the Finals. The Reserve Champion received a Gist buckle from the NRCHA, a \$300 gift certificate from Farnam for product, an UltraCruz prize pack from Santa Cruz Animal Health and a pair of DyNo Turn fleece bell boots from the NRCHA.

The sire of the reserve champion, GunnaTrashYa, receives \$2,000 from the Subscribed Stallion Program incentive.

Non Pro Stallion Stakes Champion

Hope Mills riding A Gritty Kitty (Chiquita Cat x Scooters Daisy Dukes x Dual Smart Rey) topped a deep Non Pro field of talented horses and riders to capture the 2021 NRCHA Stallion Stakes Non Pro Derby Champion title. Mills and the 2017 mare scored a 653.5 (Herd 217/Rein 216.5/Cow 220) for the win.

Having only purchased the mare right before the Celebration of Champions in February, Mills brought her to the Stakes as a trial run. To say A Gritty Kitty passed the test is

an understatement.

“This is our first big horse show together, so I am super happy that everything worked out,” Mills said. “She is super special because she gives me so much and tries so hard. We are still trying to get meshed together. My expectations weren’t high because we are getting to know each other. She just gave it all to me.”

Conincidentally, A Gritty Kitty was shown by Erin Taormino as a 3-year-old, and is a half-sister to the Open Champion, sharing a dam in Scooters Daisy Dukes.

Mills has a lot more confidence going into their next big event, the DT Horses Western Derby in June, she said.

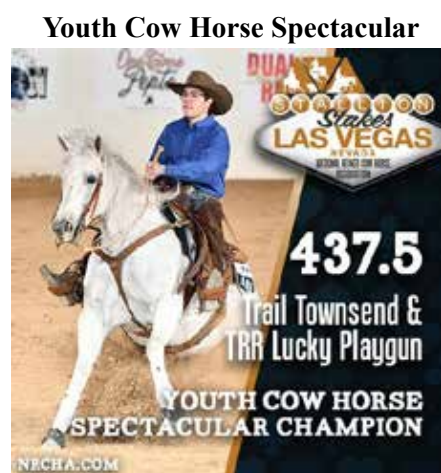
The Non Pro Champion is awarded \$8,207.55 and receives a custom Bob’s Saddle and Gist buckle from the NRCHA, a straw hat from Western Legacy, a gift certificate for product from Platinum Performance and an UltraCruz prize pack from Santa Cruz Animal Health.

The stallion nominator for Chiquita Cat receives a C.R. Morrison NRCHA trophy and \$1,500 from the NRCHA Subscribed Stallion Program Incentive.

Non Pro Reserve Champion Julia Winders also rode to the Intermediate Non Pro Champion title aboard Dual Smarty (Dual Smart Rey x Cats Gabriella Acre x Cats Merada), a 2017 stallion.

For the 648 (Herd 217.5/Rein 218.5/ Cow 212) that finished reserve, Winders pockets \$6,556.04 and receives a Gist buckle from the NRCHA, an UltraCruz prize pack from Santa Cruz Animal Health, a \$300 gift certificate from Farnam and a pair of DyNo Turn fleece bell boots from the NRCHA.

Siring the Reserve Champion is Dual Smart Rey, whose nominator receives \$1,000 from the Subscribed Stallion Program.



The Youth took center stage in the Main Arena at the 2021 NRCHA Stallion Stakes with the Youth Limited Spectacular and the Youth Cow Horse Spectacular kicking off Finals Saturday on April 3. In the Youth Cow Horse Spectacular, Trail Townsend and 2009 gelding TRR Lucky Playgun (Pepcid x TRR Ms Lucky Gun x Playgun) marked a half-point higher than the reserve run, winning the title.

For his 437 (Herd 142/Rein 145/Cow 150), Trail and his father, Tripp Townsend who owns the horse, earned \$450. It was the young man from Earth, Texas' first time to show at the Stallion Stakes and he said it's his new favorite show. Showing both his bridle horse TRR Lucky Playgun and also TRR Lucky Brazos in the Derby, Trail did double duty for the show.

"I had a little bit of trouble earlier in the week in the Derby," Trail said. "It was a relief to jump on this horse and go have fun!"

Trail is the 2020 MARS Equestrian™ World's Greatest Youth Horseman and has had consistent success on TRR Lucky Playgun over the years.

"I don't ride him extremely hard at home, just enough to keep him in shape for the shows," he said. "I try to take the best care of him as possible. I also ride him outside a lot to keep his mind fresh and give him something to think about besides competing."

In addition to the added money, Trail took home a C.R. Morrison NRCHA trophy, a Classic Equine embroidered sheet, gift certificate from Platinum Performance for product and an UltraCruz prize pack from Santa Cruz Animal Health.

Reserve Champion Catelyn Walker and her 2013 gelding Playin Motown (Mr Playinstylish x Mo Flo x Mr Peponita Flo) marked a 436.5 and earned \$375. She was also awarded a pair of Classic bell boots and front boots and a Classic bag from the NRCHA, and an UltraCruz prize pack from Santa Cruz Animal Health.

In the Youth Limited Spectacular, Laney Fjelstad was the first champion awarded of the day. Reserve in the Youth Limited Spectacular was Caroline

Buchanan riding 2010 gelding A Time For Jazz (One Time Pepto x Starlight And Jazz x Grays Starlight), owned by her mother, Anne Buchanan. Caroline earned \$390 and was awarded a Platinum Performance bag and Back on Track headband and socks from the NRCHA and an UltraCruz prize pack from Santa Cruz Animal Health.

Todd Bergen & Smartly Starstruck Win Open Bridle Spectacular



Tonight's Open Bridle Spectacular finished in a tie. The third, and final, set of the event dazzled the crowd with the two highest scores, and it also resulted in a tie for the win. However, the very last draw, Todd Bergen aboard Smartly Starstruck (Very Smart Remedy x Katie Starlight x Grays Starlight) marked the high score of the night, a 222.5. The composite 667 included three strong performances: 221.5 in the herd work and a 223 in the rein work.

Though there were minimal people in the stands of the Main Arena of the South Point Arena & Equestrian Center, the cheers were massive. The 2012 stallion had \$76,725.16 in NRCHA earnings prior to winning \$10,320 for the Open Bridle Spectacular win. Bergen and the stallion have been a team for some time, competing to tie for fourth place in the 2020 NRCHA World's Greatest Horseman and win the 2019 Open Bridle at the NRCHA Snaffle Bit Futurity®.

Owner Linda McMahon of McSpyder Ranch in Bend, Oregon, was on-hand for the win and, in a happy coincidence, received an early birthday present with her horse's new title. She also received a C.R. Morrison NRCHA trophy, a Classic Equine embroidered sheet from Classic Equine, a gift certificate for product from Platinum Performance and an UltraCruz prize pack from Santa Cruz Animal Health.

Sarah Dawson's 667 (Herd 225/Rein 221/Cow 221) on Shine Smarter (WR This Cats Smart x Shiney Tari x Shining Spark), owned by Linda Mars, was more than enough for the reserve and a check for \$8,256. The third-place horse was 4.5 points lower in composite score. The mare recently

received the American Quarter Horse Association Top Producing Dam. While still competing herself, the mare's offspring have earned \$130,656.75. Wade Reaney and Sinfully Smart Cat (WR This Cats Smart x Sinful Style x Docs Stylish Oak) to Reserve Champion in the Intermediate Open Bridle Spectacular. The 2013 gelding earned \$2,112 for owner Karen Olsen with a composite 657 (Herd 214/ Rein 218.5/Cow 224.5). The 224.5 tied with Kelby Phillips on Duals Lucky Charm (Dual Smart Rey x TRR Ms Pepcid Olena x Pepcid) for the high cow work score. Reserve champion received a Classic saddle pad from the NRCHA, a Saltwater Spa session from Oklahoma Equine Hospital and a pair of DyNo Turn fleece bell boots from the NRCHA.

Hip Hoppin' Victory for Landri Lisac

The Non Pro Limited Spectacular showed in the Main Arena today in Las Vegas, Nevada, at the South Point Arena & Equestrian Center. With 41 entries showing, 13-year-old Landri Lisac and her 2014 gelding Cat Walks Into A Bar (WR This Cats Smart x Sue C Shiner x Shining Spark) took the Non Pro Limited Spectacular title with a 431.5 (Herd 143/Rein 143/Cow 145.5).

Landri, from Pueblo, Colorado, has been riding "Grass-hopper" for a year-and-a-half to much success. The gelding has helped both Landri and her older sister, Lanni Jo, to



numerous NRCHA wins.

"He is a very good horse," Landri said. "He is always trying his best, giving it his all. He is calm and helps me through it. The herd went really well and it was the best I've ever done on him in the herd. That was the biggest accomplishment this week."

For the win, Landri earned \$3,940 and a slew of awards including a C.R. Morrison NRCHA trophy, a one-ear headstall with rawhide and silver from Dennis Moreland Tack, a gift certificate for product from Platinum Performance and an UltraCruz prize pack from Santa Cruz Animal Health.

In reserve was Ruth Jackson aboard her 2012 gelding Master Of The Seas (Yellow Roan Of Texas x Sugar Babe Taffy x Master Remedy) with a 428.5 (Herd 145/ Rein 141/ Cow 142.5), which earned \$3,152. The young man from Cathlamath, Washington, and his 2016 mare Time To Lay It Down (One Time Pepto x Katies Kitty x High Brow Cat) topped the 18-rider field in the Amateur division to take home their first premier event title, the 2021 NRCHA Stallion Stakes Amateur Championship.

A composite 645 (Herd 212/Rein 215.5/Cow 217.5) garnered the win, topping the reserve champion by 7.5 points. Their score was also high enough to secure a spot in the Non Pro Finals on Saturday, April 3.

Trent Pederson helped Landon get together with “Kitty,” after Andrea Luce purchased the mare at the 2020 Derby through Andy Kurtz.

“She is amazing; she can do it all! I am super excited to show her in the finals here and show what she can do,” Landon said. “She is just an awesome mare, a blast to ride, easy going and has a really good mind set. I can’t say enough about her. Kitty takes care of me.”

Landon previously earned \$3,376.75 in NRCHA and with this win, adds \$1,296. For the win, Landon takes home a Gist buckle, a one-ear headstall with rawhide and silver buckles from Dennis Moreland Tack, a Platinum Performance gift certificate, and an UltraCruz Prize Pack from Santa Cruz Animal Health.

As Time To Lay It Down’s sire, One Time Pepto receives \$1,000 Sire Award.

Reserve Amateur Champion Justine Munns and her 2017 stallion The Lena Look (Light N Lena x Look The Look x High Brow Cat) had a stellar performance at the Stallion Stakes. Their composite 637.5 earned \$1,036.80 and was the high herd score for the Novice Non Pro, earning \$70.15, and in the Amateur, earning another \$80. Prizes include a \$300 Farnam gift certificate, a pair of DyNo Turn Fleece Bell Boots from the NRCHA and an UltraCruz prize pack from Santa Cruz Animal Health.

The Non Pro Two Rein & Non Pro Bridle Entertain

The first of two Non Pro Spectacular titles awarded today went to Kat De Haan, DVM, in the Non Pro Two Rein. It was truly a family affair for the De Haan’s and 2015 gelding Smooth Dera Max (Smooth As A Cat x Dera Dually x Dual Pep). De Haan’s father, Harry, who owns the gelding, purchased Dera Dually because of her offspring, Dera Cat, that had been so successful for him.

“Dad looked up the mare and bought her, sight unseen, and she had a breeding to Smooth As A Cat, which would be a full brother to Dera Cat,” De Haan said. “I had just come



home from veterinary school when [Smooth Dera Max] was born and I actually delivered him. That’s kind of cool! I’ve had him for a solid year and we’ve been very successful in the derbies.”

Though their names were atop several smaller shows win lists, this is the first premier event for De Haan and “Max” to earn a title. She credits coach and NRCHA Hall of Fame rider Dan Roeser, of Marsing, Idaho, for getting she and Max to the show and through the two rein event.

“Dan Roeser helped me get him in the bridle,” said the equine veterinarian from Nampa, Idaho. “His tips have been so helpful and he’s got so much knowledge. I used my dad’s bosalita and Dan’s bridle, so it all came together today. It was really sweet we were able to put it together today because my dad and my mom are here. It’s really a family affair.”

The pair also earned the Non Pro Two Rein class win today, pocketing \$1,350. For the Spectacular, the composite score of 431 (Herd 143.5/Rein 142/Cow 145.5) helped De Haan ride away with \$2,760 in earnings and a C.R. Morrison NRCHA trophy, a one-ear headstall with rawhide and silver buckles from Dennis Moreland Tack, an UltraCruz prize pack from Santa Cruz Animal Health and a gift certificate for Platinum Performance.

Reserve Non Pro Two Rein Spectacular Champion Debbie Crafton and 2015 gelding Metallic Flame (Metallic Cat x Scooby Dooby Dual x Dual Pep) finished with a composite 430.5 (Herd 143.5/Rein 143/Cow 144), earning \$2,208 in the class. The Ordway, Colorado, Non Pro also finished second in the Non Pro Two Rein class, adding \$1,137.50 to their winnings. Prizes for reserve were an UltraCruz prize pack from Santa Cruz Animal Health, a salt water spa session from Oklahoma Equine Hospital and a pair of DyNo Turn Fleece Bell Boots from the NRCHA.

Thirty-six horse and rider teams competed in the 2021 NRCHA Stallion Stakes Non Pro Bridle Spectacular for the \$10,000-added event. A familiar face was at the top of the scoreboard: Cutter McLaughlin and CD Dee Vee Dee (CD



Lights x Shiners Missy Jay x Shining Spark). With a composite 441 (Herd 148/Rein 144.5/Cow 148.5), Cutter and “DVD” finished a point-and-a-half higher than the reserve champion.

The 2005 gelding has NRCHA earnings of \$263,380.12, prior to adding this paycheck of \$5,024 to his earnings. Cutter has \$100,413.64 in earnings and was named the 2021 MARS Equestrian™ World’s Greatest Youth Horseman Champion, riding DVD. The event was a goal Cutter aspired to for some time. Now, showing DVD anytime is just an added bonus for the Clarendon, Texas, rider.

“I am so lucky to have such a talented horse that can go from such a high-pressure situation at the Youth World’s Greatest to another prestigious event,” said Cutter. “My best moments [at the Stakes] were my cutting and my fence work because I am so blessed to ride an amazing athlete that takes such good care of me and loves his job.”

The dynamic duo also topped the Non Pro Bridle class adding another \$2,200. For the Non Pro Bridle Spectacular, Cutter received a C.R. Morrison NRCHA trophy, a Classic Equine embroidered sheet, a Platinum Performance gift certificate and an UltraCruz prize pack from Santa Cruz Animal Health.

Taking reserve in the Non Pro Bridle Spectacular and also second in the Non Pro Bridle is Addison Fjelstad riding 2006 gelding Mini Mes Mercedes (Mini Me Merada x Spooks Hickory x Olenas Command). Her composite 439.5 (Herd 147/Rein 144.5/Cow 148) earned \$4,019 in the spectacular and \$1,760 in the horse show class. She took home an UltraCruz prize pack from Santa Cruz Animal Health, a saltwater spa session from Oklahoma Equine Hospital and a pair of DyNo Turn Fleece Bell Boots from the NRCHA.

Denille LePlatt on Hannas Metallic Rey Earns First-Ever Title

In the Non Pro Limited, Denille LePlatt and her 2016 mare Hannas Metallic Rey (Metallic Cat x Rehanna x Dual Rey) were a consistent duo, riding to the championship after three successful go-rounds. Scoring a 657 (H:218/



R:217/C:222), the pair topped the division by three points, earning LePlatt her first major event win.

“My goal has been to win a major event and I’ve been so close, so many times,” said the southwest Colorado competitor. “This is tough competition!”

LePlatt teamed up with Hannas Metallic Rey just before the 2020 Stallion Stakes, in August, and made the move to Andy Kurtz training barn. It paid off with consistent runs, but nothing has compared to winning her first premier event title.

“For right now, I’m just trying to enjoy the moment,” said LePlatt. “It feels like a relief. I’m going to show at the Derby in Scottsdale and I’m starting to do Beginning Fence Work.”

For the win, LePlatt took home \$3,412.80, and \$189.60 for the high herd work score, \$126.40 for tying for the second-highest rein work score and \$110.60 for tying for second-highest cow work score. In addition, she received a Gist buckle, one-ear headstall with rawhide and silver buckles from Dennis Moreland Tack, a gift certificate for product from Platinum Performance and an UltraCruz Prize Pack from Santa Cruz Animal Health.

As the champion’s sire, Metallic Cat will receive \$500 for the Sire Award.

Reserve Non Pro Limited Stallion Stakes Champion Calley Rae Satriana rode her 2016 mare Smooth Cat Voo (Smooth As A Cat x Voodoo Chic x Smart Chic Olena) to a composite 654 (Herd 215/ Rein 217/ Cow 222). She earned \$2,730.24 for the win, \$110.60 for tying for the second highest herd work score and \$126.40 for tying for the second highest rein work score. As reserve champion, she received an UltraCruz prize pack from Santa Cruz Animal Health, a gift certificate for \$300 for Farnam product and DyNo Turn Fleece Bell Boots from the NRCHA.

Sarah Murphey & HQ Wilma Gotta Kitty win Level 1 Limited Open Championship



Sarah Murphey earned her first premier event title in Las Vegas, Nevada, aboard HQ Wilma Gotta Kitty (Meteles Cat x Wilma Gotta Gun x Spooks Gotta Gun). Murphey and the 2016 mare have been so close but until this show, hadn't grabbed that golden ring.

Murphey credits a cow that was fast enough to hook the mare with their coming out on top with a composite 649 (Herd 214/Rein 215/Cow 220). The roan had \$10,479.11 in NRCHA earnings, prior to this win, and added \$3,694.32 for the championship and \$195.47 for the high cow work score in the division.

"She is consistently good down the fence and with the cow, I know I can trust her," Murphey said. "I was really thankful that I got that cow [tonight]."

The trainer from Lipan, Texas, never wanted anything other than to train and began working toward that goal at 15 years old with NRCHA professional Luke Jones. She worked for Jones until she graduated high school and moved to Texas where she worked with Boyd Rice and Bill Freeman, then with Todd Bergen and rope horse trainer J.D. Yates. All the time as an assistant helped Murphey gain a solid background in the cow horse. Now she is on her own as a trainer and HQ Wilma Gotta Kitty's owner Reid Hockenson supports Murphey's business with a couple of horses for her to show.

"I've been assistant training a long time and I was ready to start showing," she said. "I also have a mare I consistently show in the cutting [for the Hockenson's]. I met them through Luke [Jones] and they have opened a lot of doors for me."

Awards in the Level One Limited Open include a Gist buckle, a one-ear headstall with rawhide and silver buckles

from Dennis Moreland Tack, a gift certificate for product from Platinum Performance and an UltraCruz Prize Pack from Santa Cruz Animal Health.

As the champion's sire, Meteles Cat will receive \$500 for the Sire Award.

The 2016 stallion added \$2,902.68 to his lifetime earnings and also received an UltraCruz prize pack from Santa Cruz Animal Health, a gift certificate for \$300 for Farnam product and DyNo Turn Fleece Bell Boots from the NRCHA.

Open Novice Horse Champion Heza Rowdy Cat & Clayton Edsall



Clayton Edsall and Heza Rowdy Cat (Bet Hesa Cat x Dear Little Boon Bar x Boon Bar) earned the top spot in the Open Novice Horse through three solid performances in the 2021 NRCHA Stallion Stakes derby preliminaries. The composite 661 (Herd 215/Rein 221.5/Cow 224.5) was enough for the win.

Earlier this year, the 2016 stallion previously placed eighth in the Tres Osos Cow Horse Derby held during the NRCHA Celebration of Champions in Fort Worth, Texas.

"I just got him in November and showed him in Fort Worth for the first time," Edsall, of Oakdale, California, said. "They canceled some shows before we left [for the Tres Osos Cow Horse Derby] so I didn't get a chance to show him much. We kept going to get him ready here. I didn't get him through the herd work like I liked but he was really good in the reining and the fence work."

There were 15 sets of cow work today, with the high score of the entire Open division cow work coming when Edsall

and Heza Rowdy Cat were the first horse out in the twelfth set, marking a 224. With \$7,282.39 in lifetime earnings, the payout from the Open Novice Horse gives the stallion, owned by Kim Basterrechea, a boost with \$6,313.32 and also \$2,560.61 from the Open cow work high score.

"I thought he was an awfully good horse because he got me out of a bind in Fort Worth with a really fast cow, and this is 100 percent confirmation," Edsall said. "He has a lot of stop—a lot of stop—and really wants to go with the cow."

Awards include a gift certificate for product from Platinum Performance and an UltraCruz Prize Pack from Santa Cruz Animal Health.

As the champion's sire, Bet Hesa Cat will receive \$500 for the Sire Award.

With a 662 composite (H:221/R:218/C:223), the 2015 roan gelding and Erin Taormino topped the 33-horse Spectacular field by a point and a half.

Taormino has trained the roan since late in his 2-year-old

year. Prior to this win, the horse had earned \$28,466.80 in reined cow horse competition.

"We've made finals and he's never won anything big but has been a steady horse," Taormino said. "We gelded him this winter and he really loves the gelding life."

When she learned of the win, Taormino was all smiles.

"He's a really fun horse to train," she said. "The two rein class, the competition in it is incredible. The horses are amazing and the riders are amazing. To win [this class] in such a fabulous group is just an honor."

Matt Koch & Smart Ladies Sparkle Top Two Rein Class



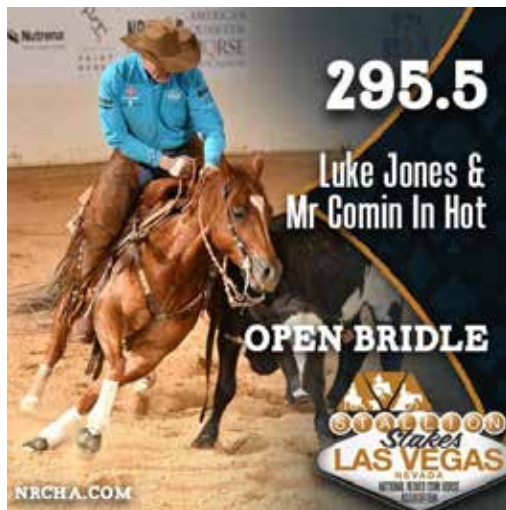
